THE TWINS: The Twins completed their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 4-3, going 2-1 in Tampa Bay last weekend followed by going 2-2 at Baltimore this week...tonight, the Twins will begin their longest homestand of the season by playing nine games in 10 days, which includes three against Oakland this weekend, an off-day on Monday, three against Houston from May 10-12 and three against Cleveland from May 13-15.

☞ After starting the season 4-8, the Twins have now won 11 of their last 14 games, with a run differential of +31 (70-39) in those games...since April 21, their 11 wins are tied with New York-AL for most in baseball.

TWINS EXIT BALTIMORE WITH SOUR TASTE: The Twins lost to the Orioles last night at Camden Yards by a score of 5-3, splitting the four-game series...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched with no walks and a season-high six strikeouts...the bullpen allowed three runs on six hits in 4.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded nine hits, including three from Max Kepler, who singled three times...Byron Buxton hit his eighth home run of the season, a 452-foot shot over the bullpens.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have recalled infielder Royce Lewis and right-handed pitcher Cole Sands from Triple-A St. Paul, and returned outfielder/first baseman Alex Kirilloff from rehab and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List.

☞ Lewis, 22, played in 24 games for the Saints this season, hitting .310 (27-for-87) with 11 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 11 RBI, 17 walks, 21 runs scored, a .430 on-base percentage and a .993 OPS...the Aliso Viejo, California native was selected first overall by Minnesota in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft and is currently listed as the top prospect in the Twins organization by MLB.com, as well as the No. 2 prospect by *Baseball America*.

☞ Sands, 24, made his major league debut for the Twins on May 1 at Tampa Bay, tossing 2.0 innings and allowing two runs on three hits, with no walks and two strikeouts.

☞ Kirilloff missed the Twins' last 21 games with right wrist inflammation and hit .227 (5-for-22) with one RBI, six walks, one run scored and a .414 on-base percentage in seven games on rehab assignment with St. Paul.

☞ To make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Jovani Moran to St. Paul, and placed infielder/outfielder Luis Arraez and right-handed pitcher Dylan Bundy on the COVID Injured List.

THE SKIP: Bench coach Jayce Tingler managed for Rocco Baldelli (Covid) last night in Baltimore and will manage tonight...Tingler was the skipper in San Diego for two seasons from 2020-21, compiling a record of 116-106 (.523)...he led the Padres to a .617 winning percentage in 2020 (37-23), the best in franchise history.

ROYCE ROLLS ACROSS THE RIVER: In his last 17 games for Triple-A St. Paul, Royce Lewis has hit .344 (21-for-61) with eight doubles, one triple, two home runs, nine RBI, 13 runs scored, 13 walks, a .453 on-base percentage, a .607 slugging percentage and a 1.060 OPS...over four seasons in the Twins minor league system, he has hit .269 (347-for-1291) with 74 doubles, 11 triples, 33 home runs, 161 RBI, 231 runs scored and 76 stolen bases...he has played in just 24 games since the end of 2019, missing the 2020 season due to the cancellation of the minor league season (COVID) and the 2021 season due to a torn right ACL.

☞ He was selected by Minnesota in the first round (1st overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft...one of three players in club history to be selected first overall, joining catcher Joe Mauer in 2001 and right-handed pitcher Tim Lincecum in 1983 (did not sign).

NOT SO ATHLETIC: The Twins and Athletics are playing the first of six scheduled meetings in 2022...they will travel to Oakland to play a three-game series from May 16-18...last season, the Twins went 1-5 against the A's, going 0-3 at Oakland from April 20-21 and 1-2 at Target Field from May 14-16...the Twins have gone 17-36 vs. the A's since the start of 2013 for a winning percentage of just .321, the Twins' second-lowest winning percentage against any AL team in that span (New York-AL - .283).

TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers began the season hitting .133 (4-for-30) with no extra-base hits, four walks and 10 strikeouts in his first 10 games, through April 21...in nine games since April 22, he is hitting .310 (9-for-29) with four doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, four walks, a .394 on-base percentage and a 1.153 OPS.

MAX HEAT: After starting the season hitting .186 (8-for-43) with a .593 OPS in his first 14 games, Max Kepler has hit .361 (13-for-36) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, six walks, a .452 on-base percentage, a .750 slugging percentage and a 1.202 OPS in his last 11.

☞ Since April 26, he ranks third in the AL in expected slugging percentage at .871 (minimum 100 pitches), trailing Yordan Alvarez (.960) and Aaron Judge (.897)...on the season, he ranks ninth in the AL in expected slugging percentage at .595 (minimum 300 pitches).

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the 12th time (7-4) in 26 games...they are hitting .233 (74-for-317) with 35 walks, 17 doubles and 11 home runs against lefties this season...however, they are hitting .273 (41-for-150) with a .360 on-base percentage in their last 11 vs. lefties.

