SEASON AT A GLANCE

THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 5-1 (2-1 in Oakland and 3-0 in Kansas City), the Twins began their fourth homestand of the season with a victory over the Tigers last night...

The Twins have now won five-straight games, two short of their season-long streak of seven, done from April 21-28...Minnesota is one of four teams with multiple winning streaks of five-plus games this season...

CAUTION, HIGH WATER: The Twins are a season-high 10 games over .500, their highest mark since ending the 2020 season 12 games over with a record of 36-24...their high water mark for 2021 was three games over.

GRAND SLAMS AND WALK-OFFS: The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Target Field in walk-off fashion, by a score of 5-4...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched...

The Twins' three grand slams this season are fourth in baseball, behind Cleveland (5), Boston (4) and Los Angeles-AL (4).

The Twins are hitting .345 (10-for-29) with the bases loaded this season, sixth in the majors and fourth in the AL.

The Twins' three walk-off wins this season are tied with San Diego for third most in the majors, behind Baltimore (5) and New York-AL (4).

The previous time that the Twins scored in just the first and ninth innings of a nine-inning win was July 20, 2016 at Detroit (1 run in first, 3 runs in ninth).

TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the fifth of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins' first trip to Comerica Park will come in five games next week from May 30-June 2 (doubleheader on May 31).

The Twins have won four straight against the Tigers...they have four winning streaks of four-plus against the Tigers four times since September of 2019...their last five-game winning streak over Detroit was from September 1-26, 2019...additionally, they have won 21 of their last 30 over the Tigers and 26 of their last 38.

At Target Field, the Twins have gone 14-3 in their last 17 vs. Detroit, 19-4 in their last 23 and 25-7 in their last 32.

Jorge Polanco is hitting .302 (104-for-344) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 54 RBI, 27 walks and an .836 OPS in 89 career games against the Tigers...he has reached base safely in 21 straight against Detroit.

Gio Urshela is hitting .310 (26-for-84) with five doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, 10 walks and a .389 on-base percentage in 29 career games vs. Detroit...he is 6-for-13 (.462) with three walks and a .563 on-base percentage against the Tigers this season.

Max Kepler is 5-for-14 (.357) with four home runs and nine RBI against Detroit this season...he has two home runs and 13 RBI against the rest of the league.

MINNESOTA WINS: The Twins have won five straight and eight of their last 10...after going 4-8 in their first 12 games, the Twins have gone 22-8 since April 21, tied with New York-AL (22-8) for the most wins in baseball since that date.

Since April 21, they lead baseball in home wins, going 12-4...they are 14-8 at home this season, tied for third-most home wins in baseball.

CENTRAL HEATING: Tonight marks the Twins' fifth game in a 15-game stretch against divisional opponents...in the next 11 games, they will play the Royals four times and the Tigers seven times...they have gone 13-3 against the AL Central this season, going 4-2 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 4-0 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland.

The Twins'.813 winning percentage in the division is the best inter-divisional record in baseball.

ARRAEZ-ING UP: Luis Arraez is hitting .349 (38-for-109), the fourth-highest average in the AL and fifth highest in baseball (minimum of 100 PA)...additionally, he has posted a .454 on-base percentage, second highest in baseball, trailing only Taylor Ward (.481).

Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .444 (16-for-36) with 11 walks, a .583 on-base percentage and a 1.111 OPS in 11 games.

MAX HEAT: After starting the season hitting .191 (9-for-47) with a .598 OPS in his first 15 games, Max Kepler has hit .301 (25-for-83) with five doubles, five home runs, 19 RBI, 13 walks, a .394 on-base percentage, a .542 slugging percentage and a .936 OPS in his last 25...he has reached safely via hit, walk or hit-by-pitch in each of his last 11 games (.435 OBP).

SERIES STUFF: With a win tonight, the Twins could improve to 8-3-3 in series play this season...their last series loss came in a three-game sweep at the hands of the Astros from May 10-12...they are 7-1-1 in their last nine series (season results to the right)...the Twins are also 6-2-1 in their last nine series against the Tigers.

CELE-BRATE GOOD TIMES: Gilberto Celestino has hit safely in a career-high seven-straight games, tied for the seventh-longest active streak in the AL...in his last 18 games, he is hitting .423 (22-for-52) with four doubles, three RBI, six walks, eight runs scored, a .492 on-base percentage and a .992 OPS...among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 50 at-bats, he ranks first in batting average (.359), second in on-base percentage (.438), fourth in OPS (.860) and eighth in slugging percentage (.422).

EL GARY: In his last 10 games, since May 13, Gary Sánchez has recorded a .694 slugging percentage with six doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.012 OPS...in that span, he ranks eighth in the AL in slugging percentage and 10th in all of baseball...additionally, his 12 RBI since then are tied for fourth in baseball.

