**THE TWINS:** After beginning their seven-game roadtrip by taking two of three against Tampa Bay in St. Petersburg over the weekend, the Twins began their four-game series at Baltimore with a victory last night...tonight, they will continue the trip/series with the second of four against the Orioles through Thursday — all night games...the Twins are 8-4 at home and 6-5 on the road.

⊕ The Twins enter today with the fourth-most wins in the AL, trailing New York (17-6), Los Angeles (15-9) and Toronto (15-9).

⊕ The Twins are now a season-high five games over .500, their most since ending the 2020 season 12 games over at 36-24.

⊕ The Twins have outscored their opponents 21-11 on their current roadtrip...since allowing a four-run first inning to Tampa Bay on Friday, the Twins have outscored opponents 21-7.

**PADD-LOCKDOWN PITCHING GETS ORIOLES:** The Twins beat the Orioles last night at Camden Yards by a score of 2-1, making them 4-3 in one-run games this season...Chris Paddack (1-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched...Joe Smith, Griffin Jax, Emilio Pagán and Jhoan Duran combined for 3.2 no-hit innings of relief...Duran earned his first career save with a perfect ninth inning and a strikeout...the offense recorded seven hits with just one going for extra-bases, a double by Trevor Larnach...Jose Miranda made his major league debut, going 0-for-4.

**TWWWWWLWWWINS:** After starting the season 4-8, the Twins have now won 10 of their last 11 games, with a run differential of +33 (56-23) in those games...since April 21, their 10 wins are tied with New York-AL for most in baseball...below are some notable MLB offensive rankings since April 21:

**FOR STARTERS:** Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 9-6, 2.58 ERA (111.2 IP, 32 ER) with 29 walks, 102 strikeouts, a .205 opponent batting average and a 1.01 WHIP this season...among all MLB teams, they rank second in ERA, third in WHIP, and fifth in BAA and opponents OPS.

⊕ Tonight's starter, Joe Ryan, will receive MLB Network's prestigious award, the Pitch Hand, presented by MLB Central host Robert Flores...Ryan earned the monthly award after his strong April...he will appear on MLB Central tomorrow morning on The Network.

**TWINS AND O's:** The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the second of seven scheduled meetings this season...the Twins will host the O's at Target Field for a three-game weekend series from July 1-3.

⊕ The Twins are 33-14 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

⊕ Since the start of 2018, the Twins are 17-3 vs. the Orioles.

⊕ Max Kepler has hit safely in 17 of 20 career games against the Orioles, hitting .373 (28-for-75) with seven doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 22 RBI, 10 walks, a .442 OBP and a 1.295 OPS...he has seven homers and 11 RBI in his last 12 games against Baltimore.

⊕ Gary Sánchez has 20 home runs in 62 career games vs. the O's, his most vs. any opponent.

⊕ Gio Urshela is hitting .367 (44-for-120) with eight doubles, six home runs, 25 RBI, a .408 on-base percentage and a .991 OPS in 37 career games against the O's...he is hitting .319 (23-for-72) with a .950 OPS in 22 games at Camden...one of his two career two-homer games was here on August 7, 2019 (August 8, 2019 at TOR was the other).

**THE SHOW-RREA:** After starting the season hitting .167 (10-for-60) with a .504 OPS in his first 16 games, Carlos Correa is hitting .500 (11-for-22) with six RBI and a 1.067 OPS in his last five...since April 28, he has an average exit velocity of 97.7 mph, the best in baseball (minimum of 75 pitches)...lastly, he is two RBI away from reaching 500 for his career.

**OH BROTHER:** Twins No. 15 prospect, 2021 minor league Pitcher of the Year and St. Paul native Louie Varland is scheduled to start for Double-A Wichita tonight, as they host the Tulsa Drillers...the Drillers' scheduled starter is Louie's older brother, Gus Varland...according to Minor League Baseball, brothers have not faced each other as opposing starting pitchers in the minors since at least 2005...it's happened a handful of times in the majors, most recently on June 20, 2009 when Jered Weaver of the Los Angeles Angels and Jeff Weaver of the Los Angeles Dodgers squared off — older brother Jeff was victorious, as the Dodgers won, 6-4...other famous starting pitcher brothers who have started against each other in the majors include: Gaylord and Jim Perry, Phil and Joe Niekro, and Greg and Mike Maddux...the Varland brothers grew up in North St. Paul — where their aunts, Denise and Sue, were legendary fastpitch softball players — and played together locally at Concordia University.

**WEEK OF SERVICE:** The Twins and their six minor league affiliates today launched the inaugural "Minnesota Twins Week of Service" from May 3-11...believed to be Major League Baseball's first-ever coordinated effort across an entire organization, the Minnesota Twins Week of Service involves front office staff and clubhouse personnel from the Twins and each of Minnesota's minor league affiliates.

⊕ The Twins began the organization's Week of Service by again partnering with Bloomington, Minnesota-based Toro to rebuild and refurbish local fields in need; this year, they delivered new life to Northwoods Park in Brooklyn Park, Minnesota, home to the Brooklyn Park Athletic Association 12U team and several youth tournaments each year...former Twins outfielder and current Twins Community Fund Board Member Darin Mastroianni joined Twins front office staff, volunteers from Toro, and members of the City of Brooklyn Park Recreation and Parks team to rebuild Northwoods Park's baseball fields, including laying new agrilime, field edgework and other miscellaneous projects.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2011, Francisco Liriano threw the fifth no-hitter in Twins history and first no-hitter of the MLB season as the Twins beat the White Sox, 1-0...Jason Kubel's solo homer in the fourth inning off Edwin Jackson was the game's only run...in 2013, Justin Morneau recorded his 800th career RBI in a Twins 7-6 loss at Cleveland...Morneau finished his Twins career with 860 RBI which stands as the sixth most in club history.

