**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 3-1 through four games on their season-long nine-game, 10-day homestand, after sweeping the A's in three games last weekend, followed by a loss to the Astros last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three against Houston before concluding the series tomorrow afternoon...they will continue the homestand with a three-game series against the Guardians this weekend.

☞ After starting the season 4-8, the Twins have now won 14 of their last 18 games, with a run differential of +29 (77-48) in those games...since April 21, their 14 wins are tied with New York-AL for the most in baseball.

**JUSTIN TIME AT TARGET FIELD...AGAIN:** The Twins were shut out by the Houston Astros and Justin Verlander at Target Field last night by a score of 5-0...Joe Ryan (3-2) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with a career-high five walks...Jharel Cotton pitched 3.2 scoreless innings of relief with three hits allowed, two walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded just three hits, all singles from Gio Urshela, Alex Kirilloff and Gilberto Celestino...Urshela broke up Verlander's no-hitter with an eighth-inning single to rightfield.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Twins have placed left-handed pitcher Danny Coulombe on the 15-day Injured List with left hip impingement.

☞ Coulombe, who exited last night's game against Houston after sustaining the injury, appeared in nine games for the Twins this season, posting a 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER), with seven walks, nine strikeouts, a .125 opponent batting average and a 1.00 WHIP.

☞ To replace Coulombe on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Yennier Cano from Triple-A St. Paul...the 28-year-old appeared in nine games for the Saints this season, going 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (12.1 IP), four walks, 14 strikeouts, a .158 opponent batting average and a 0.83 WHIP...the Havana, Cuba native was signed by the Twins as an undrafted free agent on July 15, 2019 and has pitched parts of three seasons in the Twins minor league system, going 6-3 with a 2.98 ERA (96.2 IP, 32 ER), eight saves, 52 walks and 115 strikeouts.

☞ To make room for Cano on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Jhon Romero to the 60-day Injured List...Romero, who was placed on the 10-day Injured List on April 23 with right biceps tendinitis, has missed Minnesota's last 17 games.

**SEEING STARS:** The Twins and Astros are playing each other tonight for the second of six times in 2022...the Twins will play three games in Houston from August 23-25...the Twins are 35-37 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 24-28 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

☞ Twins have won three of their last five against the Astros in the regular season, four of their last seven and six of their last 10.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .320 (32-for-100) with four doubles, two triples, six home runs, 17 RBI and a .953 OPS in 26 career regular season games vs. Houston.

☞ Gio Urshela has hit safely in each of his last nine games against the Astros, hitting .375 (12-for-32) with a .444 on-base percentage and a .944 OPS in that span.

**THE SKIP:** Bench coach Jayce Tingler has managed the last five games (3-2) after Rocco Baldelli tested positive for COVID-19 prior to Thursday night's game in Baltimore...Tingler's game-by-game results in box to the right...Tingler was the skipper in San Diego for two seasons from 2020-21, compiling a record of 116-106 (.523)...he led the Padres to a .617 winning percentage in 2020 (37-23), the best in franchise history.

**TWINS ON TARGET:** The Twins have won nine of their last 10 games at Target Field and are 11-5 at home...their 11 home wins are tied with Colorado for the third-most in baseball, trailing New York-AL (13-4) and Los Angeles-AL (12-6).

☞ The pitching staff has posted a 2.61 ERA (145.0 IP, 42 ER) with opponents hitting .202 in home games this season.

**CELEBRATE GOOD TIMES:** Gilberto Celestino is hitting .444 (12-for-27) with three doubles, one RBI, two walks, five runs scored and a 1.056 OPS in his last nine games...Celestino was originally signed by Houston in July of 2015 and played parts of three seasons in the Astros organization...he was acquired by the Twins on July 27, 2018, along with right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcalá (60-day IL — right elbow inflammation) in exchange for Ryan Pressly.

☞ During his current nine-game stretch, he is hitting .643 (9-for-14) on fastballs and .300 (3-for-10) on off-speed pitches.

**HIP HIP FOR MAY:** Jorge Polanco is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with three doubles, one home runs, nine RBI, four walks and a .937 OPS in nine games this month...he is tied for fifth in the AL in RBI this month and tied for 14th in hits.

**WEEK OF SERVICE:** The Twins and their six minor league affiliates completed their inaugural "Minnesota Twins Week of Service" today...believed to be Major League Baseball's first-ever coordinated effort across an entire organization, the Minnesota Twins Week of Service involves front office staff and clubhouse personnel from the Twins and each of Minnesota's minor league affiliates.

☞ Earlier today, the Twins partnered with Roseville, Minnesota-based nonprofit Every Meal to host a food packing event at Target Field...with more than 300,000 Minnesota children living with food insecurity, Twins front office staff and clubhouse personnel packed 4,750 bags of non-perishable food (the equivalent of 16,000 meals) to help Every Meal's mission to fight hunger in our community by filling the gaps in food access that kids face during weekends, summers and extended breaks.

**PITCHING MUSSELS:** Twins Low-A affiliate the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels pitched a combined no-hitter last night, defeating Palm Beach 3-0 at Hammond Stadium; it marked the first nine-inning no-hitter in Fort Myers franchise history...David Festa (6.0 IP, 2 BB, 11 K), Jaylen Nowlin (2.0 IP, 3 K) and Hunter McMahon (1.0 IP, 1 BB) led the way on the mound, as Mikey Perez homered and Noah Miller went 0-for-1 with three walks and one run scored.

**FELIZ CUMPLEAÑOS, MIGGY!** Today is Miguel Sanó's 29th birthday...he shares a birthday with football player Cam Newton, artist Salvador Dalí, National Baseball Hall-of-Famer Charlie Gehringer and former Twins manager Frank Quilici, among others...Sanó is currently on the 10-day Injured List with a left knee sprain.

**HBD MINNESOTA:** On this day in 1858, Minnesota joined the union as the 32nd state...the Twins are just 19-30 all-time (since 1961) on the day Minnesota became a state, including 13-14 at home.

- ✎ Tonight marks his ninth career start and appearance against Houston, but first since August 1, 2017...is 5-2, 2.15 ERA (54.1 IP, 13 ER) lifetime against the Astros, all with Tampa Bay.
- ✎ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took a no-decision in last Thursday's roadtrip finale in Baltimore, a game the Orioles rallied late to win, 5-3...worked 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on a season-high five hits (2 solo homers, by Ryan Mountcastle and Cedric Mullins), with no walks and a season-best six strikeouts...departed with a 3-2 lead, before the O's touched the Twins bullpen for three more solo shots (1 in the 5th and 2 in the 8th).

- ✎ Six strikeouts were Archer's most in a game since he also fanned six O's on August 29, 2021 at Camden Yards (with Tampa Bay)...marked his 19th career start with at least six strikeouts and no walks allowed (1st since August 19, 2019 at St. Louis, with Pittsburgh).
- ✎ Also marked the 37th start in which he allowed two-or-more home runs...has now given up at least one longball in four-straight starts (5 total, all solo), the ninth such stretch of his career (last time he surrendered a homer in 5 consecutive starts came July 3-28, 2019 with Pittsburgh).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Archer started the Twins' 9-1 victory over his former Tampa Bay squad on April 30 at Tropicana Field...pitched the first 4.0 innings, allowing just one run (Taylor Wells solo home run in the 2nd) on two hits, with three walks and four strikeouts...went toe-to-toe with the Rays' Shane Bieber until the fifth inning, when he departed and Twins relievers tossed 5.0 innings of scoreless baseball...was Archer's first career start against the Rays, where he spent his first seven seasons before being dealt with at the trade deadline in 2018.

- ✎ His three walks allowed marked his third consecutive start with at least three walks, doing so for the fourth time in his career (last: 5/12-5/23/18).

