THE TWINS: Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 3-3, going 1-2 against the Yankees and 2-1 against the Rays — the Yankees entered the series with a .722 winning percentage, while the Rays at .596...tonight, the Twins will begin a three-game series against the Mariners through Wednesday...after this series, they will travel to Arizona to enjoy an off-day, then play three games against the Diamondbacks over the weekend...the Twins are 20-14 at home and 15-13 on the road...the Twins are 3-5 in their last eight road games but won their last road series two games to one from June 3-5 at Toronto.

NEVERMIND: The Twins lost to the Rays yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-0, getting shutout for the eighth time this season...Cole Sands (0-3) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on five hits in 4.2 innings pitched with a career-high five strikeouts...Tyler Thornburg made his Twins debut with 2.1 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded just five hits, left eight men on base and went 0-for-4 with runners in scoring position.

SOMETHING IN THE WAY: The Twins have selected the contract of infielder Elliot Soto from Triple-A St. Paul...Soto, 32, has hit .213 (29-for-136) with eight doubles, two home runs, 19 RBI and 23 walks in 41 games for the Saints this season, including seven walks and a .444 on-base percentage in seven games in June...to make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Cole Sands to Triple-A St. Paul...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Cody Stashak to the 60-day Injured List. Stashak was originally placed on the Injured List on May 22 and is scheduled to undergo season-ending surgery to repair a labrum tear in his right shoulder later this week.

LIVE & UNPLUGGED IN SEATTLE: The Twins and Mariners are playing each other for the fifth of seven games in 2022...they split their last series from April 8-11 at Target Field, as the Mariners won the first two and the Twins won the second two...Minnesota's last series at T-Mobile Park was from June 14-16, 2021, as they won the third of three games.

- ☞ Carlos Correa's 100 career hits and 101 career games against the M's are his most vs. any opponent...he has hit safely in six straight games at T-Mobile Park.
- ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with four walks, a .432 on-base percentage and a 1.026 OPS in 11 career games vs. Seattle...additionally, two of his nine career homers have come against Mariners pitching...he went 5-for-9 over the three-game series in April.
- ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .464 (13-for-28) with five home runs in his last seven games against the Mariners, with multiple hits in five of those.
- ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .317 (32-for-101) with six doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI in 25 career games against the Mariners, hitting safely in 18 of those 25.

COME AS YOU ARCHER: In two June starts, Chris Archer is 1-0, 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP, 2 ER), with five walks, five strikeouts and a .161/.289/.194 opponent slash line (5-for-31 with one double)...among AL starters with at least 10.0 innings pitched in June, he ranks sixth in opponent batting average, eighth in opponent OPS (.483) and tied for 10th in ERA...on the season, he is one of 18 AL pitchers with at least 11 starts, an ERA under 3.70 and an opponent batting average under .230...additionally, he leads the staff in starts (11) in 2022.

HEART SHAPED BUX: Byron Buxton has been named AL Player of the Week, his second career honor (also August of 2017)...he hit .333 (7-for-21) with eight runs scored, a double, five home runs, seven RBI and a 1.095 slugging percentage over six games played...he homered in three straight games from Wednesday-Friday...he delivered back-to-back multi-homer games across Thursday-Friday, becoming the fifth player in Twins/Senators history to accomplish the feat, joining Hall of Famers Harmon Killebrew (1959) and Kirby Puckett (1987), as well as Don Mincher (1963) and former teammate Eddie Rosario (2019)...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, Buxton's 17 home runs on the season were the most by a player in his first 43 games of a campaign in franchise history, surpassing the previous record of 16 held by Killebrew in 1959.

IN LU-TERO: Luis Arraez enters today leading baseball with a .359 batting average and a .441 on-base percentage...since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .396 (44-for-111) with 16 walks and a .481 on-base percentage in 29 games...he is tied with Buxton for team-lead in WAR (BB Ref) at 1.9.

- ☞ Arraez is hitting .413 (45-for-109) off fastballs this season, the highest in baseball (minimum 500 pitches)...Correa ranks second at .388 (31-for-80).

SUB POP: Carlos Correa has recorded multiple hits in each of his last three games...his career-long for a multi-hit streak is five, done from May 25-29, 2017 with Houston...since April 28, he is hitting .389 (37-for-95) with eight doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI, nine walks, a .448 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.048 OPS in 23 games...since that date, he leads baseball in batting average and on-base percentage (minimum of 100 plate appearances).

- ☞ He has a 92.5 mph average exit velocity this season, the highest of his career...his hard hit rate is at 54.8%, also a career-high, which is up from 42.7% in 2021, a 12.1% increase, the highest in baseball.

