THE TWINS: Completed their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 5-1, going 2-1 in Oakland and 3-0 in Kansas City...tonight, the Twins will begin their fourth homestand of the season with the first of three against the Tigers...after this series, the Twins will host the Royals for four games from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins are 13-8 at home and 12-8 on the road.

TWINS COMEBACK LATE AT KAUFFMAN: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 7-6, scoring all seven runs in the eighth and ninth innings...the win marked their first come-from-behind victory when down by six-or-more runs since August 31, 2018 at Texas, when the Twins were down 0-6 and won 10-7...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...Trevor Megill made his Twins debut with 1.2 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Luis Arraez...Kyle Garlick added a home run, marking his fourth of the season...the win marked their fourth sweep of the season and their first at Kauffman Stadium since 2011 (4 games).

TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the fourth of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins swept their last series against the Tigers in three games from April 26-28 at Target Field, outscoring Detroit 17-5...the Twins' first trip to Comerica Park will come in five games next week from May 30-June 2 (doubleheader on May 31).

- ☞ The Twins have won 20 of their last 29 over the Tigers and 25 of their last 37.
- ☞ At Target Field, the Twins have gone 13-3 in their last 16 vs. Detroit, 18-4 in their last 22 and 24-7 in their last 31.
- ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .303 (103-for-340) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 54 RBI, 27 walks and an .840 OPS in 88 career games against the Tigers...he has reached base safely in 20 straight against Detroit.
- ☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .309 (25-for-81) with five doubles, one home run, 11 RBI, nine walks and a .385 on-base percentage in 28 career games vs. Detroit...Urshela went 5-for-10 with two walks in the last three-game series in April.
- ☞ Max Kepler went 4-for-11 with one double, three home runs, five RBI and one walk in the last three-game series with the Tigers.
- ☞ Twins pitchers combined to allow five runs in 27.0 inning pitched (1.67 ERA) over the last three game series with Detroit, including a .214 opponent batting average.

TWINS PILE UP WINS: The Twins have won four straight and six of their last seven...after going 4-8 in their first 12 games, the Twins have gone 21-8 since April 21, tied with Houston (21-9) for the second-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL's 22 (7 losses).

☞ Since that date, they rank fourth in baseball in ERA (3.13), trailing Houston (2.58), Los Angeles-NL (2.98) and Los Angeles-AL (3.04)...additionally, the offense leads baseball in OBP (.338) and ranks fourth in OPS (.755).

☞ Through games of May 22, 2021, the Twins were 16-29, in fifth place in the AL Central and 10.5 games back in the division.

CENTRAL HEATING: Tonight marks the Twins' fourth game in to a 15-game stretch against divisional opponents...in the next 12 games, they will play the Royals four times and the Tigers eight times...they have gone 12-3 against the AL Central this season, going 4-2 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 3-0 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland.

☞ The Twins' .800 winning percentage in the division is the best inter-divisional record in baseball (12-3).

RISPING IT ALL: After hitting .167 (14-for-84) with runners in scoring position in their previous 12 games (May 5-17), the Twins have hit .426 (20-for-47) with RISP in their last four games...on the season, they are hitting .274 (87-for-317) with RISP, the third highest in the AL and seventh best in baseball.

- ☞ The Twins are hitting .248 (109-for-439) with two outs this season, the best average in the AL and fourth-best in baseball...additionally, since May 10, they have scored 31 two-out runs, the third most in baseball since that date, trailing Boston (37) and New York-AL (32).
- ☞ Notable individuals with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .421 (8-for-19)...Carlos Correa is hitting .357 (10-for-28)...Jorge Polanco is hitting .342 (13-for-38)...Luis Arraez is hitting .375 (9-for-24)...Polanco's RISP average ranks sixth in the AL among players with a minimum of 40 plate appearances in such situations.

ARRAEZ-ING UP: Luis Arraez is hitting .336 (36-for-107), the fifth-highest batting average in the AL (minimum of 100 PA)...additionally, he has posted a .437 on-base percentage, second highest in the AL, trailing only Taylor Ward (.481).

- ☞ Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with nine walks, a .545 on-base percentage and a 1.045 OPS in 10 games.
- ☞ He has drawn 18 walks in 126 plate appearances this season, posting a 14.3 BB%, ranking in the top 6% of baseball...conversely, he has struck out just eight times in 126 PA's for a 6.3 K%, ranking in the top 1% of baseball.
- ☞ He is hitting .400 (26-for-65) against fastballs this season, the second best in baseball (minimum of 500 total pitches seen).

