THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their six-game homestand, going 1-2 against the Yankees this week, followed by consecutive wins over the Rays...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale against Tampa Bay...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Seattle for a three-game series against the Mariners from Monday-Wednesday, followed by an off-day in Arizona on Thursday, then play three games against the Diamondbacks next weekend...the Twins are 20-13 at home and 15-13 on the road.

ARRAEZ'S GRAND SLAM BEATS RAYS...LIKE WE ALL PREDICTED...: The Twins beat the Rays yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-5, scoring five of their runs in the third inning...Chi Chi González was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched (DFA postgame)...Emilio Pagan earned his eighth save in 11 chances with a scoreless ninth inning with two strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits, highlighted by Luis Arraez, who went 3-for-5 with a career-high four RBI and his first career grand slam.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Tyler Thornburg from Triple-A St. Paul...Thornburg, 33, appeared in two games for the Saints since signing on June 3, going 1-0, 0.00 ERA (3.0 IP), allowing two unearned runs, three hits, no walks and five strikeouts...the Houston, Texas native pitched in nine games for the Atlanta Braves earlier this season, posting a 3.86 ERA (9.1 IP, 4 ER), with five walks and 10 strikeouts, while holding opponents scoreless in seven of his nine outings...the 5-foot-11, 190-pound right-hander has appeared in 201 career major league games (10 starts), going 16-9, 3.49 ERA (278.2 IP, 108 ER), 121 walks, 283 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP with Milwaukee (2012-16), Boston (2018-19), Cincinnati (2020) and Atlanta (2022).

X-RAYS: The Twins are playing the Rays for the sixth and final time in 2022...the Twins have gone 4-1 against Tampa this season and have outscored the Rays 34-19...the Twins are 15-7 in their last 22 against the Rays dating back to July of 2018.

- ☞ Last night's win secured the season series for the Twins, their first since going 5-2 in 2019.
- ☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 12-6 against the Rays, going 6-4 at Tropicana Field and 6-2 at Target Field (since 2019).
- ☞ Twins are 87-86 all-time against the Rays...they went 44-29 over Tampa Bay from 1998-2006 and have gone 43-57 since 2007.
- ☞ Carlos Correa is 10-for-18 (.556) with one double, one home run, four RBI, a .778 slugging percentage and a 1.357 OPS in four games against the Rays this season.

OFFENSIVE COORDINATORS: The Twins have recorded double-digit hit totals in six of their last eight games and 11 of their last 17.

- ☞ They have scored 54 runs in their last eight games, all against the Blue Jays, Yankees and Rays...Yankees rank first in the AL in ERA, Rays rank third and the Jays rank fourth.
- ☞ Over the last six games, the Twins have faced Kevin Gausman (5 R/3 ER), Jameson Taillon (4 R/4 ER), Nestor Cortes (4 R/4 ER), Gerrit Cole (7 R/7 ER), Drew Rasmussen (7 R/4 ER) and Shane Bieber (5 R/5 ER), handing them all season highs in runs allowed.
- ☞ On the season, they rank first in the AL in on-base percentage (.327), second in batting average (.254) and OPS (.744), and third in slugging percentage (.417).
- ☞ The Twins have homered in a season-long eight-straight games (since June 3)...Twins home runs-per-game by month: April — 1.10 (23 HR/21 G), May — 1.00 (30 HR/30 G), June — 2.00 (20 HR/10 G).

EMP-LUEY OF THE MONTH: Luis Arraez has reached base safely in 14 of his last 24 plate appearances (12 hits, 2 walks)...he has hit safely in seven straight games, four short of his season-long of 11, done from May 21-31...he enters today leading baseball with a .367 batting average and a .449 on-base percentage...below are his monthly comparisons in 2022:

FOUR POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton has hit five home runs in his last four games (PR yesterday) and six times in his last seven games...he is hitting .393 (11-for-28) with two doubles, six home runs, nine RBI, four walks, a .485 on-base percentage, a 1.107 slugging percentage and a 1.592 OPS in eight games this month...in his last 162 games, he is hitting .275 (159-for-579) with 42 doubles, 50 home runs, 97 RBI, 111 runs scored, a .324 on-base percentage, a .610 slugging percentage and a .933 OPS.

