THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 4-3 (2-1 against the Tigers and 2-2 against the Royals)...

The Twins are one of three teams to reach the 30-win mark in the AL...the Yankees (34) and Astros (32) are the others.

TWINS SPLIT THE DAY IN DETROIT: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon in game one of the doubleheader at Comerica Park by a score of 8-2...

FRESH MEN: The Twins bullpen pitched 6.1 scoreless innings yesterday...they used just four relievers on the day: Griffin Jax (2.1 IP), Juan Minaya (2.0), Jovani Moran (1.0) and Caleb Thielbar (1.0)...

STARTING UP SUMMER: The Twins finished May with a record of 18-12, the third-most wins in the AL and fifth-most in baseball...18 wins were their most in a single month since going 18-9 in September of 2019...

ADDITIONALLY: Last June, the Twins hit .258 (222-for-859) with 38 doubles, 43 home runs, 117 runs scored, a .317 on-base percentage, a .464 slugging percentage and a .782 OPS...

THE MONTH OF LUEY: Luis Arraez finished the month of May by hitting .376 (32-for-85) with 16 walks, a .480 on-base percentage and a .892 OPS in 23 games.

ADDITIONALLY: Arraez entered yesterday's doubleheader with a .395 average and went 2-for-9 on the day, landing at .376 and 14 points from finishing .400...

KING LUEY: Luis Arraez is hitting .351 (52-for-148), the third-highest average in the AL, trailing only J.D. Martinez (.363) and Tim Anderson (.356)...

Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .400 (30-for-75) with 14 walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a .940 OPS in 19 games.

TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 10th of 19 meetings in 2022...Twins are 6-3 against Detroit this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 1-2 at Comerica Park.

The Twins have won 23 of their last 35 over the Tigers and 28 of their last 43.

Jorge Polanco is hitting .297 (106-for-357) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 54 RBI, 27 walks and an .818 OPS in 92 career games against the Tigers...

Gio Urshela is hitting .330 (33-for-100) with six doubles, two home runs, 15 RBI, 10 walks and a .396 on-base percentage in 33 career games vs. Detroit...he is 13-for-29 (.448) with three walks and a .500 on-base percentage in eight games against the Tigers this season.

LEFT SIDE IS OUR BEST SIDE: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the 17th time (10-6) in 51 games...they are hitting .254 (125-for-493) with 55 walks, 29 doubles and 13 home runs against lefties this season...

Individuals vs. lefties: Kyle Garlick is hitting .308 (8-for-26) with three home runs and four walks...Trevor Larnach is hitting .400 (10-for-25) with five doubles and four walks...

G-10 FORCE: Gio Urshela is hitting .333 (19-for-57) with two doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, six walks, a .391 on-base percentage, a .579 slugging percentage and a .970 OPS in his last 16 games, since May 14...

LARNACH ON WOOD: Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (21-for-63) with nine doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, 15 runs scored, 10 walks, a .419 on-base percentage, a .619 slugging percentage and a 1.038 OPS in his last 20 games...

- ☞ Making his seventh start and appearance of the season...also 27th career start and appearance.
- ☞ Making his second start of the season and fourth of his career against Detroit...did not factor into the decision in his first start vs. the Tigers this season on April 28 (3.2 IP, 6 H, 1 R/ER 2 BB, 3 K), as he exited early due to right groin tightness...has gone 1-0, 4.85 ERA (13.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts in his three prior starts.
- ☞ Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his second-straight start against the Royals on May 27 as the Twins won, 10-7...tossed 3.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits, with one walk and five strikeouts...marked his shortest start of the year (previously 3.2 innings vs. Detroit on April 28 when he exited the game with right groin tightness).

- ☞ His five strikeouts were his second most this season, trailing his six strikeouts on April 22 vs. Chicago-AL.
- ☞ Marked just the second time this season he allowed more than two earned runs in a start (allowed 4 earned runs on April 10 vs. Seattle).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision at Kansas City on May 22 after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in his fifth start this season...departed with the Twins trailing 1-0; Minnesota scored five runs in the eighth and two more in the ninth to win, 7-6.

- ☞ Marked his first start after returning from the 10-day Injured List with a right groin strain...was removed from his start vs. Detroit on April 28 and placed on the 10-day Injured List on April 30...made a rehab start in Triple-A St. Paul on May 15 at Columbus and covered 5.0 innings, allowing five runs (4 earned) on four hits (1 HR), with no walks and seven strikeouts.

TAMER OF TIGERS: Is slated to start against Detroit for the second time this season and fourth time in his career...did not factor into the decision in his prior start this season against the Tigers on April 28 at Target Field in the Twins' 7-1 victory...is 1-0, 4.85 ERA (13.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts in his three career starts against Detroit.

