THE TWINS: Have gone 3-3 through six games on their seven-game homestand, going 2-1 against the Tigers and 1-2 against the Royals...today, the Twins will complete the homestand with the four-game series finale against the Royals...after the game, the Twins will travel to Detroit to begin a seven-day, eight-game roadtrip with five against the Tigers from Monday-Thursday (doubleheader on Tuesday), followed by three in Toronto next weekend...the Twins are 16-11 at home and 12-8 on the road.

TOP GUN, NO FUN: The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 7-3...Chris Archer was the starter and loser, allowing five runs (3 earned) on seven hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Juan Minaya made his 2022 debut, allowing two runs on two hits in 2.1 innings of relief...the offense recorded 11 hits, three apiece from Luis Arraez and Carlos Correa...Trevor Larnach hit his second home run of the season and second in his last four games...Max Kepler left the game with right leg tightness while Gary Sanchez left with heat-related illness.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have recalled infielder Royce Lewis from Triple-A St. Paul...Lewis, who was optioned from Minnesota on May 18, played in 10 games for the Saints recently (May 19-28), hitting .318 (14-for-44) with one double, two home runs, three RBI, eight runs scored and an .825 OPS...over those 10 games, Lewis appeared at shortstop (4 games), third base (2 games), leftfield (2 games), centerfield (1 game) and designated hitter (1 game)...the 22-year-old made his major league debut on May 6 and played in 11 games for the Twins earlier this month, hitting .308 (12-for-39) with four doubles, two home runs, five RBI, five runs scored, one walk, a .325 on-base percentage and an .889 OPS...the 2017 first overall pick was hitting .346 (9-for-26) with a 1.063 OPS in seven games from May 6-17, prior to being optioned by Minnesota...to make room for Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned infielder Jose Miranda to Triple-A St. Paul...Miranda, who made his major league debut on May 2 at Baltimore, played in 19 games for the Twins, going 11-for-67 with five doubles, one home run, five RBI, four runs scored and two walks.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 10th of 19 meetings in 2022...they are 5-4 against Kansas City this season, 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 1-2 at Target Field...the next time these two will meet will be for a three-game series at Target Field from August 15-17.

☞ The Twins have just four home runs against the Royals this season (Garlick, Correa, Polanco, Larnach) after hitting 33 in 2021 — the most allowed by Royals pitchers to one team last season...last season, Polanco and Alex Kirilloff each hit five against Kansas City, while Byron Buxton hit three.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .372 (48-for-129) with five doubles, one triple, 11 RBI, 18 walks, a .450 on-base percentage and an .877 OPS in 36 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 31 of those 36...his batting average is best among actives (min. 100 AB)... additionally, he has reached safely in 15 of his last 25 plate appearances vs. KC.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .302 (16-for-53) with seven doubles, three home runs, six RBI, 13 runs scored and a .937 OPS in his last 12 games against the Royals.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .366 (26-for-71) with three doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, 11 walks, a .451 on-base percentage and a 1.029 in 19 games against the Royals since 2019.

ALL HE DOES IS HIT: Luis Arraez is hitting .359 (47-for-131), the second-highest average in baseball, trailing only J.D. Martinez (.376)... additionally, he has posted a .455 on-base percentage, the highest in baseball.

☞ Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .431 (25-for-58) with 13 walks, a .542 on-base percentage and a 1.024 OPS in 16 games.

☞ He has hit safely in a season-long eight straight games, hitting .500 (16-for-32) with six walks, a .579 on-base percentage and a 1.079 OPS during the streak...it is tied for fifth-longest active streak in the AL.

☞ He is hitting .458 (11-for-24) with four walks and a .536 on-base percentage on the current homestand.

CENTRAL HEATING: Tonight marks the Twins' 10th game in a 15-game stretch against divisional opponents...Twins have gone 6-3 in that stretch...in the next six games, they will play the Royals one time and the Tigers five times...they have gone 15-6 against the AL Central this season, going 5-4 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 5-1 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland.

☞ The Twins' .714 winning percentage in the division is the second-best inter-divisional mark in baseball, trailing Los-Angeles-NL, which is 13-5 (.722) against their division.

ADDITIONALLY: Correa has reached safely in 18 straight games, which marks the sixth-longest active streak in baseball...it is the second-longest streak of his career, with his career-long being 27, from June 10-July 15, 2017, with Houston.

LARNACH ON WOOD: Trevor Larnach is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with six doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, 14 runs scored, eight walks, a .414 on-base percentage and a .985 OPS in his last 16 games...he has reached base six times in his last eight plate appearances.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Low-A Fort Myers infielder Keoni Cavaco and left-handed pitcher Steven Hajjar are the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Cavaco, who turns 21 on Thursday, played in six games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .429 (12-for-28) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, eight RBI, a .448 on-base percentage and a 1.163 OPS...the Chula Vista, California native was selected 13th overall by the Twins in the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Eastlake High School.

☞ Hajjar, 21, started for the Mighty Mussels on Thursday at Bradenton, pitching 5.2 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and a career-high tying 10 strikeouts...the Andover, Massachusetts native was selected by the Twins in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Michigan.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2021, Josh Donaldson scored the 2-millionth run in Major League Baseball history, crossing home plate after Nelson Cruz drove him in with a first-inning double against the Royals.

