THE TWINS: After completing their season-long, nine-game, 10-day homestand with a record of 5-4 (3-0 vs. the A's, 0-3 vs. the Astros and 2-1 vs. the Guardians), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip by splitting the first two games with the A's the last two nights... today, they will continue the trip with the three-game series finale in Oakland...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Kansas City to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then play a three-game series against the Royals over the weekend...the Twins are 13-8 at home and 8-8 on the road. The Twins have won five of their last eight games on the road.

A's EVEN UP SERIES IN OAKLAND: The Twins lost to the Athletics last night at RingCentral Coliseum by a score of 5-2...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings...Josh Winder "piggy-backed" Bundy, allowing five runs on nine hits in 3.2 innings of relief...the offense recorded seven hits, two apiece from Max Kepler and Royce Lewis...Lewis doubled for the fourth time this season and hit his second home run...Gary Sánchez added a home run, his fourth of the season and second in as many days.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have reinstated shortstop Carlos Correa from the 10-day Injured List...Correa has missed the Twins' last 11 games with a right finger contusion, after sustaining the injury on May 5 at Baltimore when he fouled a ball off his hand in the seventh inning...the 27-year-old was signed by the Twins during spring training and has hit .255 (24-for-94) with five doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, 12 runs scored and eight walks in 24 games for the Twins this season...to make room for Correa on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned infielder Royce Lewis to Triple-A St. Paul...Lewis, 22, made his major league debut on May 6 and appeared in 11 games for the Twins, hitting .308 (12-for-39) with four doubles, two home runs, five RBI, one walk, five runs scored, a .325 on-base percentage and an .889 OPS.

MINNESOTA WINS: Since April 21, the Twins have gone 17-8 for the third most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Houston (18-7) and New York-AL (20-4)...below are some notable AL offensive rankings since that date:

ADDITIONALLY: The Twins rank second in the AL in batting average with runners in scoring position in that span, hitting .280 (53-for-189), trailing Los Angeles-AL (.293).

VERY ATHLETIC: The Twins and Athletics are playing for the sixth and final time in 2022...the Twins have gone 4-1 against the A's this season, outscoring them 12-10...Monday night's victory secured the season series over Oakland for the first time since going 4-3 in 2015.

Luis Arraez is hitting .353 (18-for-51) with three doubles, six runs scored, six walks, a .431 on-base percentage and an .843 OPS in 15 career games against the A's. Carlos Correa has played in 57 career games at the Coliseum, his most in any opposing ballpark...his 57 games played are seventh most among active opponents...he has a slashline in Oakland of .224/.341/.366...his 34 career walks are his most in any opposing ballpark as well.

ALWAYS SONNY IN OAKLAND: Sonny Gray was selected by the Athletics in the first round (18th overall) in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University and spent parts of seven seasons in Oakland's organization, from 2011-17...he made his major league debut with the A's on July 10, 2013...in five major leagues seasons with Oakland, he went 44-36, 3.42 ERA (705.0 IP, 268 ER), with 225 walks and 607 strikeouts in 114 games (112 starts).

HOUSE OF HORRORS: The Twins are 7-24 at the Coliseum dating back to the start of 2012, going 0-9-0 in series play in that span...their last series victory at Oakland came in a two-game sweep from May 18-19, 2011...their last victory in a series of three-or-more games here came June 4-6, 2010, taking two of three.

11-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton has homered in two of his last three games, four times in his last eight games and five times in his last 11 games...he enters today with 11 home runs, third most in baseball, trailing Aaron Judge (14) and Yordan Alvarez (12)...in his last 162 games, he has hit 49 home runs with a .620 slugging percentage.

Among all players in baseball, he ranks first in home runs from the top spot in the order (11), and second in slugging percentage (.678) and OPS (1.001).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1962, Bob Allison and Harmon Killebrew both hit grand slams in the first inning to lead the Twins to a 14-3 victory over Cleveland...in 1969, Rod Carew stole second base, third, and home plate during the third inning of an 8-2 loss to Detroit...Carew pulled off the trifecta against the battery of Mickey Lolich and Bill Freehan and became the first player in 28 years to steal three bases in sequence in the same inning...in 2021, right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober made his major league debut at Target Field against the White Sox, allowing four runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched in a Twins 5-4 victory...Miguel Sanó hit three home runs in the game.

