THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their seven-game homestand after going 2-1 against the Tigers this week, followed by a loss to the Royals last night...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the second of four against the Royals through the weekend... the Twins are 15-10 at home and 12-8 on the road.

◆ After two consecutive losses, the Twins are looking to avoid losing three-straight games for the second time this season, the other coming May 10-12 — all vs. Houston.

STRONG START FROM SMELTZ BUT BULLPEN MELTS: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 3-2, marking just their second loss this season (24-2) when leading after seven innings...the Twins outhit the Royals 12-6, also their second loss this season (20-2) when outhitting an opponent...Devin Smeltzer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching a career-high 7.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, one walk and six strikeouts, as the 7.0 innings also matched a season-high for a Twins starter (also Ryan on 4/27 vs. DET & Gray on 5/24 vs. DET)...11 of the Twins' 12 hits were singles, the only extra-base hit being a Jose Miranda double.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have returned left-handed pitcher Danny Coulombe from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Coulombe, who missed the Twins' last 15 games with left hip impingement, appeared in two games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, allowing one run on two hits in 2.0 innings pitched, with one walk and one strikeout...prior to landing on the Injured List, he appeared in nine games for the Twins, posting a 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1ER) with seven walks, nine strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP...to make room for Coulombe on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed outfielder Gilberto Celestino on the COVID Injured List...Celestino played in 31 games for the Twins this season, hitting .324 (24-for-74) with four doubles, four RBI, 10 runs scored, seven walks and a .398 on-base percentage.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the eighth of 19 meetings in 2022...they are 4-3 against Kansas City this season, 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 0-1 at Target Field.

♣ The Twins have just one home run against the Royals this season, that being a Kyle Garlick two-run shot at Kauffman Stadium on May 22, off Scott Barlow.

♣ Luis Arraez is hitting .361 (43-for-119) with five doubles, one triple, 10 RBI, 17 walks, a .443 on-base percentage and an .863 OPS in 34 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 29 of those 34...his batting average is best among actives (min. 100 AB)... additionally, he has reached safely in nine of his last 14 plate appearances vs. KC.

STARTERS, ROYALTY STATUS: Twins starters have combined to go 3-1, 1.64 ERA (38.1 IP, 7 ER) with one home run allowed, nine walks, 30 strikeouts and a .195 opponent batting average in the seven games against Kansas City this season...below are the individual game logs:

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision at Kansas City on May 22 after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in his fifth start this season... departed with the Twins trailing 1-0; Minnesota scored five runs in the eighth and two more in the

Marked his first start after returning from the 10-day Injured List with a right groin strain... was removed from his start vs. Detroit on April 28 and placed on the 10-day Injured List on April 30...made a rehab start in Triple-A St. Paul on May 15 at Columbus and covered 5.0 innings, allowing five runs (4 earned) on four hits (1 HR), with no walks and seven strikeouts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in a 7-1 Twins victory over Detroit on April 28 at Target Field after tossing 3.2 innings and allowing one run on six hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in his fourth start this season...departed in favor of Cody Stashak in the fourth inning

due to right groin tightness.

◆ Marked his third consecutive start allowing one-or-fewer earned runs and second straight against American League Central opponents

DOUBLE PAIR ROYAL: Tonight will be Ober's second-straight start against the Royals...did not factor into his decision in his last outing on May 22 at Kauffman Stadium...has faced Kansas City three times in his career and is 0-0, 3.38 ERA (13.1 IP, 5 ER) with 13 hits allowed, one walk and 14 strikeouts...has one start against Kansas City at Target Field on September 12, 2021 (ND, 4.1 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 6 K).

© Is 0-0, 1.98 ERA (13.2 IP, 3 ER) in three starts against the American League Central this season and a career 2-2, 4.08 ERA (64.0 IP, 29 ER) in 14 starts.

BACK HOME AGAIN: Marks his fourth start at home this season...is 1-0, 3.95 ERA (13.2 IP, 6 ER) with four walks and 13 strikeouts in his three prior home starts, compared to 0-1, 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and seven strikeouts in two road starts.

◆ Is 3-1, 4.09 ERA (61.2 IP, 28 ER) with 15 walks and 62 strikeouts in 13 career starts at Target Field...is 1-3, 3.58 ERA (55.1 IP, 22 ER) with 10 walks and 54 strikeouts in 12 career starts

RHYTHM OF THE NIGHT: Is making his second night start of the season after also pitching under the lights on April 22 vs. Chicago-AL (ND, 5.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 6 K), compared to his four starts during the day this season, going 1-1, 2.75 ERA (19.2 IP, 6 ER)...has posted slightly better nighttime numbers in his career...is a career 2-2, 3.56 ERA (60.2 IP, 24 ER) with 11 walks and 68 strikeouts in 13 night starts compared to 2-2, 4.15 ERA (56.1 IP, 26 ER) with 14 walks and 48 strikeouts in 12 day games

LEFT AND RIGHT: Is holding opposing right-handed hitters to a .167 (9-for-54) batting average, two doubles, two home runs and a .193 on-base percentage this season...opposing lefties are batting .333 (13-for-39) with two doubles and a .386 on-base percentage against him.

When looking at his career number, right-handed hitters have a .220 (55-for-250) batting

average and lefties are hitting .296 (59-for-199).

KEEP UP THE TEMPO: Has an average pitch tempo of 16.0 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant...ranks third on the Twins behind Jhoan Duran and Dylan Bundy (15.7 and 15.9 seconds)...works 2.2 seconds faster than the league average of 18.2 seconds.

This pitch tempo increases to 23.8 seconds when there are runners on base, the sixth fastest worker for the Twins.

SHAKE OFF THE NERVES: Ober allowed four of his seven earned runs this season in his first start on April 10 vs. Seattle (W, 5.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K)...in his four following starts he has allowed just three earned runs in 19.2 innings pitched (1.37 ERA).

TWO STRIKES, YOU'RE GOING TO BE OUT: Has been very effective when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .186 (8-for-43) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .215 (53-for-246) mark in his career.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/2 ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10-straight starts from July 20-September 12, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span...span included his two quality starts on the season, August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 3 R/2 ER) and August 30 at Detroit (6.0 IP, 2 ER).

Posted a 5.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the highest single-season mark by a Twins/Senators rookie pitcher (min. 70.0 IP), and tops among all major league rookies last season (also min. 70.0 IP).

Struck out a career-high seven batters in third start on June 11 vs. Houston (5.0 IP)...matched career high two more times: July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP) and August 25 at Boston (5.0 IP).

Named the 2021 winner of the Bill Boni Award for Twins minor league Player of the Year.

HEY, ROOKIE! YOU WERE GOOD: Ober's 20 starts in 2021 marked the most by a Twins rookie since Adalberto Mejia had 21 in 2017, while his 96 strikeouts were the most since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...96 strikeouts also matched Nick Blackburn (2008) and Gerry Arrigo (1964) for 10th most in a single season by a Minnesota rookie...ranked sixth among American League rookies in ERA (minimum Cookies). 90.0 IP) and 12th in innings pitched (92.1).

AND ALL'S FAIR IN LOVE AND WAR: Posted a 1.1 WAR in 2021, per Baseball Reference...became the first Twins rookie pitcher to surpass 1.0 WAR in a single season since Tyler Duffey in 2015 (1.6 WAR).
