THE TWINS: After completing their season-long, nine-game, 10-day homestand with a record of 5-4 (3-0 vs. the A's, 0-3 vs. the Astros and 2-1 vs. the Guardians), the Twins began their six-game, seven day roadtrip with a win over the Athletics last night...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of three against Oakland...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Kansas City to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then play a three-game series against the Royals over the weekend...the Twins are 13-8 at home and 8-7 on the road.
 ☞ The Twins have won five of their last seven games on the road.

PITCHING STAFF GETS STRAIGHT A'S IN OAKLAND: The Twins beat the Athletics last night at RingCentral Coliseum by a score of 3-1, marking their fourth consecutive win over the A's...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on two hits, including two walks and two strikeouts...Yennier Cano (2.0 IP), Griffin Jax (2.0) and Tyler Duffey (1.0) combined for 5.0 scoreless innings of relief, as Cano earned his first major league win and Duffey earned his first save of the season and fifth of his career...the offense recorded eight hits, highlighted by Gary Sánchez, who went 2-for-4 with a double and a solo home run, his third of the season.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have reinstated right-handed pitcher Dylan Bundy from the COVID Injured List...Bundy has missed the Twins' last 10 games since going on the COVID Injured List on May 6...he has started in five games for the Twins this season, going 3-2 with a 5.76 ERA (25.0 IP, 16 ER), five walks and 22 strikeouts...to make room for Bundy on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Jharel Cotton for release or assignment...Cotton, 30, made four relief appearances for the Twins over two stints with the club, going 0-1 with a 1.35 ERA (6.2 IP, 1 ER), six walks and seven strikeouts.

MINNESOTA WINS: Since April 21, the Twins have gone 17-7, tied with Houston (17-7) for the second-most wins in baseball, trailing New York-AI (19-4)...below are some notable AL offensive rankings since that date:

ADDITIONALLY: The Twins rank second in the AL in batting average with runners in scoring position in that span, hitting .290, trailing Los Angeles-AI (.304).

VERY ATHLETIC: The Twins and Athletics are playing the fifth of six scheduled meetings in 2022...the Twins have gone 4-0 against the A's this season, outscoring them 10-5...last night's victory secured the season series over Oakland for the first time since going 4-3 in 2015.

☞ Twins are looking to win five straight over the A's for the first time since July 12, 2007-April 22, 2008 (also 5)...they are looking to win five straight in a single season for the first time since May 21-July 20, 2003.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .375 (18-for-48) with three doubles, six runs scored, four walks, a .434 on-base percentage and an .871 OPS in 14 career games against the A's.

HOUSE OF HORRORS: The Twins are 7-23 at the Coliseum dating back to the start of 2012, going 0-9-0 in series play in that span...their last series victory at Oakland came in a two-game sweep from May 18-19, 2011...their last series victory here in three-or-more games came June 4-6, 2010, taking two of three.

☞ With a win tonight, the Twins will win two-straight games in Oakland for the first time since August 10, 2014 and July 17, 2015...the last time they won two-straight in a single season came in Oakland was May 19-July 29, 2011.

ARRAEZ TO THE TOP: Luis Arraez is leading off for the seventh time this season...he led off four times in the club's first 15 games but has led off just twice in the last 22...he is hitting .321 (118-for-368) from the leadoff spot in his career...he is hitting .398 (53-for-133) with a .432 on-base percentage in his career when hitting in the first inning.

JORGE IN MAY: Jorge Polanco is hitting .304 (17-for-56) with five doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, eight walks, a .385 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .885 OPS in 15 games in May.

☞ Since May of 2019, Jorge Polanco is hitting .308 (78-for-253) with 21 doubles, three triples, 10 home runs, 41 RBI, a .389 on-base percentage, a .534 slugging percentage and a .922 OPS in 67 games during the month of May...since then, his OPS ranks 12th in the AL.

ROYCE ROLLS IN THE BIGS: Since making his major league debut on May 6 vs. the A's, Royce Lewis has hit safely in eight of 10 games, including three doubles, one home run, four RBI, four runs scored, one walk, a .306 on-base percentage and a .763 OPS...since that date, he ranks second among AL rookies in hits (13), trailing Seattle's Julio Rodríguez (13).

CELE-BRATE GOOD TIMES: Since April 28, Gilberto Celestino has started seven of the Twins' 18 games in centerfield...in that span, he has played in a total of 13 games, hitting .400 (16-for-40) with four doubles, one RBI, two walks, six runs scored, a .442 on-base percentage and a .942 OPS.

☞ On the season, Celestino is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with two doubles against right-handed pitching, which leads the AL (minimum of 25 at-bats).

FIREMEN: In their last 19 games since April 27, the bullpen has combined to go 7-2, 1.96 ERA (82.2 IP, 18 ER) with 18 walks, 84 strikeouts and a .192 opponent batting average...since that date, their ERA ranks first in all of baseball, their strikeouts are tied for second-most and their opponent batting average ranks third.