- ☞ Will be his eighth career game (all starts) against the Royals and is 4-2, 2.15 ERA (46.0 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 37 strikeouts lifetime against Kansas City.
- ☞ Acquired by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher, Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Notched his second victory of the season on May 24 vs. Detroit in his fourth start this season at Target Field...sailed through a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing four hits with one walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts, to lead the Twins to a 2-0 win over the Tigers...marked his first outing of at least 7.0 innings with 10-or-more strikeouts since July 3, 2019 vs. Milwaukee (8.0 IP, 12 K).
 ☞ His 10 strikeouts are the most recorded in an outing by a Twins pitcher this season...is also the second Twins pitcher this season to toss at least 7.0 innings with nine-or-more strikeouts, joining Joe Ryan on April 27 vs. Detroit (7.0 IP, 9 K).
 ☞ The Twins have now won each of his last four starts since he was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List, going 2-0, 1.69 ERA (21.1 IP, 4 ER) with seven walks, 30 strikeouts and a .203 opponent batting average (16-for-579) in that span.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his first victory in a Twins uniform and first since September 1, 2021 vs. St. Louis (w/ Cincinnati), in a 14-4 victory over the Athletics on May 18 at RingCentral Coliseum...tossed a season-high 6.0 innings, allowing two runs on six hits, with no walks and five strikeouts as the Twins' offense erupted for 11 runs in six innings while Gray was in the game, to then put up 14 runs on 14 hits...was his first career victory against his former team that drafted him and for which he made his MLB debut...after last week's victory, Gray now has at least one victory against all 15 American League teams.

THE ROYAL TREATMENT: Is making his eighth career start against the Royals this afternoon... is a career 4-2, 2.15 ERA (46.0 IP, 11 ER), with 10 walks, 37 strikeouts and a .238/.284/.273 opponent slash line against Kansas City...his 2.15 ERA marks his lowest against any team faced with a minimum of seven starts...has won his last four straight starts against Kansas City dating back to April 16, 2016 as a member of the Athletics, going 4-0, 1.38 ERA (26.0 IP, 4 ER) with sox walks, 23 strikeouts and a .219/.272/.229 opponent slash line...made one start against the Royals last season (w/ Cincinnati) at Kauffman Stadium, earning the victory after twirling 7.0 innings (7 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 7 K) in a 5-2 Reds win.

☞ Gray has allowed two earned runs-or-fewer in 13 of his last 14 career games against American League Central opponents, going 7-2, 2.57 ERA (73.2 IP, 21 ER) with 30 walks, 82 strikeouts and a .200 opponent batting average (53-for-265).

SONNY DAYS AT HOME: Is making his fifth start at Target Field this season...has allowed two-or-fewer runs in all his home starts this season, going 1-0, 2.77 ERA (20.0 IP, 4 ER) with nine walks and 29 strikeouts...marks the first time in his career he has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in his first four home starts of the season.

☞ Has shown consistent numbers when at home and on the road over his career...has gone 47-36, 3.90 ERA (680.2 IP, 295 ER) with 231 walks and 652 strikeouts in 120 appearances (116 starts) at his home ballpark...has posted a 37-37 record, 3.24 ERA (614.1 IP, 221 ER), with 232 walks and 604 strikeouts in 109 career appearances (104 starts) on the road.

THROW A STRIKE, TAKE A HIKE: Through his first six starts this season, Gray owns a 11.39 strikeout-per-nine ratio, marking his second-highest of his career, just shy of his 11.57 mark in 2020 with the Reds...in two-strike counts this season, he has allowed just nine hits in 57 at-bats (.158)...owns a .149 opponent batting average (372-for-2501) throughout his career in two-strike counts.

VS. AL CENTRAL: Is making his third start of the season and second straight against American League Central opponents, also started on May 13 vs. Cleveland and May 24 vs. Detroit...is a career 18-11 (3.33 ERA, 238.0 IP) with 95 walks and 226 strikeouts in 42 career games (40 starts)...his 3.33 ERA marks his second lowest against any American League division (first: AL West 3.19 ERA).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...22 of his 30 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .111 (2-for-18) against his curveball...here's a look at his repertoire.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: This season, Gray has posted a .136 opponent average (6-for-44) with two walks and 16 strikeouts against left-handed hitters...has a .254 batting average (15-for-59) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts against right-handed hitters.

- ☞ In his career, Gray has limited left-handers to a .222 batting average (533-for-2398) with 635 strikeouts against left-handed hitters and right-handed hitters to a .238 batting average (581-for-2445) with 621 strikeouts.
- ☞ Gray's .136 opponent batting average against left-handers ranks third in the American League among right-handed starting pitchers (min. 40 opponent at-bats).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY (2022 SEASON: 3-2, 4.54 ERA // CAREER: 49-59, 4.71 ERA)

Right-hander Dylan Bundy is scheduled to start tomorrow's series opener against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park. his second-straight start against the Tigers...did not factor into the decision in his last outing on May 25 vs. Detroit, after pitching 5.2 innings, allowing five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts, as the Twins fell 4-2...will be making his seventh career appearance (6th start) and second consecutive start against Detroit tomorrow afternoon...is 0-2, 4.08 (28.2 IP, 13 ER) with 10 walks and 24 strikeouts against the Tigers in his career...owns two career starts in Detroit, going 0-1, 6.75 ERA (10.2 IP, 8 R/ER) with six walks and six strikeouts.

- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.
