

BACK ON THE HILL: Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List today after suffering a right pectoral strain on May 29 (missed 16 games)...will mark his second stint with the Twins this season after also being placed on the Injured List from April 17-May 7 with a strained right hamstring, missing 17 games.

LAST TIME OUT: Secured his third win of the season in as many starts on May 29 vs. Kansas City at Target Field...tossed 6.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits with no walks and four strikeouts in a 7-3 Twins victory...pitched 6.0 scoreless innings, while retiring 15 consecutive of his final 16 batters before allowing a leadoff single in the seventh inning...marked his third consecutive start of 6.0+ innings and seventh-straight start with two-or-fewer runs allowed...left the game in the seventh inning after experiencing discomfort in his right pectoral muscle...was placed on the 15-day Injured List with a right pectoral strain on June 2.

TWO STARTS AGO: Notched his second victory of the season on May 24 vs. Detroit in his fourth start this season at Target Field...sailed through a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing four hits with one walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts, to lead the Twins to a 2-0 win over the Tigers... marked his first outing of at least 7.0 innings with 10-or-more strikeouts since July 3, 2019 vs. Milwaukee (8.0 IP, 12 K).

 $m{\Phi}$ His 10 strikeouts are the most by a Twins starting pitcher this season...is also the second Twins pitcher this season to toss at least 7.0 innings with nine-or-more strikeouts, joining Joe Ryan on April 27 vs. Detroit (7.0 IP, 9 K).

WINNING THE BATTLE: His seven consecutive starts of two-or-fewer runs allowed tie his second longest streak in his career, trailing his 11 consecutive he accomplished from June 25-August 26, 2017 (with Oakland/New York-AL)...his streak of two-or-fewer runs allowed is also tied for the longest streak to start a season by a starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present)...is tied with Jim Kaat (April May 28, 1972) and John Butcher (April 7-May 15, 1984). 29-

The Twins have now won each of his last five starts dating back to May 7, has gone 3-0, 1.65 ERA (27.1 IP, 5 ER) with seven walks, 34 strikeouts and a .182 opponent batting average (18-for-99) in that span.

SHARP AS THE SPACE NEEDLE: Is making his 14th career appearance (all starts) against Seattle in the series finale this afternoon...faced the Mariners in his season debut on April 9 (ND, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K) in a 4-2 Twins defeat...has tossed 6.0+ innings in six of his last seven starts against Seattle...owns a 5-3, 2.89 ERA (84.0 IP, 27 ER) with 26 walks, 82 strikeouts and a .216/.286/.340 opponent slash line against the Mariners in his career... his 2.89 ERA vs. Seattle is his third lowest against any single opponent in his career (min. 10 starts).

- The Owns the fourth-lowest ERA against the Mariners among active pitchers (min. 10 starts), trailing only Zack Greinke (2.35), Chris Sale (2.65) and Lance McCullers Jr. (2.80).
- Φ Owns the lowest ERA (1.58) at T-Mobile Park (minimum six starts) among active starting pitchers.

ROCKY ROADS: Is making his third start on the road this season and first since May 18 at Oakland is 1-1, 4.70 ERA (7.2 IP, 4 ER) with one walk and six strikeouts on the road this season...this compares

37-37 record, 3.24 ERA (614.1 IP, 221 ER), with 232 walks and 604 strikeouts in 109 career appearances (104 starts) on the road...has gone 48-36, 3.88 ERA (686.2 IP, 296 ER) with 231 walks and 656 strikeouts in 121 appearances (117 starts) at his home ballpark

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: This season, Gray has posted a .151 opponent average (8-for-53) with two walks and 18 strikeouts against left-handed hitters...has a .214 batting average (15-for-70) Φ In his career, Gray has limited left-handers to a .222 batting average (535-for-2407) with

- 637 strikeouts and right-handed hitters to a .237 batting average (581-for-2456) with 623 strikeouts.
- Gray's .151 opponent batting average against left-handers ranks third in the American League
- among starters with at least seven starts this season.

THE ARSENAL: Grav has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...23 of his 34 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting 095 (2-for-21) against his curveball here's a look at his repertoire

 Named to *Baseball America*'s 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Wonth for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
 Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.

SONNY AND HOT STREAK: Has won three consecutive starts dating back to May 18...is the third Twins starter this season to have won three consecutive starts, joining Dylan Bundy (April 11-April 23) and Joe Ryan (April 15-April 27)...the Twins have also won in each of his last five starts dating back to May 7, marking it the longest streak by a Twins starter this season; the Twins have also won in four consecutive starts for Joe Ryan (April 15-May 3) and Bailey Ober (April 22-May 27).

FRIDAY'S STARTER - LHP DEVIN SMELTZER (2022 SEASON: 3-0, 2.38 ERA // CAREER: 7-2, 3.65 ERA)

Left-hander Devin Smeltzer is scheduled to start the series opener on Friday against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field...is coming off his third win of the season after tossing 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts, in a 9-4 Twins victory over the Rays at Target Field on June 10...tomorrow will mark his first career appearance the D-backs in his career...will also be his third career appearance against a National League opponents...0-0, 0.00 ERA (10.2 IP, 0 ER), with one walk and 10 strikeouts in two Interleague appearances (one start).
