THE TWINS: The Twins completed their season-long, nine-game, 10-day homestand with a record of 5-4, going 3-0 vs. the A's, 0-3 vs. the Astros and 2-1 vs. the Guardians...tonight, they will begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three against the A's through Wednesday afternoon, followed by an off-day in Kansas City on Thursday, then three against the Royals over the weekend...the Twins are 13-8 at home and 7-7 on the road.

☞ The Twins have won four of their last six games on the road, but looking to snap a two-game road losing streak, both losses at Baltimore from May 4-5.
☞ Since April 21, the Twins have gone 16-7, tied with Los Angeles-AL (16-8) for the third-most wins in baseball, trailing New York-AL (18-4) and Houston (17-6).

GUARDIANS GET THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: The Twins beat Cleveland yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-1, winning the rubber game and making them 5-3-3 in series play in 2022...Joe Ryan (4-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Cody Stashak (1.0), Joe Smith (0.2), Caleb Thielbar (0.1) and Emilio Pagán (1.0) combined for 3.0 scoreless innings of relief with two hits, no walks and four strikeouts...the staff did not walk a batter for the fourth time this season...the offense recorded just four hits, two being home runs from Byron Buxton (11) and Gio Urshela (3).

GARLICK OFF THE SHELF: The Twins announced today that they have returned outfielder Kyle Garlick from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Garlick, who missed the Twins' last 13 games with a right calf strain, played in two games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-for-9 with one double, one home run and two RBI...he has played in 13 games for the Twins this season, hitting .238 (5-for-21) with three home runs, six RBI, five walks, a .385 on-base percentage and a 1.051 OPS...to make room for Garlick on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Mark Contreras to Triple-A St. Paul...Contreras appeared in two games for the Twins, including his major league debut on May 11 vs. Houston, going 0-for-2 with one RBI, one sacrifice fly and one run scored.

VERY ATHLETIC: The Twins and Athletics are playing the fourth of six scheduled meetings in 2022...the Twins hosted the A's for a three-game series from May 6-8, sweeping the series and outscoring Oakland 7-4 — all one-run games...the Twins have gone 20-36 vs. the A's since the start of 2013 for a winning percentage of just .357, the Twins' second-lowest winning percentage against any AL team in that span (New York-AL - .283).

☞ Twins are looking to win four straight over the A's for the first time since July 5, 2016-May 3, 2017 (also 4)...the last time they won four straight in a single season over Oakland was from July 12-15, 2007, sweeping a four-game series at Target Field.
☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .370 (17-for-46) with three doubles, six runs scored, four walks, a .431 on-base percentage and an .866 OPS in 13 career games against the A's.

HOUSE OF HORRORS: The Twins are 6-23 at the Coliseum dating back to the start of 2012, going 0-9-0 in series play in that span...their last series at Oakland was April 20-21 of last season, getting swept in three games...in that series, they were shut out 7-0 and 1-0 in a doubleheader on the 20th, then lost game three on the 21st by a score of 13-12, allowing a three-run 10th inning on no hits and two errors.
☞ In their last 11 games at the Coliseum, they have gone 2-9 and have been walked-off in five of those 11.

11-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton has homered in each of his last two games, four times in his last seven games and five times in his last 10 games...he enters today with 11 home runs, tied with Yordan Alvarez for second-most in baseball, trailing Aaron Judge (12)...since August 6, 2020, he has 43 home runs in 115 games...since that date, he has a 10.02 at-bats-per-home run ratio, which leads baseball (minimum 400 AB).

☞ Among all players in baseball, he ranks first in home runs from the top spot in the order (11), and second in slugging percentage (.706) and OPS (1.036).

LEFTY LOOSEY: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the 13th time (8-4) in 35 games...they are hitting .243 (90-for-371) with 39 walks, 21 doubles and 13 home runs against lefties this season...however, they are hitting .276 (43-for-156) with a .350 on-base percentage and an .850 OPS in their last 13 games vs. lefties.

