THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-3 through seven games on their season-long nine-game, 10-day homestand...they swept the A's in three games last weekend, then were swept by the Astros this week, followed by a win over the Guardians last night.tonight, the Twins will Twins will travel to Oakland to begin a six- game, seven-day roadtrip with three against the T's from Monday-Wednesday, an off-day in Kansas City on thursday, then three against the Royals next weekend...the Twins are 12-7 at home and 7-7 on the road.
IT'S ROYCE NIGHT AT TARGET FIELD: The Twins beat the Guardians last night at Target Field by a score of 12-8, snapping their season-long three-game losing streak...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched with a season-high eight strikeouts...the offense recorded 13 hits, including three from Max Kepler...the Twins hit four home runs, one apiece from Byron Buxton (10), Jorge Polanco (4), Gary Sánchez (2) and Royce Lewis (1)...Lewis' homer was a grand slam as he became the second player in club history (since 1961) to hit a grand slam as his first major league home run; the other was Danny Valencia on July 26, 2010 at Kansas City.
ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have selected the contract of left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer from Triple-ASt. Paul...Smeltzer, 26, has made five starts for the Saints this season, going 1-2, 3.86 ERA ( 21.0 IP , 9 ERR), six walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP....s missed most of last season due to left elbow inflammation but made one relief appearance for the Twins on April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, pitching 4.2 innings, while allowing one unearned run on one hit, one walk with three strikeouts...to make room for Smeltzer on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder/tirst baseman Alex Kirilloff to Triple-A St. Paul...Kirilloff, who was reinstated from the 10 -day Injured List (right wrist inflammation) on May 6, appeared in 10 games for the Twins this season, hitting. 172 (5-for-29) with one walk...to make room
for Smeltzer on the 40 -man roster, the Twins have transferred infielder Miguel Sano to the for Smeitzer on the 40-man roster, the or wins have transferred infiedder Moguel Sano to the
60 -day 1 njured List..Sano was placed on the 10-day IL on May 2 with a left knee sprain.

TWINS AND GUARDIANS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the second of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins' first trip to Progressive Field this season will be in a five-game series from June 27-30 (scheduled doubleheader on the 28th)
$\mp$ The Twins have won four of their last five series' vs. Cleveland, dating back to May of 2021. Since the start of 2020, 24 of the 30 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 13 have been decided by two runs-0r-less.
क Max Kepler has 18 career home runs and 75 career hits against the Guardians, his 18 homers being his most against any opponent.
Gio Urshela made his major league debut with Cleveland on June 9, 2015 and played parts of two seasons there in 2015 and '17, hitting . 225 (95-for-423) with 15 doubles, and four RBI in his last five games against his former club.

DIVISION SIGNS: 17 of the Twins' next 20 games are against divisional opponents...in that 20-game span, they will play the Guardians twice, the Royals seven times and the Tigers eight times...they have gone 8-2 against the ALCentral this season, going 1-2 against Kansas City,
3-0 against Chicago-AL, $3-0$ against Detroit and 1-0 against Cleveland.

MAX HEAT: After starting the season hitting . 191 (9-for-47) with a 598 OPS in his first 15 games, Max Kepler has hit 298 (17-for-57) with four doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, seven walks, a 369 on-base percentage, a .579 slugging percentage and a .948 OPS in his last 17.
HIP HIP FOR MAY: Jorge Polanco is hitting . 341 ( 15 -for-45) with five doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, six walks and a 1.003 OPS in 12 games this month, reaching base safely in all $12 .$. he is tied for fifth in the AL in hits and sixth in RBI for the month.
