**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 4-2 through six games on their seven-game roadtrip, going 2-1 against Tampa Bay last weekend, followed by going 2-1 in Baltimore this week...tonight, the Twins will complete their roadtrip with the four-game series finale at Camden Yards...after tonight's game, the Twins will travel home to begin their longest homestand of the season by playing nine games in 10 days, which includes three against Oakland this weekend, three against Houston from May 10-12 and three against Cleveland from May 13-15.

☞ After starting the season 4-8, the Twins have now won 11 of their last 13 games, with a run differential of +33 (67-34) in those games...since April 21, their 11 wins are tied with New York-AL for most in baseball.

**BIG INNINGS BUG BUNNY:** The Twins lost to the Orioles last night by a score of 9-4, marking the club's most runs allowed this season and their first loss when scoring four-plus runs (12-1)...Dylan Bundy (3-2) was the starter and loser, allowing a career-high nine runs on a career-high tying 11 hits in 3.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, including two from Trevor Larnach (both singles)...Carlos Correa hit his second home run of the season, a two-run shot that gave him 500 career RBI.

**TWINS AND O'S:** The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the fourth of seven scheduled meetings this season...the Twins will host the O's at Target Field for a three-game weekend series from July 1-3...since the start of 2018, the Twins are 18-4 vs. the Orioles.

☞ The Twins are 34-15 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

☞ Gary Sánchez has 20 home runs in 64 career games vs. the O's, his most vs. any opponent.  
☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .360 (45-for-125) with nine doubles, six home runs, 26 RBI, a .406 on-base percentage and a .982 OPS in 39 career games against the O's...he is hitting .312 (24-for-77) with a .939 OPS in 24 games at Camden Yards.

**FAREWELL, KAILEY!** Baltimore Orioles Senior Coordinator of Public Relations and Publications Kailey Adams worked her final day with the Orioles yesterday...Kailey will be working communications for Towson University in Towson, MD...Kailey interned for the Twins Communications department during the 2015 season, joining the club as a 21-year-old college senior.

**END GAME:** In their last eight games, the bullpen has combined to go 3-0, 0.91 ERA (29.2 IP, 3 ER) with opponents hitting .165 (17-for-103), five extra-base hits (all doubles), three walks, 31 strikeouts, five holds and two saves.

**NOT AT THE TABLE CARLOS:** After starting the season hitting .167 (10-for-60) with a .504 OPS in his first 16 games, Carlos Correa is hitting .452 (14-for-31) with eight RBI and a 1.114 OPS in his last seven...his current seven-game hitting streak is the longest for a Twin this season...Correa's career-high for a hitting streak is 16, done April 19-May 6, 2019.

**TOP JEFF:** Ryan Jeffers began the season hitting .133 (4-for-30) with no extra-base hits, four walks and 10 strikeouts in his first 10 games, through April 21...in eight games since April 22, he is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with four doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, two walks, an .815 slugging percentage and a 1.194 OPS...the Twins are 8-0 in those games.

☞ Jeffers, four defensive runs saved this season are tied for most in baseball among catchers, along with Cleveland's Austin Hedges and New York-AL's Jose Trevino.

**MAX HEAT:** After starting the season hitting .186 (8-for-43) with a .593 OPS in his first 14 games, Max Kepler has hit .313 (10-for-32) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, six walks and a 1.171 OPS in his last 10.

☞ Since April 26, he ranks third in the AL in expected slugging percentage at .895 (minimum 100 pitches), trailing Aaron Judge (.984) and Yordan Alvarez (.970)...on the season, he ranks 11th in the AL in expected slugging percentage at .588 (minimum 300 pitches).

**THE NAME GAME:** Double-A Wichita right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month for April and High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Christian Encarnacion-Strand earned Midwest League Player of the Month for April, as announced by Minor League Baseball yesterday.

☞ The Twins' No. 7 prospect (MLB.com), Woods Richardson went 2-0 with 21.2 scoreless innings, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in four starts in the season's first month; did not allow more than two hits in a start while holding opposing hitters to a .101 batting average.

☞ Encarnacion-Strand, the Twins' No. 29 prospect, hit .410 (32-for-78) with four doubles, one triple, five home runs, 23 RBI, 14 runs scored and a 1.138 OPS in 19 April games; he started the season 9-for-10 with three home runs and 14 RBI in his first two games en route to leading the league in batting average, hits, total bases (53), RBI, slugging percentage (.679) and OPS during the month.

