- ☞ Acquired by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on June 15 at Seattle...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits with no walks and three strikeouts in a 5-0 Twins victory... was his first start since being placed on the 15-day Injured List on June 2 (right pectoral strain)... marked his eighth consecutive start with two-or-fewer runs allowed and fourth consecutive with one-or-fewer walks (for more information, please see "Winning the Battle" below).

TWO STARTS AGO: Secured his third-consecutive win on May 29 vs. Kansas City at Target Field...tossed 6.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits with no walks and four strikeouts in a 7-3 Twins victory... pitched 6.0 scoreless innings, while retiring 15 consecutive batters before allowing a leadoff single in the seventh inning...marked his third consecutive start of 6.0+ innings and seventh-straight start with two-or-fewer runs allowed...left the game in the seventh inning after experiencing discomfort in his right pectoral muscle...was placed on the 15-day Injured List with a right pectoral strain on June 2.

WINNING THE BATTLE: His eight consecutive starts of two-or-fewer runs allowed mark the second-longest streak in his career, trailing the 11 straight he accomplished from June 25-August 26, 2017 (with Oakland/New York-AL)...his streak of two-or-fewer runs allowed in eight-straight starts also marks the longest streak to start a season by a starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-present), surpassing Jim Kaat (7 from April 29-May 28, 1972) and John Butcher (7 from April 7-May 15, 1984).

☞ The Twins have now won each of his last six starts dating back to May 7, marking the longest streak for a Twins starter this season...has gone 3-0, 1.39 ERA (32.1 IP, 5 ER) with seven walks, 37 strikeouts and a .179 opponent batting average (21-for-117) in that span.

THERE'S NO GUARDING GRAY: Is making is 13th career start against Cleveland this evening and second this season...his first start this season came on May 13, where he took a no decision into the fifth inning, tossing 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on four hits with four walks and eight strikeouts in a 12-8 Twins victory at Target Field...is 5-3, 3.28 ERA (68.2 IP, 25 ER) with 29 walks and 75 strikeouts in 12 career starts against the Guardians...has allowed two-or-fewer runs with six-or-more strikeouts in five consecutive starts vs. Cleveland, going 2-1, 3.04 ERA (26.2 IP, 9 ER) with 13 walks and 35 strikeouts in that span.

SONNY DAYS AT HOME: Is making his sixth start at Target Field this season and first since May 29 vs. Kansas City...is 2-0, 1.73 ERA (26.0 IP, 5 ER) with nine walks, 33 strikeouts and a .172 batting average (16-for-93) at home this season...this compares to a 1-1, 2.84 ERA (12.2 IP, 4 ER) with one walk and nine strikeouts in three road starts this season.

☞ Has shown consistent numbers when at home and on the road over his career...has posted a 37-37 record, 3.21 ERA (619.1 IP, 221 ER), with 232 walks and 607 strikeouts in 110 career appearances (105 starts) on the road...has gone 48-36, 3.88 ERA (686.2 IP, 296 ER) with 231 walks and 656 strikeouts in 121 appearances (117 starts) at his home ballpark.

☞ His 1.73 home ERA this season ranks sixth-lowest among American League starters (min. 5 starts).

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: This season, Gray has posted a .180 opponent average (11-for-63) with two walks and 18 strikeouts against left-handed hitters...has a .188 batting average (15-for-80) with eight walks and 24 strikeouts against right-handed hitters.

☞ In his career, Gray has limited left-handers to a .223 batting average (538-for-2415) with 637 strikeouts and right-handed hitters to a .236 batting average (581-for-2466) with 626 strikeouts.

☞ Gray's .151 opponent batting average against left-handers ranks eighth-lowest in the American League among right-handed starting pitchers (min. 60 opponent at-bats).

☞ His .184 (26-for-141) opponent batting average overall ranks second-lowest in the American League among starters with at least eight starts this season...trails only Chicago-AL's Michael Kopech (.158)

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...24 of his 37 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .115 (3-for-26) against his curveball, which ranks sixth-lowest among American League starters (min. 25 at-bats)...here's a look at his repertoire.

- Acquired by Minnesota on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.
- Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

SONNY AND HOT STREAK: Won three consecutive starts from May 18-29...is the third Twins starter this season to have won three consecutive starts, joining Dylan Bundy (April 11-April 23) and Joe Ryan (April 15-April 27)...the Twins have also won in each of his last six starts dating back to May 7, marking it the longest streak by a Twins starter this season; the Twins have also won in four consecutive starts for Joe Ryan (April 15-May 3) and Bailey Ober (April 22-May 27).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP DEVIN SMELTZER (2022 SEASON: 3-1, 3.52 ERA // CAREER: 7-3, 4.00 ERA)

Left-hander Devin Smeltzer is scheduled to start the series finale tomorrow against the Guardians...is coming off his first loss of the season after tossing 4.1 innings, allowing a season-high seven runs (six earned) on nine hits with two walks and three strikeouts, in a 7-2 Twins defeat against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field on June 17...tomorrow will mark his seventh career appearance (fifth start) vs. the Guardians and second this season...took a no decision against Cleveland in his season debut on May 14 (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 2 K), a 3-2, 10-inning Twins defeat at Target Field...is career 1-2, 5.33 ERA (25.2 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks and 16 strikeouts against the Guardians.
