THE TWINS: Began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a series win over the Mariners this
week, winning the book end games of the three-game series at T-Mobile Parktonight, they
will begin a three-game Interleague series in Arizona against the Diamondbacks, their first
trip to the desert since 2011Twins are 20-14 at home and 17-14 on the road.
₱ The Twins have won their last two road series: June 3-5 at Toronto and June 13-15 at Seattle.

The Twins are 3-2 when following an off-day.

Twins have gone 33-20 since April 21, tied with Houston and New York-NL for the second most wins in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL (40-11).

TWINS WIN GRUDGE MATCH IN GRUNGE CITY: The Twins shutout the Mariners on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 5-0, winning the three-game series...it marked their sixth shutout of the season and first since May 24 vs. Detroit (2-0)...Sonny Gray made his return from the Injured List, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, no walks and three strikeouts... Griffin Jax (1.0), Joe Smith (0.2), Caleb Thielbar (0.1), Jhoan Duran (1.0) and Jharel Cotton (1.0) combined for 4.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded eight hits, led by Ryan Jeffers, who went 2-for-3 with a double, walk and the go-ahead RBI.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed infielder Jorge Polanco on the 10-day Injured List (retroactive to June 13) with low back tightness. .this marks his first stint on a major league LL and just his second on a professional Injured List, after he missed time with Low-A Cedar Rapids in August of 2013 (right groin strain)...to replace Polanco on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder/first baseman Alex Kirilloff from Triple-A St. Paul...this is Kirilloff's second stint with the Twins this season, after previously being with the club from Opening Day-May 14...he hit 385 (42-for-109) with seven doubles. 10 home runs, 31 RBI, 16 walks, 32 runs scored, a 477 on-base percentage and a 1.201 OPS in 28 games for the Saints from May 15-June 16...Kirilloff was also named International League Player of the Week for May 30-June 5, after hitting. 471 (8-for-17) with three doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, four walks, eight runs scored, a .571 on-base percentage and a 1.924 OPS in four games in that span.

DUEL IN THE DESERT: The Twins and D-Backs are playing each other for the 22nd time in their history. The Twins have gone 13-8 all-time against Arizona, going 4-2 at the Metrodome (2003-08), 5-1 at Target Field (2014-17) and 4-5 at Chase Field. Their last meeting came August 18-20, 2017 at Target Field as the Twins swept a three-game series.

♣ Their last series in Phoenix came May 20-22, 2011 as the Twins were swept in three games.

♣ The Twins' last win here came on June 8, 2005, a span of 6,218 days...in that game, the Twins won 10-0 as Johan Santana pitched a complete game shutout with four hits allowed, no walk and nine strikeouts...the Twins lineup that day was: 1) Shannon Stewart – LF, 2) Lus Rodriguez – 2B, 3) Joe Mauer – C, 4) Torri Hunter – CF, 5) Jacque Jones – RF, 6) Justin Morneau – 1B, 7) Michael Cuddyer – 3B, 8) Juan Castro – SS, 9) Johan Santana – P

♣ 6,218 days marks the longest the Twins have gone without a win in an opposing major league ballpark, the next closest being at Dodger Stadium (6,215 days/last win on June 11, 2005).

NATIONAL TREASURE: The Twins are 0-2 in Interleague Play this season, their only games against an NL opponent came in a two-game series sweep at the hands of the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13...excluding this current series, the remaining IL schedule is: Colorado at Target Field from June 24-26, Milwaukee at Target Field from July 12-13 and at American Family Field from June 24-26, Milwaukee at Target Field from July 12-13 and at American Family Field from July 29-31, Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10, San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28.

C4: Carlos Correa is hitting .380 (41-for-108) with nine doubles, four home runs, 17 RBI, 10 walks, a .437 on-base percentage, a .574 slugging percentage and a 1.011 OPS in 26 games, since April 28...since that date, he is tied for first in baseball in batting average with Iim Anderson and fourth in on-base percentage (minimum of 100 plate appearances).
▼ Since going 0-for-11 in his first three road games, he has reached safely in 18-straight away games, hitting .347 (25-for-72) with a .413 on-base percentage in that span.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his third win of the season as the Twins defeated the Tampa Bay Rays, 9-4, on June 10 at Target Field...tossed 6.0-plus innings (faced 3 batters in the 7th), allowing three runs (all solo home runs) on four hits, with three walks and three strikeouts.

