THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their six-game homestand, going 1-2 against the Yankees this week, followed by a win over the Rays last night...today, the Twins will play the second of three against Tampa Bay...after tomorrow's series finale, Minnesota will travel to Seattle for a three-game series against the Mariners from Monday-Wednesday, followed by an off-day in Arizona on Thursday, then play three games against the Diamondbacks next weekend...the Twins are 19-13 at home and 15-13 on the road.

FRIDAY NIGHT FISH FRY: The Twins beat the Rays last night at Target Field by a score of 9-4...Devin Smeltzer (3-0) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.0+ innings pitched, despite giving up three home runs...the offense recorded 13 hits, marking the fifth time in their last seven games with double-digit hit totals...Byron Buxton and Carlos Correa highlighted the offense, as Buck hit his 16th and 17th home runs of the season while Correa went 3-for-5 with his fifth home run...additionally, Buxton became the fifth player in Twins/Senators history (since 1901) with back-to-back multi-homer games, joining Harmon Killebrew (1959), Don Mincher (1963), Kirby Puckett (1987) and Eddie Rosario (2019).

☞ According to Elias, Buxton's 17 home runs are the most for a player in their first 43 games of a season in franchise history (since 1901)...Harmon Killebrew had 16 through his first 43 in 1959 and Nelson Cruz had 15 in 2020.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Chi Chi González from Triple-A St. Paul...González, who will be making his second stint with the Twins this season, made the start on June 3 at Toronto, allowing three runs on four hits in 3.0 innings pitched, with no walks and one strikeout in a Twins 9-3 victory...the 30-year-old has appeared in eight games (5 starts) for the Saints this season, going 2-2, 3.44 ERA (36.2 IP, 14 ER), 14 walks and 35 strikeouts...to make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Yennier Cano to Triple-A St. Paul...Cano has appeared in nine games over two stints with the Twins this season, going 1-0, 9.26 ERA (11.2 IP, 12 ER), nine walks and 12 strikeouts...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred infielder Royce Lewis (right ACL injury) to the 60-day Injured List.

RAY MATTERS: The Twins and Rays are playing the fifth of six games in 2022...the Twins have gone 3-1 against Tampa this season and have outscored the Rays 28-14...the Twins are 14-7 in their last 21 against the Rays dating back to July of 2018.

☞ A win today would secure the season series for the Twins, their first since going 5-2 in 2019.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 11-6 against the Rays, going 6-4 at Tropicana Field and 5-2 at Target Field (since 2019).

☞ Twins are 86-86 all-time against the Rays...they went 44-29 over Tampa Bay from 1998-2006 and have gone 42-57 since 2007.

☞ Carlos Correa is 10-for-16 (.556) with one double, one home run, four RBI, a .778 slugging percentage and a 1.357 OPS in four games against the Rays this season.

OFFENSIVE COORDINATORS: The Twins have recorded double-digit hit totals in five of their last seven games and 10 of their last 16...in those 16, they are hitting .277 (157-for-566) with 25 doubles, 29 home runs, 5.3 runs-per-game and an .815 OPS.

☞ They have scored 48 runs in their last seven games, all against the Blue Jays, Yankees and Rays...Yankees rank first in the AL in ERA, Rays rank third and the Jays rank sixth.

☞ Over the last five games, the Twins have faced Kevin Gausman (5 R/3 ER), Jameson Taillon (4 R/4 ER), Nestor Cortes (4 R/4 ER), Gerrit Cole (7 R/7 ER) and Drew Rasmussen (7 R/4 ER), handing them all season highs in runs allowed.

☞ On the season, they rank first in the AL in on-base percentage (.326), second in batting average (.252), and third in OPS (.741) and slugging percentage (.415).

EVER-LONG BALLS: After hitting three home runs last night, the Twins have now hit 19 in their last seven games and have homered in a season-long seven-straight games (since June 3)...they have hit 72 homers on the season, tied for fifth most in the AL and eighth most in baseball.

☞ Twins home runs-per-game by month: April — 1.10 (23 HR/21 G), May — 1.00 (30 HR/30 G), June — 2.11 (19 HR/9 G)

LU-PERB HITTER: Luis Arraez has reached base safely in 11 of his last 19 plate appearances (9 hits, 2 walks)...he has hit .421 (32-for-76) in his last 19 games, since May 21, raising his batting average 47 points since that date (.313 to .360)...below are his MLB ranks in a few offensive categories on the season:

MIRANDA RIGHTS: Jose Miranda is hitting .378 (17-for-45) with five doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, seven multi-hit games, a .689 slugging percentage and a 1.080 OPS in his last 14 games...he began his season/career hitting .094 (5-for-53) with 0 multi-hit games, a .189 slugging percentage and a .332 OPS in his first 14 games.

CATCHING ON: Gary Sánchez enters today ranked seventh in the AL and 14th in baseball in barrels-per-plate appearance percentage at 10.8%...among all primary catchers in the AL with a minimum of 150 plate appearances, he ranks tied for first in RBI (28) and doubles (14), and second in slugging percentage (.426) and OPS (.702).

