**THE TWINS:** The Twins began their six-game homestand with a 2-1 series loss to the Guardians this week, losing the first two and winning the third game...tonight, the Twins will begin a three-game series against the Rockies over the weekend...Twins are 21-16 at home and 18-16 on the road.

**FLASH GORDON MAKING "LONG TOM" HUGHES PROUD:** The Twins beat the Guardians yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 1-0, snapping their three-game losing streak and winning for the first time since last Saturday at Arizona...Devin Smeltzer (4-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, no walks and three strikeouts...Joe Smith (1.0), Jhoan Duran (1.1) and Caleb Thielbar (0.2) combined for 3.0 scoreless innings of relief, as Thielbar earned his first career save...the offense recorded just five hits with the game's only run coming on a Nick Gordon solo home run in the third inning, Gordon's second homer of the season.

☞ According to *Elias*, Gordon is the second player in Twins/Senators franchise history (1901-present) to start in the ninth spot in the batting order and hit a home run in a 1-0 victory...the first was pitcher "Long Tom" Hughes, who connected in the 10th inning in a road win by the Washington Senators over the St. Louis Browns on August 3, 1906.

☞ It marked the second time this season that the Twins have won on a solo home run, the other being May 7 vs. Oakland (Jorge Polanco)...it ties the 1971 and 1963 Twins for the second-most 1-0 wins via solo home run in a season, with the most being from the 2011 Twins (3 times).

**ROC MILESTONES:** Rocco Baldelli needs one win to reach 250 managerial victories in his career...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

**IL PLAY:** The Twins are 1-4 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-2 against the Dodgers at Target Field from April 12-13 and 1-2 against the D-Backs at Chase Field last weekend...after this series, the remaining IL schedule is: Milwaukee at Target Field from July 12-13 and at American Family Field from July 26-27, San Diego at Petco Park from July 29-31, Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10, and San Francisco at Target Field from August 26-28...Twins all-time IL wins ranks in lower right.

☞ Max Kepler is hitting .400 (14-for-35) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, six walks, a .488 OBP, a .686 SLG and a 1.174 OPS in his last 10 IL games.

**TWINS-ROX:** The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 16th time in their history...the Twins have gone 8-7 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 3-3 at Coors Field (2008, '14) and 3-3 at Target Field (2010, '17)...these two last played a three-game series from May 16-18, 2017 at Target Field as the Rockies won the first two games and the Twins won the third.

☞ Just three Twins on the active roster played in the last series with Colorado in 2017: Byron Buxton, Max Kepler and Tyler Duffey.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .393 (24-for-61) with seven doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, a .456 on-base percentage, a .656 slugging percentage and a 1.112 OPS in 16 career games against the Rockies.

☞ Twins assistant bench coach, Tony Diaz, coached and managed in the Rockies organization from 2000-18.

**OFFENSIVE COORDINATORS:** Twins are hitting .251 (598-for-2381) with 83 home runs, a .412 slugging percentage and a .735 OPS this season...among AL teams, they rank third in hits, fourth in batting average, walks and OPS, and fifth in slugging percentage.

**C4:** After going 3-for-4 yesterday, Carlos Correa is hitting .363 (49-for-135) with 10 doubles, six home runs, 20 RBI, 10 walks, a .411 on-base percentage, a .570 slugging percentage and a .981 OPS in his last 32 games, since April 28.

☞ Correa has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 home games...on the season, he is hitting .323 (32-for-99) in 24 games at Target Field.

☞ He has a 92.5 mph average exit velocity this season, the highest of his career and 11th in the AL...his hard hit rate is at 52.1%, also a career-high, which is up from 42.7% in 2021, a 9.4% increase...his 2022 hard hit rate ranks 10th in the AL and 14th in baseball.

☞ Correa ranks 10th in baseball in batting average off fastballs at .358 (38-for-106)... additionally, Luis Arraez ranks first at .397 (52-for-131) and Gilberto Celestino ranks second at .387 (24-for-62) — minimum 500 pitches.

**LUKEY FROM A TO Z:** Luis Arraez enters tonight riding an 0-for-his-last-9, one at-bat short of his season-long of 0-for-10, done May 31-June 3...his last hit was a seventh-inning home run on Tuesday vs. the Guardians, going 0-for-4 in two straight games since...the last time he went more than two straight games without a hit was September 9-12, 2021, going 0-for-11 over a three-game span... regardless of the slide, he is still leading baseball in batting average (.349), nine points ahead of Paul Goldschmidt (.340) and on-base percentage (.426), three points ahead of Goldschmidt (.423).

☞ Also, he has struck out just 20 times in 249 plate appearances and posted a 8.5 swing and miss %, tied with Steven Kwan for best in baseball...he has swung at 433 pitches this season and missed just 37 times.

**WIN-NESOTA:** Twins have gone 21-16 at home this season, tied with Toronto (21-14) for the third-most home wins in the AL, trailing New York (30-7) and Tampa Bay (22-15)...in their last 13 home games, the Twins are hitting .295 (136-for-461) with 24 doubles, 24 home runs, a .512 slugging percentage and an .867 OPS.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .363 (45-for-113) in home games this season, the second-best in the AL...Gio Urshela is hitting .302 (35-for-116) at home, the 11th-best in the AL.