☞ Individuals vs. lefties: Kyle Garlick is hitting .357 (5-for-14) with three home runs, six RBI, four walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.000 slugging percentage...Garlick is 3-for-4 with two home runs, four RBI and one walk in his last two games vs. lefties...Gio Urshela is hitting .300 (12-for-40)...Byron Buxton is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with five home runs and a .960 slugging percentage.

DON'T ALLOW HITS, WIN P.O.W., THAT SIMPLE: Two Twins minor leaguers have been named Pitcher of the Week in their respective leagues:
☞ Right-handed pitcher Chi Chi Gonzalez has been named International League Pitcher of the Week...Gonzalez pitched 6.0 no-hit innings for Triple-A St. Paul on May 11 at Columbus, walking four and striking out seven.

☞ Right-handed pitcher David Festa has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week and has also been promoted to High-A Cedar Rapids...Festa, 22, pitched 6.0 no-hit innings for Low-A Fort Myers on May 10 vs. Palm Beach, leading the Mighty Mussels to their fifth no-hitter in franchise history...in that start he walked two and struck out a career-high 11 batters.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, Jason Kubel hit an eighth-inning grand slam off Mariano Rivera for a 6-3 win at New Yankee Stadium...Rivera had converted a record-tying 51 consecutive save opportunities at home and had not given up a grand slam since 2002; the runs were also the first he allowed that season.

BIRTHDAY SHOUTS: Hall of Famer Jack Morris is celebrating his 67th birthday today...during his 18-year major league career, he pitched one game on his birthday, that coming in 1987, pitching a complete game over Cleveland at Tiger Stadium, allowing three runs on five hits with 11 strikeouts...he shares a birthday with Twins Radio Engineer Kyle Hammer (37), University of Minnesota baseball coach John Anderson (67), actress Megan Fox (36), pop singer Janet Jackson (56), actor Pierce Brosnan (69) and former Nirvana bassist Krist Novoselic (57).

- ☞ Making his seventh start of the season and 222nd of his career...225th career appearance.
- ☞ Tonight marks his fourth career start and appearance against Oakland, but first since May 28, 2018...is 1-0, 2.60 ERA (17.1 IP, 5 ER) lifetime vs. the Athletics, all with Tampa Bay.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Dealt his first loss of the season in Wednesday/Thursday's game against Houston...worked the first 3.0 innings and allowed a season-high five runs (4 earned) on five hits, with three walks and two strikeouts (hits and walks also matched season worsts)...was removed prior to the top of the fourth inning Wednesday night, but then the rain and thunderstorms came before Yennier Cano could throw his first pitch with the Twins trailing, 5-1...game was suspended and resumed Thursday afternoon; the Astros won, 11-3.

- ☞ Threw his hardest four-seamer of the season at 95.9 mph during a three-up, three-down first inning, before allowing two runs in the second and three more in the third.
- ☞ Also marked the fifth-straight start in which he has allowed at least one home run (6 total, all solo), the fifth such stretch of his career (last time he surrendered a homer in 6 consecutive starts was March 29 through April 26, 2018 with Tampa Bay).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision May 5 at Baltimore, a game the Orioles rallied late to win, 5-3...worked 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on a season-high five hits (2 solo homers, by Ryan Mountcastle and Cedric Mullins), with no walks and a season-best six strikeouts...departed with a 3-2 lead, before the O's touched the Twins bullpen for three more solo shots (1 in the 5th and 2 in the 8th).

- ☞ Six strikeouts were Archer's most in a game since he also fanned six O's on August 29, 2021 at Camden Yards (with Tampa Bay)...marked his 19th career start with at least six strikeouts and no walks allowed (1st since August 19, 2019 at St. Louis, with Pittsburgh).

NO MAY FLOWERS, YET: After posting a 2.93 ERA (15.1 IP, 5 ER) with a .193 opponent batting average (11-for-57) and .724 opponent OPS in four April starts, Archer has been touched for a 7.71 ERA (7.0 IP, 6 ER), .333 BAA (10-for-30) and 1.049 opponent OPS in his first two May efforts.