- ☞ 25 of his 39 hits on the season have gone for extra bases...he has posted a .594 slugging percentage this season, seventh-best in baseball.
- ☞ On the season, he ranks fourth in the AL in barrels-per-plate appearance (11.3%) and seventh in all of baseball...additionally, he ranks 14th in baseball in avg. exit velo (92.8 mph).
- ☞ He ranks second in baseball in at-bats/home run ratio at 9.71, trailing only Aaron Judge (9.04).

BRING A BROOM: The Twins are seeking their fifth sweep of the season today...their four sweeps were April 22-24 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games), April 26-28 vs. Detroit (3 games), May 6-8 vs. Oakland (3 games) and May 20-22 at Kansas City (3 games)...they swept opponents four total times last season...last time the Twins swept Tampa Bay was in four games at the Metrodome from July 17-20, 2006...Rocco Baldelli played in all four of those games for the Rays.

LEFT SIDE IS OUR BEST SIDE: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the 20th time (12-7) in 61 games...they won their last two games started by a lefty: Yusei Kikuchi on June 3 at Toronto (9-3) and Nestor Cortes on June 8 vs. New York-AL (8-1).

- ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .356 (16-for-45) with six doubles and a .453 on-base percentage against lefties...he ranks sixth in baseball in batting average against left-handers.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul infielder Spencer Steer and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Louie Varland have been named the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

- ☞ Steer, 24, played in five games for the Saints, hitting .409 (9-for-22) with one double, six home runs, 11 RBI, three walks, a .519 on-base percentage, 1.273 slugging percentage and a 1.791 OPS...he hit three home runs last Sunday at Iowa...the Long Beach, CA native was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Oregon.
- ☞ Varland, 24, made two starts (6/4 vs. Frisco and 6/10 at Arkansas) for the Wind Surge, going 1-0, 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER) with eight hits allowed, two walks and 18 strikeouts...the St. Paul, MN native was selected by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2017, the Twins selected Royce Lewis with the first overall pick in the MLB Draft out of JSerra High School...Royce will miss the rest of the season with a right ACL injury.

LAST TIME OUT: Sands was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul prior to the Twins' game on June 7 vs. New York-AL, the first contest of this six-game homestand that concludes today...took the loss after tossing 3.2 innings and allowing four runs on eight hits (2 home runs), with two walks and three strikeouts...recorded three strikeouts of Anthony Rizzo (looking in the first inning), Aaron Judge (swinging in the second inning) and Rizzo (swinging in the fourth inning).

- ☞ Is in his fifth stint with the Twins this season - was previously with the big league club from April 30-May 2, May 6-7 and as the 27th man for the second game on May 12 and the second game on May 31.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was appointed as the 27th man for the May 31 doubleheader at Detroit and made his first career major league start in game two...was dealt the loss after allowing four runs (1 home run) on five hits, with four walks and four strikeouts...his four strikeouts matched a career high (also on May 12 vs. Houston) and his 91 pitches thrown were also a career high.

DEBUT DEBRIEF: Made his major league debut on May 1 at Tampa Bay...tossed 2.0 innings in relief, allowing two runs on three hits with two strikeouts in a 9-3 Twins victory...retired his first batter faced before surrendering three consecutive hits; he then struck out the final two hitters in the eighth inning (fanning Josh Lowe for his first career strikeout)...retired his final three batters 1-2-3, to finish out his first career outing.

- ☞ Is a Tallahassee, Florida native, just a four-hour drive to Tampa Bay, where Sands got to make his debut in front of his hometown friends and family.

STARTING STRONG: Today marks Sands' third career major league start, after starting as the 27th man in the second game of the May 31 doubleheader at Detroit (L, 4.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R/ER, 4 BB, 4 K) and his last outing against the Yankees...is 0-3, 5.09 ERA (17.2 IP, 10 ER) with four walks and 21 strikeouts in five minor league starts with Triple-A St. Paul this season...owns 41 career minor league starts, going 10-8, 2.76 ERA (192.1 IP, 59 ER) with 57 walks, 221 strikeouts and a .223 (157-for-704) opponent batting average in those outings, as his teams have gone 23-18.

