THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip, all against the Tigers...today, the Twins will play the five-game series finale in Detroit at Comerica Park...following this afternoon's game, the Twins will fly to Toronto to begin a three-game weekend series against the Blue Jays, starting tomorrow night...the Twins are 17-11 at home and 13-11 on the road.

☞ The Twins are looking to avoid losing back-to-back games on the road, which would mark the fourth time this season, first since May 4-5 at Baltimore...are also looking to avoid just their second three-game losing streak of the season (also May 10-12).

TWINS TAKE THE UNDER, TIGERS TAKE THE OBER: The Twins were shut out by the Tigers last night at Comerica Park 5-0, suffering their second-straight shutout loss and MLB-most seventh of the season...Bailey Ober (1-2) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on nine hits in 6.0 innings pitched, four of the runs coming in the fifth inning...Trevor Megill pitched 2.0 perfect innings of relief with three strikeouts...the offense recorded just two hits, a pair of singles by Jorge Polanco and Gio Urshela.

☞ The Twins were shut out in consecutive games for the first time since April 20, 2021 at Oakland, when they were held scoreless in both games of a doubleheader.

☞ The Twins' last run scored came in the seventh inning in Game 1 of the doubleheader on Tuesday...they are scoreless in 20 innings since, with just seven hits.

TWINS-TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 11th of 19 meetings in 2022...Twins are 6-4 against Detroit this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 1-3 at Comerica Park...they began the season 5-0 against the Tigers, but have since gone 1-4...these two teams will meet again for a two-game series at Comerica Park from July 23-24.

☞ The Twins have won 23 of their last 36 over the Tigers and 28 of their last 44.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .296 (107-for-361) with 18 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 54 RBI, 27 walks and an .814 OPS in 93 career games against the Tigers...he has reached base safely in 24 of his last 25 Detroit...Polanco is hitting .308 (56-for-182) with six home runs, 13 walks, a .357 on-base percentage and an .818 OPS in 47 career games at Comerica.

☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .333 (34-for-102) with six doubles, two home runs, 15 RBI, 11 walks and a .404 on-base percentage in 34 career games vs. Detroit...he is 14-for-31 (.452) with four walks and a .514 on-base percentage in nine games against the Tigers this season.

☞ Max Kepler is 8-for-25 (.320) with two doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, five walks, a .433 on-base percentage, an .880 slugging percentage and a 1.313 OPS in seven games against the Tigers this season...he has two home runs and 13 RBI against the rest of the league.

CENTRAL HEATING: Today marks the Twins' final game in a 15-game stretch against divisional opponents, going 8-6 in that span...they have gone 17-9 against the AL Central this season, going 6-4 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 6-4 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland...starting tomorrow night, the Twins will begin a stretch of nine straight against the AL East, playing three at Toronto (June 3-5), three vs. New York-AL (June 7-9) and three vs. Tampa Bay (June 10-12)...below are the hitting and pitching numbers for the Twins against each of the three AL divisions:

EMP-LUEY OF THE MONTH: Since the beginning of May, Luis Arraez is hitting .376 (32-for-85) with 16 walks and a .480 on-base percentage...in that span, he ranks first in baseball in on-base percentage and fifth in batting average.

☞ Since returning from the COVID IL on May 12, he is hitting .400 (30-for-75) with 14 walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a .940 OPS in 20 games.

☞ On the season, Arraez is hitting .351 (52-for-148), the fourth-highest average in the AL and fifth highest in baseball, trailing only J.D. Martinez (.360), Tim Anderson (.356), Ty France (.355) and Paul Goldschmidt (.353)...additionally, he has posted a .442 on-base percentage, the highest in baseball.

BROUGHT TO YOU BY THE LETTER G: Gio Urshela is hitting .339 (20-for-59) with two doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, seven walks, a .403 on-base percentage, a .576 slugging percentage and a .979 OPS in his last 17 games, since May 14...since that date, he is tied for fourth in the AL in RBI, while ranking ninth in OPS and 10th in batting average.

LARNACH ON WOOD: Trevor Larnach is hitting .318 (21-for-66) with nine doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, 15 runs scored, 10 walks, a .403 on-base percentage, a .591 slugging percentage and a .994 OPS in his last 21 games...additionally, he has reached safely in 13 of his last 28 plate appearances.

☞ Since the start of May, he has posted a 1.018 OPS, fifth best in the AL and ninth in baseball (minimum 60 plate appearances).

DAY MEN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHT MEN: The Twins have played day games in four of their last six games (2-2)...three of their next four games will be day games, through the end of this trip...the Twins have played 25 day games this season, tied for fourth most in baseball...they have gone 16-9 in day games, tied with New York-AL (16-8) for the most day wins in baseball.

EARS PERK UP: Former All-Star catcher Tim Laudner will join Dan Gladden in the radio booth for the second-consecutive game today...former All-Star closer Glen Perkins will join Gladden this weekend for the three-game series against the Blue Jays...all games will be broadcast from the John Gordon Radio Booth at Target Field.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1986, Rod Carew announced his retirement from baseball at the age of 40...Carew retired with a .328 career batting average, compiled over 19 major league seasons...he was elected into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1991.

