THE TWINS: After completing their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 3-5 (1-4 at Detroit and 2-1 at Toronto), the Twins began their six-game homestand by going 1-2 against the Yankees this week...tonight, the Twins will begin a three-game series against the Rays over the weekend...the Twins are 18-13 at home and 15-13 on the road.

GRAB YOUR DEVICES: Tonight's game against the Rays will be on Apple TV+, the first for the Twins...the game will be available to anyone with internet access, for free, only on Apple TV+.

TWINS JUMP YANKS EARLY, BUT NOT OFTEN ENOUGH: The Twins lost to the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 10-7, scoring all seven runs in the first three innings...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched with two home runs allowed...the offense recorded nine hits, five going for home runs, two from Byron Buxton (14 & 15) and one apiece from Luis Arraez (2), Carlos Correa (4) and Trevor Larnach (5)...the Twins began the game with three straight homers by Arraez, Buxton and Correa, which marked the seventh time in baseball history for a team to begin a game with three consecutive homers...the nine home runs combined from both teams tied the Target Field record of most in a single game in the ballpark's history, the previous was Twins-Astros on May 31, 2017.

RAY MATTER: The Twins and Rays are playing the fourth of six games in 2022...these two played a three-game series at Tropicana Field from April 29-May 1 as the Twins won the series, taking the second and third games...Twins outscored the Rays in the series 19-10...the Twins are 13-7 in their last 20 against the Rays dating back to July of 2018.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 10-6 against the Rays, going 6-4 at Tropicana Field and 4-2 at Target Field (since 2019).

☞ Twins are 85-86 all-time against the Rays...they went 44-29 over Tampa Bay from 1998-2006 and have gone 41-57 since 2007.

☞ In the three-game series against the Rays earlier this season, Carlos Correa went 7-for-13 (.538) with two RBI, one walk and four runs scored.

THE SHOW-RREA: Below are Correa's numbers in his first 16 games, compared to his last 21:

ADDITIONALLY: In those 21 games, which spans back to April 28, he ranks fifth in the AL in batting average and fourth in on-base percentage (.427) — minimum 300 pitches seen.

C4: Correa has a career-best 92.4 average exit velocity this season and a 55.1% hard-hit rate...his 11.7% increase in hard-hit rate (% of balls leaving the bat at 95+ mph) from last season is the largest jump in baseball.

FOUR POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton hit his 14th and 15th home runs yesterday, moving into a tie for third in the AL (chart lower right)...he is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with two doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, four walks, a .432 on-base percentage, a .781 slugging percentage and a 1.214 OPS in his last eight games...in his last 162 games, he is hitting .270 (157-for-582) with 42 doubles, 48 home runs, 95 RBI, 109 runs scored, a .320 on-base percentage, a .593 slugging percentage and a .913 OPS.

☞ 23 of his 37 hits on the season have gone for extra bases.
☞ On the season, he ranks sixth in the AL in barrels-per-plate appearance (10.5%) and 12th in all of baseball.

LUEY, PROFESSIONAL HITTER: Luis Arraez has reached base safely in nine of his last 14 plate appearances (7 hits, 2 walks)...he has hit .423 (30-for-71) in his last 18 games, since May 21, raising his batting average 46 points since that date (.313 to .359)...below are his MLB ranks in a few offensive categories on the season:

ADDITIONALLY: Arraez is hitting .408 (40-for-98) off fastballs this season, the highest in baseball (minimum 400 pitches)...he has seen 477 fastballs this season, swinging 199 times and missing just 11 times...hitting .364 (8-for-22) against off-speed pitches, ninth in baseball (min. 750 pitches).

NOTHIN' BUT A GIO THANG: Gio Urshela has hit safely in seven straight, tying his season-long (previously May 21-27) and in 19 of his last 23 games since May 14, hitting .341 (28-for-82) with six doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI, seven walks, a .389 on-base percentage, a .561 slugging percentage and a .950 OPS in that span...since that date, he is fourth in the AL in batting average, tied for eighth in RBI and ninth in OPS.

☞ He is hitting .583 (7-for-12) against off-speed pitches this season, the highest in baseball (minimum 500 pitches).

POLO ON THE MARK: Jorge Polanco has posted a .357 on-base percentage in his last 16 games, reaching base 25 times in 70 plate appearances (17 hits, 8 walks)...on the season, he leads the Twins in walks (30) and has posted a walk percentage of 12.6%, going from 7.0% in 2021, a difference of 5.6 percentage points, the fourth-largest increase in baseball...the four with a higher increase are Michael A. Taylor (7.7%), Anthony Santander (6.4%) and Max Muncy (5.7%).

RYAN REHAB: Joe Ryan began his rehab assignment last night with Triple-A St. Paul as they hosted Rochester...he pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...he was placed on the COVID IL on May 25.

BIRTHDAY SHOUT: Happy 67th birthday to former Twins coach Scott Ullger...Ullger spent 20 seasons as a coach for the Twins, serving as third base coach, first base coach, bench coach and hitting coach...he also played 35 games for the Twins in 1983.

- ☞ Facing Tampa Bay for the first time in his career...also his third career appearance (2nd start) against the American League East division, after facing Toronto in his last start on June 5 (4.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 1 K) and in relief (5.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 4 K) on July 24, 2019 vs. New York-AL.
- ☞ Was acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on July 31, 2018 along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision after he allowed two runs on four hits (2 HR) and two walks over 4.0 innings in Sunday's 8-6 win at Toronto...marked his shortest start of the season...had not allowed a homer in a start since surrendering a career-high four on June 4, 2019 at Cleveland...snapped a streak of nine-straight homerless starts, tied for the fifth longest in Twins history (1961-present)...also snapped a streak of 42.2 innings without allowing a home run, which was the fourth-longest active run in the American League and seventh longest in the majors entering his last start.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his second win of the season on May 31 at Detroit, earning the 8-2 victory in the first game of the doubleheader...allowed two runs on a season-high six hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in 6.2 innings of work...6.2 innings is the second most he's pitched in an outing in his career, behind his career-best 7.0-inning performance on May 26 vs. Kansas City...did not walk a batter for the third time in a start in his career, first such instance since September 26, 2019 at Detroit.

- ☞ Paired with his start on May 26, posted quality starts in back-to-back outings for the first time in his career.
- ☞ Threw a career-high 101 pitches in the start, the second Twins starting pitcher to cross the 100-pitch threshold this season, alongside Joe Ryan (103 pitches on May 15 vs. Cleveland).
- ☞ Tossed 71 of his 101 pitches for strikes, recording a 70.3 strike percentage...marked the third time in his career that he surpassed 70 percent strikes in a start, alongside his major league debut on May 28, 2019 vs. Milwaukee (76.8%, 69/53) and September 26, 2019 at Detroit (70.4%, 81/57).

SUCCESS AS A STARTER: Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer has gone 4-2, 3.14 ERA (63.0 IP, 22 ER) with a .227 (52-for-229) opponent batting average and .648 opponent OPS in 12 starts...to compare, he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 (38-for-135) opponent batting average and .834 opponent OPS in 12 big league relief outings.

NEW OPPONENT, NEW OPPORTUNITY: Facing the Rays for the first time in his career...tonight also marks his third career appearance and second start against an American League East division club...faced Toronto in his most recent start on June 5 at Rogers Centre (ND, 4.0 IP, 2 R/ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, 1 K)...tossed 5.0 innings in relief against New York-AL on July 24, 2019 at Target Field; yielded one run on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts as the Twins lost, 10-7.

BACK ON TARGET: Smeltzer is making his third start and appearance of the season at Target Field and is 0-0, 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER) with three walks and eight strikeouts in his two prior home outings.

- ☞ Is 3-1, 2.29 ERA (55.0 IP, 14 ER) with 14 walks, 47 strikeouts, a 0.96 WHIP and a .200 (39-for-195) opponent batting average in 14 career home appearances (5 starts)...after yielding six earned runs in 4.1 innings in a home start on August 9, 2019, has permitted two-or-fewer runs in each of his last nine outings (29.1 IP, 6 ER), including two starts this season on May 14 vs. Cleveland (5.0 IP, 1 ER) and May 26 vs. Kansas City (7.0 IP, 0 R).

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Smeltzer's repertoire through his first five starts of the 2022 season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a five-pitch mix, primarily relying on his four-seam fastball and changeup...see the bullet below for more information on Smeltzer's changeup usage.

- ☞ Prior to his May 26 outing against Kansas City, Smeltzer's wife, Brienne – a former college softball player – advised him to throw more changeups down and away when attacking hitters...he's followed her advice over his last three starts, using his changeup more often (it's now his second-most-used pitch) while posting a 2.04 ERA (17.2 IP, 4 ER) and 11 strikeouts combined in those three outings.
- ☞ Has started to throw his fastball and slider from a lower-slot arm angle this season to pair with his other offerings and better attack left-handed hitters.
- ☞ Began varying the speeds of his pitches this season with the realization that throwing his fastball between 86-92 mph is better than maxing out at 89-92...aims to throw his changeup with a four-mile variance between the low and upper end.

STRIKES AND OUTS: Has been effective so far when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .178 (8-for-45) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .193 (33-for-171) mark in his career.

SO FAR IN ST. PAUL: Appeared in five games (all starts) for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-2, 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 18 strikeouts...did not pitch for the Saints in his most recent stint (was scheduled to pitch on May 25 before being recalled).

- ☞ Extended his scoreless innings streak to 11.0 innings to start the season before he permitted two runs on five hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings in his third start of the season on April 21 at Toledo...took the loss as the Saints fell, 2-1.
- ☞ Took the loss for St. Paul on May 3 vs. the Iowa Cubs and allowed six of his nine runs of the season in that single start.

THE COMEBACK IS ALWAYS STRONGER: Has worked his way back from nearly a year-long injury journey to pitch this season...lost feeling in the last three fingers of his pitching hand during 2021 spring training...placed on the 10-day Injured List on May 12, 2021 after one appearance for the Twins (April 24 vs. Pittsburgh, ND, 4.2 IP, 1 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 3 K)...left his penultimate rehab start in June 2021 after collapsing during a pregame bullpen session, which later proved to be caused by a herniated disc in his neck...transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 17, 2021...slowly built back up and began pitching in October 2021 before a healthy offseason...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts during spring training in 2022.

CAREER NOTES

- Acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL, along with outfielder Luke Raley and infielder Logan Forsythe, in exchange for infielder Brian Dozier at the 2018 trade deadline.
- Made Twins Opening Day roster in 2020, the first of his career...went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances...four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more...held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.
