THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 4-3 (2-1 in Tampa Bay and 2-2 at Baltimore), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a win over Oakland last night.... Oday, the Twins will play the second of three against the A's...after this series, the Twins will enjoy an off-day on Monday, then play three against Houston from Tuesday-Thursday and three against Cleveland next weekend.
© After starting the season 4-8, the Twins have now won 12 of their last 15 games, with a run differential of +32 (72-40) in those games...since April 21 , their 12 wins lead baseball.
YOUTH MOVEMENT AT TARGET FIELD: The Twins beat the A's last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1, marking their third 2-1 victory this season and their fifth one-run win (5-3). Josh Winder ( $2-0$ ) was the starter and winner, allowing one unearned run on three hits, with no walks and eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, walked four times, left 10 men on base and went 0 -for-10 with runners in scoring position...Royce Lewis made his major league debut, recording his first hit, singling off Kirby Snead in the eighth inning...Jose Miranda hit his first career home run and Byron Buxton hit his ninth homer of the season
THE SONN WILL COME OUT: The Twins announced today that they have returned right-handed pitcher Sonny Gray from rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List... Gray, who missed the Twins' last 19 games with a low grade right hamstring strain, made one start on rehab assignment with Low-A Fort Myers on May 1, pitching 3.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed and five strikeouts...Gray weni 1 -1, 5.08 BRA ( Gray is 4 ER), three walks and tive strikeouts prior to exiting his start on April 16 at Boston.... Gray is scheduled to make the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Cole Sands to Triple-A St. Paul...Sands was recalled prior to yesterday's game against the Athletics and did not appear in a game.

THE SKIP: Bench coach Jayce Tingler managed for Rocco Baldelli (Covid) the last two games (1-1) and will manage today....ingler was the skipper in San Diego for two seasons from 202021, compiling a record of 116-106 (.523)...he led the Padres to a .617 winning percentage in
2020 (37-23), the best in franchise history.

NOT SO ATHLETIC: The Twins and Athletics are playing the second of six scheduled meetings in 2022...they will travel to 0akland to play a three-game series from May 16-18...last season Field from May 14-16. the Twins have gone 18-36 vs. the A's since the start of 2013 for a winning percentage of just .333 , the Twins' second-lowest winning percentage against any AL team in that span (New York- AL - .283).

FOR STARTERS: Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 10-7, 3.12 ERA (130.0 IP, 45 ER) with 32 walks, 122 strikeouts, a 225 opponent batting average and a 1.08 WHIP this season...among all MLB teams, they rank sixth in ERA and WHIP, 10th in opponent OPS (.657) and 11th in opponents batting average.

TWINS ON TARGET: The Twins have won seven straight at Target Field, their longest home winning streak since September 26, 2018-March 28, 2019 (also 7)...their last seven-game home winning streak in a single season was August 3-17, 2018 (also 7)...their last eightgame home winning streak came July 21-August 18, 2010, when they won nine straight....additionally, their nine home wins are tied for sixth-most in baseball.

BYE, BYE, BYRON: Byron Buxton enters today with nine home runs, tied with C.J. Cron, Aaron Judge and Anthony Rizzo for the most in baseball...since August 6, 2020 , he has 41 home runs in 110 games...since that date, he has a 10.12 at-bats-per-home run ratio, which leads baseball (minimum 400 AB's)...additionally, his . 754 slugging percentage leads baseball (minimum 50 AB 's), he ranks third in average exit velocity ( 96.4 mph ) and fifth in barrel-per-plate appearance percentage ( $15.8 \%$ ).
MAX HEAT: After starting the season hitting. 186 ( 8 -for- 43 ) with a .593 OPS in his first 14 games, Max Kepler has hit 325 ( 13 -for-40) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, six walks, a 413 on-base percentage, a .675 slugging percentage and a 1.088 OPS in his last 12
FIREMEN: In their last 10 games, the bullpen has combined to go 3-1, 1.47 ERA (36.2 IP, 6 ER ) with opponents hitting 185 (24-for-130), nine extra-base hits ( 5 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs), five walks, 40 strikeouts, seven holds and three saves.

