TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the seventh of 19 meetings in 2022... they are 4-2 against Kansas City this season, all six games coming at Kauffman Stadium... they last hosted the Royals for three games from September 10-12, 2021, going 1-2...they went 4-5 against KC at Target Field in 202
