THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Seattle, followed by splitting the first two in Arizona over the last two nights...today, they will play the three-game series finale with the D-Backs...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, prior to starting a six-game homestand with three against the Cleveland Guardians from Tuesday-Thursday, then three against the Colorado Rockies next weekend...Twins are 20-14 at home and 18-15 on the road.
 ☞ Twins have gone 34-21 since April 21, tied with Houston (34-19) for the third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL (42-11) and New York-NL (35-19).
 ☞ Twins have gone 5-1 in rubber games this season.

DYLAN DEALS IN THE DESERT: The Twins beat the D-Backs last night at Chase Field by a score of 11-1, matching their largest margin of victory this season (14-4 on May 18 at OAK)...Dylan Bundy (4-3) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts in a season-high 8.0 innings pitched...8.0 innings marked the most by a Twins starter this season and most for Bundy since his 9.0-inning complete game on August 6, 2020 at Seattle...it also marked the longest outing for a Twins starter since José Berrios pitched 8.0 innings on May 31, 2021 at Baltimore...the offense recorded 14 hits, two shy of their season high of 16, done on June 5 at Toronto...every hitter in the starting lineup recorded at least one hit, while five players had multiple hits...Gary Sánchez (8) and Ryan Jeffers (5) each homered.

JUST ADD GARLICK: The Twins have returned outfielder Kyle Garlick from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Garlick, who missed the Twins' last 13 games with a left hamstring strain, played in three games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 3-for-11 with one home run, one RBI and one walk...to make room for Garlick on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Trevor Megill on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to June 15) with right shoulder impingement.

RAISING ARIZONA: The Twins and D-Backs are playing each other for the 24th time in their history...the Twins have gone 14-9 all-time against Arizona, going 4-2 at the Metrodome (2003-08), 5-1 at Target Field (2014-17) and 5-6 at Chase Field...last night's win snapped a five-game losing streak at Chase Field and marked their first win in Phoenix since June 8, 2005...the Twins are 6-1 against the D-Backs in their last seven, dating back to September of 2014.

THE BETTER HALF: The Twins are 1-3 in Interleague Play this season, getting swept in two games by Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13, followed by going 1-1 against the D-Backs...after today's game, the remaining IL schedule is: Colorado at Target Field from June 24-26, Milwaukee at Target Field from July 12-13 and at American Family Field from July 26-27, San Diego at Petco Park from July 29-31, Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10, and San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28...Twins IL wins ranks to lower right.
 ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .452 (14-for-31) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, six walks, a .541 OBP, a .774 SLG and a 1.315 OPS in his last nine IL games.

HEAT ARRAEZ-ES: With two more hits last night, Luis Arraez raised his batting average six more points to .363...he now has 23 multi-hit games, third most in the AL and tied for fifth most in baseball...he enters today leading baseball in batting average (7 points ahead of Paul Goldschmidt - .346) and on-base percentage at .446 (20 points ahead of Goldschmidt - .426)...below are his monthly comparisons in 2022:

BYE BYE BYRON: Byron Buxton is hitting .306 (15-for-49) with three doubles, eight home runs, 12 RBI, six walks, a .393 on-base percentage, an .857 slugging percentage and a 1.250 OPS in 13 games this month...he entered June hitting .118 (8-for-68) with a .208 OBP, .221 SLG and .428 OPS in 18 games from May 7-31.
 ☞ Over his last 162 games, Buxton is hitting .272 (158-for-581) with 41 doubles, 52 home runs, 96 RBI, a .611 slugging percentage and a .932 OPS...he is the fourth player in Twins history (since 1961) to hit 50-plus homers in a 162-game span, joining Nelson Cruz, Roy Sievers and Harmon Killebrew (ESPN Stats & Info).

C4: Carlos Correa is hitting .368 (43-for-117) with nine doubles, four home runs, 18 RBI, 10 walks, a .422 on-base percentage, a .574 slugging percentage and a .969 OPS in his last 28 games, since April 28...he enters today hitting .299 on the season, the best through his first 44 games of a season, one point ahead of his .298 average through his first 44 of 2017.
 ☞ Since going 0-for-11 in his first three road games, he has reached safely in 19 of his last 20 away games, hitting .333 (27-for-81) with a .393 on-base percentage in that span.

