THE TWINS: After beginning their seven-game roadtrip by taking two of three against Tampa Bay in St. Petersburg over the weekend, the Twins began their four-game series at Baltimore with consecutive victories the last two nights...tonight, they will continue the trip/series with the third of four against the Orioles through Thursday...the Twins are 8-4 at home and 7-5 on the road.

BALLY CAPS: Due to NHL Playoff conflicts as the Minnesota Wild play the St. Louis Blues in Game 2 of the Stanley Cup Playoffs, the Twins will be on Bally Sports North Extra tonight...they are also scheduled to play on BSNX on Friday night and Sunday afternoon.

TWINS DOUBLE-DOWN IN BALTIMORE: The Twins beat the Orioles last night at Camden Yards by a score of 7-2, winning their second game of the series, while extending their current winning streak to four games...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 4.2 innings pitched...Caleb Thielbar (1.2), Tyler Duffey (1.2) and Cody Stashak (1.0), combined for 4.1 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded seven doubles, marking their most since hitting eight on September 26, 2020 vs. Cincinnati...Carlos Correa extended his hitting streak to six games (2 doubles), the longest for a Twin this season.

TWWWWWLWLLLLLW: After starting the season 4-8, the Twins have now won 11 of their last 12 games, with a run differential of +38 (63-25) in those games...since April 21, their 11 wins are tied with New York-AL for most in baseball...below are some notable MLB offensive rankings since April 21:

NOTE: The Twins are one of four teams in baseball this season with multiple four-plus-game winning streaks, joining San Francisco (5 and 5), Milwaukee (5 and 4) and San Diego (4, 4 and 4).

FOR STARTERS: Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 9-6, 2.63 ERA (116.1 IP, 34 ER) with 30 walks, 105 strikeouts, a .210 opponent batting average and a 1.03 WHIP this season...among all MLB teams, they rank third in ERA and WHIP, and fifth in opponents batting average and opponents OPS.

END GAME: In their last seven games, the bullpen has combined to go 3-0, 1.07 ERA (25.1 IP, 3 ER) with opponents hitting .180 (16-for-89), five extra-base hits (all doubles), three walks, 26 strikeouts, five holds and two saves.

TWINS AND O's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the third of seven scheduled meetings this season...the Twins will host the O's at Target Field for a three-game weekend series from July 1-3...since the start of 2018, the Twins are 18-3 vs. the Orioles.

NOT AT THE TABLE CARLOS: After starting the season hitting .167 (10-for-60) with a .504 OPS in his first 16 games, Carlos Correa is hitting .481 (13-for-27) with six RBI and a 1.093 OPS in his last six...his current six-game hitting streak is the longest for a Twin this season...since April 28, he has an average exit velocity of 96.6 mph, the third-best in baseball (minimum of 90 pitches), trailing Yordan Alvarez (100.5) and Aaron Judge (100.5)...lastly, he is two RBI away from reaching 500 for his career.

WEEK OF SERVICE: The Twins and their six minor league affiliates today launched the inaugural "Minnesota Twins Week of Service" from May 3-11...believed to be Major League Baseball's first-ever coordinated effort across an entire organization, the Minnesota Twins Week of Service involves front office staff and clubhouse personnel from the Twins and each of Minnesota's minor league affiliates.

GLADD TO MEET YOU, CAMDEN: Did you know that future Twins Hall-of-Famer and radio stallion Dan Gladden played in the fourth game at Camden Yards on April 17, 1992...while playing for the Detroit Tigers, Gladden led off in leftfield and went 0-for-3 with a walk.

EUTAW STREET CRED: In his third career game at Camden Yards on July 25, 2004, Justin Morneau hit a 412-foot home run off Daniel Cabrera onto Eutaw Street, one of roughly 115 ball-markers in that area...additionally, Twins first base coach, Hank Conger, has a plaque 412 feet from when he hit a home run off Jason Hammel on June 12, 2013 as a member of the Angels.

LAST TIME OUT: Worked through his fourth start of the season (2nd road start), suffering his first loss of the season last Friday in Tampa Bay...threw a season-high 6.0 innings while giving up six runs on seven hits (2 HR), with two walks and a season-high seven strikeouts in a 6-1 Twins defeat...

His seven strikeouts marked his most in a start since April 6, 2021 vs. Houston (10 K's)...had made 25 appearances (21 starts) in that span.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his third start of the season and (2nd home start), earning his third consecutive win in a 9-2 Twins victory on April 23 vs. Chicago-AL...tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing four hits, no walks and four strikeouts...

AGAINST THE O'S: Has made one career start against his former team on August 24, 2021 at Camden Yards (w/ Los Angeles-AL)...did not factor into the decision after tossing 1.1 innings and allowing one run on a solo homer, with three walks and three strikeouts.

Was drafted by Baltimore in the first round (4th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft...spent his first five seasons with the Orioles, going 38-45, 4.67 ERA (614.1 IP, 319 ER, 206 BB, 602 K) in 127 appearances (103 starts) from 2012-19.

LET'S GET THIS SHOW ON THE ROAD: Is making his third road start of the season tonight...in his last seven road starts dating back to June 30, 2021, he is 2-1, 3.38 ERA (26.2 IP, 10 ER), with 10 walks, 30 strikeouts, a 1.09 WHIP and a .194 BAA...

DAY 'N NITE: Through his first four starts, Bundy has shown more one-sided numbers when tossing in the daytime this season, going 2-0, 0.87 ERA (10.1 P, 1 ER) with no walks, 10 strikeouts and a .525 opponent OPS in two day starts...

A FACE OFF OF TRADE OFF'S: Bundy will be dueling the rubber against the O's right-hander Kyle Bradish tonight...the Orioles traded Bundy to the Angels on December 4, 2019, in exchange for Bradish, who was the Angels' fourth-round pick in the 2018 First Year Player Draft.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy's pitch usage has resulted in his highest groundball percentage in his career (48.4%)...according to Baseball Savant, Bundy used a five-pitch mix in his first four starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...

SIZZLIN' START: "Bundy went 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.

- Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (Elias).
Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (Elias).
Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero (0.54 ERA, 5/2-5/13/18) and Ervin Santana (0.41 ERA, 4/3-4/14/17).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER (2022 SEASON: 0-0, 2.93 ERA // CAREER- 61-81, 3.86 ERA)

Veteran right-hander Archer is scheduled to make his fifth start of the season in tomorrow evenings series finale against the O's...did not factor into the decision after tossing 4.0 innings in his last start on April 30 at Tampa Bay, allowing one run on two hits, with three walks and four strikeouts in a 9-1 Twins victory...

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts.
In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes.
Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhard Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season.
Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City.
Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th).
Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta.
