THE TWINS: Have gone 2-1 through three games on their seven-game homestand after taking two of three from the Tigers this week...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the first of four against the Royals through the weekend...the Twins are 15-9 at home and 12-8 on the road.

☞ After yesterday's loss, the Twins are looking to avoid losing back-to-back games for the first time since dropping three straight from May 10-12 — all vs. Houston.

GLOOMY DAY LEADS TO GLOOMY LOSS: The Twins lost to the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-2 in 10 innings, failing to record their fifth sweep and falling to 1-2 in extra-innings this season...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on five hits in 5.2 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts...the bullpen combined to allow three runs on three hits (2 home runs) and five walks in 4.1 innings of relief...the offense recorded seven hits and went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position...the offense was highlighted by two hits apiece from Carlos Correa and Trevor Larnach, including Larnach's first home run of the season and first since July 7, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the seventh of 19 meetings in 2022...they are 4-2 against Kansas City this season, all six games coming at Kauffman Stadium...they last hosted the Royals for three games from September 10-12, 2021, going 1-2...they went 4-5 against KC at Target Field in 2021.

☞ The Twins have won four straight against the Royals, marking their longest streak against them since winning five straight from August 2-September 20, 2019.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .362 (42-for-116) with five doubles, one triple, 10 RBI, 16 walks, a .441 on-base percentage and an .864 OPS in 33 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 28 of those 33...his batting average is best among actives (min. 100 AB)... additionally, he has reached safely in seven of his last 10 plate appearances vs. KC.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with two home runs, eight RBI, six walks, a .417 on-base percentage and an .867 OPS in 13 career games vs. the Royals.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .326 (14-for-43) with six doubles, three home runs, six RBI, 13 runs scored and a 1.036 OPS in his last 10 games against the Royals.

STARTERS, ROYALTY STATUS: Twins starters have combined to go 3-1, 2.01 ERA (31.1 IP, 7 ER) with one home run allowed, eight walks, 24 strikeouts and a .216 opponent batting average in the six games against Kansas City this season...below are the individual game logs:

MINNESOTA WINS: The Twins have won six of their last seven games and eight of their last 10... after starting the season 4-8 in their first 12 games, the Twins have gone 23-9 since April 21, tied with Houston for second-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL (24).

☞ Since April 21, they have gone 13-5 at home, tied with Houston and New York-AL for the most home wins in baseball since that date...they are 15-9 at home this season, tied for second-most home wins in baseball.

CENTRAL HEATING: Tonight marks the Twins' seventh game in a 15-game stretch against divisional opponents...in the next nine games, they will play the Royals four times and the Tigers five times...they have gone 14-4 against the AL Central this season, going 4-2 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 5-1 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland.

☞ The Twins'.778 winning percentage in the division is the best inter-divisional mark in baseball.

LEFT SIDE IS THE BEST SIDE: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the 15th time (10-4) in 44 games...they are hitting .256 (113-for-442) with 51 walks, 27 doubles and 13 home runs against lefties this season...however, in 18 games this month, the Twins are hitting .288 (53-for-184) with a .372 on-base percentage, the highest average in the AL and third best in baseball (St. Louis - .323 & Colorado - .297).

☞ Individuals vs. lefties: Gilberto Celestino is hitting .321 (9-for-28)...Carlos Correa is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with six doubles and a .413 on-base percentage...Kyle Garlick is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with three home runs...Trevor Larnach is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with four doubles.

LARNING SIGNS: Trevor Larnach is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with six doubles, one home run, five RBI, 11 runs scored, three walks, a .383 on-base percentage and a .928 OPS in his last 13 games...in 10 games leading up to his injury (right adductor strain), he was hitting .394 (13-for-33) with a 1.020 OPS...since returning from the IL, he is hitting .182 (2-for-11) with a .636 OPS in three games.

C4: Carlos Correa is hitting .383 (23-for-60) with seven doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, five walks, 10 runs scored, a .439 on-base percentage and a .989 OPS in his last 15 games, since April 28, hitting safely in 13 of those and reaching safely in all 15 (8th longest active streak in MLB, 5th in AL)...since that date, he ranks seventh in the AL in wOBA (.434) and 11th in the AL in slugging percentage (.550).

NUTHIN' BUT A GIO THANG: Gio Urshela is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with one double, two home runs, eight RBI, five walks, a .421 on-base percentage and a .984 OPS in his last 10 games... on the season, he has a 13.2 strikeout %, ranking in the top nine percent of the league — 19 strikeouts in 144 plate appearances.

ON THIS DAY IN LATROY HAWKINS HISTORY: In 2021, LaTroy Hawkins was named Manager for the AL Team in the SiriusXM Futures Game on July 11 at Coors Field...unfortunately, the AL lost by a score of 8-3 to the NL.

- ☞ Was acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on July 31, 2018 along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier.

WELCOME BACK TO THE BIG LEAGUES: Was recalled yesterday from Triple-A St. Paul when right-handed pitcher Joe Ryan was placed on the COVID Injured List...this is his second stint with the Twins this season, after previously being with the club from May 14-21.

LAST TIME OUT: Faced Daniel Lynch and the Royals in his last start on May 20 at Kauffman Stadium...earned the win after holding Kansas City to one run on five hits, with one walk in 5.1 innings of work...his 5.1 innings pitched were his most in an MLB outing since going 6.0 on August 4, 2019 vs. Kansas City...also recorded his first major league win since earning that decision in relief on August 17, 2020 vs. the Royals (2.2 IP, 1 H, 1 BB, 3 K), as well as his first major league win as a starting pitcher since September 26, 2019 at Detroit (5.0 IP, 10 H, 3 R/ER, 4 K).

