THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 4-3 (2-1 in Tampa Bay and 2-2 at Baltimore), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a three-game sweep of the A's over the weekend...

TWINS GIFT A MOTHER'S DAY SWEEP: The Twins beat the A's on Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-3, marking their third consecutive one-run victory...

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have placed shortstop Carlos Correa (right middle finger contusion - retroactive to May 6) and right-handed pitcher Chris Paddack on the 10-day Injured List (right elbow inflammation - retroactive to May 9).

SEEING STARS: The Twins and Astros are playing each other tonight for the first of six times in 2022...the Twins will play three games in Houston from August 23-25...

TWINNING: Below are hitting and pitching comparisons for the first 12 games and last 17: Table with columns: AVG, R, H, 2B, HR, BB, K, OBP, SLG, OPS, RISP

ONE RUN FUN: The Twins have won three-straight one-run games for the first time since August 21-23, 2015 (4-3, 3-2, 4-3 all at Baltimore)...they are 7-3 in one-run games this season...

THE SKIP: Bench coach Jayce Tingler has managed for Rocco Baldelli (COVID) the last four games (3-1) and will manage tonight...his results in box to the right...

TWINS ON TARGET: The Twins have won nine straight at Target Field, their longest home winning streak since also winning nine in-a-row July 21-August 18, 2010...

CELEBRATE GOOD TIMES: Gilberto Celestino is hitting .440 (11-for-25) with three doubles, one RBI, one walk, five runs scored and a 1.041 OPS in his last eight games (Twins 7-1)...Celestino was originally signed by Houston in July of 2015...

PITCHING IN: Twins pitchers have combined to post a 3.11 ERA this season, the fourth-best in baseball...additionally, they have a 29.2% swing and miss rate, also fourth-best in baseball...

WEEK OF SERVICE: The Twins and their six minor league affiliates are in the middle of the inaugural "Minnesota Twins Week of Service" from May 3-11...

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took a no-decision in his last start on May 3 at Baltimore, allowing two runs on a career-high-tying six hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings...also plunked two batters in a single outing for the first time in his career...tossed 57 of his 81 pitches for strikes (70.4%), his second start this season with a strike percentage of over 70 percent (also, April 15 at Boston)...departed with the score tied 2-2; Twins scored thrice in the sixth and twice more in the seventh to win, 7-2.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Earned his career-best third-straight win on April 27 vs. Detroit, working a career-high-tying 7.0 shutout innings and yielding just one hit and one walk, with nine strikeouts, good for his third career start with three-or-fewer base runners allowed...marked the first Twins starting pitcher to work in the seventh inning in 2022...tossed 90 pitches, his most in a start in his career and his most in a professional outing since also throwing 90 pitches in the second game of a doubleheader on August 30, 2019 with Double-A Montgomery in the Tampa Bay Rays system...Ryan also doesn't like wearing sleeves when he pitches, so made a fashion statement by wearing a turtleneck to stay warm.

☞ Recorded his third-straight quality start, the longest streak by a Twins hurler since Kenta Maeda's run of four straight from August 1-18, 2020.

☞ Became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history with two outings of at least 7.0 shutout innings with one-or-fewer hits allowed within his first nine career games.

**SEEING STARS:** Facing the Astros for the first time in his career tonight...also marks his second career start against the American League West division, after facing Seattle on Opening Day, April 8 (L, 4.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 4 K).

**NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE:** Ryan is making his third night start of the season tonight and is 1-0, 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and 12 strikeouts in those starts...has made four career starts in day games and six in night games, entering tonight – is 2-1, 1.71 ERA (21.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks and 21 strikeouts in the daytime, compared to 3-1, 3.51 ERA (33.1 IP, 13 ER) with six walks and 37 strikeouts at night...his night numbers are slightly skewed by his outing on September 30, 2021 vs. Detroit, when he allowed six of his 13 career runs in night games...subtracting that start, he's 3-0, 2.20 ERA (28.2 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 32 strikeouts at night.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and 52.2% of the time through his first three starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

**DISCOMFORTS OF HOME:** Ryan has fared better on the road than at home so far in his career – is 1-2, 4.21 ERA (25.2 IP, 12 ER) with nine walks and 28 strikeouts in five career starts at Target Field, compared to 4-0, 1.57 ERA (28.2 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and 30 strikeouts in five career starts on the road...his home numbers are skewed slightly by his start on September 30, 2021 vs. Detroit, in which he allowed six of his 12 career earned runs at Target Field...subtracting that start, is 1-1, 2.57 ERA (21.0 IP, 6 ER) with seven walks and 23 strikeouts at home.

