THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 4-3 (2-1 in Tampa Bay and 2-2 at Baltimore), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a win over Oakland last night...

YOUTH MOVEMENT AT TARGET FIELD: The Twins beat the A's last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1, marking their third 2-1 victory this season...

THE SONN WILL COME OUT: The Twins announced today that they have returned right-handed pitcher Sonny Gray from rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...

THE SKIP: Bench coach Jayce Tingler managed for Rocco Baldelli (Covid) the last two games (1-1) and will manage today...Tingler was the skipper in San Diego for two seasons from 2020-21...

THAT WAS THEN: Below are hitting and pitching comparisons for the first 12 games and last 15:

NOT SO ATHLETIC: The Twins and Athletics are playing the second of six scheduled meetings in 2022...they will travel to Oakland to play a three-game series from May 16-18...

HOMEGROWN: Eight of the nine players in the Twins lineup were either drafted by the Twins or originally signed as a free agent...below is today's lineup and how each player was acquired.

FOR STARTERS: Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 10-7, 3.12 ERA (130.0 IP, 45 ER) with 32 walks, 122 strikeouts, a .225 opponent batting average and a 1.08 WHIP this season...

TWINS ON TARGET: The Twins have won seven straight at Target Field, their longest home winning streak since September 26, 2018-March 28, 2019 (also 7)...

BYE, BYE, BYRON: Byron Buxton enters today with nine home runs, tied with C.J. Cron, Aaron Judge and Anthony Rizzo for the most in baseball...

MAX HEAT: After starting the season hitting .186 (8-for-43) with a .593 OPS in his first 14 games, Max Kepler has hit .325 (13-for-40) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, six walks, a .413 on-base percentage, a .675 slugging percentage and a 1.088 OPS in his last 12.

FIREMEN: In their last 10 games, the bullpen has combined to go 3-1, 1.47 ERA (36.2 IP, 6 ER) with opponents hitting .185 (24-for-130), nine extra-base hits (5 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs), five walks, 40 strikeouts, seven holds and three saves.

AND I WAS LIKE, EMILIOOOOOOO!: Twins reliever Emilio Pagán is celebrating his 31st birthday today...he has appeared in one game in his career on his birthday, coming in 2019, pitching 1.0 perfect inning with three strikeouts against Arizona (with Tampa Bay).

ON THIS DAY...: In 2012, Brian Dozier made his major league debut against the Los Angeles Angels, going 1-for-4 with a run scored...Dozier went on to play 955 career games with the Twins, hitting 167 home runs, the ninth most in club history (since 1961).

THIS AND THAT: Jorge Polanco has hit safely in a season-long seven straight games...the streak is tied with Carlos Correa (4/28-5/4) for longest on the team this season. Twins outfielders have eight outfield assists, second-most in baseball, trailing Cleveland (11).

WELCOME BACK: Has returned from rehab and reinstated from the 10-day IL today after suffering from low grade right hamstring strain on April 16...made one start with Single-A Fort Myers, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings, allowing just one hit with five strikeouts on May 1.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his second start and first road start of the season in Boston...suffered his first loss of the season after going just 1.2 innings, allowed two runs on one hit, with one walk and one strikeout in a 4-0 Twins defeat...left in the second inning with two outs after feeling discomfort in his right hamstring...ended up on the 10-Day injured list on April 17 with a strained right hamstring.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his season and Twins debut on April 9 vs. Seattle at Target Field in a 4-3 Twins loss...did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings...the first run came on a Ty France two-out RBI double in the third; the second on a Tom Murphy solo homer with one out in the fifth...Gray departed with a runner on first and two outs in the fifth inning; Caleb Thielbar entered the game and stranded the inherited runner.

AGAINST THE A'S: Will be making his third career start against his former team...is 0-1, 7.71 ERA (9.1 IP, 8 ER) with eight walks and five strikeouts in two career starts...his last start against the green and gold came on May 8, 2019 (with Cincinnati), went 4.1 innings, allowing four runs (3 earned), with five walks and three strikeouts in a 5-4 Reds defeat...spent his first five seasons of his career with the Athletics, making 114 appearances (112 starts), went 44-36, 3.42 ERA (705.0 IP, 268 ER), with 225 walks, 607 strikeouts and a .648 opponent OPS.

☞ Represented the Athletics when he was selected to the 2015 All-Star game in Cincinnati...also ranked third in CY Young votes in 2015, going 14-7, 2.73 ERA (208.0 IP, 64 ER), with 57 walks, 153 strikeouts and a 1.20 WHIP.

HOME/AWAY: Is making his second start at Target Field field this season...is currently 1-3, 3.90 ERA (30.0 IP, 13 ER) with 18 walks and 26 strikeouts in seven career starts in Minnesota...has shown consistent numbers when at home and on the road, going 46-36, 3.96 ERA (665.1 IP, 293 ER) with 224 walks and 637 strikeouts in 118 appearances (113 starts) at home...is 36-27, 3.24 ERA (608.1 IP, 219 ER), with 232 walks and 599 strikeouts in 108 appearances (103 starts) on the road.

ITS A SONNY DAY ISN'T IT: In his career, Gray is 30-26, 3.39 ERA (469.1 IP, 177 ER) when pitching in day games...is slightly not as sharp in night games, going 52-47, 3.75 ERA (804.1 IP, 335 ER). ☞ Gray is 1-3, 3.26 ERA (30.1 IP, 11 ER) with eight walks and 30 strikeouts in his last six day starts, dating back to August 26, 2021.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and threw five of them in his first start of the season (minus the changeup), per Baseball Savant...all four of his strikeouts in his first start of the season came on his sinker...here's a look at his repertoire.

- Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

- ☞ Recorded a season-high five-game winning streak from July 30-September 1...went 5-0, 2.89 ERA (43.2 IP, 14 ER) and a .225 opponent batting average during the streak...was one win shy of tying his single-season career high (6-0, June 18-July 26, 2014).
- ☞ Led the Reds pitching staff (min. 50.0 IP) in opponent batting average (.225), opponent OPS (.687) and WHIP (1.22).
- ☞ Made his 200th career start on July 7 at Kansas City, becoming the 36th active pitcher with 200 career starts, the 23rd active right-hander.
- ☞ Missed time on the 10-day Injured List three times last season: April 1-17 (back spasms), June 9-July 2 (right groin strain) and July 2-18 (strained rib cage).

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: Last season, Gray posted a .239 opponent average (66-for-276) with 22 walks and 75 strikeouts against right-handed hitters...had a .208 batting average (49-for-236) with 28 walks and 80 strikeouts to lefties.

- Overall is 2-0, 1.98 ERA (27.1 IP, 6 ER) with three walks, 34 strikeouts & seven holds in last seven games...recorded 3.0 scoreless innings last night, allowing a hit, two walks with three strikeouts.
- Went 1-2, 3.10 ERA (20.1 IP, 7 ER) with 11 walks and 25 strikeouts in six games vs. OAK in 2021...1-1, 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP, 2 ER) with five walks and 15 strikeouts vs. OAK at Target Field in 2021.
