THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE：Below are some facts that summarize Ryan＇s career to date
$\Phi$ Ryan has 72 career strikeouts through his first 13 games，second most in Twins／Senators history behind Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven（ 75 in 1970）．．．．the record for most strikeouts in the first 14 career games is 78 ，also held by Blyleven．
$\Phi$ His 179 opponent batting average through his first 13 career games is third lowest in Twins／ senators history（min． 60.0 IP），behind George Dumont（． 172 from 1915－16）and Jim Roland （． 175 from 1962－1964）．
$\Phi$ Owns a 3.79 strikeout－to－walk ratio（ $72 \mathrm{~K}, 19 \mathrm{BB}$ ）through his first 13 career outings，fourth best in Twins／Senators history（min． 60.0 IP），behind Doc Ayers（4．44 from 1913－14），Kevin Slowey（4．27 in 2007）and Hall of Famer Walter Johnson（3．82 in 1907），
$\Phi$ Ryan posted a 0.74 WHIP through his first nine career starts，the lowest WHIP by any MLB pitcher through his first nine career starts since Hall of Famer Christy Mathewson from 1900－ 01 （0．70）（Stats Perform）．
$\Phi$ Ryan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four－or－fewer base runners in each of his first four career games（from September 1－22，2021），the only pitcher in baseball history （1901－present）to do so．
$\Phi$ He became one of two pitchers in MLB history（1901－present）to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three－or－fewer hits in each of his first four career games（September 1－22，2021）， alongside San Francisco＇s Matt Cain，who did so in 2005.
