pitcher this year. Gio Urshela ( 3 -for-4, RBI) Luis Arraez (2-for-4 R) and Jose Miranda (2-for-3, 2B) paced the offense, with Urshela recording a go-ahead RBI for the third-straight game.

Ryan, 25, has gone 5-2 with a 2.28 ERA ( 43.1 IP, 11 ER), 14 walks, 42 strikeouts, a 186 opponent batting average and a 0.99 WHIP in eight starts left-handed pitcher ani...t repar ryan a 3.86 ERA ( 21.0 IP, 9 ER), six walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP in nine starts for the Saints this season...this is his second stint with Minnesota this year, after being with the
major league club from May $14-21$ and making two starts, going $1-0$ with a 1.74 ERA (10.1 major league club rrom May $14-21$ and making two starts, going $1-0$ w

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his fifth start and third road start of this season on May 4 at Baltimore... handed his second loss of the season and second-consecutive loss after allowing a career-high nine runs, 11 hits, two home runs and two walks in 3.2 innings of work in a 9-4 Twins defeat...marked his second consecutive start of six-or-more runs, two home runs and two walks allowed.
$\Phi$ Was $3-0,0.59 \mathrm{ERA}(15.1 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{ER})$ with one walk, 12 strikeouts and a .435 opponent OPS in his first three starts this season.

AGAINST THE TIGERS: Will be making his sixth career appearance (5th start) against Detroit...is seeking his first career win against the Tigers, having gone $0-2,4.70$ ERA ( $23.0 \mathrm{IP}, 12 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with nine walks and 18 strikeouts when facing the Tigers....made two starts against Detroit last season (w/Los Angeles-AL), going at least 4.0 innings with two runs allowed in both starts...has shown dominant numbers when facing Detroit at his home ballpark, ( $2.92 \mathrm{ERA}, 12.1 \mathrm{IP}, 4 \mathrm{ER}, 3 \mathrm{BB}, 12 \mathrm{~K}$ ) in three career home games (2 starts).