ALL APOLO-GIOS: Despite going 0-for-his-last-9, Gio Urshela is hitting .315 (28-for-89) with six doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI, eight walks, a .367 on-base percentage, a .517 slugging percentage and an .884 OPS in his last 26 games, since May 14...since that date, he ranks ninth in the AL in batting average and 14th in on-base percentage.

- ☞ On the season, he is hitting .583 (7-for-12) against off-speed pitches, the highest in baseball (minimum 500 pitches).

IN BLOOM: Jose Miranda is hitting .358 (19-for-53) with six doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, seven multi-hit games, a .642 slugging percentage and a 1.012 OPS in his last 16 games...he began his season/career hitting .094 (5-for-53) with 0 multi-hit games, a .189 slugging percentage and a .332 OPS in his first 14 games.

SMELLS LIKE CELES-TEEN SPIRIT: Gilberto Celestino is hitting .375 (30-for-80) with five doubles, four RBI, eight walks, nine runs scored, a .438 on-base percentage and an .876 OPS in his last 27 games, since April 28...among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 100 plate appearances, he ranks first in batting average (.337), second in on-base percentage (.408), fifth in OPS (.811) and tied for 13th in hits (31).

BULL-PENNYROYAL TEA: 11 of Jhoan Duran's last 12 relief appearances have been scoreless, posting a 1.29 ERA (14.0 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and 18 strikeouts in that span...on the season, he ranks tied for second in the AL in relief strikeouts (37)...he has an average pitch velocity of 96.0 mph this season, fourth highest in baseball among pitchers with at least 300 pitches thrown, trailing Cleveland's Emmanuel Clase (97.5), Los Angeles-NL's Brusdar Graterol (96.6) and Detroit's Gregory Soto (96.5).

YOU KNOW YOU'RE RIGHT: The Twins are hitting .294 (127-for-432) with a .357 on-base percentage, a .532 slugging percentage and an .889 OPS in their last 17 games against right-handed pitching...individuals against right-handers this season: Luis Arraez is hitting .399 (57-for-143)...Gilberto Celestino is hitting .375 (21-for-56)...11 of Buxton's 17 home runs this season have come off righties.

- ☞ Byron Buxton is 5-for-5 with three doubles, one home run, four RBI and one walk lifetime against Chris Flexen.

HEADBANGERS BALDELLE: Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 9-8 vs. the Mariners with a +32 run differential (109-77)...it's the second-best run differential under Baldelli (Detroit is +60)...he has gone 4-3 at T-Mobile Park...since become the Twins manager in 2019, he has gone 245-201 for a .549 winning percentage, the fourth-best in the AL in that span.

- ☞ Making his team-leading 12th start of the season and 227th of his career...marks his 230th career appearance.
- ☞ Today marks his eighth career start and appearance against Seattle, but first since June 2, 2018 (with Tampa Bay)...is 1-3, 2.90 ERA (40.1 IP, 13 ER) lifetime against the Mariners (all with TB).
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win in a Twins uniform, holding New York-AL to one run on just two hits in a season-high-tying 5.0 innings of Minnesota's 8-1 victory last Wednesday at Target Field (season-high 4 BB, with 2 K)...retired the Yankees in order in the first and third innings, while working around the four walks in the second and fourth frames...New York plated its lone run on a sacrifice fly in the fifth inning to draw within 2-1, but the Twins scored the game's final six runs, while Griffin Jax (2.0 IP), Emilo Pagán (1.0 IP) and Caleb Thielbar (1.0 IP) combined for 4.0 scoreless relief innings.

- ☞ Had induced just one groundball double play in his first 10 starts, but got two vs. the Yanks — one in the second off the bat of Josh Donaldson to erase a leadoff walk, and then another (by Gleyber Torres) to escape a bases-loaded, one-out jam and end the fourth inning...Twins snapped a scoreless tie in the bottom of the fourth with a two-run frame.
- ☞ Snapped a personal 11-start winless stretch, dating back to his last victory on September 4, 2021 against, ironically, the Twins (for Tampa Bay, at Tropicana Field).

TWO STARTS AGO: Turned in an excellent performance June 2 at Detroit, allowing one run on three hits in a season-long 5.0 innings; did not factor in the decision as the Tigers rallied to win the five-game series finale, 3-2...worked through the Detroit lineup exactly twice on just 57 pitches, a season-low, before exiting with a 2-1 lead (the Tigers won on a two-run homer in the eighth by Daz Cameron off Pagán)...allowed a first-inning run within the first three batters (hit-by-pitch, walk, single), but blanked Detroit on just two singles after that.

