THE TWINS: Have gone 4-1 through five games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, winning a three-game series in Oakland earlier this week...

RYAN + ARRAEZ + RUNS = ROYALTY: The Twins beat the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 9-2, securing the series victory and making them 7-3-3 in series play...

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have returned outfielder Trevor Larnach from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...

THIS IS 40: With the Twins playing their 40th game last night, below are the yearly hitting and pitching comparisons for the first 40, dating back to 2018:

Table comparing hitting and pitching stats for the first 40 games from 2018 to 2022.

NOTE: 24 wins are tied for seventh most through the club's first 40 games (since 1961), their best being a 28-12 record through 40 in both 1970 and 2001.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the sixth of 19 meetings in 2022.

The Twins have not homered in their last five games at Kauffman Stadium, their longest stretch here since going homerless in eight straight from August 26, 2014-July 3, 2015...

Luis Arraez is hitting .351 (39-for-111) with five doubles, one triple, 10 RBI, 16 walks, a .435 on-base percentage and an .850 OPS in 32 career games vs. the Royals...

Carlos Correa has hit safely in 10-straight games at Kauffman Stadium, hitting .385 (15-for-39) with a 1.034 OPS in that span.

IT'S A CELEBRATION: Gilberto Celestino is hitting .420 (21-for-50) with four doubles, three RBI, four walks, seven runs scored, a .473 on-base percentage and a .973 OPS in his last 17 games...

CLUTCHING UP: After hitting .167 (14-for-84) with runners in scoring position in their previous 12 games (May 5-17), the Twins have hit .459 (17-for-37) with RISP in their last three games...

The Twins are hitting .246 (105-for-427) with two outs this season, the best average in the AL and sixth-best in baseball... additionally, since May 10, they have scored 28 two out runs...

BUST OUT THE BROOMS: The Twins are seeking their fourth sweep of the season today... their other three sweeps were April 22-24 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games), April 26-28 vs. Detroit (3 games) and May 6-8 vs. Oakland (3 games)...

RELEASE THE KRACKEN: Gary Sánchez is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with six doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, an .781 slugging percentage and a 1.153 OPS in his last eight games...

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Alex Kirilloff and High-A Cedar Rapids left-handed pitcher Cade Povich are the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

Kirilloff, who was optioned to St. Paul from Minnesota on May 14, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .458 (11-for-24) with one double, one home run, four RBI, three walks, a .519 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.144 OPS...

Povich, 22, made one start for the Kernels on Thursday vs. Lake County, earning the win after pitching 5.1 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and five strikeouts... this marks his second honor this season, the other coming on April 17.

- ☞ Making his third career start and appearance against Kansas City...has gone 0-0, 4.32 ERA (8.1 IP, 4 ER) with no walks and 10 strikeouts in his two prior starts.
- ☞ Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in a 7-1 Twins victory over Detroit on April 28 at Target Field after tossing 3.2 innings and allowing one run on six hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in his fourth start this season...departed in favor of Cody Stashak in the fourth inning due to right groin tightness.

- ☞ Marked his third consecutive start allowing one-or-fewer earned runs and second straight against American League opponents.

COME BACK STRONGER: Today will mark his first start after returning from the 10-day Injured List with a right groin strain; returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated yesterday...was removed from his start vs. Detroit on April 28 and placed on the 10-day Injured List on April 30...made a rehab start in Triple-A St. Paul on May 15 at Columbus and covered 5.0 innings, allowing five runs (4 earned) on four hits (1 HR), with no walks and seven strikeouts.

- ☞ Was the fifth time in his professional career he landed on the Injured List...most recently missed the end of the 2021 season (September 28-end of 2021 season) with a right hip strain...also went on the Injured List in Double-A Pensacola (September 8-16, 2019) with right elbow inflammation, in High-A Fort Myers (April 29-July 12, 2019) with right ulnar nerve subluxation and in Low-A Cedar Rapids (July 28-end of 2018 season) with a right elbow strain.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the 2-1 Twins victory over Chicago-AL on April 22, allowing just one run on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...the Twins scored twice in the bottom of the eighth inning to win...marked his eighth career start with no walks, first since September 24, 2021 vs. Toronto (5.1 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 6 K)...threw 70.9 percent of his pitches for strikes (79 pitches, 56 strikes), the seventh time in his career he's recorded a strike percentage of over 70 percent in a start...also posted a career long 12.0-inning scoreless streak (no ER allowed) from the fourth inning on April 10 until Andrew Vaughn's solo shot to lead off the fifth inning.

AND WE'LL NEVER BE ROYALS: Will be facing the Royals for the third time in his career (all starts)...has gone 0-0, 4.32 ERA (8.1 IP, 4 ER) with no walks and 10 strikeouts in his two prior starts...last start against Kansas City came at Target Field on September 12, 2021 (ND, 4.1 IP, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 6 K) as the Twins lost, 5-3...has one career start at Kauffman Stadium on June 6, 2021 (ND, 4.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K), as the Twins won, 2-1.

- ☞ Is 0-0, 2.08 ERA (8.2 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in two starts against the American League Central division this season.
- ☞ Owns 13 career appearances (all starts) against the AL Central...is 2-2, 4.27 ERA (59.0 IP, 28 ER) with 63 hits allowed, 12 walks and 59 strikeouts in those outings.

BACK ON THE ROAD: Today marks Ober's second start on the road of the 2022 season...took the loss in his prior start away from Target Field on April 17 at Boston (6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R/0 ER, 1 BB, 3 K)...in comparison, he is 1-0, 3.95 ERA (13.2 IP, 6 ER) with four walks and 13 strikeouts in three home starts in 2022.

- ☞ Has made 11 career appearances (all starts) on the road and is 1-3, 3.75 ERA (50.1 IP, 21 ER) with nine walks and 50 strikeouts in those outings...this compares to 3-1 record, 4.09 ERA (61.2 IP, 28 ER) with 15 walks and 62 strikeouts in 13 career appearances (all starts) at home.

DAYTIME DELIGHT: Ober will start his fourth day game of the season...is 1-1, 3.07 ERA (14.2 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and 10 strikeouts in his prior three day starts, compared to 0-0, 1.80 ERA (5.0 IP, 1 ER) in his one night start vs. Chicago-AL this season (ND, 5.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 6 K).

- ☞ Is 2-2, 4.38 ERA (51.1 IP, 25 ER) in 11 career starts in day games...is 2-2, 3.56 ERA (60.2 IP, 24 ER) in 13 career starts in night games.
- ☞ Last win in a day game came earlier this season on April 10 vs. Seattle (W, 5.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K).

DEEP ARSENAL: Here's a look at Ober's pitch selection in his first four starts this season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his 4-seam fastball and slider.

LEFT AND RIGHT: Is holding opposing right-handed hitters to a .174 (8-for-46) batting average, two doubles, two home runs and a .204 on-base percentage this season...opposing lefties are batting .367 (11-for-30) with two doubles and a .412 on-base percentage against him.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/2 ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10-straight starts from July 20-September 12, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span...span included his two quality starts on the season, August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 3 R/2 ER) and August 30 at Detroit (6.0 IP, 2 ER).

- ☞ Posted a 5.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the highest single-season mark by a Twins/Senators rookie pitcher (min. 70.0 IP), and tops among all major league rookies last season (also min. 70.0 IP).
- ☞ Struck out a career-high seven batters in third start on June 11 vs. Houston (5.0 IP)...matched career high two more times: July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP) and August 25 at Boston (5.0 IP).
- ☞ Named the 2021 winner of the Bill Boni Award for Twins minor league Player of the Year.

HEY, ROOKIE! YOU WERE GOOD: Ober's 20 starts in 2021 marked the most by a Twins rookie since Adalberto Mejia had 21 in 2017, while his 96 strikeouts were the most since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...96 strikeouts also matched Nick Blackburn (2008) and Gerry Arrigo (1964) for 10th most in a single season by a Minnesota rookie...ranked sixth among American League rookies in ERA (minimum 90.0 IP) and 12th in innings pitched (92.1).

AND ALL'S FAIR IN LOVE AND WAR: Posted a 1.1 WAR in 2021, per Baseball Reference...became the first Twins rookie pitcher to surpass 1.0 WAR in a single season since Tyler Duffy in 2015 (1.6 WAR).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER [2022 SEASON: 0-1, 4.10 ERA // CAREER: 61-82, 3.88 ERA]

Right-hander Chris Archer is slated to start tomorrow night's series opener vs. the Detroit Tigers at Target Field...did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 16 at Oakland, after tossing 4.0 innings and allowing one run on two hits, with two walks and two strikeouts; departed with the game tied 1-1, and the Twins scored one run apiece in the fifth and sixth innings to win, 3-1...will be facing the Tigers for the first time this season and 12th time in his career (all starts)...is 2-3, 3.66 ERA (59.0 IP, 24 ER) with 23 walks and 66 strikeouts in his 11 prior starts vs. Detroit.

CAREER NOTES

- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks, 117 strikeouts and a .252 opponent batting average in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week for Fort Myers on April 14 and Southern League Pitcher of the Week for Pensacola on September 2.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston for the 2017 season.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John Surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
