THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day homestand from April 22-28 with a record of 6-0 (3-0 vs. Chicago-AL and 3-0 vs. Detroit), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip by taking two of three against Tampa Bay in St. Petersburg over the weekend...tonight, they will continue the trip with the first of four against the Orioles through Thursday — all night games...the Twins are 8-4 at home and 5-5 on the road.

☞ The Twins enter today with the fourth-most wins in the AL, trailing New York (16-6), Los Angeles (15-8) and Toronto (15-8).

EIGHTH WINDER OF THE WORLD: The Twins beat the Rays yesterday afternoon at Tropicana Field by a score of 9-3, winning the rubber game and taking their third straight series (now 3-2-2 in series play)...during the series, the Twins outscored the Rays 19-10 and out-hit them 30-20...Josh Winder (1-0) made his first career start (4th appearance) and earned his first win, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts...Cole Sands made his major league debut, allowing two runs on three hits in 2.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 12 hits as Jorge Polanco went 2-for-5 with two doubles and four RBI.

☞ Josh Winder became the first pitcher in Twins history (since 1961) with 6.0-plus shutout innings and two-or-fewer hits allowed in his first major league start...fifth in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901) — the others are Mike Fornieles (1952), Wally Holborow (1945), Claude Thomas (1916) and George Dumont (1915).

☞ Winder is the eighth pitcher in club history to throw 6.0-plus scoreless in his first MLB start — the others were Devin Smeltzer (2019), Andrew Albers (2013), Anthony Swarzak (2009), Benj Sampson (1998), Eric Milton (1998), Rick Lysander (1983) and Jim Roland (1963).

TWWWWWLWINS: After starting the season 4-8, the Twins have now won nine of their last 10 games, with a run differential of +32 (54-22) in those games...since April 21, their nine wins are tied with New York-AL for most in baseball...below are some notable MLB offensive rankings since April 21:

FOR STARTERS: Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 8-6, 2.62 ERA (106.1 IP, 31 ER) with 28 walks, 99 strikeouts, a .205 opponent batting average and a 1.02 WHIP this season...where the Twins starting staff ranks in the AL and MLB below:

NOTE: Twins starters have allowed two runs-or-fewer in 19 of the 22 games this season and one run-or-fewer in 12 games this season.

TRIM DOWN FROM A SIZE 28 TO A SIZE 26: The Twins have recalled infielder Jose Miranda and left-handed pitcher Jovani Moran from Triple-A St. Paul, placed infielder Miguel Sanó on the 10-day Injured List with a left knee sprain (retroactive to May 1), placed outfielder Kyle Garlick on the 10-day Injured List with a right calf strain, and optioned catcher José Godoy and right-handed pitcher Cole Sands to St. Paul...these moves trim the Twins' active roster from 28 to 26 players.

☞ Miranda, 23, played in 21 games for the Saints this season, hitting .256 (22-for-86) with 10 doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, 10 runs scored, five walks and a .737 OPS...the Manati, Puerto Rico native is currently ranked as the No. 3 prospect in the organization, per MLB.com, and is named 2021 Twins minor league Player of the Year.

☞ Moran, 25, posted a 3.68 ERA (7.1 IP, 3 ER) with six walks and 14 strikeouts in six relief appearances for the Saints this season...Moran, who was ranked as the 24th-best prospect in the Twins organization per MLB.com, appeared in five games for Minnesota in 2021.

☞ Sanó played in 17 games for the Twins, hitting .093 (5-for-54) with one home run, three RBI, one run scored, nine walks and a .379 OBP.

☞ Garlick hit .238 (5-for-21) with three home runs, six RBI, six runs scored, five walks and a .385 on-base percentage in 13 games for the Twins...he was 3-for-4 with two home runs and four RBI combined in his last two games prior to going on the Injured List.

☞ Godoy had his contract selected by the Twins on April 23 and played in one game, April 24 vs. Chicago-AL, going 0-for-3 with two walks and two runs scored.

TWINS AND O's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the first of seven scheduled meetings this season...the Twins will host the O's at Target Field for a three-game weekend series from July 1-3.

☞ The Twins went 4-2 against the O's last season, going 3-0 at Target Field from May 24-26 and 1-2 at Oriole Park from May 31-June 2.

☞ The Twins are 32-14 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

☞ Since the start of 2018, the Twins are 16-3 vs. the Orioles...they had a 16-game winning streak over the O's from March 31, 2018-May 31, 2021 until losing their final two meetings of 2021 on June 1 and 2...the 16-game winning streak was one short of their record against a single opponent (17 vs. Boston from June 2, 1965-May 7, 1966)...also since 2018, the Twins have hit 45 home runs in 19 games against Baltimore, including 22 homers in eight games at Camden Yards.

BIRD WATCHERS: Notable individual numbers against Baltimore:

☞ Max Kepler has hit safely in 17 of 19 career games against the Orioles, hitting .389 (28-for-72) with seven doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 22 RBI, nine walks, a .451 OBP and a 1.340 OPS...he has seven homers and 11 RBI in his last 11 games against Baltimore.

☞ Gary Sánchez has 20 home runs in 62 career games vs. the O's, his most vs. any opponent.

☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .367 (44-for-120) with eight doubles, six home runs, 25 RBI, a .408 on-base percentage and a .991 OPS in 36 career games against the O's...he is hitting .319 (23-for-71) with a .950 OPS in 21 games at Camden...one of his two career two-homer games was here on August 7, 2019 (August 8, 2019 at TOR was the other).

SONN-DAY IN THE SONN-SHINE STATE: Right-handed pitcher Sonny Gray made a rehab start for Low-A Fort Myers against Clearwater yesterday, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed and five strikeouts...Gray was placed on the 10-day Injured List on April 17 with a strained right hamstring...he left his start the previous day at Boston after 1.2 innings pitched.

MAX HEAT: After starting the season hitting .156 (5-for-32) with a .571 OPS in his first 10 games, Max Kepler has hit .342 (13-for-38) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, seven walks and a 1.155 OPS in his last 12.

☞ Since April 26, he ranks second in baseball in expected slugging percentage at 1.049, trailing Mike Trout (1.189)...on the season, he ranks seventh in the AL and 12th in baseball in expected slugging percentage.

THE SHOW-RREA: After starting the season hitting .167 (10-for-60) with a .504 OPS in his first 16 games, Carlos Correa is hitting .556 (10-for-18) with five RBI and a 1.190 OPS in his last four...he has multiple hits in four straight games, tied for the second-longest streak of his career...his career-long is five from May 25-29, 2017...since April 28, he has an average exit velocity of 97.4 mph, the best in baseball (minimum of 65 pitches).

- Making his fourth start of the season and 64th of his career...65th career appearance.
Today marks his second career start and appearance against the Baltimore Orioles and fourth against the American League East division.
Acquired on April 7 along with right-handed pitcher Emilio Pagán and a player to be named later (Bryan Medina) from San Diego in exchange for left-handed pitcher Taylor Rogers, outfielder Brent Rooker and cash considerations.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.2 innings in his third start of the season on April 26 against Detroit at Target Field; the Twins won, 5-4...he allowed one run on five hits, one walk and a season-high six strikeouts...

- Has walked just one batter through his first three starts of the season...alongside Dylan Bundy (1 BB in 3 starts from April 11-23, 2022), marks the second time in Twins history that two different pitchers allowed one walk through their respective first three starts of the season... other instance was in 2005 (Brad Radke and Carlos Silva).

TWO STARTS AGO: Was dealt the 2-0 loss on April 20 against the Kansas City Royals at Kauffman Stadium, allowing two runs on five hits over 5.0 innings (0 BB, 4 K)...the Royals' runs scored on a double-play grounder and a bunt single...had yet to receive a run of support in his Twins tenure, as he started two of Minnesota's shutout losses (also 7-0 on April 13 against Los Angeles-NL).

GOOD MORNING BALTIMORE: Tonight marks Paddack's second career start against the Orioles and fourth against the American League East division...earned the win in his first start against Baltimore on July 29, 2019 in an 8-1 Padres victory (5.1 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 5 K)...has 14 career appearances (all starts) against the American League, going 5-5, 4.26 ERA (74.0 IP, 35 ER) in those outings.

- Has faced the AL East thrice in his career, most recently on August 23, 2019 vs. Boston (2.1 IP, 7 H, 6 R/ER, 1 BB, 0 K) in an 11-0 Padres defeat...last win came on July 29, 2019, an 8-1 victory over Baltimore (W, 5.1 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 5 SO)...is 1-2, 7.82 ERA (12.2 IP, 11 ER) with four walks and 11 strikeouts in his career against the AL East.
RAMBLIN' MAN: Paddack is slated to make his second road start of the season and 34th of his career...took the loss in his first start on the road this season at Kansas City...tossed 5.0 innings and allowed two earned runs on five hits and no walks with four strikeouts as the Twins lost 2-0.

NIGHT SHIFT: Making his third start in a night game this season and 47th start of his career...last made a night start on April 26, 2022 vs. Detroit at Target Field (ND, 5.2 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K), when the Twins beat the Tigers, 5-4.