- ☞ Fanned Koby Clemens leading off the second inning for his 1400th career strikeout...is one of 23 active pitchers and 251 in American/National League history (since 1901) to reach the milestone (per Statspass).

JUNE BOON: In two June starts (detailed above), Archer is 1-0, 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP, 2 ER), with five walks, five strikeouts and a .161/.289/.194 opponent slash line (5-for-31 with one double).

- ☞ Among American League starters with at least 10.0 innings pitched in June, he ranks sixth in opponent batting average, eighth in opponent OPS (.483) and tied for 10th in ERA.
- ☞ Has worked a season-high 5.0 innings in both efforts this month, marking the first time he has pitched at least 5.0 innings in consecutive starts since doing so in eight-straight from July 3-August 14, 2019 (with Pittsburgh).
- ☞ A win tonight in Seattle would give him victories in back-to-back starts for the first time since May 31 and June 6, 2019 (also with the Pirates).

VS. THE MARINERS: Archer is set to make his eighth career start and appearance against Seattle, but first since June 2, 2018 (with Tampa Bay)...is 1-3, 2.90 ERA (40.1 IP, 13 ER) lifetime against the Mariners (all with the Rays); however, his Tampa teams dropped six of his seven starts.

- ☞ Shouldered the loss in that June 2, 2018 contest here at T-Mobile Park, as the Rays dropped a 3-1 decision to Seattle and Marco Gonzalez; Archer pitched 5.0 innings (7 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 6 K).
- ☞ His lone career victory over the Mariners was also here at T-Mobile and it came in a dominant performance on June 7, 2015 in a 3-1 Tampa Bay win...allowed one unearned run on six hits in 7.0 innings, with no walks and 11 strikeouts.
- ☞ Is 1-2, 3.43 ERA (21.0 IP, 8 ER) in four career starts at T-Mobile Park.

A FEEL FOR THE ROAD: While he entered the 2022 season with dominant career numbers at Target Field, Archer has fared better on the road during his inaugural Twins campaign.

- ☞ In five road starts this season, he is 0-0, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER), nine walks, 20 strikeouts and a .205/.295/.410 opponent slash line (16-for-68, with 4 2B and 4 HR)...has departed all five of his road efforts with the Twins either tied or ahead (Minnesota is 2-3).
- ☞ In six home efforts, he is 1-2, 4.30 ERA (23.0 IP, 11 ER) with a .247/.337/.404 opponent slash line (22-for-89 with 8 2B and 2 HR)...has left with the Twins behind in three of those games.

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD: After allowing a solo home run to Houston's Jose Altuve leading off the third inning of his start May 11 — marking the fifth-straight outing he had yielded a longball (six total, all solo) — Archer has kept the last 99 batters he has faced in the yard...that stretch spans the final seven faced in the Astros game and his last five starts...in those starts, he has posted a 2.86 ERA (22.0 IP, 7 ER).

SOFT CONTACT: Archer has allowed an average exit velocity of just 89.0 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (beating the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .248 opponent batting average on balls in play would also be the lowest of his career, better than the .254 mark of his 2013 rookie campaign; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

THE ARSENAL: Archer has upped his changeup and curveball usage the last eight starts, throwing those 20.9 percent of the time (119 of 569 pitches), per Baseball Savant...just 3.5 percent of his pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed over his first three efforts...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

- ☞ His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.2 mph on the fastball and 88.7 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.
- ☞ Opponents are a combined 22-for-119 (.185) with eight doubles, two homers and 29 strikeouts against Archer's slider, changeup and curveball; they are hitting .333 (16-for-48) with three doubles, four home runs and five strikeouts against the fastball...however, opponents are 1-for-11 with no extra-base hits off Archer's fastball in June.

ONE STEP AT A TIME: Archer is the lone Twins starter to make of each of his scheduled turns through the rotation, as tonight will be his team-leading 12th start of the season, his most since logging 23 with Pittsburgh in 2019...missed the final month of that season with right shoulder inflammation, all of 2020 following thoracic outlet surgery and most of 2021 due to right lateral forearm tightness and left hip soreness (made 6 appearances/5 starts for Tampa Bay).

- ☞ Is one of 18 American League pitchers this season to make at least 11 starts with an ERA under 3.70 (3.65; 44.1 IP, 18 ER) and an opponent batting average below .230 (.228; 38-for-167).
- ☞ Has faced just six batters a third time through the order (1-for-3, 2 BB, SF)...opponents are hitting .182 (16-for-88) with a .615 OPS the first time through; .276 (21-for-76) with an .828 OPS the second time.
