tonight, they will play the fourth of five games at Comerica Parkafter tomorrow afternoon's
series finale, the Twins will travel to Toronto to play three against the Blue Jays over the
weekendthe Twins are 17-11 at home and 13-10 on the road.
The Twins are one of three teams to reach the 30 win mark in the 11 the Vankees (31)

eams to reach the 30-win mark in the AL...the Yankees (3 and Astros (32) are the others.

TWINS SPLIT THE DAY IN DETROIT: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon in game one of the doubleheader at Comerica Park by a score of 8-2, but were shut out 4-0 in game two...Devin Smeltzer (2-0) was the starter and winner in game one, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.2 innings pitched, with no walks and four strikeouts...Max Kepler went 3-for-4 and drove in three runs in the first game...in game two, Cole Sands (0-1) served as the club's 27th man and made the start, allowing four runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched and was dealt the loss...the offense recorded just three hits and were shutout for the sixth time this season...Jermaine Palacios, who made his major league debut in game one, also started in game two and recorded his first major league hit, singling off Joey Wentz in the third inning.

FRESH MEN: The Twins bullpen pitched 6.1 scoreless innings yesterday...they used just four relievers on the day: Griffin Jax (2.1 IP), Juan Minaya (2.0), Jovani Moran (1.0) and Caleb Thielbar (1.0)...Tyler Duffey, Jhoan Duran, Trevor Megill, Emilio Pagán and Joe Smith all did not pitch.

▼ Duran enters today with a 9.2-scoreless inning streak, tied for eighth longest active streak in the AL.

STARTING UP SUMMER: The Twins finished May with a record of 18-12, the third-most wins in the AL and fifth-most in baseball...18 wins were their most in a single month since going 18-9 in September of 2019...it marked their most wins in May since going 21-8 in 2019... below are the offense and pitching comparisons for April and May:

highest single-month mark by a Twins hitter (min. 80 AB) since Mauer hit .380 in August 2010

KING LUEY: Luis Arraez is hitting .351 (52-for-148), the third-highest average in the AL, trailing only J.D. Martinez (.363) and Tim Anderson (.356)...additionally, he has posted a .442 on-base percentage, the highest in baseball.

© Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .400 (30-for-75) with 14 walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a .940 OPS in 19 games.

TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 10th of 19 meetings in 2022...Twins are 6-3 against Detroit this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 1-2 at Comerica Park.

♣ The Twins have won 23 of their last 35 over the Tigers and 28 of their last 43.

♣ Jorge Polanco is hitting .297 (106-for-357) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 54 RBI, 27 walks and an .818 OPS in 92 career games against the Tigers...he has reached base safely in 23 of his last 24 Detroit...Polanco is hitting .309 (55-for-178) with six home runs, 13 walks, a .359 on-base percentage and an .825 OPS in 46 career games at Comerica.

♣ Gio Urshela is hitting .330 (33-for-100) with six doubles, two home runs, 15 RBI, 10 walks and a .396 on-base percentage in 33 career games vs. Detroit...he is 13-for-29 (.448) with three walks and a .500 on-base percentage in eight games against the Tigers this season

LEFT SIDE IS OUR BEST SIDE: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter today for the 17th time (10-6) in 51 games...they are hitting .254 (125-for-493) with 55 walks, 29 doubles and 13 home runs against lefties this season...however, in 23 games in May, the Twins hit .277 (65-for-235) with a .355 on-base percentage, the second-highest average in the AL and fourth best in baseball, trailing Boston (.308), Colorado (.301) and St. Louis (.281).

▼ Individuals vs. lefties: Kyle Garlick is hitting .308 (8-for-26) with three home runs and four walks...Trevor Larnach is hitting .400 (10-for-25) with five doubles and four walks...Larnach's mark leads all left-handed batters this season (min. 25 at-bats).

G-IO FORCE: Gio Urshela is hitting .333 (19-for-57) with two doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, six walks, a .391 on-base percentage, a .579 slugging percentage and a .970 OPS in his last 16 games, since May 14...since that date, he is tied for third in the AL in RBI, while tied for ninth in batting average and 11th in OPS.

LARNACH ON WOOD: Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (21-for-63) with nine doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, 15 runs scored, 10 walks, a .419 on-base percentage, a .619 slugging percentage and a 1.038 OPS in his last 20 games...additionally, he has reached safely in 13 of his last 25 plate appearances (.520 OBP).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his second-straight start against the Royals on May 27 as the Twins won, 10-7...tossed 3.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits, with one walk and five strikeouts...marked his shortest start of the year (previously 3.2 innings vs. Detroit on April 28 when he exited the game with right groin tightness).

- This five strikeouts were his second most this season, trailing his six strikeouts on April 22 vs. Chicago-AL
- ₱ Marked just the second time this season he allowed more than two earned runs in a start (allowed 4 earned runs on April 10 vs. Seattle).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision at Kansas City on May 22 after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in his fifth start this season... departed with the Twins trailing 1-0; Minnesota scored five runs in the eighth and two more in the

TAMER OF TIGERS: Is slated to start against Detroit for the second time this season and fourth time in his career...did not factor into the decision in his prior start this season against the Tigers on April 28 at Target Field in the Twins' 7-1 victory...is 1-0, 4.85 ERA (13.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts in his three career starts against Detroit.

4 Has started once at Comerica Park on August 30, 2021 (Twins won, 3-2)...earned the win after tossing 6.0 innings...yielded two runs on five hits, with no walks and five strikeouts.

RAMBLIN' MAN: Two of Ober's six starts this season have come away from Target Field and he has given up only one earned run on the road...is 0-1, 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, 1 ER) in away games...took the loss on April 17 at Boston, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing two unearned runs as the Twins fell, 8-1...did not factor into the decision on May 22 at Kansas City as the Twins won, 7-6...is 1-0, 4.86 ERA (16.2 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 18 strikeouts at Target Field this season.

◆ Has gone 1-3, 3.58 ERA (55.1 IP, 22 ER) with 10 walks and 54 strikeouts in 12 career road starts...numbers flip to 3-1, 4.31 ERA (64.2 IP, 31 ER) with 16 walks and 67 strikeouts in 14 career starts at Target Field, in comparison.

ACQUAINTED WITH THE NIGHT: Will be making his third start under the lights this season, after going 0-0, 4.50 ERA (8.0 IP, 4 ER) with one walk and 11 strikeouts in his two prior night starts...compares to 1-1, 2.75 ERA (19.2 IP, 6 ER) in four day game starts...has been slightly better in night starts throughout his career, going 2-2, 3.82 ERA (63.2 IP, 27 ER) with 12 walks and 73 strikeouts in 14 night starts...is a career 2-2, 4.15 ERA (56.1 IP, 26 ER) with 14 walks and 48 strikeouts in 12 day starts.

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Ober's pitch selection in his first six starts this season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his 4-seam fastball and slider.

LEFT AND RIGHT: Is holding opposing right-handed hitters to a .213 (13-for-61) batting average, two doubles, one triple, two home runs and a .234 on-base percentage this season...opposing lefties are batting .304 (14-for-46) with two doubles and a .365 on-base percentage against him.

₱ When looking at his career numbers, right-handed hitters have a .230 (59-for-257) batting average and lefties are hitting .291 (60-for-206).

KEEP UP THE TEMPO: Has an average pitch tempo of 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant...is the fastest worker on the Twins with the bases empty, followed by Dylan Bundy (15.9 seconds)...works 2.4 seconds faster than the league average of 18.2 seconds.

This pitch tempo increases to 24.2 seconds when there are runners on base, the sixth fastest

TWO STRIKES, YOU'RE GOING TO BE OUT: Has been very effective when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .173 (9-for-52) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .212 (54-for-255) mark in his career.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/2 ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10-straight starts from July 20-September 12, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span...span included his two quality starts on the season, August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 3 R/2 ER) and August 30 at Detroit (6.0 IP, 2 ER).

© Posted a 5.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the highest single-season mark by a Twins/Senators rookie pitcher (min. 70.0 IP), and tops among all major league rookies last season (also min. 70.0 IP).

© Struck out a career-high seven batters in third start on June 11 vs. Houston (5.0 IP)...matched career high two more times: July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP) and August 25 at Boston (5.0 IP).

HEY, ROOKIE! YOU WERE GOOD: Ober's 20 starts in 2021 marked the most by a Twins rookie since Adalberto Mejía had 21 in 2017, while his 96 strikeouts were the most since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...96 strikeouts also matched Nick Blackburn (2008) and Gerry Arrigo (1964) for 10th most in a single season by a Minnesota rookie...ranked sixth among American League rookies in ERA (minimum 90.0 IP) and 12th in innings pitched (92.1).

AND ALL'S FAIR IN LOVE AND WAR: Posted a 1.1 WAR in 2021, per Baseball Reference...became the first Twins rookie pitcher to surpass 1.0 WAR in a single season since Tyler Duffey in 2015 (1.6 WAR).
