THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 4-3 (2-1 in Tampa Bay and 2-2 at Baltimore), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a three-game sweep of the A's over the weekend...tonight, the Twins will continue their season-long homestand with the first of three against Houston through Thursday afternoon, followed by three against Cleveland this weekend.

♣ After starting the season 4-8, the Twins have now won 14 of their last 17 games, with a run differential of +34 (77-43) in those games...since April 21, their 14 wins lead baseball.

♣ Due to Minnesota Wild NHL Playoff scheduling conflicts, tonight's Twins game can be seen on Bally Sports North Extra.

TWINS GIFT A MOTHER'S DAY SWEEP: The Twins beat the A's on Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-3, marking their third consecutive one-run victory...it marked the first time since August 21-23, 2015 (4-3, 3-2, 4-3 at Baltimore) in which the Twins won three-straight one-run games...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits in 2.1 innings pitched, exiting in the third inning due to right elbow inflammation...Cody Stashak (2.2), Caleb Thielbar (1.0), Joe Smith (1.0), Tyler Duffey (1.0) and Emilio Pagán (1.0) combined for 6.2 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Gilberto Celestino, who set a career/season-high...the Twins went 3-for-8 with runners in scoring position.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have placed shortstop Carlos Correa (right middle finger contusion — retroactive to May 6) and right-handed pitcher Chris Paddack on the 10-day Injured List (right elbow inflammation — retroactive to May 9).

♣ Correa, who suffered the injury on May 5 at Baltimore after fouling a ball off his hand in the seventh inning, was hitting .412 (14-for-34) with three doubles, one home run, eight RBI and a 1.033 (DPS in eight games leading up to the injury...the 27-year-old was signed by the Twins during spring training and was hitting .255 (24-for-94) with five doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, 12 runs scored and eight walks in 24 games this season.

♣ Paddack exited his start on Sunday afternoon against Oakland in the third inning...the 26-year-old was acquired by the Iwins via trade with the San Diego Padres on April 7 and made five starts for Minnesota this season, going 1-2 with a 4.03 ERA (22.1 IP, 10 ER), two walks, 20 strikeouts and a 1.21 WHIP.

♣ To replace Correa and Paddack on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contracts of outfielder Mark Contreras and right-handed pitcher Jharel Cotton from Triple-A St. Paul... Contreras played in 26 games for the Saints this season, hitting .239 (21-for-88) with five doubles, one triple, five home runs, 17 RBI, 16 runs scored, 14 walks, five stolen bases and a .350 on-base percentage...the 30-year-old Cotton made four relief appearances for the Saints, posting a 2.08 ERA (4.1 IP, 1 ER) with three hits allowed, no walks and eight strikeouts...he made the Twins' Opening Day roster, appeared in two games and pitched 2.0 scoreless innings prior to being designated for release or assignment on April 13.

SEEING STARS: The Twins and Astros are playing each other tonight for the first of six times in 2022...the Twins will play three games in Houston from August 23-25...last season, the Twins went 4-3 against the Astros, going 1-2 at Target Field from June 11-13 and 3-1 at Minute Maid Park from August 5-8...the Iwins are 35-36 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 24-27 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

Twins have won three of their last four against the Astros in the regular season, four of their last six and six of their last nine.

Jorge Polanco is hitting .327 (32-for-98) with four doubles, two triples, six home runs, 17 RBI and a .966 OPS in 25 career regular season games vs. Houston.

Gio Urshela has hit safely in each of his last eight games against the Astros, hitting .379 (11-for-29) with a .455 on-base percentage and a .972 OPS in that span.

ONE RUN FUN: The Twins have won three-straight one-run games for the first time since August 21-23, 2015 (4-3, 3-2, 4-3 all at Baltimore)...they are 7-3 in one-run games this season, tied with Houston (7-5) and Arizona (7-3) for the third-most one-run wins in baseball, trailing Toronto (10-5) and Tampa Bay (8-4)...the club's longest streak of consecutive one-run victories is four, done six times, last was June 16-19, 2011.

THE SKIP: Bench coach Jayce Tingler has managed for Rocco Baldelli (COVID) the last four games (3-1) and will manage tonight...his results in box to the right...Tingler was the skipper in San Diego for two seasons from 2020-21, compiling a record of 116-106 (.523)...he led the Padres to a .617 winning percentage in 2020 (37-23), the best in franchise history.

TWINS ON TARGET: The Twins have won nine straight at Target Field, their longest home winning streak since also winning nine in-a-row July 21-August 18, 2010...their last home winning streak longer than nine was 13 from June 11-July 2, 2006...additionally, their 11 home wins are tied for second-most in baseball with two other teams (New York-AL leads with 12).

CELE-BRATE GOOD TIMES: Gilberto Celestino is hitting .440 (11-for-25) with three doubles, one RBI, one walk, five runs scored and a 1.041 OPS in his last eight games (Twins 7-1)...Celestino was originally signed by Houston in July of 2015 and played parts of three seasons in the Astros organization...he was acquired by the Twins on July 27, 2018, along with right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala (60-day IL — right elbow inflammation) in exchange for Ryan Pressly.

