- Making his first major league start and appearance of the season...also 20th career appearance (8th start).
Sixth career appearance (4th start) against Cleveland...has gone 1-2, 6.20 ERA (20.1 IP, 14 ER) with nine walks and 14 strikeouts.
Was acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on July 31, 2018 along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier.

LAST TIME OUT IN TRIPLE-A: Took the loss for St. Paul on May 3 vs. the Iowa Cubs...tagged for four runs in the first inning...tossed 2.0 innings, allowing six earned runs on eight hits...did not issue a walk and struck out two batters.

SO FAR IN ST PAUL: Has appeared in five games (all starts) for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-2, 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 18 strikeouts.

- Made his season debut on April 9 at Louisville...did not factor into the decision as he tossed 4.0 scoreless innings and gave up just two hits, with three walks and two strikeouts in the 11-1 Saints victory.
Earned the win in his second appearance of the season on April 15 vs. Indianapolis in the 6-4 victory...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed three hits with three strikeouts.
Extended his scoreless innings streak to 11 innings to start the season before he permitted two runs on five hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings in his third start of the season on April 21 at Toledo...took the loss as the Saints fell, 2-1.
Smeltzer's third appearance was on April 27 against the Nashville Sounds at CHS Field...did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.0 innings and yielding one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts...the Twins won in walkoff fashion, 3-2, in the 10th inning.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long, drawn-out injury journey...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10-day Injured list on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after an injury during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be a herniated disc in his neck...transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy, normal offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

LAST START IN THE BIGS: Appeared in one game for the Twins on April 24, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh, allowing one unearned run on one hit in 4.2 innings of relief as the Twins lost, 6-2...marked his only appearance with the Twins or Saints on season as he was optioned back to alternate training site on April 25.

A FAMILIAR FOE: Tonight marks Smeltzer's sixth career appearance and fourth start against the Guardians...he is 1-2, 6.20 ERA (20.1 IP, 14 ER) in his five prior outings...earned the win in relief in his last appearance vs. Cleveland on August 2, 2020 in an 8-1 Twins victory (2.2 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 K)...last start against the Guardians came on September 14, 2019 at Cleveland as the Twins won, 2-0...Smeltzer tossed 3.0 innings (1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 1 K) and did not factor into the decision.

- Over the course of his career, Smeltzer has appeared against the Guardians five times, tied for his most appearances against any opponent (has also faced Kansas City five times)...hasn't faced any other opponent more than twice.
Has faced the AL Central 14 times in his career (6 starts), most recently in a relief appearance on September 6, 2020 vs. Detroit (1.1 IP, 3 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 1 K) as the Twins lost, 10-8...last win came in relief on August 17, 2020, a 4-1 victory over Kansas City at Target Field (W, 2.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K)...last start against the AL Central came on August 7, 2020 at Kansas City (ND, 4.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 K) as the Twins lost, 3-2...is 4-2, 5.52 ERA (45.2 IP, 28 ER) with 15 walks and 36 strikeouts in his 14 career appearances (6 starts) against the AL Central.

BACK AT TARGET FIELD: Smeltzer is slated to make his 13th appearance (4th start) of his career at Target Field...last pitched at Target Field in a relief appearance on April 24, 2021 against the Pittsburgh Pirates (4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...last start at home was on August 9, 2019 (L, 4.1 IP, 7 H, 6 R/ER, 3 BB, 4 K) as the Twins fell to the Guardians, 6-2.

- Most recent win at home came in relief on August 17, 2020 vs. Kansas City in the 4-1 Twins win (W, 2.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K)...last win in a start at home came on August 4, 2019 (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 4 K) as the Twins defeated Kansas City, 3-0.
Is 3-1, 2.72 ERA (43.0 IP, 13 ER) with 34 hits allowed, 11 walks and 39 strikeouts at his home ballpark...those numbers shift to 1-1, 6.75 ERA (26.2 IP, 20 ER) with 36 hits allowed, seven walks and 17 strikeouts in seven career appearances (4 starts) on the road.