- ☞ Became the first starting pitcher in baseball this season to earn a win without a strikeout...joined Griffin Jax (August 5, 2021 at Houston), Bartolo Colon (August 25, 2017 at Toronto), Mike Pelfrey (May 8, 2015 at Cleveland) and Scott Diamond (September 18, 2013) as the last five Twins to accomplish the feat.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started opposite Shane Bieber on May 14 vs. Cleveland...did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.0 innings and yielding just one run on three hits, with two walks and two strikeouts as the Twins fell, 3-2, in 10 innings...his contract was purchased from St. Paul that day (Alex Kiriloff optioned), the Twins needed another starter with Bailey Ober on the 10-day Injured List and Dylan Bundy on the COVID Injured List...marked his first major league appearance since April 24, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh and first start since August 7, 2020 at Kansas City.

SUCCESS AS A STARTER: Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer has gone 3-2, 3.57 ERA (45.1 IP, 18 ER) with a .240 (40-for-167) opponent batting average and .676 opponent OPS in nine career starts...he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 (38-for-135) opponent batting average and .834 opponent OPS in 12 big league relief outings.

KC KNOWLEDGE: Making his seventh career appearance and fourth start against the Royals tonight – seven will mark his most appearances vs. any single opponent in his career, while four starts will match his total against Cleveland for his most...has gone 3-0, 2.11 ERA (21.1 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and 11 strikeouts in his prior outings against the Royals, including 2-0, 1.72 ERA (15.2 IP, 3 ER) with three walks and six strikeouts in his three starts.

- ☞ Earned his first major league win in a 3-0 victory over Kansas City on August 4, 2019 at Target Field (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 BB, 4 K), in his fifth career appearance (third start).

DIVISIONAL REDUX: Has faced the American League Central division 16 times in his career, including eight starts, going 5-2, 4.82 ERA (56.0 IP, 30 ER) with 18 walks and 38 strikeouts...this includes 3-2, 4.12 ERA (39.1 IP, 18 ER) with 12 walks and 19 strikeouts in his eight starts...is also 3-1, 2.63 ERA (28.0 IP, 12 ER) with 11 walks and 23 strikeouts in 9 games (3 starts) against the AL Central at Target Field.

NIGHT OWL: Both of Smeltzer's starts this season to date have come at night; his win on May 20 marked his first career victory as a starting pitcher in a night game...is 2-2, 3.80 ERA (45.0 IP, 19 ER) with 13 walks, 28 strikeouts, one save and a 1.18 WHIP in 11 career appearances (6 starts) at night, compared to 3-0, 4.11 ERA (35.0 IP, 16 ER) with eight walks, 30 strikeouts and a 1.31 WHIP in 10 career appearances (3 starts) in day games.

- ☞ Smeltzer is 1-1, 2.88 ERA (25.0 IP, 8 ER) with seven walks, 22 strikeouts and a 1.04 WHIP in seven career games (3 starts) under the lights at Target Field.

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Smeltzer's repertoire through his first two starts of the 2022 season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a five-pitch mix, primarily relying on his four-seam fastball and curveball.

STRIKES AND OUTS: Has been effective so far in his career when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .188 (3-for-16) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .197 (28-for-142) mark in his career.

SO FAR IN ST. PAUL: Appeared in five games (all starts) for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-2, 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 18 strikeouts...did not pitch for the Saints in his most recent stint (was scheduled to pitch yesterday before being recalled).

- ☞ Extended his scoreless innings streak to 11.0 innings to start the season before he permitted two runs on five hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings in his third start of the season on April 21 at Toledo...took the loss as the Saints fell, 2-1.
- ☞ Took the loss for St. Paul on May 3 vs. the Iowa Cubs and allowed six of his nine runs of the season in that single start.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey to pitch this season...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10-day Injured List on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after an injury during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be a herniated disc in his neck...transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Was in Twins spring training for the second-consecutive season and was optioned to the alternate training site on March 29...recalled from the Taxi Squad on April 17...appeared in one game for the Twins on April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, allowing one unearned run on one hit in 4.2 innings of relief...marked his only appearance with the Twins or Saints on the season as he was optioned back to the alternate training site on April 25...recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 6 just prior to the minor league season but did not appear for the Twins...placed on the 10-day Injured List on May 12 with left elbow inflammation and missed the remainder of the season...transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17.

TOMORROW'S STARTER – RHP BAILEY OBER (2022 SEASON: 1-1, 2.55 ERA // CAREER: 4-4, 3.85 ERA)

Right-hander Bailey Ober is scheduled to start tomorrow night's game against the Kansas City Royals at Target Field...faced the Royals in his last start on May 22 at Kauffman Stadium, taking a no-decision after yielding just one run on three hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings...departed with the Twins trailing 1-0; Minnesota scored five runs in the eighth and two more in the ninth to win, 7-6...will be facing Kansas City for the fourth time in his career (all starts), posting no record and a 3.38 ERA (13.1 IP, 5 ER), one walk and 14 strikeouts in his three prior outings.

CAREER NOTES

- Acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL, along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe, in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier at the 2018 trade deadline.
- Made Twins Opening Day roster in 2020, the first of his career...went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances...four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more...held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.
- Combined to post a 3.02 ERA (104.1 IP, 32 ER) in 20 games (19 starts) between Double-A Pensacola and Triple-A Rochester, going 4-5 in 2019...
