THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 4-3 (2-1 in Tampa Bay and 2-2 at Baltimore), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day homestand with consecutive wins over the A's the last two days...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale against Oakland...the Twins will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then play three against Houston from Tuesday-Thursday and three against Cleveland next weekend.

☞ After starting the season 4-8, the Twins have now won 13 of their last 16 games, with a run differential of +33 (73-40) in those games...since April 21, their 13 wins lead baseball.

SOLO POLO, TWINS TAKE THE A's: The Twins beat the Athletics yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 1-0, marking their sixth one-run victory (6-3) this season...a Jorge Polanco sixth inning solo home run was the difference in the game; it was the 24th time in club history (since 1961) that the Twins won a 1-0 game on a solo homer, first since August 11, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL (Polanco off José Ruiz)...Sonny Gray was the starter, returning from the 10-day Injured List (low grade right hamstring strain), pitching 4.0 shutout innings with a season-high seven strikeouts...Polanco finished the day with three of the five Twins hits, adding a double and a single to his homer.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed outfielder Trevor Larnach on the 10-day Injured List (retroactive to May 7) with a right adductor strain...Larnach played in 22 games for the Twins this season, hitting .313 (21-for-67) with nine doubles, seven RBI, 12 runs scored, six walks, a .365 on-base percentage and an .813 OPS...to replace Larnach on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled catcher José Godoy from Triple-A St. Paul...the 27-year-old has played in eight games for the Saints this season, hitting .241 (7-for-29) with one double, three RBI, five runs scored, three walks and a .313 on-base percentage...this is Godoy's second stint with the Twins this season, after being with the club from April 23-May 1 and playing in one game, April 24 vs. the Chicago White Sox (0-for-3, two walks, two runs scored).

THE SKIP: Bench coach Jayce Tingler has managed for Rocco Baldelli (COVID) the last three games (2-1) and will manage today...Tingler was the skipper in San Diego for two seasons from 2020-21, compiling a record of 116-106 (.523)...he led the Padres to a .617 winning percentage in 2020 (37-23), the best in franchise history.

NOT SO ATHLETIC: The Twins and Athletics are playing the third of six scheduled meetings in 2022...the Twins will travel to Oakland to play a three-game series from May 16-18...the Twins have gone 19-36 vs. the A's since the start of 2013 for a winning percentage of just .345, the Twins' second-lowest winning percentage against any AL team in that span (New York-AL - .283).

☞ Yesterday's victory secured the Twins' first series win over the A's since May 2-4, 2017, when they took two of three at Target Field.

☞ The Twins are looking to win three straight over the A's for the first time since taking four straight from July 5, 2016-May 3, 2017.

HE'S GOING THE DISTANCE: After Jorge Polanco's 451-foot home run into the Delta SKY360° Suite yesterday afternoon, the Twins now lead baseball with four home runs hit 450-plus feet: Byron Buxton 469 feet on April 24 vs. Chicago-AL off Liam Hendriks, Carlos Correa 458 feet on April 10 vs. Seattle off Yohan Ramirez and Buxton 452 feet on May 5 at Baltimore off Spenser Watkins...the Twins have an average home run distance of 406 feet, ranking fourth in baseball, trailing Colorado (413), Washington (409) and Miami (407).

☞ All-time list of home runs hit into the centerfield suite to the right.

TWINS ON TARGET: The Twins have won eight straight at Target Field, their longest home winning streak since July 21-August 18, 2010, when they won nine straight...additionally, their 10 home wins are tied for second-most in baseball with four other teams (Colorado leads with 11).

BUST OUT THE BROOMS: The Twins are seeking their third sweep of the season today...their other two sweeps were April 22-24 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games) and April 26-28 vs. Detroit (3 games)...they swept opponents four times last season: May 24-26 vs. Baltimore in three games, June 18-20 at Texas in three games, July 8-11 vs. Detroit in four games and September 21-22 at Chicago-NL in two games...the Twins' last sweep of the A's came in three games at Target Field from May 28-30, 2012.

PITCHING IN: Twins pitchers have combined to post a 3.11 ERA this season, the fifth-best in baseball...they have also struck out 252 batters, tied for fifth-most in baseball.

☞ In their last 11 games, the bullpen has combined to go 4-1, 1.30 ERA (41.2 IP, 6 ER) with opponents hitting .171 (25-for-146), with 10 extra-base hits (6 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs), six walks, 48 strikeouts, seven holds and four saves.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Low-A Fort Myers infielder Noah Miller and High-A Cedar Rapids left-handed pitcher Brent Headrick are the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Miller, 19, played in five games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .556 (10-for-18) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, three RBI, four runs scored, four walks, a .636 on-base percentage, a .636 slugging percentage and a 1.581 OPS...the Fredonia, Wisconsin native was selected by the Twins in the first round (36th overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Ozaukee High School.