NIGHT SHIFT: Making his 10th appearance (5th start) of his career...last appearance in a night game came on September 2, 2020 vs. Chicago-AL (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 K) in the 8-1 Twins victory...last start in a night game was on August 7, 2020 at Kansas City (4.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 K) as the Twins lost, 3-2.

- Most recent night game win was in relief on August 17, 2020 vs. Kansas City (W, 2.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K) as the Twins won, 4-1...has yet to earn the win in a night game he has started.
Is 1-2, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) in nine career night appearances (4 starts), compared to a 3-0 record, 4.11 ERA (35.0 IP, 16 ER) in 10 career day appearances (3 starts).

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Smeltzer's pitch selection in his lone start of the 2021 season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his changeup and four-seam fastball.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Was in Twins spring training for the second-consecutive season and was optioned to the alternate training site on March 29...recalled from the Taxi Squad on April 17...appeared in one game for the Twins on April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, allowing one unearned run on one hit in 4.2 innings of relief...marked his only appearance with the Twins or Saints on season as he was optioned back to alternate training site on April 25...recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 6 just prior to the minor league season beginning but did not appear for Twins...placed on the 10-day Injured List on May 12 with left elbow inflammation and missed the remainder of the season...transferred to 60-day Injured List on July 17.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN [2022 SEASON: 3-2, 2.56 ERA // CAREER: 5-3, 3.24 ERA]

Right-hander Joe Ryan is due to start in tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the Cleveland Guardians...is 3-2, 2.56 ERA (31.2 IP, 9 ER) with 12 walks and 31 strikeouts in six starts this season...took the loss in his last start on May 10 vs. Houston at Target Field, tossing 4.0 innings (4 H, 4 R/ER, 5 BB, 3 K) as the Twins fell, 5-0...his five walks allowed were a career high and marked the first time in his career he had more walks than strikeouts in a single start...Sunday will mark his third career appearance (all starts) against the Guardians...is 1-0, 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and nine strikeouts in his two prior career starts against Cleveland.

CAREER NOTES

- Acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL, along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe, in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier at the 2018 trade deadline.
Made Twins Opening Day roster in 2020, the first of his career...went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances...four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more...held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.
Combined to post a 3.02 ERA (104.1 IP, 32 ER) in 20 games (19 starts) between Double-A Pensacola and Triple-A Rochester, going 4-5 in 2019... Began season with Double-A Pensacola...earned the Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week and Southern League Pitcher of the Week April 14 after making two starts, going 2-0, 0.00 ERA (14.0 IP) with five hits allowed, two walks and 17 strikeouts...Made five starts with the Blue Wahoos, posting a 0.60 ERA (30.0 IP, 2 ER) before being promoted to Triple-A Rochester May 2...Went 0-1, 1.82 ERA (24.2 IP, 5 ER) in four starts for the Red Wings and had contract selected by Minnesota on May 28...Made major league debut May 28 vs. Milwaukee... became fourth Twins starter in history to throw 6.0-or-more shutout innings in his debut, joining Andrew Albers (8.1 on August 6, 2013), Anthony Swarzak (7.0 on May 23, 2009) and Eric Milton (6.0 on April 5, 1998).
Became the ninth New Jersey-born player (7th pitcher) to make his debut for the Twins, and the first since RHP Rob Delaney on Sept. 4, 2010.
Won the National Junior College Athletic Association Player of the Week award for April 4-10, 2016, after throwing a complete game no-hitter in an 8-0 win over Wharton County Junior College, in wherein he struck out 16 batters and walked three.
Was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft, but chose to continue his development at Florida Gulf Coast University.
Smeltzer was set to transfer to Texas Tech University for the 2017 season, but signed with Los Angeles-NL after being drafted in the fifth round (No. 161 overall).