RICHIE THE RALLY GOAT: During the most recent road trip to Kansas City, starter Sonny Gray purchased a small white goat figurine at Barnes & Noble and named him 'Richie'...the goat, which screams when you press him, has found a home with Paddack and currently resides in his locker to bring the team luck...Richie made its Target Field debut Friday, April 22, when the Twins were down 1-0 to Chicago...the Twins came back in the eighth inning to ultimately win 2-1...the goat was also present for the back-to-back walk-off victories against Chicago-NL on Sunday, April 24 and Detroit on Tuesday, April 26...there are plans in place for Richie to rotate around the clubhouse and travel to all the away games for the rest of the season.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2022 SEASON: 3-1, 1.17 ERA // CAREER: 5-2, 2.72 ERA)

Right-hander Ryan is scheduled to start tomorrow night's game against the Orioles...earned the win in his last start on April 27 vs. Detroit after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing just two base runners on one hit and one walk, while recording a season-high nine strikeouts...with those nine strikeouts he now has 55 in his career, passing Bert Blyleven (50) for most strikeouts through a pitcher's first nine career games in Twins/Senators history (1901-present)...now has a WHIP of 0.74 through his first nine career starts, the lowest WHIP by any MLB pitcher over his first nine career starts since Hall of Famer Christy Mathewson from 1900-01 (0.70)...currently on a 17.0-inning scoreless streak, the longest by a Twins rookie since Andrew Albers in 2013 (17.1 innings on August 6, 2013 and August 12, 2013)...facing Baltimore for the first time in his career and facing the American League East division for just the second time...first start against the AL East came earlier this season on April 15 at Boston in an 8-4 Twins victory (W, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 7 K).

CAREER NOTES

- Twins are his third organization, following time with Miami (2015-2016) and San Diego (2016-2021).
Made 23 appearances (22 starts) for San Diego in 2021, going 7-7 with a 5.07 ERA (108.1 IP, 61 ER) and a staff-leading 1.83 BB/9 IP ratio that also tied for ninth in the majors (min. 100.0 IP) and tied for fourth in the NL.
Made his first career Opening Day start on July 24, 2020 vs. Arizona, tossing six shutout innings of four-hit ball in San Diego's 7-2 victory.
Posted 58 strikeouts to 12 walks for a 4.83 SO/BB ratio...among all major league pitchers who made at least 12 starts, his 4.83 SO/BB ratio ranked 10th in the majors and fifth in the NL in 2020.
Made his first career Postseason start and appearance in Game 1 of the 2020 Wild Card Series vs. St. Louis, allowing six runs and eight hits in 2.1 IP in San Diego's 7-4 defeat.
Spent a majority of the 2019 season with San Diego, ranking second on the club in wins (9) and strikeouts (153), and third in starts (26) and innings pitched (149.2).
Made major league debut on March 31, 2019...retired his final 19 batters faced on April 24, 2019 at Seattle to earn his first major league victory.
Posted a 1.93 ERA through his first nine career starts, the lowest ERA in Padres history of any pitcher through their first nine starts...also became the only major league pitcher to debut since 1893 (when the mound was moved to its current distance) to record at least 56 strikeouts while allowing 42-or-fewer baserunners (via hit, walk or HBP) through his first nine career starts.
Became just the third pitcher since 1908 to allow five-or-fewer hits in each of his first nine career starts (min. 3.0 IP per start).
Was one of just six pitchers in 2019 with multiple starts of one-or-fewer hits allowed in 7.0+ innings, along with Trevor Bauer, Luis Castillo, Gerrit Cole, Jack Flaherty and Justin Verlander.
Became one of only 14 rookies in major league history to make more than 25 starts and have a sub-1.00 WHIP.
Rode a perfect game into the sixth inning and a no-hitter into the eighth on July 17, 2019 at Miami before Starlin Castro ended the bid with a solo shot to open the frame.
Fans began calling Paddack "the Sheriff" during Spring Training in 2019 as an ode to his Texas roots and his cowboy hat and boots he wears on start days.

A LOOK BACK AT 2021: Made 23 appearances (22 starts) for San Diego, going 7-7, 5.07 ERA (108.1 IP, 61 ER) and a staff-leading 1.83 walks-per-9.0 IP ratio that also tied for ninth in the majors (min. 100.0 IP) and tied for fourth in the NL.

- As a rookie in 2019, his 71.4 first pitch strike percentage led the majors (min. 140.0 IP), ahead of veterans Max Scherzer (70.4), Madison Bumgarner (69.5) and Masahiro Tanaka (68.7).