- ☞ Has started once at Comerica Park on August 30, 2021 (Twins won, 3-2)...earned the win after tossing 6.0 innings...yielded two runs on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts.

RAMBLIN' MAN: Two of Ober's six starts this season have come away from Target Field and he has given up only one earned run on the road...is 0-1, 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, 1 ER) in away games...took the loss on April 17 at Boston, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing two unearned runs as the Twins fell, 8-1...did not factor into the decision on May 22 at Kansas City as the Twins won, 7-6...is 1-0, 4.86 ERA (16.2 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 18 strikeouts at Target Field this season.

- ☞ Has gone 1-3, 3.58 ERA (55.1 IP, 22 ER) with 10 walks and 54 strikeouts in 12 career road starts...numbers flip to 3-1, 4.31 ERA (64.2 IP, 31 ER) with 16 walks and 67 strikeouts in 14 career starts at Target Field, in comparison.

ACQUAINTED WITH THE NIGHT: Will be making his third start under the lights this season, after going 0-0, 4.50 ERA (8.0 IP, 4 ER) with one walk and 11 strikeouts in his two prior night starts...compares to 1-1, 2.75 ERA (19.2 IP, 6 ER) in four day game starts...has been slightly better in night starts throughout his career, going 2-2, 3.82 ERA (63.2 IP, 27 ER) with 12 walks and 73 strikeouts in 14 night starts...is a career 2-2, 4.15 ERA (56.1 IP, 26 ER) with 14 walks and 48 strikeouts in 12 day starts.

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Ober's pitch selection in his first six starts this season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his 4-seam fastball and slider.

LEFT AND RIGHT: Is holding opposing right-handed hitters to a .213 (13-for-61) batting average, two doubles, one triple, two home runs and a .234 on-base percentage this season...opposing lefties are batting .304 (14-for-46) with two doubles and a .365 on-base percentage against him.

- ☞ When looking at his career numbers, right-handed hitters have a .230 (59-for-257) batting average and lefties are hitting .291 (60-for-206).

KEEP UP THE TEMPO: Has an average pitch tempo of 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant...is the fastest worker on the Twins with the bases empty, followed by Dylan Bundy (15.9 seconds)...works 2.4 seconds faster than the league average of 18.2 seconds.

- ☞ His pitch tempo increases to 24.2 seconds when there are runners on base, the sixth fastest worker for the Twins.

TWO STRIKES, YOU'RE GOING TO BE OUT: Has been very effective when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .173 (9-for-52) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .212 (54-for-255) mark in his career.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10-straight starts from July 20-September 12, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span...span included his two quality starts on the season, August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 3 R/ER) and August 30 at Detroit (6.0 IP, 2 ER).

- ☞ Posted a 5.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the highest single-season mark by a Twins/Senators rookie pitcher (min. 70.0 IP), and tops among all major league rookies last season (also min. 70.0 IP).
- ☞ Struck out a career-high seven batters in third start on June 11 vs. Houston (5.0 IP)...matched career high two more times: July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP) and August 25 at Boston (5.0 IP).
- ☞ Named the 2021 winner of the Bill Boni Award for Twins minor league Player of the Year.

HEY, ROOKIE! YOU WERE GOOD: Ober's 20 starts in 2021 marked the most by a Twins rookie since Adalberto Mejia had 21 in 2017, while his 96 strikeouts were the most since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...96 strikeouts also matched Nick Blackburn (2008) and Gerry Arrigo (1964) for 10th most in a single season by a Minnesota rookie...ranked sixth among American League rookies in ERA (minimum 90.0 IP) and 12th in innings pitched (92.1).

AND ALL'S FAIR IN LOVE AND WAR: Posted a 1.1 WAR in 2021, per Baseball Reference...became the first Twins rookie pitcher to surpass 1.0 WAR in a single season since Tyler Duffey in 2015 (1.6 WAR).

CAREER NOTES

- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks, 117 strikeouts and a .252 opponent batting average in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week for Fort Myers on April 14 and Southern League Pitcher of the Week for Pensacola on September 2.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston for the 2017 season.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John Surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.

Right-handed pitcher Chris Archer is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the Detroit Tigers...took the loss in his last start on May 28 vs. Kansas City after pitching 4.0 innings and allowing five runs (3 earned) on seven hits, with no walks and one strikeout...tomorrow will be his second start against the Tigers this season after also facing Detroit at Target Field on May 23 (ND, 4.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K)...is 2-3, 3.57 ERA (63.0 IP, 25 ER) in his 12 career games (all starts) against Detroit.

- ☞ In nine games vs. DET this season 'pen has gone 3-2-2, 2.67 ERA (30.1 IP, 9 ER) with 11 walks, 30 strikeouts, five holds & an opponent batting average of .230 (26-for-113).