AND I WAS LIKE, EMILIOOOOOOOO!: Twins reliever Emilio Pagán is celebrating his 31st birthday today...he has appeared in one game in his career on his birthday, coming in 2019, pitching 1.0 pertect inning with three strikeouts against Arrizona (with Tampa Bay).

ON THIS DAY.... In 2012, Brian Dozier made his major league debut against the Los Angeles Angels, going 1-for-4 with a run scored. Dozier went on to play 955 career games with the Twins, hitting 167 home runs, the ninth most in club history (since 1961).

WELCOME BACK：Has returned from rehab and reinstated from the 10－day IL today after suffering from low grade right hamstring strain on April 16．．．made one start with Single－A Fort Myers，tossing 3.0 scoreless innings，allowing just one hit with five strikeouts on May 1

LAST TIME OUT：Made his second start and first road start of the season in Boston．．．suffered his first loss of the season after going just 1，2 innings，allowed two runs on one hit，with one walk and one strikeouts in a 4－0 Twins defeat．．．left in the second inning with two outs after feeling discomfort in his right hamstring．．．ended up on the 10－Day injured list on April 17 with a strained right hamstring．

TWO STARTS AGO：Made his season and Twins debut on April 9 vs．Seattle at Target Field in a 4－3 Twins loss．．．did not factor into the decision after allowing two runs on four hits（1 HR），with two walks and four strikeouts in 4.2 innings．．．the first run came on a Ty France two－0ut RBI double in the third； the second on a Tom Murphy solo homer with one out in the fifth．．．Gray departed with a runner on first and two outs in the fifth inning；Caleb Thielbar entered the game and stranded the inherited runner．

AGAINST THE A＇S：Will be making his third career start against his former team．．．is 0－1，7．71 ERA（9．1 IP， 8 ER）with eight walks and five strikeouts in two career starts．．．his last start against the green and gold came on May 8， 2019 （with Cincinatti），went 4.1 innings，allowing four runs（3 earned）， with five walks and three strikeouts in a 5－4 Reds defeat．．．spent his first five seasons of his career with the Athletics，making 114 appearances（ 112 starts），went 44－36，3．42 ERA（705．0 IP， 268 ER）， with 225 walks， 607 strikeouts and a .648 opponent OPS
क Represented the Athletics when he was selected to the 2015 All－Star game in Cincinnati． also ranked third in CY Young votes in 2015，going 14－7， 2.73 ERA（208．0 IP， 64 ER），with 57 walks， 153 strikeouts and a 1.20 WHIP

HOME／AWAY：Is making his second start at Target Field field this season．．．is currently 1－3，3．90 ERA （ 30.0 IP， 13 ER）with 18 walks and 26 strikeouts in seven career starts in Minnesota．．．has shown consistent numbers when at home and on the road，going 46－36， 3.96 ERA（665．1 IP， 293 ER）with 224 walks and 637 strikeouts in 118 appearances（ 113 starts）at home．．．is 36－27， 3.24 ERA（ 608.1 IP， 219 ER），with 232 walks and 599 strikeouts in 108 appearances（ 103 starts）on the road．

ITS A SONNY DAY ISN＇T IT：In his career，Gray is 30－26， 3.39 ERA（469．1 IP， 177 ER）when pitching in day games．．．is slightly not as sharp in night games，going 52－47，3．75 ERA（804．1 IP， 335 ER）． $\Phi$ Gray is $1-3,3.26$ ERA（ $30.1 \mathrm{IP}, 11 \mathrm{ER}$ ）with eight walks and 30 strikeouts in his last six day starts，dating back to August 26， 2021.

THE ARSENAL：Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and threw five of them in his first start of the season（minus the changeup），per Baseball Savant．．．all four of his strikeouts in his first start of the season came on his sinker．．．here＇s a look at his repertoire．
