THE TWINS: The Twins opened their 62nd season with a 2-1 loss to the Mariners yesterday...they will continue the four-game series against Seattle with the second of four today...following this series, the Twins will host Los Angeles-NL for two games on Tuesday and Wednesday.

JUST FEET AWAY ON OPENING DAY: The Twins lost their 2022 Opener by a score of 2-1 to the Mariners at Target Field yesterday...Joe Ryan (0-1) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on two hits in 4.0 innings pitched, setting a career-high with four walks while throwing 70 pitches...Jhoan Duran made his major league debut with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief, striking out four of his nine batters faced...the offense recorded four hits with the only run scored coming on a Gio Urshela fourth-inning solo shot off Robbie Ray...Gary Sanchez missed a walk-off two-run homer with a 361-foot fly ball to leftfield to end the game...the attendance was 35,462.

THE DURANTULA: Jhoan Duran became the first Twins pitcher to throw at least 2.0 scoreless innings of relief and strikeout at least four batters in his debut since Mike Walters (4.2 IP/4 K) on July 8, 1983 vs. CLE...he threw three of the five highest velocity pitches yesterday: Duran 100.7, TB's Shane Bieber 100.5, Duran 100.3, NY's Aroldis Chapman 100.2, Duran 100.1.

ALWAYS SONNY: Sonny Gray was acquired via trade with Cincinnati on March 13, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Chase Petty...Gray, 32, started 26 games for the Reds last season, going 7-9, 4.19 ERA (135.1 IP, 63 ER) with 50 walks, 155 strikeouts, a .225 (115-for-512) opponent batting average and a 1.22 WHIP...the two-time All-Star (2015, '19) has appeared in 223 career major league games (214 starts) for the Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18) and Reds (2019-21), going 82-72, 3.61 ERA (1267.1 IP, 508 ER) with six complete games (including 4 shutouts), 453 walks, 1221 strikeouts, a .231 (1,093-for-4,740) opponent batting average and a 1.22 WHIP...he ranks tied for seventh in starts (204) among right-handed pitchers since 2014, 10th in innings pitched (1203.1), 11th in opponent batting average (.231), and 12th in strikeouts (1,154)...he was the 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher, finished second in voting for the MLBPA's NL Comeback Player of the Year Award (behind Josh Donaldson) and seventh in the NL Cy Young Award voting.

SEATTLE'S BEST: The Twins and Mariners are playing each other for the second of seven scheduled games in 2022...they will travel to Seattle for three games at T-Mobile Park from June 13-15...the Twins are just 1-5 in their last six vs. the M's, dating back to April 10, 2021.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .311 (28-for-90) with five doubles, one home run and eight RBI in 22 career games against the Mariners, hitting safely in 16 of those 22.

☞ Carlos Correa has reached safely in 17-straight games against the Mariners, hitting .343 (23-for-67) with seven doubles, six RBI, 14 runs scored, eight walks, a .413 OBP and a .891 OPS in those games...his 99 career hits and 98 career games against the M's are his most vs. any opponent...more information to the right.

☞ Joe Smith was traded from Houston to Seattle (along with Abraham Toro) on July 27 of last season...after the trade, he held opponents scoreless in 19 of 23 appearances, posting a 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER) with opponents hitting .185 (12-for-65) and four walks.

I SEE A BAD MAN ARRAEZ-ING: Luis Arraez enters today with a seven-game hitting streak which dates back to September 26...in his career, he has hit .331 (218-for-658) against right-handed pitching, compared to .258 (54-for-209) against left-handed pitching...additionally, in 246 career games, Arraez's batting average has never dipped below .307 (September 26, 2021).

FELIZ CUMPLEAÑOS, LUEY: Luis Arraez is celebrating his 25th birthday today...he has never appeared in a major league game on his birthday...he has played in one minor league game on his birthday, coming in 2016 with Cedar Rapids at Quad Cities (1-for-3, BB, R)...he shares a birthday with actors Dennis Quaid, Jay Baruchel, actress Kristen Stewart and rapper Lil Nas X.

C4: Carlos Correa signed with the Twins on March 22...the Santa Isabel, Puerto Rico native was selected first overall (Buxton 2nd) by the Astros in the 2012 MLB Draft out of Puerto Rico Baseball Academy and has batted .277 (782-for-2828) with 162 doubles, eight triples, 133 home runs, 489 RBI, 438 runs scored, 347 walks, a .356 on-base percentage and an .836 OPS in 753 career major league games, all with Houston...Correa's 34.1 career WAR, per Baseball Reference, ranks sixth among major league position players since 2015.

WHO'S WHO: The Twins opened the 2022 season with 19 players on their 28-man roster who were not on the 2021 Opening Day roster: pitchers (13) - Chris Archer, Dylan Bundy, Jharel Cotton, Danny Coulombe, Jhoan Duran, Sonny Gray, Bailey Ober, Chris Paddack, Emilio Pagan, Jhon Romero, Joe Ryan, Joe Smith and Josh Winder; catchers (1) - Gary Sanchez; infielders (3) - Carlos Correa, Nick Gordon and Gio Urshela; and outfielders (2) - Gilberto Celestino and Alex Kirilloff...of the 28 players on the Twins' active roster, 11 began their professional careers in the Twins organization...Winder is the only two remaining players looking to make their major league debuts...the oldest on the club is Joe Smith (38 years, 0 months, 18 days) and the youngest is Gilberto Celestino (23 years, 1 month, 27 days).

I'D LIKE TO BUY A VOWEL: High-A Cedar Rapids third baseman Christian Encarnacion-Strand went 4-for-5 with two home runs and a franchise Opening Day record nine RBI in the Kernels' 12-5 win over Beloit yesterday...Encarnacion-Strand's nine RBI were the second-most in a single game in both franchise history and Midwest League history...CES was originally selected by the Mariners in the 34th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Yavapai College in Prescott, AZ...he was later drafted by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2021 Draft out of Oklahoma State University.

SPRING CLEANING: The Twins finished their 32nd Spring Training in Fort Myers, FL on Tuesday with a record of 9-10...Byron Buxton led the club in hits (15), runs (8), doubles (5), home runs (5) and RBI (13)...Bailey Ober led the club in innings pitched (12.0), while Dylan Bundy and Jhoan Duran tied for team-lead in strikeouts (10)...additionally, the Twins drew 45,055 over 19 openings for an average of 5,006-per-game.

THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1995, Twins Hall of Famer Bob Allison passed away in Rio Verde, Arizona, at the age of 60 after a long battle with ataxia...Allison was inducted into the Twins Hall of Fame in 2003...in 2000, the Twins beat the Kansas City Royals, 13-7, as both teams each hit three consecutive home runs in the same game for the first time in baseball history...Ron Coomer, Jacque Jones and Matt LeCroy did it in the sixth inning...Carlos Beltran, Jermaine Dye and Mike Sweeney of Kansas City two innings later.