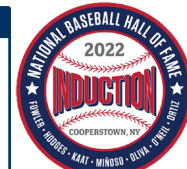

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his career-best third-straight win in his last start on April 27 vs. Detroit, working a career-high-tying 7.0 shutout innings and yielding just one hit and one walk, with nine strikeouts, good for his third career start with three-or-fewer base runners allowed...marked the first Twins starting pitcher to work in the seventh inning in 2022...tossed 90 pitches, his most in a start in his career and his most in a professional outing since also throwing 90 pitches in the second game of a doubleheader on August 30, 2019 with Double-A Montgomery in the Tampa Bay Rays system... Ryan also doesn't like wearing sleeves when he pitches, so made a fashion statement by wearing a turtleneck to stay warm.

- ☞ Recorded his third-straight quality start, the longest streak by a Twins hurler since Kenta Maeda's run of four straight from August 1-18, 2020.
- ☞ Became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history with two outings of at least 7.0 shutout innings with one-or-fewer hits allowed within his first nine career games.
- ☞ Ended the game with 55 career strikeouts, tops in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first nine career games.
- ☞ Extended his scoreless streak to 17.0 innings, longest by a Twins pitcher this season and the longest active run by a starting pitcher in the majors.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Earned his second win of the season on April 21 at Kansas City, outdueling Zack Greinke...faced the Royals for the first time in his career and permitted just two hits and one walk, with five strikeouts in 6.0 shutout innings, tossing the first leg of a 1-0 victory...paired with his start on April 15, recorded quality starts in back-to-back outings for the first time in his career.

**GOOSE EGGS:** Enters his start tonight with a 17.0-inning scoreless streak, dating back to the third inning on April 15 at Boston...streak is the longest of his career and the longest by a Twins pitcher this season...also the longest active run in the majors by a starting pitcher.

- ☞ Per Elias, Ryan's 17.0-inning scoreless streak is the fourth-longest run by a rookie starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present), trailing only Joe Mays (20.1 IP; July 17-29, 1999), Jim Hughes (20.0 IP; May 14-24, 1975) and Andrew Albers (17.1 IP; August 6-12, 2013).

**APRIL SHOWERS:** Went 3-1, 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP, 3 ER) in four April starts, recording the lowest ERA in March/April by a rookie in Twins/Senators history (min. 20.0 IP)...his ERA also marked the fifth-lowest ERA by a rookie in a single month in Twins/Senators history (min. 20.0 IP), trailing only Jim Hughes (0.87 ERA in May 1975), Milo Candini (0.88 ERA in June 1943), Jim Shaw (0.91 ERA in September 1914) and Francisco Liriano (1.13 ERA in May 2006).

**FIRST-TIME ORNITHOLOGIST:** Facing the Orioles for the first time in his career tonight...owns one career start against the American League East division, occurring earlier this season on April 15 at Boston — earned his first win of the campaign as the Twins defeated the Red Sox 8-4...yielded one run on five hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings...lone run he allowed came on a solo homer by Alex Verdugo in the second inning.

**NIGHT MARES:** Ryan is making his second night start of the season tonight, alongside his last outing on April 27 vs. Detroit...has made four career starts in day games and five in night games, entering tonight — is 2-1, 1.71 ERA (21.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks and 21 strikeouts in the daytime, compared to 3-1, 3.45 ERA (28.2 IP, 11 ER) with five walks and 34 strikeouts at night...his night numbers are skewed by his outing on September 30, 2021 vs. Detroit, when he allowed six of his 11 career runs in night games...subtracting that start, he's 3-0, 1.88 ERA (24.0 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and 29 strikeouts at night.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball — he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and 52.0% of the time through his first three starts of 2022...here's a look at the season's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

**RULER OF THE ROAD:** Ryan has fared better on the road than at home so far in his career — is 1-2, 4.21 ERA (25.2 IP, 12 ER) with nine walks and 28 strikeouts in five career starts at Target Field, compared to 4-0, 1.13 ERA (24.0 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and 27 strikeouts in four career starts on the road...one of the best outings of his career to date — his 7.0-inning, one-hit start on September 8, 2021 at Cleveland — occurred on the road...he also recorded a career-best 11 strikeouts in 5.0 innings at Wrigley Field on September 22, 2021...has tossed 6.0-or-more innings and struck out at least five batters in three of his four career road starts.

**MASTER OF THE FIRST INNING:** Ryan has allowed just one hit in the first inning in his career — a Mitch Haniger two-run home run on Opening Day, April 8 vs. Seattle — and is isolating hitters to a .036 (1-for-28) opponent batting average in the opening frame in his career...his .036 mark leads the majors since the start of 2021 (min. 25 opponent at-bats in the first).

**MAKING THE LORAX PROUD:** In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 25 batters so far, which will lead to 1,250 new trees planted.

**SET YOUR DIALS:** Ryan is scheduled to be presented with the Pitch Hand Award by Robert Flores sometime tomorrow morning on MLB Network.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY (2022 SEASON: 3-1, 2.95 ERA // CAREER: 49-58, 4.67 ERA)

Right-hander Dylan Bundy is due to start tomorrow night against Baltimore in the third game of this four-game series at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...took his first loss of the season in his last start on April 29 in Tampa Bay, yielding six runs on seven hits (2 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings...facing the Orioles for the second time in his career, after a start on August 24, 2021 at Baltimore with Los Angeles-AL (ND, 1.1 IP, 1 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 3 K)...Bundy was selected by Baltimore in the first round (4th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft, debuted for the O's on September 23, 2012 and spent 2011-19 with the organization.

- 2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Single-A Bowling Green (6 starts), Single-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
