THE TWINS: Completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 4-3, going 2-1 against the Tigers and 2-2 against the Royals...today, the Twins will begin their fourth roadtrip of the season with the first of five games in four days against the Tigers...after today, the Twins will play the Tigers four more times in three days (doubleheader tomorrow), then travel to Toronto to play three against the Blue Jays over the weekend...the Twins are 17-11 at home and 12-8 on the road...they have gone 10-4 in their last 14 road games, since April 21.

COSTLY WIN FOR TWINS: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 7-3, finishing the four-game series with a 2-2 split...Sonny Gray (3-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and four strikeouts...Gray exited in the seventh inning with right pectoral soreness...the offense recorded 11 hits, their fourth-straight game with double-digit hit totals...Trevor Larnach went 3-for-4 with his third home run and his 10th double...Royce Lewis made his return to the club and left after three innings, experiencing right knee pain after colliding with the centerfield wall while making a catch...he was replaced by Nick Gordon, who went 2-for-3 with his first home run of the season, fourth double and first career game with multiple extra-base hits.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have placed infielder Royce Lewis on the 10-day Injured List with a right knee bone bruise...Lewis, who was recalled yesterday from Triple-A St. Paul and started in centerfield against the Royals, was removed from the game in the fourth inning after colliding with the wall while making a catch to start the third inning...to replace Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled infielder Jose Miranda from St. Paul...Miranda, who was optioned to the Saints yesterday, made his major league debut on May 2 at Baltimore and has played in 19 games for the Twins this season, going 11-for-67 with five doubles, one home run, five RBI, four runs scored and two walks.

TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the seventh of 19 meetings in 2022...Twins are 5-1 against Detroit this season, all six of the previous games came at Target Field in late April and early last week...this marks the club's first trip to Comerica Park since August 30, 2021, when they traveled to Detroit to play a make-up game from earlier in the 2021 season (won 3-2)...their last series at Comerica came July 17-18, 2021, getting swept in three games (doubleheader on July 17)...they went 4-5 at Detroit in 2021.

- ☞ The Twins have won 22 of their last 32 over the Tigers and 27 of their last 40.
- ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .302 (104-for-344) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 54 RBI, 27 walks and an .836 OPS in 89 career games against the Tigers...he has reached base safely in 21 straight against Detroit...Polanco is hitting .321 (53-for-165) with six home runs, 13 walks, a .374 on-base percentage and an .865 OPS in 43 career games at Comerica...he ranks sixth among actives in batting average at Comerica (minimum 175 PA).
- ☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .326 (30-for-92) with five doubles, one home run, 13 RBI, 10 walks and a .398 on-base percentage in 31 career games vs. Detroit...he is 10-for-21 (.476) with three walks and a .542 on-base percentage in six games against the Tigers this season.
- ☞ Max Kepler is slugging .857 with one double, four home runs and nine RBI against Detroit this season...he has two home runs and 13 RBI against the rest of the league.

SERIES PREMIERE: The Twins are playing their first five-game series since September 4-7, 2020 vs. Detroit at Target Field...the second game of the doubleheader on September 4 was a home game for the Tigers...in that series, the Twins won four games to one...the Twins have played 44 five-game series in their history (since 1961): 15 times in the '60s, 17 times in the '70s, seven times in the '80s, two times in the '90s and three times in the 2000s...they have played a six-game series once, coming August 17-20, 1962 vs. Boston (2 doubleheaders in that series).

OFFENSIVE COORDINATORS: The Twins have recorded double-digit hit totals in each of their last four games and are hitting .329 (49-for-149) with six doubles, one triple, six home runs, 15 walks, 22 runs scored, a .392 on-base percentage, a .503 slugging percentage and an .895 OPS in that span.

- ☞ On the season, they rank first in the AL in on-base percentage (.329), second in batting average (.251), third in OPS (.729) and fourth in slugging percentage (.399).

