**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 5-1 (2-1 in Oakland and 3-0 in Kansas City), the Twins began their fourth homestand of the season with two-straight wins over the Tigers the last two nights...this afternoon, the Twins will continue their seven-game homestand with the three-game series finale against Detroit...the Twins will then host the Royals for four games starting tomorrow through Sunday...the Twins are 15-8 at home and 12-8 on the road.

☞ The Twins have now won six-straight games, one shy of their season-long streak of seven, done from April 21-28...Minnesota is one of just two teams with multiple winning streaks of six-plus games this season, alongside Los Angeles-NL (7, 7 & 6).

☞ The Twins are a season-high 11 games over .500, their highest mark since ending the 2020 season 12 games over with a record of 36-24...their high water mark for 2021 was three games over.

**SONNY, SHUTOUTS, SERIES W'S:** The Twins shut out the Tigers, 2-0, last night, winning their sixth-straight game and clinching their fourth-straight series victory...Sonny Gray (2-1) was the starter and winner, tossing a season-high 7.0 shutout innings while allowing four hits and one walk, with 10 strikeouts – his 11th career 10-plus strikeout game and the first by a Twins pitcher this year...Gio Urshela (3-for-4, RBI), Luis Arraez (2-for-4, R) and Jose Miranda (2-for-3, 2B) paced the offense, with Urshela recording a go-ahead RBI for the third-straight game.

**TODAY, ON THE INTERWEBS:** Today's game can be seen on YouTube TV...it marks the third time the Twins played on YouTube TV over the last two seasons...the first came on April 28, 2021 at Cleveland, winning by a score of 10-2, highlighted by a Byron Buxton 5-for-5 day with 10 total bases (1 home run, 2 doubles, 2 singles)...the second was on August 11, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL, winning by a score of 1-0 as Jorge Polanco's solo home run was the difference...Buxton and Polanco both earned YouTube Player of the Game, respectively and were each awarded a trophy postgame.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins announced today that they have placed right-handed pitcher Joe Ryan on the COVID Injured List...Ryan, 25, has gone 5-2 with a 2.28 ERA (43.1 IP, 11 ER), 14 walks, 42 strikeouts, a .186 opponent batting average and a 0.99 WHIP in eight starts for the Twins this season...to replace Ryan on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer from Triple-A St. Paul...Smeltzer, 26, has gone 1-2 with a 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER), six walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP in nine starts for the Saints this season...this is his second stint with Minnesota this year, after being with the major league club from May 14-21 and making two starts, going 1-0 with a 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), three walks, two strikeouts and a 1.06 WHIP in those outings.

**PITCHERS WITH PIZZAZZ:** Twins pitchers have combined for a 3.33 ERA (381.0 IP, 141 ER) through the first 43 games of the season, the eighth-lowest mark in that span in a single season in Twins history (1961-present) and lowest since 1972 (2.53 – best mark through the first 43 games in club history).

☞ Twins starting pitchers enter today with a combined 3.12 ERA (202.0 IP, 70 ER) this season, fourth best in the AL and fifth best in baseball.

**TWINS-TIGERS:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the sixth of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins' first trip to Comerica Park will come in five games next week from May 30-June 2 (doubleheader on May 31).

☞ The Twins have won five straight against the Tigers...over the last 10 seasons (since 2013) they have just four winning streaks of five-plus games against the Tigers (5 3x, 6 1x)...their last six-game winning streak over Detroit was from August 13-September 29, 2017...additionally, they have won 22 of their last 31 over the Tigers and 27 of their last 39.

☞ At Target Field, the Twins have gone 15-3 in their last 18 vs. Detroit, 20-4 in their last 24 and 26-7 in their last 33.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .302 (104-for-344) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 54 RBI, 27 walks and an .836 OPS in 89 career games against the Tigers...he has reached base safely in 21 straight against Detroit.

☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .330 (29-for-88) with five doubles, one home run, 13 RBI, 10 walks and a .404 on-base percentage in 30 career games vs. Detroit...he is 9-for-17 (.529) with three walks and a .600 on-base percentage in 5 games against the Tigers this season.

☞ Max Kepler is slugging 1.059 with one double, four home runs and nine RBI against Detroit this season...he has two home runs and 13 RBI against the rest of the league.

**MINNESOTA WINS:** The Twins have won six straight and nine of their last 11...after going 4-8 in their first 12 games, the Twins have gone 23-8 since April 21, tied with New York-AL (23-8) for the most wins in baseball since that date.

☞ Since April 21, they lead baseball in home wins, going 13-4...they are 15-8 at home this season, tied for second-most home wins in baseball.

**CENTRAL HEATING:** Tonight marks the Twins' sixth game in a 15-game stretch against divisional opponents...in the next 10 games, they will play the Royals four times and the Tigers six times...they have gone 14-3 against the AL Central this season, going 4-2 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 5-0 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland.

☞ The Twins'.824 winning percentage in the division is the best inter-divisional mark in baseball.

**BUST OUT THE BROOMS:** The Twins are seeking their fifth sweep of the season today...their other four sweeps were April 22-24 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games), April 26-28 vs. Detroit (3 games), May 6-8 vs. Oakland (3 games) and May 20-22 at Kansas City (3 games)...they swept opponents four total times last season...last time the Twins swept the Tigers twice in multiple series of three-or-more games in the same season was 2005, with a pair of three-game sweeps from April 12-14 and September 30-September 2, both at the Metrodome.

**MPLS – THIS IS OUR CITY:** In 2022, the Target Field outfield wall signage reads "MPLS – This Is Our City"...the Twins, as full partners with others in Minneapolis and beyond, are committed to supporting positive change in our city focused on racial equity and social justice...with today being the second anniversary of George Floyd's death, Twins front office staff will stand together during pregame ceremonies, united in strength, collaboration and hope, and wearing t-shirts mirroring the outfield wall sign.

- ☞ Today will be Bundy's sixth career appearance (5th start) against the Tigers...is 0-2, 4.70 ERA (23.0 IP, 12 ER) with nine walks and 18 strikeouts in his career vs. Detroit.
- ☞ Will be his second start since coming off the COVID Injured List...took a no decision on May 17 at Oakland, tossing 3.0 innings, allowing no runs on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts in a 5-2 Twins defeat.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his sixth start of the season and fourth start on the road on May 17 at RingCentral Coliseum...did not factor into the decision after pitching 3.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in his first start since coming off the COVID Injured List (missed 12 games), as the Twins fell, 5-2...marked his third scoreless start this season...also pitched two 5.0 scoreless starts on April 11 vs. Seattle and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL.

☞ In his previous two starts, Bundy was 0-2, 13.97 ERA (9.2 IP, 15 ER) with four walks, 10 strikeouts and a 1.222 opponent OPS.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Made his fifth start and third road start of this season on May 4 at Baltimore...handed his second loss of the season and second-consecutive loss after allowing a career-high nine runs, 11 hits, two home runs and two walks in 3.2 innings of work in a 9-4 Twins defeat...marked his second consecutive start of six-or-more runs, two home runs and two walks allowed.

☞ Was 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk, 12 strikeouts and a .435 opponent OPS in his first three starts this season.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** Will be making his sixth career appearance (5th start) against Detroit...is seeking his first career win against the Tigers, having gone 0-2, 4.70 ERA (23.0 IP, 12 ER) with nine walks and 18 strikeouts when facing the Tigers...made two starts against Detroit last season (w/Los Angeles-AL), going at least 4.0 innings with two runs allowed in both starts...has shown dominant numbers when facing Detroit at his home ballpark, (2.92 ERA, 12.1 IP, 4 ER, 3 BB, 12 K) in three career home games (2 starts).

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Bundy will be starting his third home game this season at Target Field...has yet to yield a run at home this season after going 2-0, 0.00 ERA (10.0 IP, 0 ER) with one walk and six strikeouts (April 11 vs. Seattle and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL)...has shown slightly better numbers when pitching at home in his career, going 25-32, 4.60 ERA (436.1 IP, 223 ER) with 130 walks and 404 strikeouts in 90 home appearances (76 starts)...is 24-27, 4.89 ERA (362.1 IP, 197 ER) with 134 walks and 379 strikeouts in 77 road appearances (63 starts).

**STAYING CENTRAL FOCUSED:** Will be making his 34th career appearance (29th start) and second start this season against an American League Central opponent...also started on April 23 vs. Chicago-AL (W, 5.0 IP, 0 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K)...is 11-10, 4.04 ERA (165.0 IP, 74 ER) with 49 walks and 157 strikeouts in his career vs. the American League Central...has shown dominant numbers in his last 10 starts vs. the division, going 3-2, 2.64 ERA (58.0 IP, 17 ER) with 16 walks, 52 strikeouts and has allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in those 10 starts while striking out six-or-more batters in six of those 10 starts.

**MUGGY MAYS:** Is making his third May start this season...Bundy has struggled in the month of May throughout his career, going 8-14, 5.64 ERA (142.0 IP, 89 ER) with 47 walks, 124 strikeouts and a .858 opponent OPS in 32 appearances (24 starts)...his 5.64 May ERA marks his second highest in any month (July: 6.46 ERA).

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** Bundy's pitch usage has resulted in his highest career groundball percentage (46.0%)...according to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first six starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

**STARTING OFF RIGHT:** Bundy went 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.

- ☞ Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (*Elias*).
- ☞ Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (*Elias*).
- ☞ Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero (0.54 ERA, 5/2-5/13/18) and Ervin Santana (0.41 ERA, 4/3-4/14/17).

## CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs. Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts.
- In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes.
- Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhardt Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season.
- Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City.
- Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th).
- Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta.
- Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012).
- Named Orioles top prospect according to *Baseball America* and Baseball Prospectus following the 2014 season.
