THE TWINS: Have gone 3-1 through four games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, winning a three-game series in Oakland this week, followed by a victory in the series-opener last night in Kansas City...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three at Kauffman Stadium and complete the series tomorrow afternoon...the Twins are 13-8 at home and 10-8 on the road.
 ☞ Since April 21, the Twins have gone 19-8, tied with Houston for the second-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL's 21.
 ☞ The Twins have won seven of their last 10 games on the road, dating back to April 30.
 ☞ A win tonight would make the Twins eight games over .500, which would be their highest mark since ending the 2020 season 12 games over at 36-24.

YOU THROW THE BALL, YOU HIT THE BALL, YOU CATCH THE BALL: The Twins beat the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 6-4, improving to 11-7 in May...Devin Smeltzer (1-0) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and no strikeouts...Emilio Pagán recorded his sixth save in seven chances...the offense recorded seven hits, two apiece from their number eight and nine batters, Jose Miranda and Gilberto Celestino...Miranda drove in two insurance runs in the eighth inning with a two-out double...Gary Sánchez doubled, giving him an extra-base hit for the fourth-straight game.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins announced today that they have returned right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List, and selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Trevor Megill from Triple-A St. Paul.

☞ Ober, who missed the Twins' last 20 games with a right groin strain, made one start on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul on May 15 at Columbus, pitching 5.0 innings and allowing five runs (4 earned), with four hits allowed and seven strikeouts...he went 1-1, 2.75 ERA (19.2 IP, 6 ER), five walks and 16 strikeouts in four starts for the Twins prior to exiting his outing on April 28 vs. Detroit.
 ☞ Megill, 28, has gone 0-2, 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks, 15 strikeouts, two saves and a 1.36 WHIP in nine relief outings for the Saints this season, after signing a minor league contract with the Twins in December 2021...he made his major league debut for Chicago-NL on April 26, 2021 and has gone 1-2, 8.37 ERA (23.2 IP, 22 ER), eight walks and 30 strikeouts in 28 career major league appearances, all with the Cubs last season.
 ☞ To make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer to Triple-A St. Paul and placed right-handed pitcher Josh Winder on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to May 18) with right shoulder impingement.
 ☞ To make room for Megill on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated minor league right-handed pitcher Chris Vallimont for release or assignment...Vallimont, 25, has gone 0-2, 9.95 ERA (19.0 IP, 21 ER), 23 walks and 20 strikeouts in seven games (6 starts) for Double-A Wichita this season...he was acquired by Minnesota via trade from the Miami Marlins on July 27, 2019 and is currently the No. 22 prospect in the Twins organization, per MLB.com.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the fifth of 19 meetings in 2022.
 ☞ The Twins have not homered in their last four games at Kauffman Stadium, their longest stretch here since going homerless in eight straight from August 26, 2014-July 3, 2015...their last homer in this ballpark was a Byron Buxton two-run fifth-inning shot off Joel Payamps on October 3, 2021...they have 37 home runs at Kauffman Stadium since 2019, the most of any opponent in this park during that span.
 ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .343 (37-for-108) with five doubles, one triple, eight RBI, 14 walks, a .421 on-base percentage and an .828 OPS in 31 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 26 of those 31...his batting average is tops among actives (min. 100 AB)... additionally, he is hitting .377 (23-for-61) with a .426 on-base percentage in 17 career games at Kauffman...he has 13 hits in his last 28 at-bats at Kauffman (.464 avg).
 ☞ Carlos Correa has hit safely in nine-straight games at Kauffman Stadium, hitting .382 (13-for-34) with a 1.038 OPS in that span.

DIVISION SIGNS: Each of the Twins' next 14 games are against divisional opponents...in that 14-game span, they will play the Royals six times and the Tigers eight times...they have gone 10-3 against the AL Central this season, going 2-2 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 3-0 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland.
 ☞ The Twins'.769 winning percentage in the division is the third-best in baseball, trailing Miami (.714 — 10-4 vs. NL East), New York-AL (.682 — 15-7 vs. the AL East) and Milwaukee (.682 — 15-7 vs. the NL Central).

IT'S A CELE-BRATION: Gilberto Celestino is hitting .417 (20-for-48) with four doubles, three RBI, three walks, six runs scored, a .462 on-base percentage and a .962 OPS in his last 16 games, since April 28...among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 50 at-bats, he ranks first in batting average (.350) and on-base percentage (.409), fourth in OPS (.826) and fifth in slugging percentage (.417).

ROCCO'S WALLBANGERS: The Twins have hit 40 doubles in 18 games this month...they have 70 doubles on the season, third-most in baseball, trailing Boston (86) and Los Angeles-AL (76)...Gary Sánchez has 12 doubles on the season, tied for fourth-most in the AL and tied for ninth-most in baseball.

RELEASE THE KRACKEN: Gary Sánchez is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with five doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, an .821 slugging percentage and a 1.209 OPS in his last seven games...Sánchez has recorded an extra-base hit in four-straight games, tying the second-longest of his career (5th time), last being May 19-22, 2019...his career-long for an extra-base hit streak is six, done September 15-21, 2016 with the Yankees.

TENACIOUS D: The Twins have committed just one error in their last six games and 18 errors on the season, fifth-fewest in the AL and tied for ninth-fewest in baseball...additionally, Twins outfielders have combined for 13 defensive runs saved (8 from LFs, 4 from RFs and 1 from CFs), the second-most in baseball, trailing Houston (15).

HAPPY HRBIE DAY! Twins Hall of Famer Kent Hrbek is celebrating his 62nd birthday today...he played eight games on his birthday during his 14-year career with Minnesota, hitting .240 (6-for-25) with two doubles, one home run and two RBI...Hrbek had a 38.6 BWAR for his career, second-best of any player born on May 21, behind Hall of Famer Earl Averill (51.1)...he shares a birthday with Bobby Cox (81), Al Franken (71) and Mr. T (70).
