† Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 9-6 against the Rays, going 5-4 at Tropicana Field and 4-2 at Target Field (since 2019).

† The Twins are seeking their fifth series win over the Rays in their last six chances...their last series win at Tropicana Field was from May 30-June 2, 2019, taking three of four.

MR. DEVIL RAY: Rocco Baldelli played in 215 career games at Tropicana Field as a member of the Devil Rays and Rays from 2003-08 & '10, hitting .284 (231-for-813) with 45 doubles, 10 triples, 18 home runs, 103 RBI, 130 runs scored and 32 stolen bases...Rocco ranks 10th all-time in stolen bases at the Trop, tied for 11th in runs scored, 13th in hits and doubles, and tied for 15th in RBI.

SONN-DAY IN THE SONN-SHINE STATE: Right-handed pitcher Sonny Gray is scheduled to make a rehab start for Low-A Fort Myers against Clearwater today at 1:00 pm (ET)...Gray was placed on the 10-day Injured List on April 17 with a strained right hamstring...he left his start the previous day at Boston after 1.2 innings pitched.
