**THE TWINS:** Completed their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 3-3, going 2-1 in Seattle and 1-2 in Arizona...tonight, they will begin a six-game homestand with the first of three against the Guardians through Thursday...following this series, the Twins will host the Rockies for three over the weekend...Twins are 20-14 at home and 18-16 on the road.  
 ☞ Twins have gone 34-22 since April 21, fourth-most in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL (43-12), New York-NL (36-20) and Houston (35-19).

**THAT'S NOT OUR BUDDY:** The Twins lost to the Diamondbacks on Sunday afternoon at Chase Field by a score of 7-1...Chris Archer (1-3) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts...Caleb Thielbar allowed four runs in relief, including a grand slam to Buddy Kennedy, the first tied by a Twins pitcher this season...the offense recorded five hits, including two from Jose Miranda, both singles...the Twins reached 300 runs scored on the season, the 13th team in baseball to do so.

**TWINS AND GUARDIANS:** The Twins are playing the Guardians for the fourth of 19 meetings in 2022...their last series came May 13-15 at Target Field as the Twins won the first and third games of the three-game series...eight of the next 11 games will be against the Guardians...the Twins' first trip to Progressive Field this season will be in a five-game series next week from Monday-Thursday (scheduled doubleheader on Tuesday).

☞ The Twins have won five of their last six series vs. Cleveland, dating back to May of 2021.  
 ☞ Since the start of 2020, 25 of the 32 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 15 have been decided by two runs-or-less.

☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with four home runs, seven RBI and a 1.111 OPS in his last seven games against the Guardians...he made his major league debut with Cleveland on June 9, 2015 and played parts of two seasons there in 2015 and '17, hitting .225 (95-for-423) with 15 doubles, seven home runs and 36 RBI in 148 games.

**CENTRAL HEATING:** Starting tonight, the Twins will play an AL Central opponent in 11 of their next 17 games, and in 15 of their next 26 leading up to the All-Star break...they have gone 17-10 against the AL Central this season, going 6-4 against Kansas City, 3-0 against Chicago-AL, 6-5 against Detroit and 2-1 against Cleveland.

**ARRAEZ-ING TO THE TOP:** Luis Arraez enters today leading baseball in both batting average and on-base percentage...below are his rankings in a few offensive categories:

**NOTE:** Arraez is leading off for the 23rd time this season...he has led off in 10 of the Twins last 14 games...he is hitting .379 (33-for-87) from the leadoff spot this season...he is hitting .452 (19-for-42) with a .500 on-base percentage in 2022 when hitting in the first inning.

**BYE BYE BYRON:** Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with three doubles, eight home runs, 12 RBI, seven walks, a .400 on-base percentage, an .827 slugging percentage and a 1.227 OPS in 14 games this month...he enters today with 19 home runs, tie for third-most in baseball with Pete Alonso and Anthony Rizzo, trailing Aaron Judge (25) and Mike Trout (21).  
 ☞ Buxton's 19 home runs match his single season career-high, done in 2021...he has homered seven times in his last 10 games and in eight times in his last 13 games.

**EXIT SIGNS:** The Twins enter today with an average exit velocity of 90.0 mph, the third-highest in baseball, trailing New York-AL (90.4 mph) and Toronto (90.3 mph)...among individuals with a minimum of 750 pitches seen, Carlos Correa (92.3 mph) ranks 11th in the AL and Byron Buxton (91.9 mph) ranks 14th.

**BALLOT BOX:** Major League Baseball released its first All-Star ballot update this afternoon...Byron Buxton ranks sixth among AL outfielders with 403,050 votes, Luis Arraez fourth among first basemen with 307,442 votes, Gary Sanchez ranks sixth among catchers with 168,340 votes, Jorge Polanco ranks sixth among second basemen with 137,032 votes, Carlos Correa ranks sixth among shortstops with 186,403 votes, Gio Urshela ranks seventh among third basemen with 124,800 votes, and Kyle Garlick ranks eighth among designated hitters with 77,698 votes...the next ASG balloting update will be on Monday, June 27.

**MR. BASEBALL/MS. SOFTBALL:** Play Ball! Minnesota and the Minnesota All Sports Alliance are proud to announce the winners of the 2022 Play Ball! Minnesota Mr. Baseball and Ms. Softball awards...Mr. Baseball is Maddox Mihalakis, an infielder from Hopkins High School who has committed to the University of Arizona...Ms. Softball is Sydney Schwartz, a right-handed pitcher from Chanhassen High School who has committed to the University of Minnesota...award finalists and winners, which represent the finest senior players in the state, were selected by a panel of high school and college coaches...athletic and character attributes, as well as season accomplishments, were considered by award voters...Mihalakis and Schwartz were recognized during a ceremony earlier this afternoon at Target Field and will be honored by the Twins by throwing out a first pitch before an upcoming 2022 home game.