CELE-BRATE GOOD TIMES: Gilberto Celestino is hitting .378 (28-for-74) with four doubles, four RBI, six walks, eight runs scored, a .432 on-base percentage and an .865 OPS in his last 25 games, since April 28...among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 75 at-bats, he ranks first in batting average (.337), second in on-base percentage (.400), seventh in OPS (.784) and tied for 14th in hits (29).

SERIES-LY?: The Twins are looking to improve to 10-3-2 in their last 15 series and 10-5-4 in series play overall in 2022...the Twins are seeking their sixth series win over the Rays in their last seven chances...series results on the season to right >>>

WINDER REFINEMENT: Right-handed pitcher Josh Winder appeared on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul last night against Rochester at CHS Field...Winder allowed two runs on three hits in 1.0 inning pitched, with one walk, three strikeouts and one home run allowed (30 pitches)...Winder was placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 21 with right shoulder impingement.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his Twins debut on June 3 at Toronto...did not factor into the decision after tossing 3.0 innings, allowing three runs on four hits with no walks and one strikeout in a 9-3 Twins victory...was his first big league appearance since October 2, 2021 at Arizona; also his first start since September 7, 2021 vs. San Francisco (w/ Colorado)...was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent on March 17...Minnesota marks his third professional organization in six career seasons (Texas 2013-16, Colorado 2019-21, Minnesota 2022).

- Made two starts for the Twins in spring training, going 0-0, 18.69 ERA (4.1 IP, 9 ER) with seven walks and four strikeouts. Was returned to the Saints on June 4 and did not appear in a game before having his contract selected today.

FISHING FOR A NEW OPPONENT: Will be making his first career start and appearance against Tampa Bay this afternoon.

- Will mark his second consecutive start against a team from the American League East...has made four career starts against American League East teams, going 1-1, 5.03 ERA (19.2 IP, 11 ER) with 11 walks and eight strikeouts against Boston (1x), New York-AL (1x) and Toronto (2x).

LAST TIME OUT (MINORS): Made his fifth start of the season for Triple-A St. Paul on May 25 vs. Indianapolis...did not factor into the decision after going 5.1 innings, allowing three runs (2 earned) on six hits with one walk and seven strikeouts in a 5-3 Saints victory...marked his fourth consecutive start of at least 5.0 innings pitched and his third consecutive start with six-or-more strikeouts.

SAINTS RECAP: Has made eight appearances (5 starts) for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 2-2, 3.44 ERA (36.2 IP, 14 ER) with 14 walks, 35 strikeouts, and a .247 opponent batting average...is 0-1, 3.12 ERA (26.0 IP, 9 ER) with nine walks and 28 strikeouts as a starter for the Saints...is 2-1, 4.22 ERA (10.2 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and seven strikeouts as reliever this season for St. Paul.

- In his last four starts in the month of May, González is 0-1, 2.53 ERA (21.1 IP, 6 ER) with eight walks, 22 strikeouts and a .250 opponent batting average...has allowed three runs-or-fewer in all four starts, and has not allowed a home run in four consecutive starts.

Right-hander Cole Sands is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the Tampa Bay Rays at Target Field...is coming off his second consecutive loss after pitching 3.2 innings, allowing four runs on eight hits with two walks and three strikeouts in a 10-4 loss to the Yankees on June 7...tomorrow will mark his second appearance (1st start) against the Rays in his career...made his major league debut against Tampa Bay earlier this season on May 1 at Tropicana Field...threw 2.0 innings in relief, allowing two runs on three hits with no walks and two strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- Selected by Texas in first round (23rd overall) in 2013 First-Year Player Draft...signed by Colorado as minor league free agent on December 3, 2018...signed by Minnesota as minor league free agent on March 18, 2022. Made 12 starts for Colorado in 2019, following two seasons without a major league appearance. Became the first free agent signing to pitch for Colorado since 2015. Missed the entire 2017 season while recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made major league debut on May 30, 2015 vs. Boston as a member of the Texas Rangers. Pitched a complete-game shutout in his second career start, June 5, 2015 vs. Kansas City. Missed the entire 2017 season due to "Tommy John" surgery on right elbow. Made his major league debut on May 30 with Texas...threw a complete-game shutout on June 5 vs. the Kansas City Royals, his second career start, allowing three hits with two walks and two strikeouts...had three stints with the major league club, going 4-6 with a 3.90 ERA (67.0 IP, 29 ER) in 14 games, 10 starts...made his Triple-A debut and, in 16 starts, went 8-7 with a 3.57 ERA (88.1 IP, 35 ER). First pitcher in Rockies franchise history to have the team lose each of his first eight starts...it was the longest such streak in MLB since the Reds lost each of Cory Reed's first 14 starts, June 18, 2016-September 4, 2018...snapped the streak with a win vs. St. Louis on September 10... Went 2-0 with a 1.65 ERA (27.1 IP, 5 ER) in five appearances (four starts) in September, 2019 and posted the fourth-lowest ERA in the National League that month.

WHAT'S IN A NAME: González's given name is Alexander, but he's gone by "Chi Chi" — a nickname given to him by his great uncle — since childhood... "We don't ever go by our first names. It was only in school that we'd go by our first names, but our parents always call us by our nicknames or "Hey you,"" he said in an interview in 2015.