☞ Headrick, 24, made one start for the Kernels on Wednesday vs. Quad Cities, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, one walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts...the Braidwood, Illinois native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Illinois State University.

WORD TO YOU MOTHER: The Twins were rained out on Mother's Day in 2021 and did not play a Mother's Day game in 2020 (COVID)...the Twins' last game on Mother's Day game was in 2019, losing to Detroit by a score of 5-3...the Twins last win on Mother's Day came in 2014 when a Ron Gardenhire-led Twins team beat Detroit at Comerica Park by a score of 4-3...the club is 26-35 all-time on Mother's Day (since '61)...Samuel Deduno was the Twins starter, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched as today's Bally Sports North pregame analyst Glen Perkins earned his 10th save...the Twins lineup that day: 1) 2B Brian Dozier, 2) DH Joe Mauer, 3) 3B Trevor Plouffe, 4) 1B Chris Colabello, 5) C Josphil Pinto, 6) LF Eduardo Núñez, 7) RF Chris Parmelee, 8) CF Aaron Hicks, 9) SS Eduardo Escobar.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win of the season after tossing 5.1 innings on May 2 against Baltimore at Oriole Park at Camden Yards; the Twins won, 2-1...allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...Baltimore's lone run came in the fifth inning after Paddack gave up a leadoff triple to Rougned Odor, followed by Ramón Urías' sacrifice fly...the Twins scored one in the top of the sixth inning on a Carlos Correa RBI single to retake the lead and put Paddack in line for the win. ☞ Is 1-0, 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in his last two starts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision after tossing 5.2 innings in his third start of the season on April 26 against Detroit at Target Field; the Twins won, 5-4...he allowed one run on five hits, one walk and a season-high six strikeouts...marked his longest outing of the season and his most strikeouts since July 27, 2021 vs. Oakland (also six)...also marked his first start of the season where he received any run support...threw 87 pitches, the third-most pitches thrown by a Twins starting pitcher this season.

FACING THE A'S: Today marks Paddack's third career start and appearance against the Athletics...he is 1-1, 5.91 ERA (10.2 IP, 7 ER) in his two prior starts...earned the win in his last start vs. Oakland on July 27, 2021 in an 7-4 Padres victory (6.0 IP, 9 H, 3 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K)...first start came on September 5, 2020 at Oakland as the Padres lost, 8-4...Paddack tossed 4.2 innings (7 H, 4 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K) and took the loss in the contest.

☞ Has faced the AL West nine times in his career (all starts), most recently on September 5, 2021 vs. Houston (ND, 6.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R/ER, 0 BB, 0 K) as the Padres won, 4-3...last win came on July 27, 2021, a 7-4 victory over Oakland (W, 6.0 IP, 9 H, 3 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K)...is 4-2, 3.73 ERA (50.2 IP, 21 ER) with 11 walks and 45 strikeouts in his nine career starts against the AL West.

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME: Paddack is slated to make his third home start of the season and 32nd appearance (31st start) of his career...made his Target Field debut on April 13, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-NL (L, 4.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R/ER, 0 BB, 3 K) as the Twins fell 7-0 to the Dodgers...also started on April 26 against Detroit (ND, 5.2 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K) in the 5-4 Twins victory.

☞ Is 12-10, 4.20 ERA (156.1 IP, 73 ER) with 146 hits allowed, 32 walks and 160 strikeouts at his home ballpark...those numbers shift slightly to 9-11, 4.09 ERA (171.2 IP, 78 ER) with 156 hits allowed, 35 walks and 166 strikeouts in 34 career starts on the road.

☞ Most recent win at home came on July 27, 2021 vs. Oakland in the 7-4 Padres win (W, 6.0 IP, 9 H, 3 R/ER, 1 BB, 6 K).

IT'S A BEAUTIFUL DAY: Making his second start in a day game this season...first came on April 13 vs. Los Angeles-NL at Target Field (L, 4.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R/ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...the Twins were shut out, 7-0, and held to just one hit...Los Angeles-NL starting pitcher Clayton Kershaw tossed 7.0 perfect innings and struck out 13 batters.

☞ Most of his career starts have come in night games...is 16-15, 4.23 ERA (242.1 IP, 114 ER) in 47 career night starts, compared to a 5-6 record, 3.89 ERA (85.2 IP, 37 ER) in 18 career day appearances (17 starts).

☞ Most recent day game win was on July 21, 2021 at Atlanta (W, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 K)...Padres won, 3-2

THE ARSENAL: Paddack has displayed a four-pitch mix in his first four starts this season, relying primarily on his four-seam fastball, which he's thrown 51.3 percent of the time...here is a look at his full arsenal this season, per Baseball Savant:
