**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-2 through five games on their seven-game homestand, going 2-1 against the Tigers and 1-1 against the Royals...today, the Twins will continue the homestand with the third of four against the Royals through tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's series finale, the Twins will travel to Detroit to begin a seven-day, eight-game roadtrip with five against the Tigers from Monday-Thursday (doubleheader on Tuesday), followed by three in Toronto next weekend...the Twins are 16-10 at home and 12-8 on the road.

ROYALS CHASE TWINS ALL NIGHT, COME UP SHORT: The Twins beat the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 10-7, evening the series at 1-1...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits in 3.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...Trevor Megill earned his first win of the season, pitching 2.2 scoreless innings (career-high) of relief and was one of seven relievers used, which matched a season-high...the offense recorded a season-high 15 hits, their most since recording 16 hits on September 21, 2021 at Chicago-NL...six players had multiple hits as Gary Sánchez and Gio Urshela each recorded three, Sánchez setting a season-high and Urshela matching a season-high...Carlos Correa hit his third home run of the season and just second of the month, while Jorge Polanco hit his fifth of the season.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have placed left-handed pitcher Danny Coulombe on the 15-day Injured List with left hip impingement... Coulombe, who was reinstated from the Injured List yesterday from the same ailment, appeared against the Royals last night, allowing one run on two hits in 0.1 innings pitched, with two walks... Moran, who was with the Twins earlier this season from May 2-6, made four appearances during his most recent stint with the Saints, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts while holding opponents to a .238 (5-for-21) batting average...the 25-year-old appeared in two games for the Twins earlier this month, pitching 2.2 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, no walks and five strikeouts... Minaya, 31, appeared in 11 games for the Saints this season, going 0-1, 6.06 ERA (16.1 IP, 11 ER), eight walks, 16 strikeouts, a .217 (13-for-60) opponent batting average and a 1.29 WHIP... additionally, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Yennier Cano to Triple-A St. Paul... Cano made his major league debut on May 11 and pitched in six games for the Iwins, allowing 11 runs on 12 hits in 7.1 innings pitched, with four walks and seven strikeouts.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the ninth of 19 meetings in 2022...they are 5-3 against Kansas City this season, 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 1-1 at Target Field.

♣ The Twins have just three home runs against the Royals this season (Garlick, Correa, Polanco) after hitting 33 in 2021 — the most allowed by Royals pitchers to one team last season...last season, Polanco and Alex Kirilloff each hit five against Kansas City, while Byron Buxton hit three.

♣ Luis Arraez is hitting .363 (45-for-124) with five doubles, one triple, 11 RBI, 18 walks, a .445 on-base percentage and an .865 OPS in 35 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 30 of those 35...his batting average is best among actives (min. 100 AB)... additionally, he has reached safely in 12 of his last 20 plate appearances vs. KC.

♣ Byron Buxton is hitting .313 (15-for-48) with six doubles, three home runs, six RBI, 13 runs scored and a .971 OPS in his last 11 games against the Royals.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .348 (23-for-66) with three doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, 11 walks, a .442 on-base percentage and a 1.107 in 18 games against the Royals since 2019.

STARTERS, ROYALTY STATUS: Twins starters have combined to go 3-1, 2.18 ERA (41.1 IP, 10 ER) with one home run allowed, 10 walks, 35 strikeouts and a .211 opponent batting average in the eight games against Kansas City this season, below are the individual game logs.

CLUTCH GENES: The Twins have hit .348 (32-for-92) with RISP in their last nine games... on the season, they are hitting .273 (99-for-362) with RISP, the third highest in the AL and ninth best in baseball.

▼ The Twins are hitting .255 (127-for-499) with two outs this season, the best average in the AL and third-best in baseball.

▼ Notable individuals with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .375 (9-for-24)...Carlos Correa is hitting .303 (10-for-33)...Jorge Polanco is hitting .350 (14-for-40)...Luis Arraez is hitting .429 (12-for-28)...among AL qualifying players, Arraez ranks second, Jeffers ranks fifth and Polanco ranks 12th.

**NUTHIN' BUT A GIO THANG:** Gio Urshela has hit safely in seven straight games and has reached safely in nine straight...in his last 12 games, he is hitting .366 (15-for-41) with one double, two home runs, 10 RBI, six walks, a .438 on-base percentage and a .974 OPS. 11 games... he will be playing in his 500th career game this afternoon.

KING LUEY: Luis Arraez is hitting .349 (44-for-126), the third-highest average in the AL and fourth-highest in baseball, trailing J.D. Martinez (.379), Tim Anderson (.363) and Manny Machado (.357)...additionally, he has posted a .450 on-base percentage, the highest in baseball.

Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .415 (22-for-53) with 13 walks, a .537 on-base percentage and a 1.009 OPS in 15 games.

**GOOD FOR GARY:** In his last 14 games, since May 13, Gary Sánchez has recorded a .566 slugging percentage with six doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI and an .899 OPS...since that date, he ranks tied for third in the AL in RBI and 15th in slugging percentage...additionally, since that date he ranks fifth in baseball in expected slugging percentage (.577).

