**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-1 through three games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, after winning a series in Oakland this week, taking the book-end games at RingCentral Coliseum... tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three at Kauffman Stadium against the Royals over the weekend...the Twins are 13-8 at home and 9-8 on the road.

The Twins have won six of their last nine games on the road, dating back to April 30.

TWINS GET ON OFFENSIVE IN OAKLAND: The Twins beat the A's on Wednesday afternoon at RingCentral Coliseum by a score of 14-4, setting a season-high in runs scored...Sonny Gray (1-1) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with no walks and five strikeouts against his former team...the offense recorded 14 hits and went 10-for-17 with runners in scoring position...of the 14 hits, five were doubles and nine were singles... according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the last time the Twins scored as many runs without the benefit of at least one home run came in a 15-3 win vs. Milwaukee on May 21, 2010...Luis Arraez went 3-for-5 with two doubles, one walk, two RBI and a career-high four runs scored.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the fourth of 19 meetings in 2022...their last series came at Kauffman from April 19-21, losing the first two but winning game three. 

In their last three-game series at Kansas City, the Twins went 22-for-95 (.232) with four runs scored, three doubles, one triple, eight RBI and a .579 0PS...it marked the Twins' first time not hitting a home run in a three-game series at Kauffman since April 20-22, 2015...their last homer here was a Byron Buxton two-run fifth-inning shot off Joel Payamps on October 3, 2021.

Luis Arraez is hitting .352 (37-for-105) with five doubles, one triple, eight RBI, 14 walks, a .431 on-base percentage and an .850 0PS in 30 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 26 of those 30...his batting average is tops among actives (min. 100 AB)... additionally, he is hitting .397 (23-for-58) with a .446 on-base percentage in 16 career games at Kauffman...he has 13 hits in his last 25 at-bats at Kauffman (.520 avg).

Byron Buxton is hitting .389 (14-for-36) with six doubles, three home runs, five RBI, 11 runs scored and a 1.211 0PS in his last eight games against the Royals.

Carlos Correa has hit safely in eight straight games at Kauffman Stadium, hitting .400 (12-for-30) with a 1.090 0PS in that span.

MINNESOTA WINS: Beginning with a 1-0 victory over the Royals in the April 21 series finale at Kauffman Stadium, the Twins have gone 18-8 for the third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL (21-5) and Houston (19-8)...below are some notable AL offensive rankings since that date:

**DIVISION SIGNS:** Each of the Twins' next 15 games are against divisional opponents...in that 15-game span, they will play the Royals seven times and the Tigers eight times...they have gone 9-3 against the AL Central this season, going 1-2 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 3-0 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland.

ALL TO ARMS: Twins pitchers have posted a 3.35 ERA (336.0 IP, 125 ER) with 110 walks, 30 strikeouts and a .229 opponent batting average this season...below are the AL ranks in a few notable pitching categories:

RISPY BUSINESS: After hitting .167 (14-for-84) with runners in scoring position in their previous 12 games (May 5-17), the Twins went 10-for-17 with RISP on Wednesday afternoon at Oakland...on the season, they are hitting .268 (77-for-287) with RISP, the third highest in the AL and 10th best in baseball.

▼ Notable individuals with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .421 (8-for-19)...Carlos Correa is hitting .360 (9-for-25)...Jorge Polanco is hitting .353 (12-for-34)...Luis Arraez is hitting .350 (7-for-20)...Polanco's RISP average ranks fifth in the AL among players with a minimum of 30 plate appearances in such situations.

LEFTY LOOSEY: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the 14th time (9-4) in 38 games...they are hitting .251 (102-for-406) with 45 walks, 24 doubles and 13 home runs against lefties this season...however, in 14 games this month, the Twins are hitting .284 (42-for-148) with a .366 on-base percentage, the highest average in the AL and third best in baseball (Colorado - .299 & St. Louis - .292).

▼ Individuals vs. lefties: Byron Buxton is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with five home runs and an .862 slugging percentage...Gilberto Celestino is hitting .308 (8-for-26)...Carlos Correa is hitting .294 (10-for-34) with five doubles and a .385 on-base percentage.

I LOVE LUEY: Luis Arraez is hitting .323 (31-for-96), the seventh-highest batting average in the AL (minimum of 100 PA)...additionally, he has posted a .425 on-base percentage, third highest in the AL, trailing only Taylor Ward (.488) and Mike Trout (.432).

◆ He has drawn 16 walks in 113 plate appearances this season, posting a 14.2 BB%, ranking in the top 8% of baseball...conversely, he has struck out just seven times in 113 PA's for a 6.2 K%, ranking in the top 1% of baseball.

◆ He is hitting .386 (22-for-57) against fastballs this season, the third best in baseball (minimum of 450 total pitches seen).

**FIREMEN:** In their last 21 games since April 27, the bullpen has combined to go 7-3, 2.48 ERA (90.2 IP, 25 ER) with 20 walks, 90 strikeouts and a .216 opponent batting average...since that date, their strikeouts rank second in all of baseball, their ERA ranks third and their opponent batting average ranks seventh...the Twins are 20-0 this season when leading after 7.0 innings.

THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1970, Hall of Famer Rod Carew hit for the first cycle in Twins history in a 10-5 win in Kansas City...he went 4-for-5 and sealed the cycle with an eighth-inning triple...in 1989, Randy Bush tied a team record with eight RBI in a 19-3 rout against the Texas Rangers...collected three-run home runs in back-to-back innings, while current Twins broadcaster Dan Gladden tied a major league record with seven plate appearances in the game, going 1-for-7 with an RBI and run scored...in 2005, Carlos Silva threw a 74-pitch complete game in a 7-1 victory over the Brewers at home...in 2011, the Twins were fortunate enough to be playing in Arizona and were able to attend the funeral of Twins legend Harmon Killebrew, who had passed a few days prior.

LAST TIME OUT: Went toe-to-toe in a pitchers' duel with Shane Bieber but did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.0 innings and yielding just one run on three hits, with two walks and two strikeouts on May 14 vs. Cleveland as the Twins fell, 3-2 in 10 innings...his contract was purchased from Triple-A St. Paul that day (Alex Kirilloff optioned) as the Twins needed another starter with Bailey Ober on the 10-day Injured List and Dylan Bundy on the COVID-Injured List.

The Made his first major league appearance since April 24, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh and first start since August 7, 2020 at Kansas City.

Marked the first time he pitched at least 5.0 innings in a single outing since he also went 5.0 innings in a start at Detroit on September 26, 2019.

His 77 pitches tied the most he has thrown this season in a professional game, after also throwing 77 pitches for Triple-A St. Paul on April 21 at Toledo.

SO FAR IN ST PAUL: Appeared in five games (all starts) for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-2, 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 18 strikeouts.

◆ Extended his scoreless innings streak to 11.0 innings to start the season before he permitted

- two runs on five hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings in his third start of the season on April 21 at Toledo...took the loss as the Saints fell, 2-1.

  Took the loss for St. Paul on May 3 vs. the lowa Cubs and allowed six of his nine runs of the
- season in that single start.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training... placed on the 10-day Injured list on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after an injury during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be a herniated disc in his neck... transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

SUCCESS AS A STARTER: Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer is 2-2, 3.83 ERA (40.0 IP, 17 ER) with a .235 BAA (35-for-149) and .674 opponent OPS in eight career starts...he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 BAA (38-for-135) and .834 opponent OPS in 12 big league relief outings.

A FAMILIAR FOE: Tonight marks Smeltzer's sixth career appearance and third start against the Royals...he is 2-0, 2.25 ERA (16.0 IP, 4 ER) in his five prior outings but has a 5.68 ERA (6.1 IP, 4 ER) at Kauffman Stadium...earned his first major league win with a 3-0 victory over KC on August 4, 2019 at Targeit Field (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 BB, 4 K)...last earned the win in relief vs. Kansas City on August 17, 2020 in an 4-1 Twins victory (2.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K)...last start against the Royals came on August 7, 2020 at Kauffman Stadium as the Twins lost, 3-2...Smeltzer tossed 4.1 innings (4 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 K) and did not factor into the decision.

◆ Over the course of his career, Smeltzer has appeared against the Royals five times, his second most appearances against any opponent (has faced Cleveland six times)...has not faced any other opponent more than twice.

◆ Has faced the AL Central 15 times in his career (7 starts)...last win came in relief on August 17, 2020, a 4-1 victory over Kansas City at Target Field...last start against the AL Central came on August 7, 2020 at Kansas City as the Twins lost, 3-2...is 4-2, 5.15 ERA (50.2 IP, 29 ER) with 17 walks and 38 strikeouts in his 15 career appearances (7 starts) against the AL Central.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Smeltzer is slated to make his eighth career road appearance (5th start)...last pitched away from Target Field in a relief appearance on August 23, 2020 against the Royals (2.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R/ER, 0 BB, 1 K) in the 5-4 Twins win...last start on the road was on August 7, 2020 (ND, 4.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 K) as the Twins fell to the Royals, 3-2.

The Most recent win on the road came in a start on September 26, 2019 (W, 5.0 IP, 10 H, 3 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K) as the Twins defeated Detroit, 10-4.

Is 1-1, 6.75 ERA (26.2 IP, 20 ER) with 36 hits allowed, seven walks and 17 strikeouts in his career on the road...those numbers shift to 3-1, 2.63 ERA (48.0 IP, 14 ER) with 37 hits allowed, 13 walks and 41 strikeouts in 13 career appearances (4 starts) at Target Field.

NIGHT SHIFT: Making his second start/appearance of the season in a night game and 11th appearance (6th start) of his career...most recent night game win was in relief on August 17, 2020 vs. Kansas City (W, 2.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K) as the Twins won, 4-1...has yet to earn a win in a night game he has started.

To Is 1-2, 4.08 ERA (39.2 IP, 18 ER) in 10 career night appearances (5 starts), compared to a 3-0 record, 4.11 ERA (35.0 IP, 16 ER) in 10 career day appearances (3 starts).