◆ Marked his third quality start of the season, matching Sonny Gray for second most on the Twins (Joe Ryan leads with 4).

◆ Joined Gray as the only other Twins starter this season to allow three-or-fewer runs in his first six starts of the year.

◆ After allowing a home run to Isaac Paredes in the second inning, he allowed a home run in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career and second time in back-to-back appearances, first since August 15-September 8, 2019...after allowing the home run, he retired 13 of his next 14 batters faced.

◆ Allowed an inside-the-park home run to Randy Arozarena in the seventh inning; was the first time a Twins pitcher allowed one since August 13, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay against Kevin Kiermaier.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision after he allowed two runs on four hits (2 HR) and two walks over 4.0 innings in the 8-6 win at Toronto on June 10...marked his shortest start of the season...had not allowed a homer in a start since surrendering a career-high four on June 4, 2019 at Cleveland...snapped a streak of nine-straight homerless starts, tied for the fifth longest in Twins history (1961-present)...also snapped a streak of 42.2 innings without allowing a home run, which was the fourth-longest active run in the American League and seventh longest in the majors entering that start.

SUCCESS AS A STARTER: Over the course of his major league career, Smeltzer has gone 5-2, 3.26 ERA (69.0 IP, 25 ER) with a .224 (56-for-250) opponent batting average and .670 opponent OPS in 13 starts (Twins are 8-5)...to compare, he's 2-0, 4.41 ERA (34.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .281 (38-for-135) opponent batting average and .834 opponent OPS in 12 big league relief outings.

NEW OPPONENT, DIFFERENT LEAGUE: Facing the Diamondbacks for the first time in his career.

tonight also marks his third career appearance and second start against a National League club...is 0-0, 0.00 ERA (10.2 IP, 0 ER), with one walk and 10 strikeouts in Interleague play.

Faced Pittsburgh in relief on April 24, 2021 (ND, 4.2 IP, 1 UER, 1 H, 1 BB, 3 K)...made his major league debut with a start against Milwaukee on May 28, 2019 at Target Field; did not factor into the decision after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings (3 H, 0 BB, 7 K) in a 5-3 Twins win.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Smeltzer is making his fourth start and appearance of the season away from Target Field and is 2-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and five strikeouts in his three prior road outings...this compares to 1-0, 2.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 4 ER) with six walks and 11 strikeouts in three home starts.

© Is 3-1, 5.27 ERA (42.2 IP, 25 ER) with 10 walks, 22 strikeouts, a 1.43 WHIP and a .302 (51-for-169) opponent batting average in 10 career road appearances (7 starts).

Prior to his May 26 outing against Kansas City, Smeltzer's wife, Brianne − a former college
softball player − advised him to throw more changeups down and away when attacking hitters.

he's followed her advice over his last four starts, using his changeup more offen (it's now his second-most-used pitch) while posting a 2.66 ERA (23.2 IP, 7 ER), a .193 opponent batting average (16-for-83) and 14 strikeouts combined in those four outings.

That started to throw his fastball and slider from a lower-slot arm angle this season to pair with his other offerings and better attack left-handed hitters.

Began varying the speeds of his pitches this season with the realization that throwing his fastball between 86-92 mph is better than maxing out at 89-92...aims to throw his changeup with a four-mile variance between the low and upper end.

STRIKES AND OUTS: Has been effective so far when facing hitters with two strikes, holding opponents to a .145 (8-for-55) batting average in two-strike situations this season, as well as a .182 (33-for-181) mark in his career.

SO FAR IN ST. PAUL: Appeared in five games (all starts) for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-2, 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 18 strikeouts.

◆ Extended his scoreless innings streak to 11.0 innings to start the season before he permitted two runs on five hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings in his third start of the season on April 21 at Toledo...took the loss as the Saints fell, 2-1.
