LAST TIME OUT: Saddled with his second loss of the season and snapped his career-best three-start win streak in his last outing on May 10 vs. Houston...yielded four runs on four hits with a career-high five walks and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work; marked his first career start with more walks than strikeouts...cruised through a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing a run on an RBI groundout in the second...stranded a leadoff walk in a scoreless third and allowed one more run on an RBI single in the fourth before running into trouble in the fifth...permitted the first three batters in the inning to reach (1B, BB, RBI 2B) before departing in favor of Danny Coulombe; one additional run scored on a sac fly.

UNGUARDED: Ryan is making his third career start and appearance against Cleveland today, going 1-0, 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and nine strikeouts in his two prior starts...faced the Guardians for the first time on September 8, 2021 in Cleveland, arguably one of the best starts of his career – that night, he worked 7.0 shutout innings and allowed one base runner, a single, becoming the first pitcher in American League history to toss seven-or-more shutout innings and allow one-or-fewer base runners within his first two career starts (*Stats Perform*)...also retired the first 19 batters he faced, first Twins pitcher to do so since Francisco Liriano retired the first 19 on June 12, 2011 vs. Texas (*Elias*).
 Cast faced Cleveland again in the first game of a doubleheader on September 14, 2021 at Target Field; worked 5.0 innings and allowed one run on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts.

**DAYTIME EXPERIENCE:** Ryan is making his fourth daytime start of the season today, going 2-1, 1.69 ERA (16.0 IP, 3 ER) with five walks and 16 strikeouts in his three prior starts, compared to 1-1, 3.45 ERA (15.2 IP, 6 ER) with seven walks and 15 strikeouts in three night starts this season...his numbers, both season and career, have historically been better during the day than at night – he's 2-1, 1.71 ERA (21.0 IP, 4 ER) in four career day starts and 3-2, 4.10 ERA (37.10 P, 412R) in soven career night starts...his night numbers are skewed by the fact that he's made three more starts at night than during the day in his career.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and 52.8% of the time through his first three starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

DISCOMFORTS OF HOME: Ryan has fared better on the road than at home so far in his career — is 1-3, 4.85 ERA (29.2 IP, 16 ER) with 14 walks and 31 strikeouts in six career starts at Target Field, compared to 4-0, 1.57 ERA (28.2 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and 30 strikeouts in five career starts on the road.