☞ Individuals vs. lefties: Trevor Larnach is hitting .368 (7-for-19), Gio Urshela is hitting .306 (11-for-36) and Byron Buxton is hitting .292 (7-for-24).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2015, Eddie Rosario homered in his first career at-bat becoming the 11th Twin to homer in his first game as a Twin and sixth to ever homer in his first at-bat as a Twin...he became one of 115 players in MLB history to homer in his first career at-bat and one of 109 players to homer in his first career plate appearance...additionally, he became the 29th player in baseball history to homer on his first-ever pitch seen...in 2021, Nick Gordon made his major league debut vs. Texas, batting seventh and playing second base...he went 1-for-2 with a single, a walk, a strikeout and two stolen bases.

LAST TIME OUT: Winder made his first career major league start on Sunday, May 1 at Tampa Bay...tossed 6.0 shutout innings, giving up only two hits and one walk while striking out seven batters, en route to his first career major league win...Twins scored five runs in the first inning and went on to win, 9-3.

- Winder's seven strikeouts are tied for sixth most in Twins/Senators history in a pitcher's first career start and are the most since Lewis Thorpe also fanned seven on June 30, 2019 at Chicago-AL.
- Became the first Twins pitcher to record a win in his first career start since Fernando Romero on May 2, 2018.
- Is the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) and fifth in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) with at least 6.0 shutout innings and two-or-fewer hits allowed in his first career start...the others are Mike Fornieles on September 2, 1952 (9.0 IP, 1 H, 6 BB, 4 K), Wally Holborow on August 4, 1945 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K), Claude Thomas on September 18, 1916 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 5 BB, 2 K) and George Dumont on September 14, 1915 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 4 BB, 2 K).

2022 SUMMARY: Winder was named to the Twins' Opening Day roster this year, the first of his career...enters today fifth among American League rookie pitchers in innings pitched (16.1).

- Made his major league debut on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL at Target Field...entered the game in the top of the fifth and struck out Will Smith, his first batter faced...walked Cody Bellinger and Chris Taylor, before allowing a run on a Gavin Lux sacrifice fly and getting Mookie Betts to fly out to left to end the inning.
- His second career appearance came on April 16 at Boston, when he entered in the second inning after Sonny Gray departed due to injury...tossed 5.1 innings and permitted two runs on four hits (1 HR), with one walk and two strikeouts...became first Twins rookie to toss at least 5.1 innings in relief since Kohl Stewart (6.0 IP) on September 2, 2018 vs. Detroit...also became the first Twins pitcher to toss at least 5.1 innings in relief within his first two career games since Pat Dean (5.1 IP) on May 16, 2016 at Detroit.
- Winder's third appearance and last before his start was on Sunday, April 24 against the Chicago White Sox at Target Field...entered in the fourth inning and departed after completing the seventh, tossing 4.0 innings and yielding one run on three hits (1 HR - Danny Mendick in 7th), with no walks and a career-high-tying two strikeouts...the Twins won in comeback fashion, 6-4, on Byron Buxton's two-run walk-off home run in the bottom of the 10th inning.
- For a summary of his first career start (4th appearance), please see "LAST TIME OUT" note above.

NEW LEVEL, NEW OPPONENTS: Winder will be facing the Athletics and the American League West for the first time in his career tonight...owns three career appearances (one start) against the American League...is 1-0, 1.76 ERA (15.1 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and 11 strikeouts against the AL.

WHEREVER, WHENEVER: Is making his first career home start and third appearance...owns a 3.60 ERA (5.0 IP, 2 ER) at home and a 1.59 ERA (11.1 IP, 2 ER) in two road appearances (1 start)...posted comparable home/road splits as a starter in the minors, going 7-2, 2.84 ERA (120.1 IP, 38 ER) in 22 career home starts and 7-1, 2.79 ERA (116.0 IP, 36 ER) in 22 career road starts.

THE ARSENAL: Winder has displayed a four-pitch mix in his first four major league appearances, relying primarily on his slider, which he's thrown 39.9 percent of the time...here is a look at the rookie's arsenal this season, per Baseball Savant:

IT'S TIME TO START: Tonight marks Winder's second career major league start...three of his four career outings to date have come in relief...his major league debut on April 12 was his first career professional relief outing - all 44 of his career minor league outings were starts and went 14-3, 2.82 ERA (236.1 IP, 74 ER) with 49 walks and 240 strikeouts over three seasons as a starter in the minors...15 of his 44 starts were quality and recorded eight starts of at least 7.0 innings (including two of 8.0 IP)...also fanned seven-or-more batters in 17 starts, including a career-high nine batters thrice.

SPRING RECAP: Made three Grapefruit League starts for the Twins this year, tossing 8.0 innings and allowing just two earned runs on seven hits and two walks, with nine strikeouts...faced Boston at JetBlue Park on March 23 (2.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K), Pittsburgh at Hammond Stadium on March 30 (3.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K) and pitched again at Boston on April 5 (3.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 K).

- Made his major league debut in a relief appearance for the Twins on April 12, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-NL (1.0 IP, 0 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 1 K).
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.
- In 2021, went a combined 4-0, 2.63 ERA (72.0 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks, 80 strikeouts and a .211 (55-for-261) opponent batting average in 14 starts between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul.
- Selected to the American League team in the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field...tossed 0.1 inning (1 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 K, 1 WP).
- Did not play in a professional game in 2020, as the minor league season was cancelled due to COVID-19...was not part of Twins' 60-man player pool...participated in instructional league in October in Fort Myers, FL.