ARSENAL: Sands has displayed a four-pitch mix so far through his first four career appearances, relying primarily on his four-seam fastball, which he's thrown 51.1 percent of the time so far.

SAINTS SEASON RECAP: Sands recently made one appearance with St. Paul on May 24 vs. Indianapolis, starting and pitching 3.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...has gone 0-4, 7.23 ERA (18.2 IP, 15 ER) with six walks and 21 strikeouts in six appearances (5 starts) for the Saints this season.

- ☞ Allowed just one run and four hits with 12 strikeouts in his first two starts combined (10.0 IP)...has allowed one walk-or-fewer in five of his six appearances this season for the Saints.
- ☞ Was placed on the 7-day Injured List (May 13-23) with a left groin strain.
- ☞ Did not pitch in his most recent stint with the Saints (June 1-6).

2021 RECAP: Began the season with Double-A Wichita and spent the entire year with the Wind Surge...Missed time on the 7-day Injured List from June 21-July 14 with a right elbow strain...matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts on August 14 at Tulsa (5.2 IP, 2 R/ER, 1 BB)...went 2-0, 0.00 ERA (17.0 IP) with seven walks and 14 strikeouts across his last three regular-season starts...started the first game of the Double-A Central Championship Series at Northwest Arkansas, taking the loss (5.0 IP, 7 H, 5 R/ER, 1 BB, 1 HB, 4 K).

- ☞ Held right-handed batters to a .167 (25-for-150) batting average in the regular season, while lefties hit .243 (34-for-140) against him.
- ☞ Allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18 of 19 outings...also struck out at least six batters six times, including at least eight batters thrice.
- ☞ Went 4-2, 2.46 ERA (80.1 IP, 22 ER) with 35 walks, 96 strikeouts and a .203 opponent batting average in 19 games (18 starts)...the Wind Surge went 12-7 when he pitched.
- ☞ Finished the season as the 19th-best prospect in the Twins system, per MLB.com.

MINORS CAREER: 11-9, 3.03 ERA (196.1 IP, 66 ER), 60 walks and 225 strikeouts in 43 minor league games (41 starts)...averaged 10.3 strikeouts per 9.0 innings in minor league career, with a 3.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER (2022 SEASON: 1-2, 3.65 ERA // CAREER: 62-83, 3.87 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Archer is scheduled to start tomorrow night's series opener against the Mariners in Seattle...earned his first victory in a Twins uniform in his last start on June 8 vs. New York-AL at Target Field...tossed 5.0 innings of two-hit, one-run ball, with a season-high four walks and two strikeouts as the Twins won, 8-1...is slated to face the Mariners for the first time since June 2, 2018 with Tampa Bay (L, 5.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 1 HB, 6 K)...is 1-3, 2.90 ERA (40.1 IP, 13 ER) with nine walks and 43 strikeouts in seven career starts against Seattle...his 4.78 strikeout-to-walk ratio vs. the Mariners is his second highest against any single opponent in his career (min. 3 games), behind only his 4.93 mark (69 K, 14 BB) against the Twins.

- Made his major league debut on May 1, 2022 at Tampa Bay...worked the final 2.0 innings of a 9-3 Twins win (2.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R/ER, 2 K)...fanned Josh Lowe for his first career strikeout.
- Spent the entire 2021 minor league season with Double-A Wichita...went 4-2, 2.46 ERA (80.1 IP, 22 ER) with 35 walks, 96 strikeouts and a .203 opponent batting average in 19 games (18 starts)...the Wind Surge went 12-7 when he pitched...matched his career high with 10 strikeouts on August 14 at Tulsa (5.2 IP, 2 R/ER, 1 BB).
- Allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18 of 19 outings in 2021...also struck out at least six batters six times, including at least eight batters thrice.
- Started the first game of the 2021 Double-A Central Championship Series at Northwest Arkansas, taking the loss (5.0 IP, 7 H, 5 R/ER, 1 BB, 1 HB, 4 K).
- Finished the 2021 season as the 19th-best prospect in the Twins system, per MLB.com...added to the Twins 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.