**WEEK OF SERVICE:** The Twins and their six minor league affiliates today launched the inaugural "Minnesota Twins Week of Service" from May 3-11...believed to be Major League Baseball's first-ever coordinated effort across an entire organization, the Minnesota Twins Week of Service involves front office staff and clubhouse personnel from the Twins and each of Minnesota's minor league affiliates.

☞ Earlier today, players and staff from Double-A Wichita visited Linwood Elementary School in Wichita as part of both the organization's Week of Service and the local Wichita Wind Surge Reading Program, presented by Credit Union of America.

**DAZZLE FACTS:** Did you know Twins radio savant Dan Gladden played in not only the fourth game in Camden Yards history, but also the fifth game...in that game on April 18, 1992, he went 2-for-3 with two singles...additionally, the foul ball Gladden caught in the radio booth on Tuesday night was the first time he had caught a ball at Camden Yards since September 26, 1993, when he hauled in a flyout in the eighth inning off the bat of Mark McLemore — a span of 10,449 days.

- Making his fifth start of the season and 220th of his career...223rd career appearance.
Today marks his 22nd career appearance (21st start) against the Orioles...is 6-10, 5.05 ERA (11.7 IP, 66 ER), against the O's in his career.
Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...in addition to his time with the Rays, has also pitched in the majors for Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Archer started last Saturday's win against his former squad in Tampa Bay...went on to toss 4.0 innings, allowing just one run on two hits, while allowing three walks with four strikeouts in a 9-1 Twins victory...

- After allowing just two hits in his previous start, Archer has now allowed four hits or less in each of his last 11 appearances, dating back to August 20, 2019 vs. Washington...in that span, he is 1-1, 3.79 ERA (35.2 IP, 15 ER) with 17 walks, 37 strikeouts and a .226 opponent batting average (31-for-137).
His three walks allowed marked his third consecutive start with at least three walks, doing so for the fourth time in his career (last: 5/12-5/23/18).

TWO STARTS AGO: Archer started on April 24, in a 6-4, 10-inning win over the Chicago White Sox at Target Field, working the first 3.0 innings of a planned 60-pitch outing and piggyback scenario with long reliever Josh Winder...struggled with his command, throwing just 32 strikes among his 61 pitches...

WOES VS. THE O'S: Is making his 21st career start (22nd appearance) against the Orioles in tonight's series finale...is 6-10, 5.05 ERA (117.2 IP, 66 ER), with 40 walks and 111 strikeouts against Baltimore...has made 10 career starts (11 appearances) at Camden Yards, going 2-7, 6.44 ERA (58.2 IP, 42 ER), with 23 walks and 51 strikeouts...has given up at least one home run in each of his last eight starts at Oriole Park.

- Has made 87 career appearances against American League East opponents, allowing a .243 opponent batting average (472-for-1945) with 178 walks, 530 strikeouts and a .697 opponent OPS.

HOME/ROAD: Archer has fared better when pitching at home this season, twirling a 2.57 ERA (7.0 IP, 2 ER), with three walks, five strikeouts and allowing a .192 opponent batting average...on the road this season, he owns a 3.24 ERA (8.1 IP, 3 ER) with six walks, nine strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average.

- Against AL East opponents on the road, Archer is 9-16, 4.64 ERA (228.2 IP, 118 ER), with 89 walks, 217 strikeouts and a .760 opponent OPS in 40 career appearances (39 starts).

THE MOON KNIGHT: Archer takes the ball this evening for his third night start of the 2022 season...has posted better numbers in night games this season, with a 2.16 ERA (8.1 IP, 2 ER), .194 opponent batting average (6-for-31) and a .652 opponent OPS...has a 3.86 ERA (7.0 IP, 3 ER), .192 BAA (5-for-26) and .805 OPS during day games this season.

RIGHT/LEFT SPLITS: In his first four starts this season, Archer has held opposing right-handers to a .194 batting average (6-for-31) with six walks, six strikeouts and a .711 opponent OPS...has similar numbers against left-handers with a .192 opponent batting average (4-for-26) with three walks, eight strikeouts and a .737 opponent OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Archer has relied primarily on either a slider or four-seam fastball during his first four Twins starts, throwing those for a combined 260 of his 279 pitches, per Baseball Savant...below is the website's tracking of his first four starts of the 2022 campaign:

- His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.2 mph on the fastball and 88.8 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.