- ☞ Twins have a .744 OPS against right-handed pitching, compared to a .707 OPS against left-handed pitching.
- ☞ In his last 22 games, Jose Miranda is hitting .343 (24-for-70) with seven doubles, three home runs and a .933 OPS.
- ☞ In his last 29 games, Carlos Correa is hitting .355 (43-for-121) with a .409 on-base percentage and a .938 OPS.
- ☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .370 (44-for-119) with a 1.154 OPS in his last 31 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was reinstated from the Covid Injured List to start June 14 at Seattle, his first major league appearance since May 21...tossed 4.2 innings and allowed four earned runs on five hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...looked to be his typical, sharp self as he threw 3.0 hitless innings to start the game before he fatigued and allowed a pair of two-run blasts that sent the Twins to a 5-0 defeat...matched a season-high with four earned runs allowed on two homers (Eugenio Suárez in the 4th inning and Ty France in the 5th).

- ☞ Marked just the second start of his career allowing multiple homers, also occurring on September 30, 2021 vs. Detroit (2).
- ☞ His velocity topped at 93.7 mph in the first inning but his hardest pitch registered at 89.2 mph in his final game...his average fastball velocity by inning is as follows; first inning - 92.5 mph, second inning - 91.2 mph, third inning - 90.0 mph, fourth inning 90.4 mph, fifth inning - 88.5 mph.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Earned the win on May 21 at Kansas City...yielded one run on five hits over 5.2 innings, with two walks and six strikeouts...stranded one base runner in the first, second and third innings and went one-two-three in the fourth and fifth...exited with the bases loaded in favor of Caleb Thielbar in the sixth...Thielbar stranded all three inherited runners and the Twins capped the game with a four-run ninth inning for a 9-2 win over the Royals.

- ☞ His 72 career strikeouts were second most by a Twins pitcher through his first 13 starts, trailing only Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven, who had 75 strikeouts through his first 13 career starts in 1970.

**FAMILIAR FOE:** Ryan is slated to make his second start of the season and third of his career against the Guardians...started against Cleveland on May 15 at Target Field opposite Triston McKenzie, earning the 3-1 win (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 5 SO)...is 2-0, 1.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER) in three career starts against the Guardians, allowing one-or-fewer earned runs in each...has faced Cleveland more than any other opponent in his career (has started against Chicago-NL, Detroit and Kansas City twice each).

**GETTING BACK ON TARGET:** Making his fifth start at Target Field this season...has gone 2-2, 3.00 ERA (21.0 IP, 7 ER) with 10 walks and 21 strikeouts at home...this compares to 3-1, 2.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 8 ER) with five walks and 24 strikeouts in five starts on the road.

- ☞ Has performed better on the road throughout his career, going 5-1, 2.31 ERA (39.0 IP, 10 ER) with six walks and 39 strikeouts in seven starts...is a career 2-3, 4.29 ERA (35.2 IP, 17 ER) with 14 walks and 36 strikeouts in starts at Target Field.

**TAKING THE NIGHT SHIFT:** Is starting under the lights for the sixth time this season...has a 2-2 record, 3.81 ERA (26.0 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 24 strikeouts in his five prior night starts...this compares to 3-1, 1.64 ERA (22.0 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and 21 strikeouts in four day starts.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball - he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 57.4% of the time through his first nine starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

**MAKING THE LORAX PROUD:** In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 45 batters so far, which will lead to 2,250 new trees planted.

**THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE:** Below are some facts that summarize Ryan's career to date.

- ☞ Ryan has 75 career strikeouts through his first 14 games, third most in Twins/Senators history behind Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (78 in 1970) and Tyler Duffey (76 from 2015-16)...the record for most strikeouts in the first 15 career games is 78, shared by Blyleven and Duffey.
- ☞ His .185 opponent batting average through his first 14 career games is second lowest in Twins/Senators history (min. 65.0 IP), behind George Dumont (.172 from 1915-16).
- ☞ Owns a 3.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio (75 K, 20 BB) through his first 13 career outings, fourth best in Twins/Senators history (min. 65.0 IP), behind Kevin Slowey (4.45 from 2007-08) and Doc Ayers (4.36 from 1913-14).
- ☞ Ryan posted a 0.74 WHIP through his first nine career starts, the lowest WHIP by any MLB pitcher through his first nine career starts since Hall of Famer Christy Mathewson from 1900-01 (0.70) (*Stats Perform*).
- ☞ Ryan worked at least 5.0 innings and allowed four-or-fewer base runners in each of his first four career games (from September 1-22, 2021), the only pitcher in baseball history (1901-present) to do so.
- ☞ He became one of two pitchers in MLB history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings and allow three-or-fewer hits in each of his first four career games (September 1-22, 2021), alongside San Francisco's Matt Cain, who did so in 2005.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY [2022 SEASON: 3-1, 2.09 ERA // CAREER: 85-73, 3.56 ERA]

Right-hander Sonny Gray is scheduled to start tomorrow night's game against the Cleveland Guardians at Target Field...was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to his last start on June 15 in Seattle...took a no-decision, tossing the first 5.0 innings (3 H, 0 BB, 3 K) of a 5-0 Twins shutout win...marked his third career start of at least 5.0 shutout innings and no walks allowed (also, September 28, 2014 at Texas and May 24, 2015 at Tampa Bay)...slated to face Cleveland for the second time this season, after a no-decision on May 13 at Target Field (4.1 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 8 K - Twins won, 12-8)...will be making his 13th career start and appearance against the Guardians, going 5-3, 3.28 ERA (68.2 IP, 25 ER) with 29 walks and 75 strikeouts in his prior outings.