- ☞ Will be his seventh career game and sixth start against Detroit...is 2-1, 3.23 ERA (30.2 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 28 strikeouts lifetime against the Tigers.
- ☞ Acquired by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for Twins minor league right-handed pitcher, Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first victory in a Twins uniform and first since September 1, 2021 vs. St. Louis (w/ Cincinnati), in a 14-4 victory over the Athletics last Wednesday at RingCentral Coliseum...tossed a season-high 6.0 innings, allowing two runs on six hits, with no walks and five strikeouts as the Twins' offense erupted for 11 runs in six innings while Gray was in the game, to then put up 14 runs on 14 hits...was his first career victory against his former team that drafted him and for which he made his MLB debut...after last week's victory, Gray now has at least one victory against all 15 American League teams.

- ☞ The Twins have now won each of his last three starts since he was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List, going 1-0, 2.51 ERA (14.1 IP, 4 ER) with six walks, 20 strikeouts and .222 opponent batting average (12-for-54) in that span.
- ☞ Has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in his first five starts of the season (eight total), tying his fewest earned runs allowed in his first five starts of the season and doing so for the third time: (3/31-4/23/2014 w/ Oakland and 4/6-4/28/2015 w/ Oakland).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on Friday, May 13 vs. Cleveland after allowing two earned runs on four hits, with four walks and eight strikeouts in 4.1 innings pitched...the Twins exploded for nine runs in the bottom of the fifth inning and won, 12-8...his eight strikeouts were his most in a single game this season and most since September 6, 2021 at Chicago-NL (also 8) as a member of the Cincinnati Reds.

EYE OF THE TIGER: Is making his sixth career start (seventh appearance) against Detroit...will be his first start against the Tigers since Gray was the Reds' Opening Day starter in the shortened 2020 season on July 24, 2020 (w/ Cincinnati)...earned his second career win against Detroit, where he allowed one run on three hits, with two walks and nine strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work to cap off a 7-1 Reds victory.

- ☞ Gray has allowed one-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last three starts against Detroit (all at home), going 1-0, 1.84 ERA (14.2 IP, 3 ER) with four walks and 14 strikeouts.
- ☞ Gray has allowed two earned runs-or-fewer in 13 of his last 14 career games against American League Central opponents, going 7-2, 2.57 ERA (73.2 IP, 21 ER) with 30 walks, 82 strikeouts and a .200 opponent batting average (53-for-265).

STAYING ON TARGET: Is making his fourth start at Target Field this season...has allowed two-or-fewer runs in all his home starts this season (2.77 ERA, 4 ER, 8 BB, 19 K)...marks the fourth time in his career he has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in his first three home starts of the season (also: 2020 w/ Cincinnati, 2015 w/ Oakland and 2013 w/ Oakland).

- ☞ Has shown consistent numbers when at home and on the road over his career...has gone 46-36, 3.94 ERA (673.2 IP, 295 ER) with 230 walks and 642 strikeouts in 119 appearances (115 starts) at his home ballpark...has posted a 37-37 record, 3.24 ERA (614.1 IP, 221 ER), with 232 walks and 604 strikeouts in 109 career appearances (104 starts) on the road.

NIGHT WATCH: Will be making his second start under the lights this season...also started on May 13 vs. Cleveland where he took a no decision...his numbers during night games are slightly higher than when pitching during the day in his career...is 52-47, 3.75 ERA (808.2 IP, 337 ER) with 298 walks, 790 strikeouts and a .229 opponent batting average (688-for-3007) in 142 career night games (137 starts)...when the sun is up, his numbers go down, going 31-26, 3.36 ERA (479.1 IP, 179 ER) with 164 walks, 456 strikeouts and a .233 opponent batting average (422-for-1811) in 86 career day games (82 starts).

VS. AL CENTRAL: Is making his second start of the season against American League Central opponents, also started on May 13 vs. Cleveland...is a career 17-11 (3.43 ERA, 231.0 IP) with 94 walks and 216 strikeouts in 41 career games (39 starts)...his 3.43 ERA marks his second lowest against any American League division (first: AL West 3.19 ERA).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...18 of his 25 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker...here's a look at his repertoire.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: This season, Gray has posted a .188 opponent average (6-for-32) with two walks and nine strikeouts against left-handed hitters...has a .239 batting average (11-for-46) with seven walks and 16 strikeouts against right-handed hitters.

- ☞ In his career, Gray has limited left-handers to a .223 batting average (533-for-2386) with 628 strikeouts against left-handed hitters and right-handed hitters to a .237 batting average (577-for-2432) with 618 strikeouts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY (2022 SEASON: 3-2, 5.14 ERA // CAREER: 49-59, 4.73 ERA)

Right-hander Dylan Bundy is scheduled to start Wednesday afternoon's series finale against the Detroit Tigers...did not factor into the decision in his last outing on May 17 at Oakland, after pitching 3.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in his first start since being reinstated off the COVID Injured List (missed 12 games); the Twins fell, 5-2...will be making his sixth career appearance (5th start) against Detroit tomorrow afternoon...is 0-2, 4.70 (23.0 IP, 12 ER) with nine walks and 18 strikeouts against the Tigers in his career...made two starts against Detroit last season with Los Angeles-AL, putting up a 3.12 ERA (8.2 IP, 4 R/3 ER, 5 BB, 5 K).

- Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.