POWER OUTAGE: The Twins have scored 36 runs in their last four games, but have hit just one home run — Kyle Garlick two-run shot yesterday in Kansas City...the Twins hit 23 home runs in April, the eighth most in baseball but have hit 18 homers in May, tied for 19th in baseball for the month.

MAX HEAT: After starting the season hitting .191 (9-for-47) with a .598 OPS in his first 15 games, Max Kepler has hit .300 (24-for-80) with five doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, 12 walks, a .389 on-base percentage, a .513 slugging percentage and a .902 OPS in his last 24...he has reached safely via hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in each of his last 10 games (.429 OBP).

LARNING SIGNS: Trevor Larnach is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with six doubles, three RBI, 10 runs scored, three walks, a .390 on-base percentage and an .890 OPS in his last 11 games.

- ✎ Tonight marks his 12th career start and appearance against Detroit...is 2-3, 3.66 ERA (59.0 IP, 24 ER) lifetime against the Tigers, including a September 11, 2021 start with Tampa Bay.
- ✎ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Turned in his most effective outing of the month a week ago tonight, allowing one run on two hits in 4.0 innings of the Twins' roadtrip-opening, 3-1 victory May 16 at Oakland...walked two and struck out two, while he did not allow a home run for the first time in six starts, dating back to his season-opening effort on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL (5-start streak giving up a longball was the 5th stretch of at least that length in his career)...Byron Buxton's RBI single in the fifth snapped a 1-1 tie. Gary Sánchez added a solo homer in the sixth and three Twins relievers blanked the A's on two hits over the final 5.0 frames.

✎ Two hits allowed matched Archer's season low for the third time (also April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL and April 30 at Tampa Bay; all 3 outings were 4.0 innings).

TWO STARTS AGO: Dealt his first loss of the season during the May 11 suspended game against Houston...worked the first 3.0 innings and allowed a season-high five runs (4 earned) on five hits, with three walks and two strikeouts (hits and walks also matched season worsts)...was removed prior to the top of the fourth inning, but then the rain and thunderstorms came before Yennier Cano could throw his first pitch with the Twins trailing, 5-1...game was suspended and resumed the next afternoon (May 12); the Astros won, 11-3.

✎ Threw his hardest four-seamer of the season at 95.9 mph during a three-up, three-down first inning, before allowing two runs in the second and three more in the third.

1400 STRIKEOUTS ON THE HORIZON: Archer enters tonight with 1394 career strikeouts and, with six more, would become the 22nd active pitcher and 250th in American/National League history (since 1901) to reach the 1400 plateau (per StatPass).

✎ Has compiled his 1394 strikeouts in 1280.2 innings pitched, good for an average of 9.80 punchouts per 9.0 innings...fanned 1167 batters with Tampa Bay (2nd in franchise history) and 203 with Pittsburgh, while posting 24 strikeouts thus far in his first season in Minnesota.

✎ Despite spending half of the 2018 season and all of the 2019 campaign in the National League, before missing 2020, he still ranks sixth in the American League with 1155 strikeouts since 2013, his first full season...is fifth in the Junior Circuit over the same stretch by averaging 9.63 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched.

TIGER TAMER: Archer is set to make his 12th career start and appearance against Detroit...has posted a 3.66 ERA (59.0 IP, 24 ER) over his first 11 outings, despite a 2-3 record (his Tampa Bay teams went 6-5 in those efforts).

✎ Last faced the Tigers on September 11, 2021 at Comerica Park, allowing one run on two hits in 4.0 innings of the Rays' 7-2 road win (1 BB, 2 K).

✎ His last win vs. Detroit came on June 17, 2017 (also at Comerica), a 3-2 Tampa Bay victory (6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 8 K).

✎ Posted a 3.13 ERA (31.2 IP, 11 ER) in six home starts for the Rays against the Tigers.

LOOKING TO GET BACK ON TARGET: Following 4-0-scoreless innings against Los Angeles-NL in his Twins debut on April 12, Archer boasted a perfect 4-0 mark and a 2.06 ERA (39.1 IP, 9 ER) in seven lifetime starts at Target Field...however, in his two home starts since (April 24 vs. Chicago-AL and May 11 vs. Houston), he is 0-1 while allowing seven runs (6 earned) on eight hits in 6.0 innings (6 BB, 4 K).

✎ In three home efforts overall this season, he is 0-1, 5.40 ERA (10.0 IP, 6 ER) with a .256/.348/.462 opponent slash line (10-for-39 with 2 2B and 2 HR)...has left with the Twins behind in two of those games.