TWO OUT OF THREE AIN'T BAD: The Twins have gone 11-5-4 in series play this season and 7-2-1 in their last 10...the Twins are seeking their first series win over the D-Backs since sweeping them in three games at Target Field from August 18-20, 2017...the Twins' last series win in IL Play came September 21-22, 2021, sweeping the Cubs in two games at Wrigley Field...series results on the season to right >>>

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: Outfielder/first baseman Alex Kirilloff and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher David Festa have been named the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ Kirilloff, who was recalled by the Twins from Triple-A St. Paul on Friday, played in five games for the Saints, hitting .474 (9-for-19) with one double, four home runs, nine RBI, a .565 on-base percentage, a 1.158 slugging percentage and a 1.723 OPS.
 ☞ Festa, 22, made one start for the Kernels on Wednesday vs. Dayton, allowing two runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched with no walks and five strikeouts...the Verona, NJ native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Seton Hall University...this marks his second weekly honor of 2022 after previously winning on May 15.

TYLER, THE CREATOR: Reliever Tyler Thornburg made his major league debut on this day in 2012, pitching for the Milwaukee Brewers...he made the start at Miller Park against Toronto, allowing five runs on seven hits in 5.1 innings pitched...his first strikeout was of Rajai Davis in the third inning...he has since appeared in 203 major league games with Milwaukee, Boston, Cincinnati, Atlanta and Minnesota.

ICYMI: Twins Hall-of-Famer and current Bally Sports North analyst Justin Morneau was inducted into the Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame yesterday...the New Westminster, Vancouver, British Columbia native was inducted along with Pedro Martínez, Duane Ward and Jeff Francis.

FATHER'S DAY/JUNETEENTH: Twins are 33-30 on Father's Day (since 1961)...they are also 30-22 on Juneteenth, since 1961.

- ☞ Making his team-leading 13th start of the season and 228th of his career...marks his 231st career appearance.
- ☞ Is 1-0, 1.29 ERA (14.0 IP, 2 ER) in three June starts (Twins are 2-1) and 1-1, 2.42 ERA (26.0 IP, 7 ER) in his last six trips to the mound (Twins are 4-2).
- ☞ Today marks his fourth career start and appearance against Arizona, but first since May 15, 2019 (with Pittsburgh)...is 1-1, 7.94 ERA (11.1 IP, 10 ER) lifetime against the Diamondbacks.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Delivered his third-straight strong start, and fifth in his last six efforts, in Monday's roadtrip opener at Seattle...did not factor in the decision, allowing one unearned run on four hits in 4.0 innings of a 3-2 Twins win (2 BB, 3 K)...was staked to a 2-0 lead on Byron Buxton's first-inning, two-run home run, and made that stand...yielded an unearned run in the third inning when Dylan Moore reached on a one-out catcher's interference and eventually scored...six Twins relievers combined for the final 5.0 innings, allowing just two hits and one run, to close out the victory.

- ☞ Induced his third groundball double play in his last two starts (in the first inning, off the bat of Ty France), after posting just one GIDP in his first 10 efforts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his first win in a Twins uniform June 8 at Target Field, holding New York-AL to one run on just two hits in a season-high-tying 5.0 innings of Minnesota's 8-1 victory (season-high 4 BB, with 2 K)...retired the Yankees in order in the first and third innings, while working around the four walks in the second and fourth frames...New York plated its lone run on a sacrifice fly in the fifth inning to draw within 2-1, but the Twins scored the game's final six runs, while Griffin Jax (2.0 IP), Emilio Pagan (1.0 IP) and Caleb Thielbar (1.0 IP) combined for 4.0 scoreless relief innings...induced a pair of groundball double plays (by Josh Donaldson in the second inning and Gleyber Torres in the fourth).

- ☞ Snapped a personal 11-start winless stretch, dating back to his last victory on September 4, 2021 against, ironically, the Twins (for Tampa Bay, at Tropicana Field).
- ☞ Combined with his 5.0-inning effort June 2 at Detroit, marked the first time he pitched at least 5.0 innings in consecutive starts since doing so in eight-straight from July 3-August 14, 2019 with Pittsburgh.

JUNE BOON CONTINUES STRONG STRETCH: In three June starts, Archer is 1-0, 1.29 ERA (14.0 IP, 2 ER) with seven walks, eight strikeouts and a .196/.309/.239 opponent slash line (9-for-46 with 2 2B and a HBP)...he has allowed one-or-zero earned runs in all three efforts, while the Twins are 2-1.

- ☞ Among American League starters with at least 14.0 innings pitched in June, he ranks third in ERA, seventh in opponent OPS and ninth in opponent batting average.
- ☞ Going back even further, Archer is 1-1, 2.42 ERA (26.0 IP, 7 ER) with 11 walks, 15 strikeouts and a .221/.312/.305 opponent slash line (21-for-95 with 8 2B and 2 HBP) in his last six starts (Twins are 4-2)...he has allowed one-or-zero earned runs in five of those six trips to the mound (since May 16).