LAST TIME OUT: Turned in his second-straight effective start in Monday's homestand-opening, 5-4 walk-off win vs. Detroit...held the Tigers to one run on three hits over 4.0 innings, with two walks, one hit batter and four strikeouts...the Twins jumped out to a 4-0, first-inning lead on Max Kepler's grand slam; after Detroit scored in the seventh to tie it, Minnesota walked if off on Gio Urshela's eight higher PDL infield circle. ninth-inning, RBI infield single.

The Twins have won consecutive Archer starts (also May 16 at Oakland) for the second time this season (also April 24 vs. Chicago-AL and April 30 at Tampa Bay)...he owns a 2.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 2 ER) in his last two trips to the hill, with five hits allowed, four walks and six strikeouts... also has not allowed a home run in-back-to-back starts, after getting touched for a longball in his grief five outline. in his prior five outings.

TWO STARTS AGO: Allowed one run on two hits in 4.0 innings of the Twins' roadtrip-opening, 3-1 victory May 16 at Oakland...walked two and struck out two, while he did not allow a home run for the first time in six starts (5-start streak giving up a longball was the 5th stretch of at least that length in his career)...Byron Buxton's RBI single in the fifth snapped a 1-1 tie, Gary Sánchez added a solo homer in the sixth and three Twins relievers blanked the A's on two hits over the final 5.0 frames.

Two hits allowed matched Archer's season low for the third time (also April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL and April 30 at Tampa Bay; all 3 outings were 4.0 innings).

1400 STRIKEOUTS ON THE HORIZON: Archer enters this afternoon's start with 1398 career strikeouts and, with two more, would become the 22nd active pitcher and 250th in American/National League history (since 1901) to reach the 1400 plateau (per Statspass).

The Has compiled his 1398 strikeouts in 1284.2 innings pitched, good for an average of 9.79 punchouts per 9.0 innings...fanned 1167 batters with Tampa Bay (2nd in franchise history) and 203 with Pittsburgh, while posting 28 strikeouts thus far in his first season in Minnesota.

Despite spending half of the 2018 season and all of the 2019 campaign in the National League, before missing 2020, he still ranks sixth in the American League with 1159 strikeouts since 2013, his first full season...is fifth in the Junior Circuit over the same stretch by averaging 9.63 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched.

ROYAL BLUE: Archer is set to make his ninth career start and appearance against Kansas City, and his second of 2022...is 2-4, 4.03 ERA (51.1 IP, 23 ER) in his first eight efforts.

Pitched a season-high 4.1 innings in a no-decision April 19 at Kansas City, allowing two runs on four hits (including a solo homer by Salvador Perez), with three walks and five strikeouts... departed with a 3-2 lead that was preserved when Joe Smith induced a double-play grounded to escape the fifth; however, the Royals homered twice off Tyler Duffey in the sixth for a 4-3 win.

His last win vs. KC came on September 19, 2018 at PNC Park, as he pitched the Pirates to a 2-1 victory (7.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 8 K).

BACK ON TARGET: Following 4.0-scoreless innings against Los Angeles-NL in his Twins debut on April 12, Archer boasted a perfect 4-0 mark and a 2.06 ERA (39.1 IP, 9 ER) in seven lifetime starts at Target Field...however, in his next two home starts (April 24 vs. Chicago-AL and May 11 vs. Houston), he went 0-1 while allowing seven runs (6 earned) on eight hits in 6.0 innings (6 BB, 4 K)...bounced back with Monday's 4.0-inning, one-run effort vs. Detroit.

To In four home starts overall this season, he is 0-1, 4.50 ERA (14.0 IP, 7 ER) with a .241/.344/.407 opponent slash line (13-for-54 with 3 2B and 2 HR).

Owns a 3.31 ERA (16.1 IP, 6 ER) in his four road starts, with eight walks, 17 strikeouts and a .210/.300/.468 opponent slash line (13-for-62 with 4 2B and 4 HR).

**SOFT CONTACT:** Archer has allowed opponents an average exit velocity of just 88.2 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (besting the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .241 opponent batting average on balls in play would also be the lowest of his career, better than the .254 mark of his 2013 rookie campaign; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

**EVEN STINGIER WHEN IT COUNTS:** Archer has allowed a .224 opponent batting average (26-for-116) with 13 extra-base hits (6 2B and 7 HR) overall...with runners on base, he tightens to a .214 mark (9-for-42) with three doubles...he is stingiest with runners in scoring position, allowing just three hits — all singles — in 27 at-bats (.111) for the sixth-lowest such BAA in the American League (min. 25 opponent at-bats with RISP).

**THE ARSENAL:** Archer has upped his changeup and curveball usage the last four starts, throwing those 20.3 percent of the time (74 of 364 pitches), per Baseball Savant...just 3.5 percent of his pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed over his first three efforts...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:
