THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 3-3 through six games on their season-long nine-game, 10-day homestand...

TWINS HAVE A PROBLEM WITH HOUSTON: The Twins lost both games to the Astros yesterday, completing their suspended game from Tuesday night...

TWINS AND GUARDIANS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the first of 19 meetings in 2022...

Since the start of 2020, 24 of the 29 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less...

Max Kepler has 18 career home runs and 72 career hits against the Guardians, his 18 homers being his most against any opponent.

Byron Buxton hit .524 (11-for-21) with two doubles and five home runs in a six-game stretch against Cleveland from September 11, 2020-September 6, 2021...

Gio Urshela made his major league debut with Cleveland on June 9, 2015 and played parts of two seasons there in 2015 and '17...

DIVISION SIGNS: 18 of the Twins' next 21 games are against divisional opponents...in that 21-game span, they will play the Guardians three times...

LAND OF 1,000 RAKES: The Twins have hit 993 home runs in Target Field's history (since 2010)...

Table listing top 15 home run hitters for the Twins: 1) Brian Dozier, 2) Miguel Sanó, 3) Eddie Rosario, etc.

NOTE: The 993 home runs excludes all opponents.

FEELING MINNESOTA: The Twins have won nine of their last 12 games at Target Field and are 11-7 at home...

Twins pitching staff has posted a 3.09 ERA (163.0 IP, 56 ER) with opponents hitting .216 (131-for-606) in home games this season.

LUEY, PROFESSIONAL HITTER: Luis Arraez is hitting .316 (24-for-76), the 10th highest average in the AL (minimum 75 at-bats).

Arraez is hitting .364 (20-for-55) with three doubles, one home run, five RBI, nine walks, a .453 on-base percentage and a .926 OPS against right-handed pitching...

HIP HIP FOR MAY: Jorge Polanco is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with five doubles, one home run, 11 RBI, five walks and a .963 OPS in 11 games this month...

This month, Polanco is hitting .556 (5-for-9) on breaking balls.

TENACIOUS D: The Twins enter today with a total of 13 defensive runs saved on the season, tied with San Diego for third-most in baseball...

Twins outfielders have eight outfield assists, second-most in baseball, trailing Cleveland (12).

'PEN POLISH: In their last 15 games, since April 27, the bullpen has combined to go 5-1, 1.80 ERA (65.0 IP, 13 ER) with 15 walks, 69 strikeouts and a .185 opponent batting average...

JOE COOL: Joe Smith has appeared in 12 games this season, posting a 0.00 ERA (10.1 IP) and a 0.68 WHIP...he is one of nine pitchers in baseball without an earned run...

THIS AND THAT:

Outfielder Kyle Garlick is scheduled to begin his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul tonight at Columbus...Garlick has missed the Twins' last nine games with a right calf strain.

Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 6, Royce Lewis has hit safely in five of six games.

Jorge Polanco has walked 17 times this season, tied for 10th most in the AL and in the 85th percentile of all MLB players.

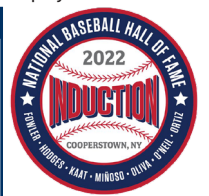

- Making his fourth start and appearance of the season...will mark his 218th career start and 227th career appearance. Will be his 12th career start against the Guardians...is 5-3, 3.22 ERA (64.1 IP, 23 ER) with 25 walks and 67 strikeouts against Cleveland. Acquire by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for Twins prospect Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his third start of the season on May 7 vs. Oakland, his former team...did not factor into the decision after tossing 4.0 scoreless innings, innings and allowing two hits and two walks, with a season-high seven strikeouts... since missing 19 games on the 10-day Injured List with a low-grade right hamstring strain...also marked his first scoreless start since August 26, 2021 at Milwaukee.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his second start and first road start of the season in Boston on April 16... suffered his first loss of the season after going just 1.2 innings, allowed two runs on one hit, with one walk and one strikeouts in a 4-0 Twins defeat...left in the second inning with two outs after feeling discomfort in his right hamstring...ended up on the 10-day injured list on April 17 with a low-grade right hamstring strain.

YOU CAN'T GUARD HIM: Will be making his 12th career start against the Guardians...is 5-3, 3.22 ERA (64.1 IP, 23 ER) with 25 walks and 67 strikeouts in his career against Cleveland...has pitched at least 6.0 innings in four of his last five starts, and has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in his last five consecutive starts against the Guardians.

CENTRAL PERKS: Owns a 17-11, 3.41 ERA (220.1 IP, 91 ER) against American League Central opponents, his 3.41 ERA marks his lowest against any major league division (minimum of 12 starts)...dating back to May 5, 2018, Gray has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in 12 of his last 13 starts against the American League Central, going 7-2 2.47 ERA (69.1 IP, 19 ER) with 26 walks, 74 strikeouts and a .198 opponent batting average.

HOME/AWAY: Is making his third start at Target Field field this season...is currently 1-3, 3.44 ERA (34.0 IP, 13 ER) with 20 walks and 33 strikeouts in seven career starts in Minnesota...has shown consistent numbers when at home and on the road, going 46-36, 3.94 ERA (669.1 IP, 293 ER) with 226 walks and 634 strikeouts in 118 appearances (113 starts) at home...is 36-37, 3.24 ERA (608.1 IP, 219 ER), with 232 walks and 599 strikeouts in 108 appearances (103 starts) on the road.

RIDE OUT THE NIGHT: In his career, Gray is 30-26, 3.39 ERA (473.1 IP, 177 ER) when pitching in day games...is slightly not as sharp in night games, going 52-47, 3.75 ERA (804.1 IP, 335 ER)... will be making his first night start this season...in his last nine starts under the lights, he is 4-1, 3.83 ERA (44.2 IP, 19 ER) with 15 walks, 52 strikeouts and a .207 opponent batting average.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and threw five of them in his first three starts of the season (minus the changeup), per Baseball Savant...nine of his 12 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker...here's a look at his repertoire.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: Last season, Gray posted a .239 opponent average (66-for-276) with 22 walks and 75 strikeouts against right-handed hitters...had a .208 batting average (49-for-236) with 28 walks and 80 strikeouts to lefties.

- In his career, Gray owns a .237 opponent batting average (569-for-2398) with 606 strikeouts against right-handed hitters and a .224 batting average (529-for-2366) with 620 strikeouts against left-handed hitters.

- Twins are fourth organization (Oakland 2011-17, New York-AL 2017-18 and Cincinnati 2019-21). Acquired by Minnesota on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty. Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022). Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either). 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award. Named to Baseball America's 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a Baseball America Triple-A All-Star. Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011. Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

Made three starts last April with the Reds and put up a 5.93 ERA (13.2 IP, 9 ER) with eight walks and 23 strikeouts...in his next five starts he went 1-1, 2.20 ERA (28.2 IP, 7 ER) with 11 walks and 29 strikeouts in the month of May. Recorded a season-high five-game winning streak from July 30-September 1...went 5-0, 2.89 ERA (43.2 IP, 14 ER) and a .225 opponent batting average during the streak... was one win shy of tying his single-season career high (6-0, June 18-July 26, 2014).