SOFT CONTACT: Average exit velocity off Archer in his first four starts has been just 87.4 mph (down from 92.1 mph in his 6 appearances in 2021), with a hard-hit percentage of 39.5 (50% in 2021).

- Has yielded just 11 hits in 57 at-bats overall (.193).

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Archer signed a one-year contract with Minnesota on March 27...marks his fifth organization (Cleveland 2006-08, Chicago-NL, 2019-10, Tampa Bay 2011-18 and '21) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

- In a Bally Sports North interview, Archer cited his relationship with Twins Manager Rocco Baldelli and Vice President, Baseball Operations Strategy & Innovation Josh Kalk (both of whom were with Tampa Bay's front office and/or coaching staff from 2011-17), Minnesota's catching duo and up-the-middle defense, and positive reviews from one-time Rays teammate and former Twins starter Jake Odorizzi among his many reasons for coming to the Twin Cities.

MEANT TO BE: Upon signing with Minnesota, Archer took to his personal Instagram page to post a photo of himself from his Little League days wearing a Twins uniform...the young, then-outfielder was supporting a blue Twins top with the "M" hat...in his Bally Sports North interview, Archer mentioned being a fan of the Twins' "Soul Patrol" outfielders of Torii Hunter, Jacque Jones and Matt Lawton (and later with Hunter, Jones and Shannon Stewart).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOSH WINDER [2022 SEASON: 1-0, 2.20 ERA // CAREER: 1-0, 2.20 ERA]

Rookie right-hander Josh Winder is due to start tomorrow night's series opener against the Oakland Athletics at Target Field, making his second career start and fifth appearance...earned the win in his last outing on May 1 at Tampa Bay...held the Rays to two hits and one walk over 6.0 scoreless innings, with seven strikeouts in his first career start...became the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) and fifth in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) with at least 6.0 shutout innings and two-or fewer hits allowed in his first career start...also became the first Twins pitcher to win his first career start since Fernando Romero on May 2, 2018...will be facing the A's and the American League West for the first time in his career.

CAREER NOTES

- Twins are his fifth organization, following time with Cleveland (2006-08), Chicago-NL (2009-10), Tampa Bay (2011-18 and 2021) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).
Has recorded double-digit strikeout totals 30 times in career...also boasts three seasons with at least 200.0 innings pitched and 200-plus strikeouts (212.0 IP and 252 K in 2015, 201.1 and 233 in 2016, and 201.0 and 249 in 2017).
Despite spending half of the 2018 season and all of the 2019 campaign in the National League, before missing 2020, he still ranks eighth in the American League with 1044 strikeouts since 2014...is fourth in the Junior Circuit over the same stretch by averaging 10.00 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched.
Missed the 2020 season recovering from thoracic outlet surgery...procedure was performed on June 2, 2020 by Dr. Robert Thompson at Washington University in St. Louis.
Twice named to the American League All-Star Team (2015 and 2017).
Pitched for Team USA in 2017 World Baseball Classic, starting and tossing 4.0 perfect innings with three strikeouts in an eventual 3-2, 10-inning walk-off win over Columbia to open Pool Play...Team USA would go on to win the 2017 WBC.
Led Major League Baseball and tied the Tampa Bay record with 34 starts in 2017.
Posted a Rays-record 252 strikeouts in 2015, second in the AL behind the White Sox' Chris Sale (274) and fourth in the majors...finished the season 12-13, becoming the seventh pitcher in the modern era (since 1900) to record 250 strikeouts without posting a winning record...four of the previous six are Hall of Famers: Nolan Ryan (three times), Steve Carlton, Phil Niekro and Ed Walsh.
Finished fifth in 2015 AL Cy Young Award voting after leading the big leagues and tying Tampa's club mark with 34 starts...also ranked sixth in the AL with a 3.23 ERA.
Finished third in 2013 AL Rookie of the Year balloting...named AL Pitcher of the Month and AL Rookie of the Month for July 2013.
Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 2 prospect in the Rays' system following the 2012 season...was tabbed by the same organization as the top prospect in the Chicago-NL organization following the 2010 campaign.
Originally selected by Cleveland in the fifth round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft...part of multi-player trades to Chicago-NL in December of 2008, to Tampa Bay in January of 2011 and to Pittsburgh at the 2018 Trade Deadline.