PITCHING IN: Twins pitchers have combined to post a 3.11 ERA this season, the fourth-best in baseball...additionally, they have a 29.2% swing and miss rate, also fourth-best in baseball.

© In their last 12 games, the bullpen has combined to go 5-1, 1.12 ERA (48.2 IP, 6 ER) with opponents hitting .161 (27-for-168), with 10 extra-base hits (6 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs), eight walks, 54 strikeouts, 10 holds and five saves.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his last start on May 3 at Baltimore, allowing two runs on a career-high-tying six hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings...also plunked two batters in a single outing for the first time in his career...tossed 57 of his 81 pitches for strikes (70.4%), his second start this season with a strike percentage of over 70 percent (also, April 15 at Boston)...departed with the score tied 2-2; Twins scored thrice in the sixth and twice more in the seventh to win, 7-2.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his career-best third-straight win on April 27 vs. Detroit, working a career-high-tying 7.0 shutout innings and yielding just one hit and one walk, with nine strikeouts, good for his third career start with three-or-fewer base runners allowed...marked the first Twins starting pitcher to work in the seventh inning in 2022...tossed 90 pitches, his most in a start in his career and his most in a professional outing since also throwing 90 pitches in the second game of a doubleheader on August 30, 2019 with Double-A Montgomery in the Tampa Bay Rays system...Ryan also doesn't like wearing sleeves when he pitches, so made a fashion statement by wearing a turtleneck to stay warm.

Recorded his third-straight quality start, the longest streak by a Twins hurler since Kenta Maeda's run of four straight from August 1-18, 2020.

Became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history with two outings of at least 7.0 shutout innings with one-or-fewer hits allowed within his first nine career games.

SEEING STARS: Facing the Astros for the first time in his career tonight...also marks his second career start against the American League West division, after facing Seattle on Opening Day, April 8 (L, 4.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 4 K).

NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE: Ryan is making his third night start of the season tonight and is 1-0, 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and 12 strikeouts in those starts...has made four career starts in day games and six in night games, entering tonight — is 2-1, 1.71 ERA (21.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks and 21 strikeouts in the daytime, compared to 3-1, 3.51 ERA (33.1 IP, 13 ER) with swalks and 37 strikeouts at night...his night numbers are slightly skewed by his outing on September 30, 2021 vs. Detroit, when he allowed six of his 13 career runs in night games...subtracting that start, he's 3-0, 2.20 ERA (28.2 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 32 strikeouts at night.

DISCOMFORTS OF HOME: Ryan has fared better on the road than at home so far in his career — is 1-2, 4.21 ERA (25.2 IP, 12 ER) with nine walks and 28 strikeouts in five career starts at Target Field, compared to 4-0, 1.57 ERA (28.2 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and 30 strikeouts in five career starts on the road...his home numbers are skewed slightly by his start on September 30, 2021 vs. Detroit, in which he allowed six of his 12 career earned runs at Target Field...subtracting that start, is 1-1, 2.57 ERA (21.0 IP, 6 ER) with seven walks and 23 strikeouts at home.

MASTER OF THE FIRST INNING: Ryan has allowed just two hits in the first inning in his career — a Mitc Haniger two-run home run on Opening Day, April 8 vs. Seattle and an infield single by Trey Mancini in hi last start on May 3 at Baltimore — and is holding hitters to a .063 (2-for-32) opponent batting average if the opening frame in his career...his .063 mark leads the majors since the start of 2021 (min. 30 opponent above in the first).

THE GOAL IS...TO THROW STRIKES: Ryan has posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent twice this season, on April 15 in Boston (73.2%; 80 pitches, 62 strikes) and May 3 at Baltimore (70.4%, 81 pitches, 57 strikes)...has thrown at least 70 percent of his pitches in the zone in a single outing five times in his career (career best percentage is 74.6%, done in the first game of the doubleheader on September 14, 2021 vs. Cleveland)...owns a 68.8 career strike percentage, which ranks ninth in the American League since the start of 2021 (min. 50.0 IP).

GOOSE EGGS: Posted a career-high 20.0-inning scoreless streak from to the third inning on April 15 at Boston to the third inning on May 3 at Baltimore...streak is the longest by a Twins pitcher this season.

Per Elias, Ryan's 20.0-inning scoreless streak is tied with Jim Hughes (20.0 IP; May 14-24, 1975) for the second-longest run by a rookie starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present), trailing only Joe Mays (20.1 IP; July 17-29, 1999).

APRIL SHOWERS: Went 3-1, 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP, 3 ER) in four April starts, recording the lowest ERA in March/April by a rookie in Twins/Senators history (min. 20.0 IP)...his ERA also marked the fifth-lowest ERA by a rookie in a single month in Twins/Senators history (min. 20.0 IP), trailing only Jim Hughes (0.87 ERA in May 1975), Milo Candini (0.88 ERA in June 1943), Jim Shaw (0.91 ERA in September 1914) and Francisco Liriano (1.13 ERA in May 2006).

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 28 batters so far, which will lead to 1,400 new trees planted.