- ☞ Has allowed five hits in both of his starts this month (May 5 at Baltimore and May 11 vs. Houston), with four of the 10 going for extra-bases (1 2B, 3 HR).

FEELING ATHLETIC: Is making his fourth career start and appearance against Oakland, but his first since May 28, 2018...in his first three outings, all with Tampa Bay (also May 22, 2015 and June 11, 2017). Archer is 1-0, 2.60 ERA (17.1 IP, 5 ER), nine walks and 23 strikeouts.

- ☞ Has made one appearance at the Oakland Coliseum, which came in that May 28, 2018 start...combined with five Rays relievers on a 13-inning, seven-hit shutout as Tampa won, 1-0...worked the first 6.0 innings, blanking the A's on four hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts.

A FEEL FOR THE ROAD: While he entered the 2022 season with dominant career numbers at Target Field, Archer has fared better on the road during his inaugural Twins campaign.

- ☞ In three road starts, he is 0-0, 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 5 ER), six walks, 15 strikeouts and a .229/.315/.542 opponent slash line (11-for-48, with 3 2B and 4 HR)...has departed all three of his road efforts with the Twins either tied or ahead.
- ☞ In three home efforts, he is 0-1, 5.40 ERA (10.0 IP, 6 ER) with a .256/.348/.462 opponent slash line (10-for-39 with 2 2B and 2 HR)...has left with the Twins behind in two of those games.

STINGY WHEN IT COUNTS: Archer has allowed a .241 opponent batting average (21-for-87) with 11 extra-base hits (5 2B and 6 HR) overall...with runners on base, he tightens to a .214 mark (6-for-28) with just one double allowed...he is stingiest with runners in scoring positing, allowing just three hits -- in 19 at-bats (.158).

THE ARSENAL: Archer has upped his changeup and curveball usage the last three starts, throwing those 16.9 percent of the time (39 of 230 pitches), per Baseball Savant...just 3.5 percent of his pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed over his first three efforts...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

- ☞ His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.2 mph on the fastball and 88.8 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.

ONE STEP AT A TIME: Tonight will be Archer's seventh appearance and start of the season, his most since logging 23 (all starts) with Pittsburgh in 2019...missed the final month of that season with right shoulder inflammation, all of 2020 following thoracic outlet surgery and most of 2021 due to right lateral forearm tightness and left hip soreness (made 6 appearances and 5 starts for Tampa Bay).

- ☞ Also had an even more abbreviated 2022 Spring Training than most after signing with Minnesota on March 27...has thrown 70-plus pitches in four starts (topping out at 79 on April 30 at Tampa Bay), while his 430 pitches overall are already more than the 327 he threw in 2021.
- ☞ Has pitched into the fifth inning just once in his first six starts (April 19 at Kansas City), but has departed with the Twins either tied (twice) or ahead by a run (twice) in four of his efforts.
- ☞ Is looking for his first win in a Minnesota uniform...last victory came September 4, 2021 against the Twins, with Tampa Bay at Tropicana Field.

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Archer signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on March 27...marks his fifth organization (Cleveland 2006-08, Chicago-NL, 2019-10, Tampa Bay 2011-18 and '21) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

- ☞ In a Bally Sports North interview, Archer cited his relationship with Twins Manager Rocco Baldelli and Vice President, Baseball Operations Strategy & Innovation Josh Kalk (both of whom were with Tampa Bay's front office and/or coaching staff from 2011-17), Minnesota's catching duo and up-the-middle defense, and positive reviews from one-time Rays teammate and former Twins starter Jake Odorizzi among his many reasons for coming to the Twin Cities.

- Twins are his fifth organization, following time with Cleveland (2006-08), Chicago-NL (2009-10), Tampa Bay (2011-18 and 2021) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).