**MASTER OF THE FIRST INNING:** Ryan has allowed just two hits in the first inning in his career – a Mitch Haniger two-run home run on Opening Day, April 8 vs. Seattle and an infield single by Trey Mancini in his last start on May 3 at Baltimore – and is holding hitters to a .063 (2-for-32) opponent batting average in the opening frame in his career...his .063 mark leads the majors since the start of 2021 (min. 30 opponent at-bats in the first).

**THE GOAL IS...TO THROW STRIKES:** Ryan has posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent twice this season, on April 15 in Boston (73.2%; 80 pitches, 62 strikes) and May 3 at Baltimore (70.4%, 81 pitches, 57 strikes)...has thrown at least 70 percent of his pitches in the zone in a single outing five times in his career (career best percentage is 74.6%, done in the first game of the doubleheader on September 14, 2021 vs. Cleveland)...owns a 68.8 career strike percentage, which ranks ninth in the American League since the start of 2021 (min. 50.0 IP).

**GOOSE EGGS:** Posted a career-high 20.0-inning scoreless streak from to the third inning on April 15 at Boston to the third inning on May 3 at Baltimore...streak is the longest by a Twins pitcher this season.

☞ **Per Elias, Ryan's 20.0-inning scoreless streak is tied with Jim Hughes (20.0 IP; May 14-24, 1975) for the second-longest run by a rookie starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present), trailing only Joe Mays (20.1 IP; July 17-29, 1959).**

**APRIL SHOWERS:** Went 3-1, 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP, 3 ER) in four April starts, recording the lowest ERA in March/April by a rookie in Twins/Senators history (min. 20.0 IP)...his ERA also marked the fifth-lowest ERA by a rookie in a single month in Twins/Senators history (min. 20.0 IP), trailing only Jim Hughes (0.87 ERA in May 1975), Milo Candini (0.88 ERA in June 1943), Jim Shaw (0.91 ERA in September 1914) and Francisco Liriano (1.13 ERA in May 2006).

**MAKING THE LORAX PROUD:** In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 28 batters so far, which will lead to 1,400 new trees planted.

TOMORROW'S STARTER – RHP CHRIS ARCHER (2022 SEASON: 0-0, 3.26 ERA // CAREER: 61-81, 3.87 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Archer is scheduled to start tomorrow night's game against the Houston Astros...did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 5 at Baltimore, allowing two runs on five hits (2 HR), with no walks and a season-high six strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...six strikeouts marked his most since also fanning six on August 29, 2021, also at Baltimore...is due to face the Astros for the ninth time in his career (all starts), going 5-2, 2.15 ERA (54.1 IP, 13 ER) with 11 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .160 (30-for-187) opponent batting average in his eight prior outings...last faced Houston on August 1, 2017 in Houston (with Tampa Bay), and two of his three career complete-game shutouts have come against the Astros (July 14, 2013 and August 20, 2015).

CAREER NOTES

- 2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Single-A Bowling Green (6 starts), Single-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
- Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts...earned the win in his professional debut on June 22 vs. Vermont, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings (2 H, 3 K).
- Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
- Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams, including first team All-America honors by the Division II Conference Commissioners Association...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.

**THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE:** Below are some facts that summarize Ryan's career to date.

- ☞ Ryan has 58 career strikeouts, tied with Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven for most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first 10 career games...the record for most strikeouts through a pitcher's first 11 is 62, held by Blyleven.
- ☞ His .168 career opponent batting average is the lowest mark in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first nine career games (min. 50.0 IP).
- ☞ Owns a 4.83 strikeout-to-walk ratio through his first 10 career outings, also best in Twins/Senators history (min. 50.0 IP) in a pitcher's first nine career games.
- ☞ Ryan posted a 0.74 WHIP through his first nine career starts, the lowest WHIP by any MLB pitcher through his first nine career starts since Hall of Famer Christy Mathewson from 1900-01 (0.70) (*Stats Perform*).
- ☞ Ryan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games (from September 1-22, 2021), the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so.
- ☞ He became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.
- ☞ On September 8, 2021 at Cleveland, Ryan worked 7.0 shutout innings and allowed one base runner, a single...became the first pitcher in American League history to toss seven-or-more shutout innings and allow one-or-fewer base runners within his first two career starts (*Stats Perform*)...retired the first 19 batters he faced, first Twins pitcher to do so since Francisco Liriano retired the first 19 on June 12, 2011 vs. Texas (*Elias*).
