Twins have gone 34-22 since April 21, fourth-most in baseball since that date, trailing

**THAT'S NOT OUR BUDDY:** The Twins lost to the Diamondbacks on Sunday afternoon at Chase Field by a score of 7-1...Chris Archer (1-3) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts...Caleb Thielbar allowed four runs in relief, including a grand slam to Buddy Kennedy, the first allowed by a Twins pitcher this season...the offense recorded five hits, including two from Jose Miranda, both singles...the Twins reached 300 runs scored on the season, the 13th team in baseball to do so.

TWINS AND GUARDIANS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the fourth of 19 meetings in 2022...their last series came May 13-15 at Target Field as the Twins won the first and third games of the three-game series...eight of the next 11 games will be against the Guardians... the Twins' first trip to Progressive Field this season will be in a five-game series next week from Monday-Thursday (scheduled doubleheader on Tuesday).

▼ The Twins have won five of their last six series vs. Cleveland, dating back to May of 2021.

▼ Since the start of 2020, 25 of the 32 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 15 have been decided by two runs-or-less.

▼ Gio Urshela is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with four home runs, seven RBI and a 1.111 OPS in his last seven games against the Guardians...he made his major league debut with Cleveland on June 9, 2015 and played parts of two seasons there in 2015 and '17, hitting .225 (95-for-423) with 15 doubles, seven home runs and 36 RBI in 148 games.

**NOTE:** Arraez is leading off for the 23rd time this season...he has led off in 10 of the Twins last 14 games... he is hitting .379 (33-for-87) from the leadoff spot this season...he is hitting .452 (19-for-42) with a .500 on-base percentage in 2022 when hitting in the first inning.

BYE BYE BYRON: Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with three doubles, eight home runs, 12 RBI, seven walks, a .400 on-base percentage, an .827 slugging percentage and a 1.227 OPS in 14 games this month...he enters today with 19 home runs, tie for third-most in baseball with Pete Alonso and Anthony Rizzo, trailing Aaron Judge (25) and Mike Trout (21). 

▼ Buxton's 19 home runs match his single season career-high, done in 2021...he has homered seven times in his last 10 games and in eight times in his last 13 games.

**EXIT SIGNS:** The Twins enter today with an average exit velocity of 90.0 mph, the third-highest in baseball, trailing New York-AL (90.4 mph) and Toronto (90.3 mph)...among individuals with a minimum of 750 pitches seen, Carlos Correa (92.3 mph) ranks 11th in the AL and Byron Buxton (91.9 mph) ranks 14th.

**BALLOT BOX:** Major League Baseball released its first All-Star ballot update this afternoon... Byron Buxton ranks sixth among AL outfielders with 403,050 votes, Luis Arraez fourth among first basemen with 307,442 votes, Gary Sánchez ranks sixth among catchers with 168,340 votes, Jorge Polanco ranks sixth among second basemen with 137,032 votes, Carlos Correa ranks sixth among shortstops with 186,403 votes, Gio Urshela ranks seventh among third basemen with 124,800 votes, and Kyle Garlick ranks eighth among designated hitters with 77,698 votes...the next ASG balloting update will be on Monday, June 27.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was reinstated from the Covid Injured List to start June 14 at Seattle, his first major league appearance since May 21...tossed 4.2 innings and allowed four earned runs on five hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...looked to be his typical, sharp self as he threw 3.0 hitless innings to the war and the time strikeouts...tode to be instypical, sharp sen as he threw 3.0 intest nillings to defeat...matched a season-high with four earned runs allowed on two homers (Eugenio Suárez in the 4th inning and Ty France in the 5th).

Marked just the second start of his career allowing multiple homers, also occuring on September 30, 2021 vs. Detroit (2).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Earned the win on May 21 at Kansas City...yielded one run on five hits over 5.2 innings, with two walks and six strikeouts...stranded one base runner in the first, second and third innings and went one-two-three in the fourth and fifth...exited with the bases loaded in favor of Caleb Thielbar in the sixth...Thielbar stranded all three inherited runners and the Twins capped the game with a four-run ninth inning for a 9-2 win over the Royals.

This 72 career strikeouts were second most by a Twins pitcher through his first 13 starts, trailing only Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven, who had 75 strikeouts through his first 13 career starts in 1970.

FAMILIAR FOE: Ryan is slated to make his second start of the season and third of his career against the Guardians...started against Cleveland on May 15 at Target Field opposite Triston McKenzie, earning the 3-1 win (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 5 S0)...is **2-0, 1.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER) in three career starts against the Guardians, allowing one-or-fewer earned runs** in each...has faced Cleveland more than any other opponent in his career (has started against Chicago-NL, Detroit and Kansas City twice each).

GETTING BACK ON TARGET: Making his fifth start at Target Field this season...has gone 2-2, 3.00 ERA (21.0 IP, 7 ER) with 10 walks and 21 strikeouts at home...this compares to 3-1, 2.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 8 ER) with five walks and 24 strikeouts in five starts on the road.

TAKING THE NIGHT SHIFT: Is starting under the lights for the sixth time this season...has a 2-2 record. 3.81 ERA (26.0 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 24 strikeouts in his five prior night starts...this compares to 3-1, 1.64 ERA (22.0 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and 21 strikeouts in four day starts.

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 45 batters so far, which will lead to 2,250 new trees planted.

- THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: Below are some facts that summarize Ryan's career to date.

  ♣ Ryan has 75 career strikeouts through his first 14 games, third most in Twins/Senators history behind Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (78 in 1970) and Tyler Duffey (76 from 2015-16)...the record for most strikeouts in the first 15 career games is 78, shared by Blyleven and Duffey.

  ♣ His .185 opponent batting average through his first 14 career games is second lowest in Twins/ Senators history (min. 65.0 IP), behind George Dumont (.172 from 1915-16).

  ♣ Owns a 3.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio (75 K, 20 BB) through his first 13 career outings, fourth best in Twins/Senators history (min. 65.0 IP), behind Kevin Slowey (4.45 from 2007-08) and Doc Avers (4.36 from 1913-14).
  - Doc Ayers (4.36 from 1913-14).

    ♣ Ryan posted a 0.74 WHIP through his first nine career starts, the lowest WHIP by any MLB pitcher through his first nine career starts since Hall of Famer Christy Mathewson from 1900-01 (0.70) (Stats Perform).
  - Rvan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games (from September 1-22, 2021), the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so.
  - The became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.