- ☞ Tonight will be Bundy's second career start and appearance against Colorado...first since July 27, 2016 (with Baltimore).
- ☞ Is making his fifth home start this season, going 2-0, 2.29 ERA (19.2 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and 13 strikeouts so far.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).
- ☞ Is 8-9, 4.94 ERA (94.2 IP, 52 ER) in 18 career Interleague games (17 starts).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his fourth victory of the season and first since April 23 vs. Chicago-AL...tossed a season-high 8.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits with no walks and seven strikeouts in a 11-1 Twins victory against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field on June 18...marked the longest outing by a Twins starter this season; Joe Ryan, Sonny Gray and Devin Smeltzer all had 7.0-inning outings... Bundy's outing also marked his longest since August 6, 2020 at Seattle (with Los Angeles-AL), where he pitched a complete game (W, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 10 K)...his seven strikeouts also set a season high, marking his highest since April 6, 2021 vs. Houston (10 K, with Los Angeles-AL).

- ☞ His start marked the first appearance by a Twins starter with least 8.0 innings pitched, one-or-fewer runs allowed and seven-or-more strikeouts since Kenta Maeda on August 18, 2020 vs. Milwaukee.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Did not factor into the decision against the New York Yankees on June 9 at Target Field...tossed 4.0 innings, allowing four runs on five hits, with one walk and one strikeout in a 10-7 Twins defeat...had allowed six home runs in his last four starts, after allowing four home runs in his six starts prior...his one strikeout marked his lowest in a start since June 28, 2021 at New York-AL (w/ Los Angeles-AL, 0 K)...also marked his fourth career start with one-or-fewer strikeouts.

**ROCKING UP THAT HILL:** Bundy is making his second career start and appearance against the Rockies this evening...was dealt the loss in his only other start on July 27, 2016 (with Baltimore), after tossing 5.2 innings, allowing three runs on two hits with one walk and eight strikeouts in a 3-1 Orioles defeat...is a career 4-7, 5.28 ERA (58.0 IP, 34 ER) with 23 walks and 58 strikeouts in 12 career appearances (11 starts) against National League West opponents.

**INTERLEAGUE:** Bundy will be making his 19th career appearance (18th start) in Interleague Play tonight...is a career 8-9, 4.94 ERA (94.2 IP, 52 ER) with 34 walks and 91 strikeouts when facing the National League...in his first seven career appearances (six starts) vs. NL opponents, he went 4-2, 2.39 ERA (37.2 IP, 10 ER), allowing two-or-fewer runs allowed in five of those seven outings...since then, he is 4-7, 6.63 ERA (57.0 IP, 42 ER) in 11 starts

**ON TARGET AT HOME:** Bundy will be making his fifth start at Target Field this season...has pitched well when facing opponents at home this season, going 2-0, 2.29 ERA (19.2 IP, 5 ER) with three walks, 13 strikeouts and a .203 opponent batting average (15-for-74)...has shown opposite numbers on the road this season, going 2-3, 6.82 ERA (34.1 IP, 26 ER) with seven walks, 31 strikeouts and a .315 opponent batting average (46-for-146) in seven starts.

- ☞ In his career, Bundy has posted slightly better numbers at home than on the road, going 25-32, 4.60 ERA (446.0 IP, 228 ER) with 132 walks and 411 strikeouts in 92 home appearances (78 starts)...compares to 25-28, 4.92 ERA (378.2 IP, 207 ER) with 135 walks and 391 strikeouts in 80 road appearances (66 starts).

**WALKING IN STYLE:** Allowed just one walk combined in his first three starts of the season; has walked at least one batter in six of his last eight starts (9 BB total)...even with his last eight starts, his walks overall equate to a career-low 4.3 walk percentage...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (34.5%) and first-pitch strike percentage (68.1%).

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** According to Baseball Savant, Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 11 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, sinker, changeup, curveball and slider...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

**STARTING OFF RIGHT:** Bundy went 3-0, 0.59 ERA (15.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his first three starts this season, from April 11-23.

- ☞ Became the eighth pitcher since the current mound distance was set in 1893 to have one-or-fewer runs allowed and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his first three appearances (all starts) of the season (*Elias*).
- ☞ Became the third pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) to toss at least 5.0 innings, allow one-or-fewer runs and walk one-or-fewer batters in each of his first three starts of the season, joining Johan Santana in 2003 and Bill Krueger in 1992 (*Elias*).
- ☞ Posted the third lowest ERA (0.59) in Twins history within a pitcher's first three starts of the season...trailed only Fernando Romero (0.54 ERA, 5/2-5/13/18) and Ervin Santana (0.41 ERA, 4/3-4/14/17).

**CAREER NOTES**

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts.
- In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes.
- Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhardt Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season.
- Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City.
- Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th).
- Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta.