BEWARE OF SNAKES: Archer is set to make his fourth career start and appearance against Arizona, but first since May 15, 2019 (with Pittsburgh)...is 1-1, 7.94 ERA (11.1 IP, 10 ER) lifetime against the Diamondbacks, with all three previous starts also coming here at Chase Field (also August 7, 2013 and June 6, 2016, both with Tampa Bay).

- ☞ Shouldered the 11-1 loss to Arizona and Zack Greinke in that May 15, 2019 contest here in the desert; Archer was knocked out in the fourth inning (3.2 IP, 4 H, 7 R/6 ER, 4 BB, 5 K).
- ☞ His lone career victory over the D-backs was also here at Chase Field on June 6, 2016, as he struck out 12 in 6.0 innings of a 6-4 Rays victory over Robbie Ray (5 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB).

INTERLEAGUE: Today's contest marks Archer's 27th career Interleague appearance (26th start) and second of 2022...is 7-11, 3.44 ERA (149.0 IP, 57 ER) lifetime, including 4.0 scoreless innings in a start April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL (ND; 2 H, 0 BB, 3 K in a 7-2 Twins loss).

- ☞ His last Interleague win was September 19, 2018 for Pittsburgh vs. Kansas City (7.0 IP, 6 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 8 K; Pirates won, 2-1); his last Interleague victory against a National League team was July 4, 2017 at Chicago, for Tampa Bay (6.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 8 K; Rays won, 6-5).
- ☞ Including his time with the Pirates, Archer is 11-21, 4.23 ERA (287.0 IP, 135 ER) in 53 career games (52 starts) against NL clubs.

A FEEL FOR THE ROAD: While he entered the 2022 season with dominant career numbers at Target Field, Archer has fared better on the road during his inaugural Twins campaign.

- ☞ Has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his six road starts this season, going 0-0, 2.49 ERA (25.1 IP, 7 ER), 11 walks, 23 strikeouts and a .215/.305/.398 opponent slash line (20-for-93, with 5 2B and 4 HR)...has departed all six of his road efforts with the Twins either tied or ahead (Minnesota is 3-3).
- ☞ In six home efforts, he is 1-2, 4.30 ERA (23.0 IP, 11 ER) with a .247/.337/.404 opponent slash line (22-for-89 with 8 2B and 2 HR)...has left with the Twins behind in three of those games.

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD: After allowing a solo home run to Houston's Jose Altuve leading off the third inning of his start May 11 - marking the fifth-straight outing he had yielded a longball (six total, all solo) - Archer has kept the last 117 batters he has faced in the yard...that stretch spans the final seven batters faced in the Astros game and his last six starts.

SOFT CONTACT: Archer has allowed an average exit velocity of just 89.2 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (besting the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .255 opponent batting average on balls in play would be the second lowest of his career, just higher than the .254 mark of his 2013 rookie campaign; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

THE ARSENAL: Archer has upped his changeup and curveball usage the last nine starts, throwing those 21.7 percent of the time (138 of 636 pitches), per Baseball Savant...just 3.5 percent of his pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed over his first three efforts...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

- ☞ His velocity has been up thus far in 2022, when compared with his 2021 numbers...he has averaged 93.1 mph on the fastball and 88.6 mph on the slider this season, as opposed to 92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year.
- ☞ Opponents are a combined 25-for-128 (.195) with nine doubles, two homers and 31 strikeouts against Archer's slider, changeup and curveball; they are hitting .315 (17-for-54) with three doubles, four home runs and six strikeouts against his fastball...however, opponents are 2-for-17 (.118) with no extra-base hits off Archer's fastball in June.

TUESDAY'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2022 SEASON- 5-3, 2.81 ERA // CAREER- 7-4, 3.25 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is scheduled to start Tuesday's series and homestand opener vs. Cleveland at Target Field...reinstated from the COVID IL to start June 14 at Seattle, his first appearance since May 21...tossed 3.0 hitless innings to open the game; surrendered a pair of two-run home runs and shouldered the 5-0 loss (4.2 IP, 5 H, 4 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K)...is 2-0, 1.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER) in three career starts against the Guardians, allowing one-or-fewer earned runs in each...earned a 3-1 victory May 15 at Target Field opposite Triston McKenzie (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 5 K, career-high 103 pitches).