REMEMBERING HARMON: On this day in 2011, Twins legend Harmon Killebrew passed away at age 74 in Scottsdale, AZ after being diagnosed with esophageal cancer...Killebrew played 21 seasons for the Twins/Senators franchise, from 1954-1974...he was the 1969 AL MVP and was elected to the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1984...Killebrew is the club's all-time leader in home runs (475), RBI (1,325), walks (1,321) and games (1,939).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his fifth start and third road start of this season on May 4 at Baltimore...handed his second loss of the season and second consecutive loss after allowing a career-high nine runs, 11 hits, two home runs and two walks in 3.2 innings of work in a 9-4 Twins defeat...marked his second consecutive start of six-or-more runs, two home runs and two walks allowed.

- ☞ Was 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk, 12 strikeouts and a .435 opponent OPS in his first three starts this season...in his previous two starts, Bundy is 0-2, 13.97 ERA (9.2 IP, 15 ER) with four walks, 10 strikeouts and a 1.222 opponent OPS.

TWO STARTS AGO: Worked through his fourth start of the season (2nd road start), suffering his first loss of the season on April 29 at Tampa Bay...threw a season-high 6.0 innings while giving up six runs on seven hits (2 HR), with two walks and a season-high seven strikeouts in a 6-1 Twins defeat...struggled early on in the game, allowing four of his six runs in the first inning...would then go on to allow two more runs in his next two innings...retired his final nine consecutive batters faced.

- ☞ His seven strikeouts marked his most in a start since April 6, 2021 vs. Houston (10 K's)...had made 25 appearances (21 starts) in that span.

AGAINST THE A'S: Will be making his 11th career start and 13th appearance against the Athletics...is 4-3, 5.13 ERA (54.1 IP, 31 ER) with 13 walks, 68 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP in his career vs. Oakland...had arguably one of his best starts of his career against Oakland on August 11, 2020, earning the victory after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings, with just one walk and 10 strikeouts (with Los Angeles-AL)...has appeared in five games (four starts) at the Coliseum, going 2-1, 5.40 ERA (21.2 IP, 13 ER) with six walks, 28 strikeouts and a .253 (22-for-87) opponent batting average.

- ☞ Is making his first start after missing the last 10 games since being placed on the COVID Injured List on May 6.

HOMESICKNESS: Is making his fourth road start of the season tonight...has struggled on the road compared to his home starts this season...in his first three road starts this season, Bundy is 1-2, 9.60 ERA (15.0 IP, 16 ER) with four walks, 16 strikeouts and a 1.80 WHIP...is 2-0, 0.00 ERA (10.0 IP, 0 ER) with one walk, six strikeouts and a .139 (5-for-36) opponent batting average...is a career 24-27, 4.93 ERA (359.1 IP, 197 ER), with 132 walks and 376 strikeouts in 76 appearances (62 starts) on the road...compares to 25-32, 4.60 ERA (436.1 IP, 223 ER), with 130 walks and 404 strikeouts in 90 home appearances (76 starts).

DAY 'N NITE: Through his first five starts, Bundy has shown more one-sided numbers when tossing in the daytime this season, going 2-0, 0.87 ERA (10.1 P, 1 ER) with no walks, 10 strikeouts and a .525 opponent OPS in two day starts...after the sun goes down, his numbers go up; is 1-2, 9.20 ERA (14.2 IP, 15 ER) with five walks and 12 strikeouts in three night starts.

MUGGY MAYS: Is making his second May start this season...Bundy has struggled in the month of May throughout his career, 8-14, 5.76 ERA (139.0 IP, 89 ER) with 45 walks, 121 strikeouts and a .866 opponent OPS in 31 career May appearances (23 starts)...his 5.76 May ERA marks his second highest in any month with a minimum of 18 starts (July: 6.46 ERA).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy's pitch usage has resulted in his highest groundball percentage in his career (46.3%)...according to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first five starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Bundy went 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.

- ☞ Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (*Elias*).
- ☞ Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (*Elias*).
- ☞ Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero (0.54 ERA, 5/2-5/13/18) and Ervin Santana (0.41 ERA, 4/3-4/14/17).

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Signed to a one-year contract with Minnesota on December 1, 2021...this marks his third professional organization, as he spent the previous two seasons with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and his first five Major League seasons with Baltimore (2012-19).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY [2022 SEASON: 0-1, 3.68 ERA // CAREER: 82-73 3.61 ERA]

Veteran right-hander Gray is scheduled to make his fifth start of the season in tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the A's...did not factor into the decision after tossing 4.1 innings in his last start on May 13 vs. Cleveland, allowing two runs on four hits, with four walks and a season-high eight strikeouts in a 12-8 Twins victory...will be making his fourth career start against Oakland and second this season...did not factor into the decision after tossing 4.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with seven strikeouts in a 1-0 Twins victory on May 7 vs. Oakland...is a career 0-1, 5.40 ERA (13.1 IP, 8 ER), 10 BB, 12 K in three starts against the A's.