- ☞ Making his 10th start of the season and 225th of his career...228th career appearance.
- ☞ Today marks his 13th career start and appearance against Detroit, and second of 2022...is 2-3, 3.57 ERA (63.0 IP, 25 ER) lifetime against the Tigers, including a no-decision on May 23 at Target Field (4.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K; Twins won, 5-4).
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Shouldered his second loss of the season in a start last Saturday vs. Kansas City...allowing a season-high-tying five runs (3 earned) on a season-worst seven hits in 4.0 innings of the Twins' 7-3 setback at Target Field...was undone by a combo of hard contact and bad luck, beginning in the third inning when Bobby Witt Jr.'s two-out double got momentarily lodged under the padding of the leftfield wall, allowing a run to score...the Royals' three-run uprising with two outs in the fourth was aided by an Emmanuel Rivera single that left the bat at 68.0 mph and a throwing error by Jorge Polanco that extended the frame.

- ☞ Allowed three hits (2 doubles) in six at-bats with runners in scoring position, after holding opponents to a .111 mark (3-for-27; all singles) over his first eight starts.
- ☞ The loss snapped the Twins' two-game winning streak in Archer starts (May 16 at Oakland and May 23 vs. Detroit), during which he fashioned a 2.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 2 ER).
- ☞ Archer did not walk a batter for the third time this season (also, April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL and May 5 at Baltimore), while he extending his streak of not allowing a home run to three-straight starts (had surrendered a longball in his previous five).

TWO STARTS AGO: Turned in his second-straight effective start on May 23 in a, 5-4 walk-off win vs. these Detroit Tigers at Target Field...held the Tigers to one run on three hits over 4.0 innings, with two walks, one hit batter and four strikeouts...the Twins jumped out to a 4-0, first-inning lead on Max Kepler's grand slam; after Detroit scored in the seventh to tie it, Minnesota walked it off on Gio Urshela's ninth-inning, RBI infield single.

1400 STRIKEOUTS ON THE HORIZON: Archer enters this afternoon's start with 1399 career strikeouts and, with just one in this game, would become the 22nd active pitcher and 250th in American/National League history (since 1901) to reach the 1400 plateau (per Statspazz).

- ☞ Has compiled his 1399 strikeouts in 1288.2 innings pitched, good for an average of 9.77 punchouts per 9.0 innings...fanned 1167 batters with Tampa Bay (2nd in franchise history) and 203 with Pittsburgh, while posting 29 strikeouts thus far in his first season in Minnesota.
- ☞ Despite spending half of the 2018 season and all of the 2019 campaign in the National League, before missing 2020, he still ranks sixth in the American League with 1160 strikeouts since 2013, his first full season...is fifth in the Junior Circuit over the same stretch by averaging 9.60 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched.

TIGER TAMER: Archer is set to make his 13th career start and appearance against Detroit, and his second of 2022 (both within the last 11 days)...is 2-3, 3.57 ERA (63.0 IP, 25 ER) in his first 12 efforts.

- ☞ Worked 4.0 innings in a no-decision May 23 vs. Detroit at Target Field (3 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K) in a 5-4, walk-off win for the Twins...for more information, please see "TWO STARTS AGO" note above.
- ☞ His teams have won five of his last six starts against Detroit dating back to April 19, 2017...stretch includes his last personal victory over the Tigers, a 3-2 decision for the Tampa Bay Rays on June 17, 2017 here at Comerica Park (6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 8 K).
- ☞ Including that June 17, 2017 win, is 2-2, 4.28 ERA (27.1 IP, 13 ER) in five career outings at Comerica...his last start here was a no-decision on September 11, 2021, as he worked the first 4.0 innings of the Rays' 7-2 victory (2 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 2 K).

A FEEL FOR THE ROAD: While he entered the 2022 season with dominant career numbers at Target Field, Archer has fared better on the road during his inaugural Twins campaign.

- ☞ In four road starts, he is 0-0, 3.31 ERA (16.1 IP, 6 ER), eight walks, 17 strikeouts and a .210/.300/.468 opponent slash line (13-for-62, with 4 2B and 4 HR)...has departed all four of his road efforts with the Twins either tied or ahead (Minnesota is 2-2).
- ☞ In five home efforts, he is 0-2, 5.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 10 ER) with a .270/.345/.446 opponent slash line (20-for-74 with 7 2B and 2 HR)...has left with the Twins behind in three of those games.

MAY'S FLOWERS WERE A MIXED BOUQUET: After pitching to a 2.93 ERA (15.1 IP, 5 ER) in four April starts, Archer scuffled to a 5.21 mark (19.0 IP, 11 ER) in five May outings...he did, however, mix the good (season-high 6 K in 4.0 IP on May 5 at Baltimore; back-to-back 4.0 IP/1 R outings May 16 at Oakland and May 23 vs. Detroit) with the bad (5 R/4 ER in 3.0 IP on May 11 vs. Houston and 5 R/3 ER on May 28 vs. Kansas City).

SOFT CONTACT: Archer has allowed opponents an average exit velocity of just 88.5 mph, which would stand as a career-best mark over a full season (besting the 89.4 mph of his 2019 campaign)...his current .265 opponent batting average on balls in play would also be the lowest of his career, better than the .254 mark of his 2013 rookie campaign; in fact, his lowest full-season BABIP since is .297 in 2015.

THE ARSENAL: Archer has upped his changeup and curveball usage the last six starts, throwing those 21.4 percent of the time (95 of 442 pitches), per Baseball Savant...just 3.5 percent of his pitches (7 of 200) were offspeed over his first three efforts...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:
