RYAN REHAB: Joe Ryan began his rehab assignment last night with Triple-A St. Paul as they hosted Rochester...he pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, no walks and four strikeouts... he was placed on the COVID IL on May 25.

BIRTHDAY SHOUT: Happy 67th birthday to former Twins coach Scott Ullger...Ullger spent 20 seasons as a coach for the Twins, serving as third base coach, first base coach, bench coach and hitting coach...he also played 35 games for the Twins in 1983.