✎ Owns a 3.31 ERA (16.1 IP, 6 ER) in his four road starts, with eight walks, 17 strikeouts and a .210/.300/.468 opponent slash line (13-for-62 with 4 2B and 4 HR).

STINGY WHEN IT COUNTS: Archer has allowed a .228 opponent batting average (23-for-101) with 12 extra-base hits (6 2B and 6 HR) overall...with runners on base, he tightens to a .206 mark (7-for-34) with just two doubles allowed...he is stingiest with runners in scoring position, allowing just three hits – all singles – in 22 at-bats (.136).

THE ARSENAL: Archer has upped his changeup and curveball usage the last four starts, throwing those 20.2 percent of the time (59 of 292 pitches), per Baseball Savant...just 3.5 percent of his pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed over his first three efforts...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

✎ His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.1 mph on the fastball and 88.8 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.

✎ His changeup has been used almost exclusively to left-handed batters, and has been effective: Opponents are 2-for-15 (.133) with one double and five strikeouts against the pitch.

ONE STEP AT A TIME: Tonight will be Archer's eighth appearance and start of the season, his most since logging 23 (all starts) with Pittsburgh in 2019...missed the final month of that season with right shoulder inflammation, all of 2020 following thoracic outlet surgery and most of 2021 due to right lateral forearm tightness and left hip soreness (made 6 appearances/5 starts for Tampa Bay).

✎ Also had an even more abbreviated 2022 Spring Training than most after signing with Minnesota on March 27...has thrown 70-plus pitches in four starts (topping out at 79 on April 30 at Tampa Bay), while his 492 pitches overall are already more than the 327 he threw in 2021.

✎ Has pitched into the fifth inning just once in his first seven starts (April 19 at Kansas City), but has departed with the Twins either tied (3 times) or ahead by a run (twice) in five of his efforts.

✎ Is looking for his first win in a Minnesota uniform...last victory came September 4, 2021 against the Twins, with Tampa Bay at Tropicana Field.

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Archer signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on March 27...marks his fifth organization (Cleveland 2006-08, Chicago-NL, 2019-10, Tampa Bay 2011-18 and '21) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

✎ In a Bally Sports North interview, Archer cited his relationship with Twins Manager Rocco Baldelli and Vice President, Baseball Operations Strategy & Innovation Josh Kalk (both of whom were with Tampa Bay's front office and/or coaching staff from 2011-17), Minnesota's catching duo and up-the-middle defense, and positive reviews from one-time Rays teammate and former Twins starter Jake Odorizzi among his many reasons for coming to the Twin Cities.

MEANT TO BE: Upon signing with Minnesota, Archer took to his personal Instagram page to post a photo of himself from his Little League days wearing a Twins uniform...the young, then-outfielder was supporting a blue Twins top with the "M" hat.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY (2022 SEASON: 1-1, 3.48 ERA // CAREER: 83-73, 3.61 ERA)

Right-hander Sonny Gray is scheduled to take the Target Field mound tomorrow night in the middle contest of this three-game series...is coming off his first win in a Twins uniform and his first career victory against the Oakland franchise that drafted him, as he worked 6.0 innings in Minnesota's 14-4 rout on May 18 at RingCentral Coliseum (6 H, 2 R/ER, 0 BB, 5 K)...the Twins have won all three of his starts since he was returned from rehab assignment and reinstated from the 10-day IL on May 7, while he has fashioned a 2.51 ERA (14.1 IP, 4 ER) with 12 hits allowed, six walks and 20 strikeouts...is 2-1, 3.23 ERA (30.2 IP, 11 ER) in six career games (5 starts) vs. Detroit...has not faced the Tigers since earning a 7-1 win for Cincinnati on Opening Day of the shortened 2020 season (July 24; 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 9 K).

- Twins are his fifth organization, following time with Cleveland (2006-08), Chicago-NL (2009-10), Tampa Bay (2011-18 and 2021) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).
- Has recorded double-digit strikeout totals 30 times in career...also boasts three seasons with at least 200.0 innings pitched and 200-plus strikeouts (212.0 IP and 252 K in 2015, 201.1 and 233 in 2016, and 201.0 and 249 in 2017).
- Despite spending half of the 2018 season and all of the 2019 campaign in the National League, before missing 2020, he still ranks sixth in the American League with 1155 strikeouts since 2013 (his first full season)...is fourth in the Junior Circuit over the same stretch by averaging 9.63 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched.