ALL HE DOES IS HIT: Luis Arraez is hitting .363 (49-for-135), the second-highest average in baseball, trailing only J.D. Martinez (.379)...additionally, he has posted a .456 on-base percentage, the highest in baseball.

- ☞ Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .435 (27-for-62) with 13 walks, a .539 on-base percentage and a 1.023 OPS in 17 games.
- ☞ He has hit safely in a season-long nine-straight games, hitting .500 (18-for-36) with six walks, seven multi-hit games, a .571 on-base percentage and a 1.071 OPS during the streak...it is tied for third-longest active streak in the AL and tied with Jorge Polanco (April 30-May 8) for the longest by a Twin this season.
- ☞ He finished the seven-game homestand hitting .464 (13-for-28) with four walks and a .531 on-base percentage.

CENTRAL HEATING: Today marks the Twins' 11th game in a 15-game stretch against divisional opponents...Twins have gone 7-3 in that stretch...they have gone 16-6 against the AL Central this season, going 6-4 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 5-1 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland.

- ☞ The Twins' .727 winning percentage in the division is the second-best interdivisional mark in baseball, trailing Los-Angeles-NL, which is 14-5 (.737) against the National League West.

LARNACH ON WOOD: Trevor Larnach is hitting .358 (19-for-53) with seven doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, 15 runs scored, eight walks, a .435 on-base percentage, a .660 slugging percentage and a 1.096 OPS in his last 17 games...in those 17 games, he has an average exit velocity of 93.9 mph...additionally, he has reached base safely nine times in his last 13 plate appearances across his last three games.

HAPPY MEMORIAL DAY: The Twins are 24-31 all-time on Memorial Day...they are also 8-3 in their last 11 road Memorial Day games...on Memorial Day 2021, they beat the Orioles at Camden Yards by a score of 3-2 in 10 innings...José Berrios pitched 8.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits, with no walks and six strikeouts...Jorge Polanco hit a solo home run in the 10th inning.

- ☞ Making his eighth start of the season and 141st of his career...169th career appearance.
- ☞ Today will be Bundy's seventh career appearance (6th start) and second straight against the Tigers...is 0-2, 4.08 ERA (28.2 IP, 13 ER) with 10 walks and 24 strikeouts in his career vs. Detroit.
- ☞ Will be his third start against American League Central division opponent this season and is 1-0, 0.84 ERA (10.2 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 10 strikeouts in his two prior starts.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his seventh start of the season and third home start on May 25 vs. Detroit...did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.2 innings and allowing one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts...was removed from the game with a 2-1 lead in the sixth inning; the Tigers tied the game in the eighth inning and the Twins eventually fell, 4-2, in 10 innings...marked his second start since being reinstated from the COVID Injured List on May 17.

- ☞ Marked his third consecutive home start allowing one-or-fewer earned runs with at least 5.0 innings pitched, marking the first time in his career he tossed at least 5.0 innings with one-or-fewer earned runs in his first three home starts of a season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his sixth start of the season and fourth start on the road on May 17 at RingCentral Coliseum...did not factor into the decision after pitching 3.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in his first start since being reinstated from the COVID Injured List (missed 12 games), as the Twins fell, 5-2...marked his third scoreless start this season, after also pitching two 5.0 scoreless innings on April 11 vs. Seattle and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL.

- ☞ In his previous two starts, Bundy was 0-2, 13.97 ERA (9.2 IP, 15 ER) with four walks, 10 strikeouts and a 1.222 opponent OPS.

AGAINST THE TIGERS: Will be making his seventh career appearance (6th start) against Detroit...will be his second consecutive start against the Tigers after going 5.2 innings (ND, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K) last Wednesday...is seeking his first career win against the Tigers, after going 0-2, 4.08 ERA (28.2 IP, 13 ER) with 10 walks and 24 strikeouts in his prior outings...is 0-1, 6.75 ERA (10.2 IP, 8 ER) with six walks and six strikeouts in two career starts at Comerica Park...last pitched at Comerica on August 17, 2021 with Los Angeles-AL (ND, 4.2 IP, 3 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 3 K).

