The Twins ${ }^{1} .727$ winning percentage in the division is the second-best interdivisional mark in baseball, trailing Los-Angeles-NL,
which is $14-5$ (.737) against the National League West.
LARNACH ON WOOD: Trevor Larnach is hitting . 358 (19-for-53) with seven doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, 15 runs scored, eight walks, a. 435 on-base percentage, a 660 slugging percentage and a 1.096 OPS in his last 17 games... in those 17 games, he has an average exit velocity of 93.9 mph...additionally, he has reached base safely nine times in his last 13 plate appearances across his last three games.
HAPPY MEMORIAL DAY: The Twins are 24-31 all-time on Memorial Day...they are also 8-3 in their last 11 road Memorial Day games...on Memorial Day 2021, they beat the Orioles at Camden Yards by a score of 3-2 in 10 innings....José Berríos pitched 8.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits, with no walks and six strikeouts...Jorge Polanco hit a solo home run in the 10th inning.

$\Phi$ Making his eighth start of the season and 141st of his career...169th career appearance. $\Phi$ Today will be Bundy's seventh career appearance (6th start) and second straight against the Tigers...is 0-2, 4.08 ERA (28.2 IP, 13 ER) with 10 walks and 24 strikeouts in his career vs. Detroit. $\Phi$ Will be his third start against American League Central division opponent this season and is 1-0, 0.84 ERA ( 10.2 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 10 strikeouts in his two prior starts.
$\Phi$ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).


LAST TIME OUT: Made his seventh start of the season and third home start on May 25 vs. Detroit...did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.2 innings and allowing one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts....was removed from the game with a 2-1 lead in the sixth inning; the Tigers tied the game in the eighth inning and the Twins eventually fell, 4-2, in 10 innings...marked his second start since being reinstated from the COVID Injured List on May 17.
$\boldsymbol{\Phi}$ Marked his third consecutive home start allowing one-or-fewer earned runs with at least 5.0 innings pitched, marking the first time in his career he tossed at least 5.0 innings with one-or-fewer earned runs in his first three home starts of a season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his sixth start of the season and fourth start on the road on May 17 at RingCentral Coliseum...did not factor into the decision after pitching 3.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in his first start since being reinstated from the COVID Injured List (missed 12 games), as the Twins fell, 5-2...marked his third scoreless start this season, after also pitching two 5.0 scoreless innings on April 11 vs. Seattle and April 23 vs. Chicago-AL.
$\Phi$ In his previous two starts, Bundy was 0-2, 13.97 ERA (9.2 IP, 15 ER ) with four walks, 10
strikeouts and a 1.222 opponent OPS.
AGAINST THE TIGERS: Will be making his seventh career appearance (6th start) against Detroit... will be his second consecutive start against the Tigers after going 5.2 innings (ND, $5 \mathrm{H}, 1$ R/ER, 1 $\mathrm{BB}, 6 \mathrm{~K}$ ) last Wednesday...is seeking his first career win against the Tigers, after going 0-2, 4.08 ERA (28.2 IP, 13 ER ) with 10 walks and 24 strikeouts in his prior outings...is $0-1,6.75 \mathrm{ERA}$ ( $10.2 \mathrm{IP}, 8 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with six walks and six strikeouts in two career starts at Comerica Park...last pitched at Comerica on August 17, 2021 with Los Angeles-AL (ND, 4.2 IP, 3 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 3 K).

ROCKY ROADS: Bundy will be starting his fifth start on the road this season...is 1-2, 8.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 16 ER) with six walks and 19 strikeouts on the road, compared to 2-0, 0.57 ERA (15.2 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and 12 strikeouts in three home starts this season...has shown slightly better numbers when pitching at home in his career, going 25-32, 4.56 ERA ( 442.0 IP, 224 ER) with 131 walks and 410 strikeouts in 91 home appearances (77 starts)...is 24-27, 4.89 ERA (362.1 IP, 197 ER) with 134 walks and 379 strikeouts in 77 road appearances ( 63 starts).

STAYING CENTRAL FOCUSED: Will be making his 35th career appearance (30th start) and third start this season against the American League Central division...is 1-0, 0.84 ERA (10.2 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 10 strikeouts in his two prior starts, which occurred on April 23 vs. Chicago-AL (W, 5.0 IP, 0 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K ) and May 25 vs. Detroit (ND, 5.2 IP, 1 R/ER, $1 \mathrm{BB}, 6 \mathrm{~K}$ )...is 11-10, 3.96 ERA ( 170.2 IP, 75 ER) with 50 walks and 163 strikeouts in his career vs. the American League Central...has dominated in his last 11 starts vs. the division, going 3-2, 2.54 ERA ( 63.2 IP, 18 ER) with 17 walks and 58 strikeouts...has allowed three-or-fewer earned earned runs in those 11 starts while striking out six-or-more batters in seven of the 11 .

WALKING IN STYLE: Allowed just one walk combined in his first three starts of the season; has walked at least one batter in each of his last four starts (7 BB total)...even with his last four starts, his walks overall equate to a career-low 5.6 walk percentage...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (35.4\%) and first-pitch strike percentage (69.4\%).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy's pitch usage has resulted in his highest career groundball percentage ( $45.1 \%$ )...according to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first seven starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

## STARTING OFF RIGHT: Bundy went $3-0,0.59$ ERA ( $15.1 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in

 his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.$\Phi$ Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-orfewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (Elias).
क Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (Elias).
क Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero ( 0.54 ERA, $5 / 2-5 / 13 / 18$ ) and Ervin Santana ( 0.41 ERA, 4/3-4/14/17).

GETTING BACK ON TRACK: Allowed just one earned run in 15.1 innings pitched in his first three starts of the season, to then allow 15 earned runs in his next two starts ( 13.97 ERA) in 9.2 innings pitched, before going on the COVID Injured List on May 6...since being reinstated, Bundy has allowed just one earned run in 8.2 inning pitched ( 1.04 ERA) in two starts.

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on December 1, 2021...this marks his third professional organization, as he spent the previous two seasons with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and his first five Major League seasons with Baltimore (2012-19).