**NO PROBLEM WITH HOUSTON:** Is making his ninth career start and appearance vs. Houston, but first since August 1, 2017...over his first eight starts against the Astros, all with Tampa Bay between 2013-17, Archer went 5-2, 2.15 ERA (54.1 IP, 13 ER), 11 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .160 opponent batting average (30-for-187).

- ✎ **Two of Archer's three career complete-game shutouts have come against the 'Stros...** turned in one of the finest outings of his career on August 20, 2015 at Minute Maid Park, twirling a one-hitter with one walk and 11 strikeouts in a 1-0 Tampa Bay win over Collin McHugh and a playoff-bound Houston club (lone Astros hit was a Colby Rasmus single leading off the 5th)...also tossed a five-hitter with no walks and eight strikeouts in a 5-0 Rays victory on July 14, 2013 at Tropicana Field.

**ARCHER ON TARGET:** In eight lifetime starts at Target Field, Archer is 4-0, 2.34 ERA (42.1 IP, 11 ER) with eight walks and 45 strikeouts - his lowest ERA at any ballpark in which he has made at least four starts.

- ✎ In a limited sample size this season, Archer has fared slightly better when pitching at home, posting a 2.57 ERA (7.0 IP, 2 ER) with three walks, five strikeouts and a .192 opponent batting average (5-for-26) in two Target Field starts...he has a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 5 ER), six walks, 15 strikeouts and a .229 BAA (11-for-48) in three road efforts.

**THE MOON KNIGHT:** Archer takes the ball this evening for his fourth night start of the 2022 season...has posted better numbers in night games this season, with a 2.92 ERA (12.1 IP, 4 ER), .229 opponent batting average (11-for-48) and a .775 opponent OPS...has a 3.86 ERA (7.0 IP, 3 ER), .192 BAA (5-for-26) and .805 OPS during day games this season.

**RIGHT/LEFT SPLITS:** Archer has held opposing right-handers to a .190 batting average (8-for-42) with six walks, 11 strikeouts and a .696 OPS (3 extra-base hits, all homers) this season...lefties have gone 8-for-32 (.250) with five doubles, two home runs, three walks, nine strikeouts and a .908 OPS.

**QUALITY OVER QUANTITY:** As he continues to build up from an even more abbreviated spring training than most (signing with Minnesota on March 27), Archer has pitched into the fifth inning just once in his first five starts (April 19 at Kansas City)...however, he has yet to allow more than two earned runs in a start and has departed each game with the Twins either tied (twice), ahead by a run (twice) or down by just a single run (once).

**THE ARSENAL:** Archer has relied primarily on either a slider or four-seam fastball during his first four Twins starts, throwing those for a combined 324 of his 355 pitches (91.3%), per Baseball Savant...below is the website's tracking of his first four starts of the 2022 campaign:

- ✎ His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.1 mph on the fastball and 88.6 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.

**WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY:** Archer signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on March 27...marks his fifth organization (Cleveland 2006-08, Chicago-NL, 2019-10, Tampa Bay 2011-18 and '21) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

- ✎ In a Bally Sports North interview, Archer cited his relationship with Twins Manager Rocco Baldelli and Vice President, Baseball Operations Strategy & Innovation Josh Kalk (both of whom were with Tampa Bay's front office and/or coaching staff from 2011-17), Minnesota's catching duo and up-the-middle defense, and positive reviews from one-time Rays teammate and former Twins starter Jake Odorizzi among his many reasons for coming to the Twin Cities.

**MEANT TO BE:** Upon signing with Minnesota, Archer took to his personal Instagram page to post a photo of himself from his Little League days wearing a Twins uniform...the young, then-outfielder was supporting a blue Twins top with the "M" hat.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOSH WINDER [2022 SEASON: 2-0, 1.61 ERA // CAREER: 2-0, 1.61 ERA]