- Making his fifth start and appearance of the season...will mark his 219th career start and 228th career appearance.
Will be his second start against Oakland this season and fourth career start against the Athletics...did not factor into the decision against the A's on May 7 (4.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K)...is 0-1, 5.40 ERA (13.1 IP, 8 ER) with 10 walks and 12 strikeouts against Oakland in his career.
Acquired by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for Twins prospect Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on Friday, May 13 vs. Cleveland after allowing two earned runs on four hits, with four walks and eight strikeouts in 4.1 innings pitched...the Twins exploded for nine runs in the bottom of the fifth inning and won, 12-8...his eight strikeouts were his most in a single game this season and most since September 6, 2021 at Chicago-NL (also 8) as a member of the Cincinnati Reds...now has 20 strikeouts on the season, 14 looking and six swinging.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his third start of the season on May 7 vs. Oakland as the Twins won, 1-0, on a Jorge Polanco solo home run...did not factor into the decision after tossing 4.0 shutout innings and allowing two hits and two walks, with seven strikeouts...marked his first start since missing 19 games on the 10-day Injured List with a low grade right hamstring strain...was his first scoreless start since August 26, 2021 at Milwaukee (6.0 IP in a 5-1 Cincinnati victory).

BACK WHERE IT ALL BEGAN: Will be making his second start of the season and fourth of his career against the Athletics, the team who drafted him in 2011 and that he was with until 2017...did not factor into the decision in his first start against Oakland this season on May 7 at Target Field, a 1-0 Twins victory (4.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K).

- Earned his first major league win at the Oakland Coliseum on August 15, 2013 (W, 8.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 9 K) in the 5-0 victory over the Astros.
In 61 career games (all starts) at the Coliseum, Gray is 25-20, 3.53 ERA (390.1 IP, 153 ER) with 117 walks and 323 strikeouts.
Is 0-1, 5.40 ERA (13.1 IP, 8 ER) with 10 walks and 12 strikeouts in his career against Oakland.
Last start at the Oakland Coliseum came on May 8, 2019 as a member of the Reds (ND, 4.1 IP, 6 H, 4 R/3 ER, 5 BB, 3 K) as the Reds lost, 5-4, in 13 innings.
In his career, Gray owns a 23-15 record, 3.19 ERA (343.2 IP, 122 ER) against the American League West.

LIFE ON THE ROAD: Is making his second start on the road this season...his prior road start came at Boston on April 16 (L, 1.2 IP, 1 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 1 K) as the Twins lost, 4-0...departed due to injury and later was added to the 10-day Injured List with a low grade right hamstring strain...has shown consistent numbers when at home and on the road over his career...has posted a 36-37 record, 3.24 ERA (608.1 IP, 219 ER), with 232 walks and 599 strikeouts in 108 career appearances (103 starts) on the road...has gone 46-36, 3.94 ERA (673.2 IP, 295 ER) with 230 walks and 642 strikeouts in 119 appearances (115 starts) at his home ballpark.

WEDNESDAY MATINEE: Will be making his fourth day start of the season and is currently 0-1, 3.48 ERA (10.1 IP, 4 ER) in his prior three day starts...last win in a day start came on August 26, 2021 (W, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 6 K) as the Reds defeated Milwaukee, 5-1...in his career, Gray is 30-26, 3.37 ERA (473.1 IP, 177 ER) in 85 day games (81 starts), compared to 52-47, 3.75 ERA (808.2 IP, 337 ER) in 142 night games (137 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career, per Baseball Savant...14 of his 20 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker...here's a look at his repertoire.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: This season, Gray has posted a .125 opponent average (3-for-24) with two walks and eight strikeouts against left-handed hitters...has a .267 batting average (8-for-30) with seven walks and 12 strikeouts against right-handed hitters.
In his career, Gray owns a .223 opponent batting average (530-for-2378) with 627 strikeouts against left-handed hitters and a .238 batting average (574-for-2416) with 614 strikeouts against right-handed hitters.

FRIDAY'S STARTER - LHP DEVIN SMELTZER (2022 SEASON: 0-0, 1.80 ERA // CAREER: 4-2, 4.10 ERA)

Left-hander Devin Smeltzer is scheduled to start Friday night's series opener against the Kansas City Royals...did not factor into the decision in his first start of the season on May 14 vs. Cleveland at Target Field, after yielding one run on three hits, with two walks and two strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work, as the Twins fell, 3-2 in 10 innings...marked his first major league appearance since April 24, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh (ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K) in a relief outing as the Twins fell, 6-2...worked his way back after suffering a herniated disc in June 2021...is due to face the Royals for the sixth time in his career (3rd start) and has gone 2-0, 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER) with four walks and 11 strikeouts in his five prior games (2 starts).

Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
Named to Baseball America's 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a Baseball America Triple-A All-Star.
Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

Made three starts last April with the Reds and put up a 5.93 ERA (13.2 IP, 9 ER) with eight walks and 23 strikeouts...in his next five starts he went 1-1, 2.20 ERA (28.2 IP, 7 ER) with 11 walks and 29 strikeouts in the month of May.