ROCKY ROADS: Bundy will be starting his fifth start on the road this season...is 1-2, 8.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 16 ER) with six walks and 19 strikeouts on the road, compared to 2-0, 0.57 ERA (15.2 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and 12 strikeouts in three home starts this season...has shown slightly better numbers when pitching at home in his career, going 25-32, 4.56 ERA (442.0 IP, 224 ER) with 131 walks and 410 strikeouts in 91 home appearances (77 starts)...is 24-27, 4.89 ERA (362.1 IP, 197 ER) with 134 walks and 379 strikeouts in 77 road appearances (63 starts).

STAYING CENTRAL FOCUSED: Will be making his 35th career appearance (30th start) and third start this season against the American League Central division...is 1-0, 0.84 ERA (10.2 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 10 strikeouts in his two prior starts, which occurred on April 23 vs. Chicago-AL (W, 5.0 IP, 0 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K) and May 25 vs. Detroit (ND, 5.2 IP, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K)...is 11-10, 3.96 ERA (170.2 IP, 75 ER) with 50 walks and 163 strikeouts in his career vs. the American League Central...has dominated in his last 11 starts vs. the division, going 3-2, 2.54 ERA (63.2 IP, 18 ER) with 17 walks and 58 strikeouts...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in those 11 starts while striking out six-or-more batters in seven of the 11.

WALKING IN STYLE: Allowed just one walk combined in his first three starts of the season; has walked at least one batter in each of his last four starts (7 BB total)...even with his last four starts, his walks overall equate to a career-low 5.6 walk percentage...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (35.4%) and first-pitch strike percentage (69.4%).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy's pitch usage has resulted in his highest career groundball percentage (45.1%)...according to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first seven starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Bundy went 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.

- ☞ Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (*Elias*).
- ☞ Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (*Elias*).
- ☞ Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero (0.54 ERA, 5/2-5/13/18) and Ervin Santana (0.41 ERA, 4/3-4/14/17).

GETTING BACK ON TRACK: Allowed just one earned run in 15.1 innings pitched in his first three starts of the season, to then allow 15 earned runs in his next two starts (13.97 ERA) in 9.2 innings pitched, before going on the COVID Injured List on May 6...since being reinstated, Bundy has allowed just one earned run in 8.2 inning pitched (1.04 ERA) in two starts.

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on December 1, 2021...this marks his third professional organization, as he spent the previous two seasons with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and his first five Major League seasons with Baltimore (2012-19).

TOMORROW'S GAME 1 STARTER - LHP DEVIN SMELTZER [2022 SEASON: 1-0, 1-.4 ERA // CAREER: 5-2, 3.62 ERA]

Southpaw Devin Smeltzer is scheduled to start the first game of tomorrow's doubleheader against the Detroit Tigers at Comerica Park...did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 26 vs. Kansas City at Target Field, tossing a career-high 7.0 scoreless innings and allowing two hits and no walks, with a season-high six strikeouts in an eventual 3-2 Twins loss...marked the first time he pitched at least 6.0 innings with no runs allowed since August 4, 2019 against Kansas City (also 6.0 IP)...will be facing the Tigers for the third time in his career (2nd start); is 1-0, 7.11 ERA (6.1 IP, 5 ER) with one walk and five strikeouts in his two prior outings...earned the win in his prior start on September 26, 2019 at Comerica Park (5.0 IP, 10 H, 3 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs. Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts.
- In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes.
- Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhart Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season.
- Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City.
- Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th).
- Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta.
- Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012).
- Named Orioles top prospect according to *Baseball America* and *Baseball Prospectus* following the 2014 season.
- Underwent Tommy John surgery on right elbow June 27 2013, performed by Dr. James Andrews.
- Named Carolina League 2012 Midseason All-Star and *Baseball America* Minor League All-Star.
